- Color C: baby blue **YarnArt Jeans 75** (50g, 160m)
- Color D: red **YarnArt Jeans 90** (50g, 160m)
- Color E: fuchsia **YarnArt Jeans 59** (50g, 160m)

### Other materials

- Crochet hook size 2.5mm
- 1 pairs of safety eyes size 5mm
- Tapestry needles, brown thread, pins, stitch markers, scissors, polyester fiberfill





Break the yarn, weave in the last 6 sts (pic 4).



Use the crochet hook to push the last 6 rnds inside the body (pic 5&6).

Skip the next 2 sts from the last st on the whale's body (pic 7), join yarn B on, continue to crochet the tail.



### Tail (yarn B)



Break the yarn, weave in the last 5 sts (pic 10).

## INSTRUCTIONS

Use the tapestry needle to sew the remaining sts on the body (pic 11&12).

Insert eyes between rnd 20&21, 17 sts apart (pic 13&14), use white thread to embroider 1 line under the eyes.

Break the yarn with a long rest to sew later. Sew the Fins on the tail & Flippers, Cheeks on both side (pic 15&16).



Break the yarn with a long rest to sew later. Make another 3 pieces the same way, but do not break the yarn on the 4th piece (pic 17), continue to crochet the following rnds:

8	sc 4 on the 4th piece, sc 4 on the 3th piece, sc 4 on the 2nd piece, sc 4 on the 1st piece = 16 sts (pic 18-19-20-21), slst on the 1st st to make a ring (pic 22)	(16)
9	[sc 2, dec] 4x	(12)





Break the yarn, weave in the last 8 sts (pic 23). Join yarn C on the remaining sts of the upper part (pic 24), crochet:

1	sc 16 (4 sts for each piece) (pic 25)	(16)
2	dec 8, stuff firmly	(8)

Break the yarn, weave in the last 8 sts (pic 26). Use tapestry needle to create a dent in the middle of the fountain (pic 27&28). Use your finger to bend each piece (pic 29&30). Put the water fountain inside the hole (pic 31&32).



## Heart (yarn D)

rnd		sts
1	sc 6 into a magic loop	(6)
2	inc 6	(12)
3	[sc 1, inc] 6x	(18)
4-5	sc 18 (2 rnds)	(18)

Break the yarn, make the 2nd piece the same way but do not break the yarn, join with the 1st piece (pic 31), and continue to crochet the following rnds:

6	sc 18 (on the 1st piece), sc 18 (on the 2nd piece)	(36)
7	sc 36	(36)
8	[sc 4, dec] 6x	(30)
9	[sc 3, dec] 6x	(24)
10	[sc 2, dec] 6x, stuff firmly	(18)
11	[sc 1, dec] 3x	(12)
12	dec 6	(6)

Break the yarn, weave in the last 6 sts (pic 34). Put the heart above the water fountain (pic 35), and we have finished the Cupid Whale!

### Yarns

- Color A: white **YarnArt Jeans 01** (50g, 160m)
- Color B: grey **YarnArt Jeans 46** (50g, 160m)
- Color C: blue **YarnArt Jeans 33** (50g, 160m)
- Color D: pink **Gazzal Baby Cotton 3435** (50g, 165m)
- Color E: orange **Gazzal Baby Cotton 3416** (50g, 165m)

### Other materials

- Crochet hook size 2.5mm
- 2 pairs of safety eyes size 5mm
- Tapestry needles, brown thread, pins, stitch markers, scissors, polyester fiberfill



Do not break the yarn, use a piece of yarn A–15cm (same color with the muzzle, I use the blue yarn to illustrate more clearly) to pull through the middle st of rnd 3 as pic 3, stuff slightly, pull the yarn slowly to make the dent on the muzzle (pic 4), then tighten the string (pic 5). Repeat the same with the 2 eye dents (pic 6-7), insert safety eyes between rnd 7&8 (pic 8), continue to crochet the following rnds:


Use pins to locate the nose (pic 10). Separate the pink yarn/thread as pic 11, use a single thread to embroider the nose (pic 12).

