

25 Earrings to Crochet



Crochet Mon Cherie 's Basic Pattern Information

Difficulty Levels:

- = Beginner
- = Easy
- = Intermediate
- = Expert

Materials Needed for every design:

- # 10 Cotton Crochet Thread
- 1.5 mm Crochet Hook
- Fishhook Earring Posts

Materials needed for shaping and stiffening:

- Fabric Stiffener for medium level of stiffness
- Modge Podge for extreme level of stiffness (recommended for loops and thin earring designs)
- Straight Pins (for shaping/blocking)
- Cardboard/block or other surface you can use the straight pins in during the shaping process

Pattern Notes:

- Check each pattern for additional materials needed prior to beginning.
- Weave in loose ends as work progresses.
- Work should be blocked/shaped and stiffened once completed to maintain the desired appearance.
- We recommend hand washing, laying flat to dry, and reblocking with all handmade items when necessary.
- We recommend *Aleene's Stiffen Quik* for a medium level of stiffness and a thin layer of

Modge Podge for a high level of stiffness (especially for thin designs and designs that can't hold their shape on their own).

- Dimensions are not included for designs measuring less than 2 inches

Stitches used in this book:

Magic Ring – *there are many tutorials available online if you are unfamiliar with the magic ring.*

ch - chain

sl st - slip stitch

sc - single crochet

hdc - half double crochet

dc - double crochet

tr - treble crochet

dtr - double treble

Ttr – triple treble (*see special stitches*)

Qtr – Quadruple Treble (*see special stitches*)

p – picot (*see special stitches*)

Special Stitches:

Triple treble (Ttr): yo 4 times, insert hook in stitch indicated, draw up a loop, (yo, pull through 2 loops) 5 times.

Quadruple treble (Qtr): yo 5 times, insert hook in stitch indicated, draw up a loop, (yo, pull through 2 loops) 6 times

Picot: ch 3, slst in third ch from hook.




Finishing:

Finish off. Weave in ends.

Shape as desired and pin in place, then stiffen. Follow label instructions on your selected stiffening product. **Don't skip the shaping and stiffening; it makes all the difference!** 😊 Using pliers, open and attach earring hook to topmost stitch. Make sure to go through two thicknesses of thread for strength.

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Earring Design #1 “Take the Helm”:



Difficulty Level:

●●●○ = Intermediate

Round 1: Ch4. Working in first ch: dc, (ch2, 2dc) 3 times, ch2, join with slst to top of ch4.

Round 2: Ch3, dc in next dc, (ch2, 2 dc in next ch sp, ch2, 1dc in each of next 2 dc) 3 times, ch2, 2dc in next ch sp, ch2, join with slst to top of ch3.

Round 3: Sc in same st, sc in next dc, [(sc, picot, sc) in ch sp, 1 sc in each of next two sts] around, ending with (sc, picot, sc) in ch sp, join with slst. Finish off.

Finishing: Follow finishing instructions as explained on page 2.

Earring Design #2 – Lacey Circles:

Difficulty Level: ●●○○ = Easy

Dimensions: 2 Inches (not including earring post)

Optional – use stitch markers to help keep track of rounds easier.

Foundation ring: Ch10, join with slst in first ch to form a ring.

Row 1: Ch3 (counts as a dc), 21 dc in ring. Join with slst to third ch of beginning ch-3.

Row 2: (Ch3, slst in next dc) around.

Rows 3-6: (Ch3, slst in next ch-sp) around. Finish off.

Finishing: Follow finishing instructions as explained on page 2



Earring Design #3 “Golden Loops”:

Difficulty Level:

●●●○ = Intermediate

Ch6, join to form ring.

Round 1: Ch3 (counts as dc here and throughout), dc in each st around, join with slst to top of beginning ch3.

Consecutive Rounds: Repeat round 1 until work is 5 ½” long or long enough to make your desired size earring.

Joining: Loop earring around so you can join the final row with the very first row. Slst in each st around, making sure to go through the stitch in the final row and its corresponding stitch in the first row. (6 slsts). Finish off.

Finishing: Follow finishing instructions as explained on page 2.



Earring Design #4 “Golden Rimmed Bells”:

Difficulty Level: ●●●○= Intermediate

**Note: Two thread colors are used in this pattern (white and gold). **



Foundation Ring: With white thread: Ch6, join with slst in first ch to form ring.

