

# Baby Bears

Pattern Step by Step



# Wellcome!!

## Suggestions before starting

- Make sure that the crocheting is tense so that the filling is not visible. For that it's better to work with a hook of 1 or 2 points less the size it's used to crochet. the amigurumi technique requires tension.
- Stuff with polyester filling until it's firm, though the crochet is tense at the beginning, it will yield
- The yarn thickness will change noticeably the size of your toys
- Remember that there are 3 factors that modify your crochet (size, tension, etc):
  - \*the hook size
  - \*the yarn tickness
  - \*the crocheter's hand (every person crochets with diferent tension)

## Pattern

### Materials:

- Hooks size 2mm / 3.5mm / 4mm / 5mm.
- 100grs of medium cotton yarn (blue/pink/beige).
- 100grs of Himalaya Baby Dolphin (blue/pink/beige/grey).
- Small amount of embroidery thread.
- Polyester fiberfill stuffing.
- Scissors
- Tapestry needle.
- Embriodery needle.



### Abbreviations:

- ssl: slip stitch
- sc: single crochet
- hdc: half double crochet
- dc: double crochet
- inc: 2 single crochet stitches in the same stitch
- dec: 2 single crochet stitches together
- ch: chain
- FLO: front loop only
- BLO: back loop only

### Toys Sizes:

- Bears: 20 cm tall.
- Blanket: 27 x 27 cm.
- Bassinet: 27 cm (measuring from outside) or 24 cm (measuring from inside).



## Feet x2

With beige yarn and hook size 2mm

**1 rnd:** 6 sc in a magic ring (6)

**2 rnd:** 6 inc (12)

**3 rnd:** 1 sc, 1 inc (18)

**4 - 5 rnds:** 18 sc (2 rounds) (18)

**6 rnd:** 3 dec, 12 sc (15)

**7 rnd:** 15 sc (15)

**8 rnd:** 3 dec, 9 sc (12)

**9 - 10 rnds:** 12 sc (2 rounds) (12)

**Stuff only the bottom, the rest of the leg is empty.**

**11 rnd:** 4 sc, 1 dec (10)

**12 - 15 rnds:** 10 sc (4 rounds) (10)

**16 rnd:** fold the edge flat and close with 5 sc.



## Arms x2

with hook size 2mm

**1 rnd:** 6 sc in a magic ring (6)

**2 rnd:** 6 inc (12)

**3 rnd:** 12 sc (12)

**4 rnd:** 3 dec, 6 sc (9)

**5 rnd:** 2 dec, 5 sc (7)

**6 rnd:** 7 sc (7)

**7 - 17 rnds:** 7 sc (11 rounds) (7)

**18 rnd:** fold the edge flat and crochet 3 sc

Stuff only the hand, the rest of the arm is empty.



## Body

With hook size 2mm

**1 rnd:** 6 sc in a magic ring (6)

**2 rnd:** 6 inc (12)

**3 rnd:** 1 sc, 1 inc (18)

**4 rnd:** 2 sc, 1 inc (24)

**5 rnd:** 3 sc, 1 inc (30)

**6 rnd:** 4 sc, 1 inc (36)

**7 rnd:** 5 sc, 1 inc (42)

**8 rnd:** 6 sc, 1 inc (48) **(Photo 1)**

**9 rnd:** 48 sc (48)

**10 rnd:** Place the legs and work 5 sc together with the body, 19 sc, 5 sc with the other leg, 19 sc (48) **(Photos 2 -4)**

**11 - 14:** 48 sc (4 rounds) (48)

**15 rnd:** 6 sc, 1 dec (42)

**16 rnd:** 42 sc (42)

**17 rnd:** 5 sc, 1 dec (36)

**18 rnd:** 36 sc (36)

**19 rnd:** 4 sc, 1 dec (30)

**20 rnd:** 30 sc (30)

**21 rnd:** 3 sc, 1 dec (24)

**22 rnd:** 24 sc (24)

**23 rnd:** 2 sc, 1 dec (18)

Stuff the body.