Use brown thread to sew the nose & black thread to sew the eyebrows (pic 13). Embroider 3 French Knots on each cheek (search Youtube for French Knot if you do not know how to make this st). Sew the tongue on the dent we created before (pic 14).



Break the yarn, sew 2 edges together.

3	[dec, sc 6] 2x (14)

Break the yarn, sew 2 edges together. Sew flippers & tail fins as pic 15&16.







- Color B: white **YarnArt Jeans 01** (50g, 160m)
- Color C: yellow **YarnArt Jeans 35** (50g, 160m)
- Color D: green **YarnArt Jeans 60** (50g, 160m)

### Other materials

- Crochet hook size 2.5mm
- 1 pair of 5mm safety eyes
- Tapestry needles, black thread, pins, stitch markers, scissors, polyester fiberfill

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<b>Rnds</b>	Rounds
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<b>Double Tr</b>	Double Treble - <i>it's just like Treble st, but you yarn over 3 times (4 loops on the hook)</i>

## INSTRUCTIONS

### Body (yarn A)

rnd		sts
1	sc 6 into a magic loop	(6)
2-6	sc 6 (5 rnds)	(6)
7	inc, sc 5	(7)
8	sc 7	(7)

Break the yarn, make the 2nd piece the same way but do not break the yarn, **ch 3** and join with the 1st piece (pic 1&2), and continue to crochet the following rnds:

13	sc 9 (on the 1st piece), sc 3 (on the 3 chs), sc 9 (on the 2nd piece), sc 3 (on the 3 chs)	(24)
14	[sc 3, inc] 6x	(30)

Do not break the yarn, leave it here (pic 3). If you make this toy for babies, you should not put the wire inside, please move the rnd 18 to continue crocheting. But if you want the eyes can be bendable, following these steps:

Stuff slightly the eyes (pic 4), use a plastic coated wire-about 7-8cm (pic 5), push the wire into the eyes and then continue to stuff firmly (pic 6), and make a knot as pic 7 to fix the wire. Repeat the same for the 2nd eye (pic 8), now we can bend the eyes (pic 9). Continue to crochet:





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## MATERIALS

### Yarns

- Color A: light yellow **YarnArt Jeans 67** (50g, 160m)
- Color B: dark green **YarnArt Jeans 52** (50g, 160m)
- Color C: orange **Madame Cotton 07** (100g, 280m)
- Color D: white **YarnArt Jeans 01** (50g, 160m)
- Color E: blue **YarnArt Jeans 33** (50g, 160m)
- Color F: red **YarnArt Jeans 90** (50g, 160m)

### Other materials

- Crochet hook size 2.5mm
- 1 pairs of safety eyes size 5mm
- Tapestry needles, brown thread, pins, stitch markers, scissors, polyester fiberfill





Do not break the yarn, slst 54 on the blo sts of rnd 16 (pic 12-13), stuffing firmly along crocheting (pic 14), hide the remaining yarn (pic 15-16). Wear the shell on the body (pic 17).

### Front Legs (yarn A, X2)



3	[sc 1, inc] 6x	(18)

5	sc 24	(24)
6	ch 1, fold the legs in half, crochet 2 edges together, sc 12	(12)

Break the yarn with a long rest to sew later.

### Behind Legs (yarn A, X2)

rnd		sts
1	sc 6 into a magic loop	(6)
2	inc 6	(12)
3	[sc 1, inc] 6x	(18)
4	sc 18	(18)
5	ch 1, fold the legs in half, crochet 2 edges together, sc 9	(9)

Break the yarn with a long rest to sew later.



Sew 2 fronts legs & behind legs on the body (pic 18-19).

### Belly (yarn D)

1	sc 6 into a magic loop	(6)
2	inc 6	(12)
3	[sc 1, inc] 6x	(18)
4	[sc 1, inc, sc 1] 6x	(24)
5	[sc 3, inc] 6x	(30)
6	[sc 2, inc, sc 2] 6x	(36)
7	[sc 5, inc] 6x	(42)
8	sc 42	(42)

Break the yarn, sew the belly on the body (pic 20).