Row 1: (Right Side) Ch3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), 8dc in ring, push sts together. (9 dc)

Row 2: Turn, ch1, sc in same st and in each st across. (9 sc)

Row 3: Turn, ch3, dc in next st and in each st across. (9 dc)

Row 4: Repeat row 2 (9 sc)

Row 5: Turn, ch2 (counts as hdc), hdc in next st and in each st across. (9chdc)

Row 6: Repeat row 2. (9 sc)

Row 7: Turn, ch4 (counts as tr), tr in same st, ch1, 2tr in each of next 7 sts, ch1, 2tr in next st, finish off. (18 tr)

Row 8: With right side facing, join gold thread in first tr of row 7, sc in first 2tr, skip ch sp, sc in each of next 7tr, ch4, slst in fourth ch from hook, sc in each of next 7 tr, skip ch-sp, sc in last 2tr. Finish off.

Finishing: Follow finishing instructions as explained on page 2.

Earring Design #5 “Snowflake Flower”:

Difficulty Level: ●●○○= Easy

Round 1: Ch6, join to form ring.

Round 2: Ch3, 2dc in ring, (ch3, 3dc in ring) 5 times, ch3, slst in top of beginning-ch-3.
(6 ch spaces made)

Round 3: Ch1, sc in same st, skip next st, sc in next st, (5sc in ch sp, 1sc in next st, skip next st, 1sc in next st) 5 times, 5sc in ch sp, join with slst to first st of round. Finish off.

Finishing: Follow finishing instructions as explained on page 2.



Earring Design #6 “Green Double Loops”:



Difficulty Level:

Intermediate

Dimensions: 2”

(not including earring post)

Note: On Row 2 of the inner and outer rings, the number of single crochets is recommended as a guideline. Use more or less single crochets until the ring is full and the stitches are tight together.

Beginning Ring:

Ch4, join with slst in first ch to form ring.

Round 1: ch1, 7sc in ring, join with slst to first sc.

Inner Ring:

Row 1: ch20, skip two sts of beginning ring, slst in next st.

Row 2: Turn, 30sc around inner ring, slst in next 2sts of beginning ring.

Outer Ring

Row 1: Turn, ch40, skip inner ring, slst in next stitch.

Row 2: Turn, 60sc around outer ring, slst in in same st of beginning ring that was used to begin the outer ring.

Finishing: Follow finishing instructions as explained on page 2.

Earring Design #7 “Christmas Trees”:



Difficulty Level: ●●●○ = Intermediate

Place desired bead on thread prior to beginning to crochet.

Row 1: Ch5, (tr, ch2, 2tr) in first ch.

Row 2: Turn, slst in same st, slst in next st and in ch sp. Working in chain space: ch4 (counts as tr), 2tr, ch3, 3tr.

Row 3: Turn, slst in same st, slst in next 2 sts and in ch sp. Working in chain space: ch4, 3tr, ch1, slide bead close to hook, ch2, 4tr. Finish off.

Finishing: Follow finishing instructions on page 2.

Earring Design #8 “Pineapple Classic”:

Difficulty Level: Intermediate

Dimensions: 2 Inches (not including earring post)

●●●○ = Intermediate

Row 1: Ch4, (dc, ch2, 2dc, ch2, 2dc) in first ch.


Row 2: Turn, slst in ch sp, ch3, (dc, ch2, 2dc) in same ch sp, ch3, (2dc, ch2, 2dc) in next ch sp.

Row 3: Turn, slst in ch sp, ch3, (dc, ch2, 2dc) in same ch sp, (ch2, dc, ch3, dc, ch2) in next ch sp, (2dc, ch2, 2dc) in next ch sp.

Row 4: Turn, slst in ch sp, ch3, (dc, ch2, 2dc) in same ch sp, ch2, skip ch sp, (dc, ch1) 5 times in ch3-sp, ch1, skip ch sp, (2dc, ch2, 2dc) in last ch sp.

Row 5: Turn, slst in ch sp, ch3, (dc, ch2, 2dc) in same ch sp, ch2, skip ch2-sp, (sc in next dc, ch3) 4 times, sc in next dc, ch 2, skip ch2-sp, (2dc, ch2, 2dc) in last ch sp.

Row 6: Turn, slst in ch sp, ch3, (dc, ch2, 2dc) in same ch sp,



ch2, skip ch2-sp, (sc in next ch-sp, ch3) 3 times, sc in next ch-sp, ch2, skip ch2-sp, (2dc, ch2, 2dc) in last ch sp.