**24 rnd:** place the arms and work 3 sc together with the body, 6 sc, 3 sc with the other arm and 6 sc (18) **(Photo 5)**

**25 rnd:** 18 sc (18)

**26 rnd:** 1 sc, 1 dec (12)

**27 rnd:** 12 sc **(Photo 6)**



## Head

(Continue from the body)

**1 rnd:** 12 inc (24)

**2 rnd:** 3 sc, 1 inc (30) **(Photo7)**

**3 rnd:** 4 sc, 1 inc (36)

**4 rnd:** 5 sc, 1 inc (42)

**5 rnd:** 6 sc, 1 inc (48)

**6 rnd:** 7 sc, 1 inc (54)

**7 - 8 rnds:** 54 sc (3 rounds) (54) **(Photo 8)**

**9 rnd:** 8 sc, 1 inc (60)

**10 - 17 rnds:** 60 sc (8 rounds) (60)

**18 rnd:** 8 sc, 1 dec (54)

**19 rnd:** 7 sc, 1 dec (48)

**20 rnd:** 6 sc, 1 dec (42)

**21 rnd:** 5 sc, 1 dec (36)

**22 rnd:** 4 sc, 1 dec (30)

**23 rnd:** 3 sc, 1 dec (24)

**24 rnd:** 2 sc, 1 dec (18)

Stuff the head firmly.

**25 rnd:** 1 sc, 1 dec (12)

**26 rnd:** 6 dec (6) **(Photo 9)**

Close the hole with the sewing needle.



## Ears x2

With hook size 2mm

- 1 rnd: 6 sc in a magic ring (6)
- 2 rnd: 6 inc (12)
- 3 rnd: 1 sc, 1 inc (18)
- 4 - 5 rnds: 18 sc (2 rounds) (18)
- 6 rnd: 1 sc, 1 dec (12)
- 7 rnd: fold the edge flatt and crochet 6 sc.  
Leave a long yarn tail to sew.



## Tail

With hook size 2mm

- 1 rnd: 6 sc in a magic ring (6)
  - 2 rnd: 6 inc (12)
  - 3 rnd: 1 sc, 1 inc (18)
  - 4 rnd: 18 sc (18)
  - 5 rnd: 1 sc, 1 dec (12)
  - 6 rnd: 4 sc, 1 dec (10)
- Leave a long yarn tail to sew.  
Stuff a little bit. Sew it between rounds 5 - 8  
of the body.



## Pacifier

with hook size 3.5mm

- 1 rnd: Magic ring, ch 2, 11 hdc, close with a ssl (12)
- 2 rnd: 12 sc FLO (12)

Pacifier ring: ch 6, 1 ssl.



## Overall

With medium coton yarn and hook size 3.5mm

**1 rnd:** ch 17 + ch 2, 17 hdc, join ends with ssl (18)



**2 - 3 rnds:** ch 2, 17 hdc, 1 ssl (18)

Cut the yarn and make another piece.



**4 rnd:** 1 ssl in the ending of the first leg (**Photos 5 - 6**), ch 2, 17 hdc around the first round (**Photos 7 - 8**), keep crocheting in the second leg and finish with 1 ssl (36)



**5 - 10 rnds:** ch 2, 35 hdc (6 rounds) (36)

Mark 9 st in the front center, 9 st in the sides and 9 st in the back center. **(Photo 12)**



**11 rnd:** start from the front center, ch 2, 8 hdc **(Photo 13)** (9)

**12 - 13 rnds:** ch 2, 8 hdc **(Photo 14)** (2 rounds)



Crochet the straps: ch 12 from one side of the front, 1 ssl in the the back (Photo 15).  
Cut the yarn and crochet the other strap the same way (Photos 16 - 17).



Hide the yarn

In the edge of the legs, crochet 18 ssl (Photo 19).



Dress the overall as it shows in the pictures.



Sew the tail over rounds 6 - 7 of the overall, in the center of the back.



## Beanie

With hook size 3.5mm

**1 rnd:** 6 sc in a magic ring (6)

**2 rnd:** 6 inc (12)

**3 rnd:** 1 sc, 1 inc (18)

**4 rnd:** 2 sc, 1 inc (24)

**5 rnd:** 3 sc, 1 inc (30)

**6 rnd:** 4 sc, 1 inc (36)

**7 rnd:** 5 sc, 1 inc (42)

**8 - 11 rnds:** 42 sc (4 rounds) (42)

**12 rnd:** 38 sc, turn (leave 4 stitches unused)

From now on you will not crochet in spiral.

**13 rnd:** ch 1, BLO all the round, 7 sc, 6 ch, skip 6 st, 8 sc, 6 ch, skip 6 st, 8 sc, turn (38)

**14 rnd:** ch 2 (this count as 1 hdc), 37 hdc, turn (38)

**15 rnd:** ch 2, 37 hdc (38)

Lace: ch 20, 19 hdc, 1 ssl, cut the yarn.