### Eyes (yarn D, X2)

rnd		sts
1	sc 5 into a magic loop	(5)
2	inc 5	(10)
3	[sc 1, inc] 5x	(15)
4-5	sc 15 (2 rnds), break yarn D, change to yarn A, turn (pic 21)	(15)
6-7	sc 15 (2 rnds) (pic 22-23)	(15)

Break the yarn with a long rest to sew later, fold the eyes as pic 24. Sew 2 eyes on the head (pic 25).



### Captain's Hat (yarn D)

rnd		sts
1	sc 6 into a magic loop	(6)
2	[sc 1, inc] 3x	(9)
3	[sc 1, inc, sc 1] 3x	(12)
4	[sc 3, inc] 3x	(15)
5	[sc 2, inc, sc 2] 3x	(18)
6	[sc 5, inc] 3x, break yarn D, change to yarn E, turn (pic 26)	(21)
7	[sc 3, inc, sc 3] 3x	(24)
8	sc 24	(24)

Break the yarn with a long rest to sew later, fold the hat as pic 28. Sew the hat on the head (pic 29).




4	(blo) (sc 3) on the 1st st, sc 7, (sc 3) on the next st, sc 7, (sc 3) on the last st, ch 1, turn	(23)
5	(blo) (sc 3) on the 1st st, sc 10, (sc 3) on the next st, sc 10, (sc 3) on the last st, ch 1, turn	(30)

Break the yarn (pic 30), crochet 26 chs, start on the 2nd st from the hook, slst 25, join with the scarf (pic 31), continue to crochet sc across the scarf (pic 32), ch 26, start on the 2nd st from the hook, slst 25, break the yarn, hide the remaining yarn (pic 33).

Join yarn D on the 6th rnd of the scarf (pic 34), slst 36, break the yarn, hide the remaining yarn, wrong side: pic 35, right side: pic 36.

## CROCHETING TIPS

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### 1. What is X-shape stitch/V-shape stitch? Which one is better?

X-shape stitch or V-shape stitch depends on the way you pull the yarn through the loop. If you yarn over the hook from back to front, you're making a V-shape stitch. If you yarn under the hook, then it's a X-shape stitch. Both ways are fine, you can crochet whichever you find easier.

V-shape stitch helps your amigurumi look bigger, while X-shape stitch makes your amigurumi more beautiful and helps to make the amigurumi tighter.

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### 2. Right side vs wrong side? Which one is correct?

You can see the difference between the right side and wrong side in the photos bellow.

When you crochet mini-sized toys/dolls, it is unable to turn the sides. Therefore, it is normal having the wrong side out.

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### 3. Hide the yarn

For the remaining yarn, you can use a tapestry needle and weave it vertically through stitches. Repeat a couple times to make sure it stays firmly.




**4. How to count stitches?**

Do not count the stitch on the hook.

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**Chain 6, start from 2nd chain on the hook**

For the oval shapes ( arms and legs parts of this book)

Chain 6



Start from the 5th stitch



Follow the instruction



On last chain, we often crochet three stitches



Continue crochet on other side



We finish the 1st rnd



**5. How to change the yarn color correctly?**

Before changing the yarn color, there are two loops on the hook.



Take the yarn (you want to change) through both loop.



Change the color as instructed.



## CROCHETING TIPS

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
### 6. Invisible Decrease

Normal decrease (photo bellow) will make a large hole, so we should use invisible decrease. Just crochet on front loop only.

Pull the yarn through two front loops



Pull the yarn through two loop



Pull the yarn through two remaining loops



### 7. Weave in the remaining 6 sts on the last rnd

After you finish crochet



Use a tapestry needle and weave over remaining sts.



Pull the yarn to close and hide the remaining yarn.



### 8. Finishing

There are a loop like photo bellow



Pull the yarn through last stitch