Row 7: Turn, slst in ch sp, ch3, (dc, ch2, 2dc) in same ch sp, ch2, skip ch2-sp, (sc in next ch-sp, ch3) 2 times, sc in next ch-sp, ch2, skip ch2-sp, (2dc, ch2, 2dc) in last ch sp.

Row 8: Turn, slst in ch sp, ch3, (dc, ch2, 2dc) in same ch sp, ch2, skip ch2-sp, sc in next ch-sp, ch3, sc in next ch-sp, ch2, skip ch2-sp, (2dc, ch2, 2dc) in last ch sp.

Row 9: Turn, slst in ch sp, ch3, (dc, ch2, 2dc) in same ch sp, ch2, skip ch2-sp, sc in next ch-sp, ch2, skip ch2-sp, (2dc, ch2, 2dc) in last ch sp.

Row 10: Turn, slst in ch sp, ch3, (dc, ch2, 2dc) in same ch sp, (2dc, ch2, 2dc) in last ch sp.

Row 11: Turn, slst in ch sp, ch2, dc in last ch sp.

Finishing: Follow finishing instructions as explained on page 2.

Earring Design #9 “Small Pineapples”:

Difficulty Level:

●●○○ = Easy

Ch8, join to form ring.

Round 1: Ch3 (counts as dc), 15dc in ring, join in 3rd chain of beginning ch-3.

Row 1: (Ch3, slst in next st) 5 times.

Row 2: Turn, (Ch3, slst in next ch space) 5 times.

Rows 3-4: Repeat row 2.

Row 5: Turn, slst in ch sp, (ch3, slst in next ch sp) 4 times.

Row 6: Turn, slst in ch sp, (ch3, slst in next ch sp) 3 times.

Row 7: Turn, slst in ch sp, (ch3, slst in next ch sp) 2 times.

Row 8: Turn, slst in ch sp, ch4, slst in next ch sp. Finish off.

Finishing: Follow finishing instructions as explained on page 2.



Earring Design #10 “Sailboat Lace”:

Difficulty Level: ●●○○= Easy

Dimensions: 2 Inches (not including earring post)

Ch10, join with slst in first ch to form a ring.

Foundation ring: Ch3 (counts as a dc), 23dc in ring.
Join with slst to third ch of beginning ch-3.

Row 1: (Ch3, slst in next dc) 12 times.

Row 2: Turn, (ch3, slst in next dc) 12 times.

Rows 3-4: Repeat row 2.

Row 5: Turn, (ch3, slst in next dc) 12 times, ch14, Ttr in top most dc of foundation ring, ch14, join with slst to first st of row 4. Finish off.

Finishing: Follow finishing instructions as explained on page 2



Earring Design #11 “Tea Cup Flowers”:

Difficulty Level: ●●○○= Easy

Magic Ring

Rnd 1: (Ch4, sc) 6 times in ring. Pull ring tight.
6 loops made.

Rnd 2: (Sc, 4dc, sc) in each loop. Slst to first sc of round. Finish off.

Finishing: Follow finishing instructions as explained on page 2.



Earring Design #12 “Fans”:

Difficulty Level: ●●○○= Easy

Dimensions: 2.5 Inches (not including earring post)

Ch10, join with slst in first ch to form a ring.

Round 1: Ch3 (counts as a dc), 23dc in ring. Join with slst to third ch of beginning-ch3.

Row 1: (Ch3, slst in next dc) 12 times.

Row 2: Turn, (ch3, slst in next dc) 12 times.

Rows 3-5: Repeat row 2. Finish off.

Finishing: Follow finishing instructions on page 2

Variants:

For smaller size end at rows 2, 3, or 4.

For larger size repeat row 2 for five rows rather than three.

For a different look, turn, so ring is the top of the earring.



Earring Design #13 “Shades of Grey Granny Square”:

Difficulty Level: ●●○○= Easy

*Note: This pattern uses three thread colors.

With first color:

Ch6, join with slst in first ch to form ring.

Round 1: ch2, 2hdc in ring, ch3 (3hdc in ring, ch3) three times, join second color at the same time working a slst to top of beginning-ch2.

Round 2: turn, ch2, (2hdc, ch3, 3hdc) in next ch sp, ch2, *(3hdc, ch3, 3hdc) in next ch sp, ch2; repeat from * around. Join third color with slst to top of beginning-ch2.