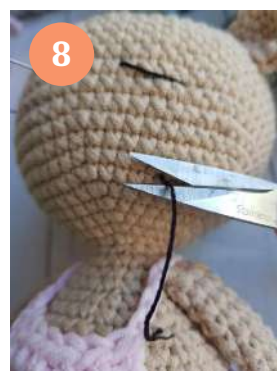
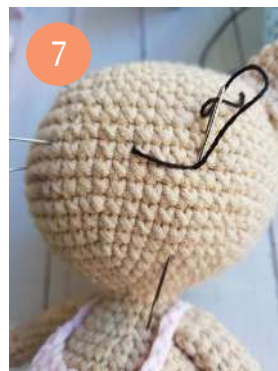
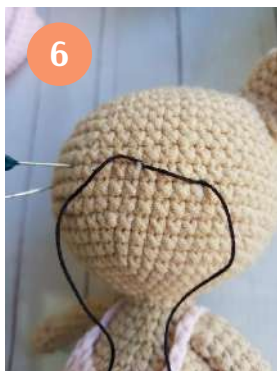
Repeat the same for the other side.



## Finishing touches

### Eyes:

Option 1: use an embroidery needle. Mark 4 stitches for both eyes, 6 st separated, sew a black yarn from 11 rnd to 12 rnd.



**Photo 2:** pass the needle from below.

**Photos 3 - 5:** pass the needle again to where you started.

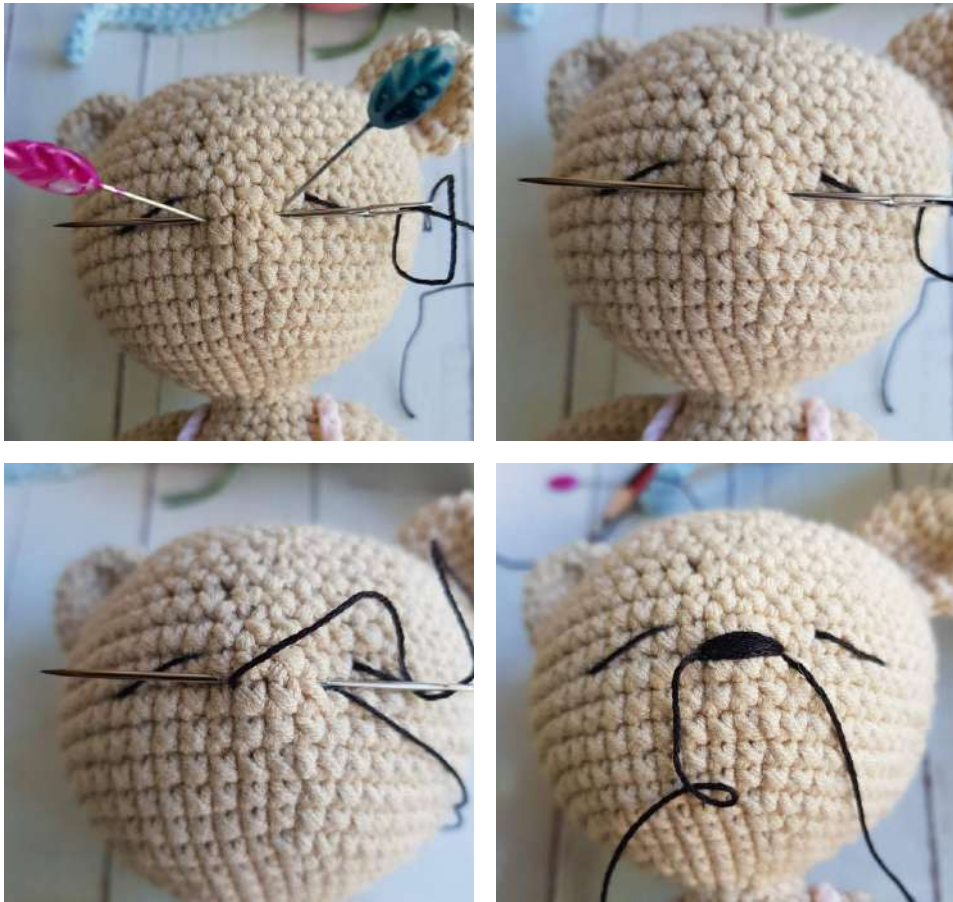
**Photo 6:** there are 2 yarn tails hanging.