Round 3: turn, ch2, 2hdc in next ch sp, ch1, *(3hdc, ch3, 3hdc) in corner ch sp, ch1, ** 3hdc in next ch sp, ch1, repeat from * around, ending at **. Join with slst. Finish off.

Finishing: Follow finishing instructions as explained on page 2.



Earring Design #14 Diamond Spider Web”:



Difficulty Level: ●●●○= Intermediate

Dimensions: 2 Inches (not including earring post)

Row 1: Ch5, 2dc in third ch from hook, leave remaining sts unworked. Turn.

Row 2: Ch2 (counts as dc here and throughout), dc in base of ch2, dc in next dc, 2dc in last dc. Turn.

Row 3: Ch2, dc in base of ch2, dc in next dc, ch5, skip next dc, dc in next dc, 2dc in last dc. Turn.

Row 4: Ch2, dc in each of next 2 dc, ch4, sc in ch5-sp, ch4, dc in each of next 3 dc. Turn.

Row 5: Ch2, dc in each of next 2 dc, ch4, sc in each of next ch4-sp, sc, and last ch4-sp, ch4, dc in each of next 3 dc. Turn.

Row 6: Ch2, dc in each of next 2 dc, ch4, sc in next ch4-sp, sc in each of next three sc and in next ch4-sp, ch4, 1dc in each of next 3 dc. Turn.

Row 7: Ch2, skip next dc, 1dc in next dc, dc in ch4-sp, ch4, skip one sc, sc in each of next three sc, ch4, skip next sc, dc in ch4-sp, dc in next dc, skip one dc, dc in next dc. Turn.

Row 8: Ch2, skip next dc, dc in next dc, dc in ch4-sp, ch4, skip one sc, sc in next sc, ch4, skip next sc, dc in ch4-sp, dc in next dc, skip one dc, dc in last dc. Turn.

Row 9: Ch2, skip next dc, dc in next dc, dc in ch4-sp, ch1, skip next sc, dc in next ch4-sp, dc in next dc, skip one dc, dc in last dc. Turn.

Row 10: Ch2, skip next dc, dc in next dc, dc in ch1-sp, dc in next dc, skip one dc, dc in last dc. Turn.

Row 11: Ch2. (YO, insert hook in next dc, yo pull up loop, yo draw through two loops on hook) 4 times, yo pull through all 5 remaining loops on hook. Finish off.

Finishing: Follow finishing instructions as explained on page 2.



Earring Design #15 “Two Toned Tear Drops”:



Difficulty Level: ●●●○= Intermediate

Two colors needed

With Color A: Ch15, join with slst in first ch to form ring.

Round 1: Sc in each st around. Join using color B with slst to first st of round. (15sts)

Round 2: Slst in same st, Working in each st around: slst, sc, sc, 2hdc, 2dc, 2tr, 2tr, 2tr, 2dc, 2hdc, sc, sc, slst, slst. Join with slst in first st of round. Finish off. **Finishing:** Follow finishing instructions as explained on page 2.

Earring Design #16 “Tear Drops”:

Difficulty Level: ●●●○= Intermediate

Ch 15, join with slst in first ch to form ring.

Working in each st around: slst, slst, sc, sc, 2hdc, 2dc, 2tr, 2tr, 2tr, 2dc, 2hdc, sc, sc, slst, slst. Join with slst. Finish off.

Finishing: Follow finishing instructions on page 2.



Earring Design #17 “Silver Bars”:

Difficulty Level: ●○○○= Beginner

Chain until you have a 2.5-inch chain.

Row 1: Hdc in third chain from hook and in each st across, ch2, turn.

Row 2: Working in front loops only, hdc in each st across. Finish off.

Finishing: Follow finishing instructions as explained on page 2.

Earring Design #18 “Leaf Motif”:

Difficulty Level: ●●●○= Intermediate

Special Stitches:

Dc cluster- (yo, insert hook in st indicated, yo, draw up loop, yo, pull through two loops on hook) 3 times, yo pull through remaining four loops on hook.

Tr cluster - (yo twice, insert hook in st indicated, yo, draw up loop, yo pull through two loops, yo, pull through two loops) 3 times, yo, pull through remaining four loops on hook.

Ch24 (foundation ch made),

Round 1: Dc cluster in 8th ch from hook, ch3, skip 3 sts, dc cluster in next st, ch3, skip 3sts, tr cluster in next st, ch8, skip 3 sts, sc in each of next four sts, 4 sc in next st. Rotate work so you are stitching on the bottom side of the foundation chain.