**Photo 7 - 8:** hide the yarn tails inside the head and cut.

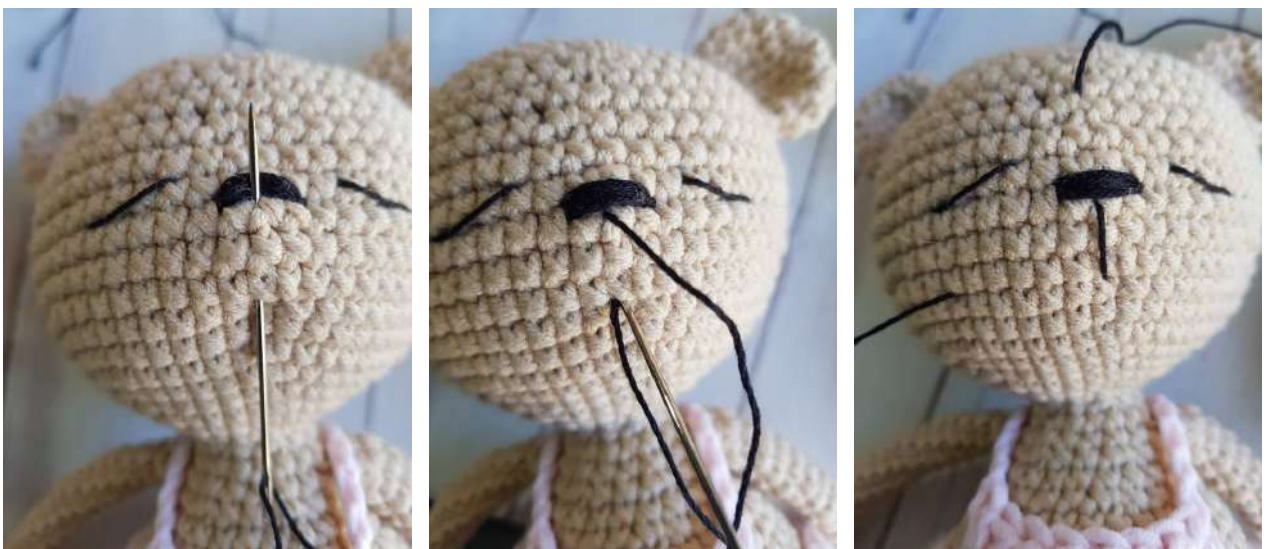
Option 2: in rnd 11 with 7 stitches separated, embroider onto 1 st vertically, by passing the needle 3 times.



**Nose:** mark 3 stitches between the eyes, in the 11 rnd and pass the needle 2 times.



**Snout:** draw a vertical line, between 9 - 10 rnds.



**Pacifier:** sew it between 10 - 6 rnds of the head.



**Ears:** sew them between 14 - 20 rnds of the head, 12 stitches apart between both ears, counted from the top side.



Place the beanie on the head by passing the ears through the holes.



## Blanket

With medium cotton yarn and hook size 5mm

- 1) Ch 40 + 3, 1 sc in the 4th chain, ch 1; Repeat till the end 1 sc, ch 1, skip 1 st; Finish with 1 sc, ch 2 and turn.
- 2) 1 sc in between sc (below each chain) and repeat all the round \*1 sc, 1 ch\* till the end. Repeat this sequence till you have a square of 27 x 27 cm.

- 3) Crochet a separate chain 90 to tie the blanket.
- 4) Mark 10 cm between 1 corner and the center of the blanket and pass the chain through the blanket.



## Bassinet

With Himalaya Baby Dolphin and hook size 4mm

It can be made also with medium cotton yarn, using double thread.

Start with the base.

**1 rnd:** ch 26 (photo 1), 24 sc, 3 sc in the last ch, 24 in the other side of the chain, 24 sc, 3 sc (photo 2) (54) Place the marker.