Sc in each of next 4 sts, ch8, tr cluster in next cluster st, ch3, dc cluster in next cluster st, ch3, dc cluster in next cluster st, ch4, skip 3 sts, slst in next st.

Round 2: Sc in same st and in each st across until you reach the stem. Slst in each st around both sides of stem. Sc in each remaining st until you reach the first st of round 2. Join with slst. Finish off.

Finishing: Follow finishing instructions as explained on page 2.



Earring Design #19 “Picot Tipped Oval”:

Difficulty Level: ●●○○= Easy

Special Stitches: dtr, and Picot – see special stitches on pg 2.

Ch18, join with slst in first ch to form ring.

Round 1: Slst in next st, ch 5. Working in ring: 3dtr, * 2tr, 4dc, 5hdc, 4dc, 2tr, 4dtr, picot, ** 4dtr, repeat from * to **, slst in top of ch 5.

Finish off.

Finishing: Follow finishing instructions on page 2.

Earring Design #20 “Precious Metal Circles”:

Difficulty Level: ●●○○= Easy

Note: This pattern uses two colors of thread, silver and gold.

With silver: Begin with a Magic Ring.

Row 1: Ch2, 11 dc in ring, join with slst in top of beginning-ch2. Pull magic ring tight and secure tail.

Row 2: ch2, dc in same st, 2dc in each st around. Join. Finish off.

With gold:

Repeat as above, ending with row 1. Finish off.

When attaching these to your earring post, make sure the silver circles are placed beneath the golden ones

Finishing: Follow finishing instructions on page 2.



Earring Design #21 “Interlocking Rings”:

Difficulty Level: ●●○○= Easy

Note: this pattern uses three colors of thread.

First ring, with white:

Ch15, join with slst in first chain to form ring.

Round 1: Ch1, 30 sc around ring. Join with slst in first st of round.

Finish off. Spread stitches evenly around and shape into a circle. If desired, stiffen this ring prior to continuing.

Second ring, with light grey thread:

Ch15, place chain through the center of white ring from front to back, slst in first chain to form ring.

Round 1: Ch1, 30 sc around ring. Join with slst in first st of round.

Finish off.

Third ring, with dark grey thread:

Ch15, place chain through the center of light grey ring from front to back, slst in first chain to form ring.

Round 1: Ch1, 30 sc around ring. Join with slst in first st of round.

Finish off.

Finishing: Follow finishing instructions as explained on page 2.



Earring Design #22 “3-Inch Pineapple Drops”:

Difficulty Level: ●●●○= Intermediate

Dimensions: 3 Inches (not including earring post)



Row 1: Ch3, hdc in first ch.

Row 2: Ch2 (counts as hdc here and throughout), turn, 2hdc in next st.

Row 3: Ch2, turn, hdc in each of next 2 sts.

Row 4: Ch2, turn, 2hdc in next st, hdc in next st.

Row 5: Ch2, turn, hdc in next st, ch1, hdc in each of the next two sts.

Row 6: Ch2, turn, hdc in next st, ch2, skip ch sp, hdc in each of the next two sts.

Row 7: Ch2, turn, hdc in next st, ch2, hdc in ch sp, ch 2, hdc in each of the next two sts.

Row 8: Ch2, turn, hdc in next st, ch3, 2dc in next hdc, ch3, hdc in each of the next two sts.

Row 9: Ch2, turn, hdc in next st, ch3, hdc in next dc, ch2, hdc in next dc, ch3, skip ch sp, hdc in each of the next two sts.

Row 10: Ch2, turn, hdc in next st, ch3, hdc in next hdc, ch1, (hdc, ch1, hdc, ch1, hdc, ch1) in center ch sp, hdc in next hdc, ch3, skip ch sp, hdc in each of the next two sts.

Row 11: Ch2, turn, hdc in next st, ch3, (sc in next ch1-sp, ch3) four times, skip ch3-sp, hdc in each of the next two sts.

Row 12: Ch2, turn, hdc in next st, ch3, skip ch sp, (sc in next ch sp, ch3) three times, skip ch3-sp, hdc in each of the next two sts.

Row 13: Ch2, turn, hdc in next st, ch3, skip ch sp, (sc in next ch sp, ch3) two times, skip ch3-sp, hdc in each of the next two sts.

Row 14: Ch2, turn, hdc in next st, ch3, skip ch sp, sc in next ch sp, ch3, skip ch sp, hdc in each of the next two sts.

Row 15: Ch2, turn, hdc in next st, ch5, skip ch spaces, hdc in each of the last two sts.

Row 16: Ch2, turn, hdc in next st, skip ch sp, hdc in each of last two sts.

Row 17: Turn, sc in next st, skip next st, sc in last st.

Row 18: Turn, slst in next st. Finish off.

Finishing: Follow finishing instructions on page 2.

Earring Design #23 “Spoke Drops”:

Difficulty Level:

●●○○ = Easy

Ch8, join to form ring.

Round 1:

Ch3 (counts as dc), 1 dc in ring, join in 3rd chain of beginning-ch3.

Round 2:

Ch5 (counts as dc and a ch2-sp), (dc in next dc, ch2) 7 times, dc in next dc, ch5, slst in next dc, sc in next dc, hdc in next dc, dc in next dc, ch10, dc in next dc, hdc in next dc, sc in next dc, slst in next st. Finish off.

Finishing: Follow finishing instructions on page 2. Using pliers, open and attach earring hook in ch10-loop. Make sure to go around the entire chain rather than a single thickness of thread for strength.



Earring Design #24 “Fruity Pineapples”:

Difficulty Level: ●●○○= Easy

Note: This pattern uses two colors of thread, brown and green.

Foundation Ring: With brown, Ch3, join with slst to form ring.

Round 1: Ch3, 11hdc in ring, join with slst in top of beginning-ch3.

Round 2: Ch2, hdc in same st, 2hdc in each st around. Join with slst in top of beginning ch2.

Round 3: Ch1, sc in next st, 2sc in next st, (sc in each of next 2 sts, 2sc in next st) around, sc in last 2 sts, join green thread in last st.

Leaves: (Ch4, tr in same st, ch4, slst in next st) 3 times. Finish off

Finishing: Follow finishing instructions on page 2.

Earring Design #25 “Maple Leaves”:

Difficulty Level: ●●●○ = Intermediate

Ch4, join with slst to form ring.

Round 1: Ch3, 11dc in ring, join with slst to top of beginning-ch-3.

Round 2: 2Sc in each st around. Join. (24 sts)

Round 3: [Skip one st, (3dc, tr, picot, 3dc) in next st, skip one st, slst in next st] 3 times, [skip one st, (3dc, picot, tr, 3dc) in next st, skip one st, slst in next st] two times.

Stem: Slst in next st, sc in next st, ch6, Slst in second ch from hook and in each st back up the chain, slst in same st as chain and in next st. Finish off.



Finishing: Follow finishing instructions on page 2.

Tips on making your crochet jewelry look great:

Unlike garments that can sometimes be worked loosely for a flowy fabric, with jewelry it is important to keep your stitches tight. (Not so tight that you are fighting with your project, but tighter than you would make a shawl for instance).


In addition, it is important to have consistent tension throughout. Since these are small projects, large variations in tension can quickly cause irregularities when it comes to finishing.

DON'T skip the “finishing.” I can't stress this enough. Finishing includes shaping, blocking, and stiffening. It makes all the difference between mediocre jewelry and professional jewelry. The way you crochet *is* important, but the way you finish is equally if not more so! Here are the steps I take to finish my jewelry:

Finishing Your Jewelry:

1. Using a smaller hook or sewing needle, weave in ends, being careful not to loosen or stretch out your stitches.
2. Wet the earring completely with water and pat out the excess with a paper towel. (This makes the thread more flexible and easy to shape into its final design.)
3. On a blocking board lay the earring out (wrong side facing up) and pull/press/squash into shape as needed to match the images included in this book for each pair of earrings. (Don't be afraid to tug and pull on your thread earrings to get them to cooperate.)
4. Pin the earring to the blocking board, careful to maintain the desired shape.
5. Spray completely with fabric stiffener or paint completely with Mod Podge, being careful to avoid beads. Use fabric stiffener for a light stiffening effect and use Mod Podge for a very stiff effect (especially for designs that need help maintaining their shape). Dry completely. Repeat the fabric stiffening as needed until desired stiffness is achieved!
6. Using jewelry pliers, attach earring posts in top stitch/loop (or stitch mentioned in individual pattern).
7. If earrings begin to lose their shape, repeat the finishing as needed.