**2 rnd:** 24 sc, 3 inc, 24 sc, 3 inc (60)

**3 rnd:** 24 sc, (1 sc, 1 inc)x3, 24 sc, (1 sc, 1 inc)x3 (66)

**4 rnd:** 24 sc, (2 sc, 1 inc)x3, 24 sc, (2 sc, 1 inc)x3 (72)

**5 rnd:** 24 sc, (3 sc, 1 inc)x3, 24 sc, (3 sc, 1 inc)x3 (78)

**6 rnd:** 24 sc, (4 sc, 1 inc)x3, 24 sc, (4 sc, 1 inc)x3 (84)

**7 rnd:** 24 sc, (5 sc, 1 inc)x3, 24 sc, (5 sc, 1 inc)x3 (90)

**8 rnd:** 24 sc, (6 sc, 1 inc)x3, 24 sc, (6 sc, 1 inc)x3 (96)

**9 rnd:** 24 sc, (7 sc, 1 inc)x3, 24 sc, (7 sc, 1 inc)x3 (102)

**10 rnd:** 102 sc BLO (102) (Photos 3 - 4)



**11 - 19 rnd:** 102 sc (9 rounds) (102)

**20 rnd:** change color, 102 sc BLO (102) (Photo 6)

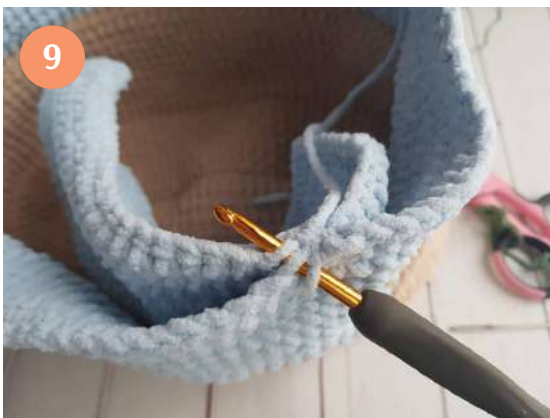
**21 - 30 rnd:** 102 sc (10 rounds) (102)



Crochet another base with the second color



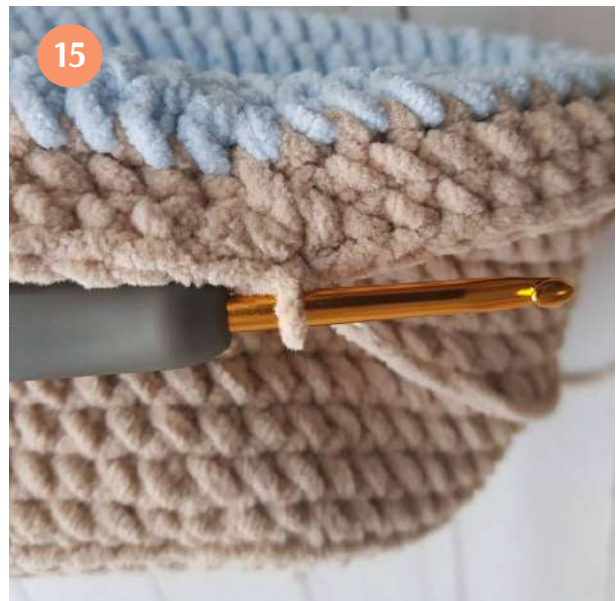
**31 rnd:** place the new base over the bassinet and join the edges. work 102 ssl from 1 loop, the back loop from rnd 30 of the bassinet and the front loop from the base.



Adjust the base inside the bassinet.



**32 rnd:** in the loops from rnd 20, work 2 rounds of sc. Start with ch 1, 101 sc. In the second round finish with a ssl in the end.



In the 10 rnd of the base work 1 ch, 101 sc, close with a ssl, crocheting the whole round with the bassinet up side down.



Wrap the baby bear with the blanket and tie (optional).



## Flower

with medium cotton yarn and hook size 3.5mm

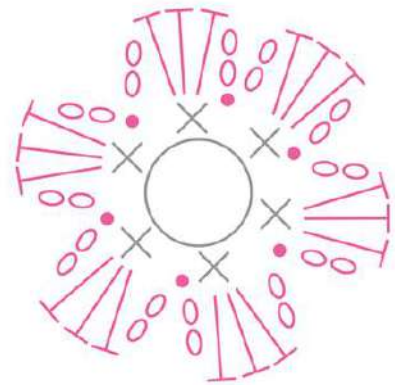
**1 rnd:** 6 sc in a magic ring, close with a ssl (6)

Change color.

**2 rnd:** 2 ch, 3 hdc in the same st, 3 ch and 1 ssl in the next st. Repeat 5 more times and you should have 6 petals. Close with a ssl in the base of the first ch 2 (12)



Sew the flower in the edge of the hood.



The baby bears are finished! Congratulations!
