

CROCHET PATTERN BABY BLANKET, CARDIGAN & HAT.



MATERIALS & TOOLS YOU WILL NEED:

- Acrylic or other yarn in baby pink colour 350gr approx. - DK, Double Knitting in UK, Light Worsted in the USA, 8ply in Australia.
- Crochet hook sizes J 6mm and 4.5mm.
- Satin ribbon in white colour 35" (90cm) in length approx.
- 3 pearl beads in white colour (optional).
- Yarn needle to weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS:

- CH - chain
- CH SP - chain space
- SC - single crochet (double crochet for UK/Australia)
- DC - double crochet (treble crochet for UK/Australia)
- TR- triple (treble) crochet (double treble crochet for UK/Australia)

- SS - slip stitch
- ST - stitch

BABY BLANKET SIZES 27"x 27" (70cm x 70cm) and 31"x 31" (80cm x 80cm)



Use crochet hook size J 6mm. CH5, join with SS to first CH to form a ring.

ROUND 1: CH3 (counts as a double in this and all following rounds), 2DC in ring, (CH3, 3DC in ring), repeat 3 times, CH3; join with SS in 3rd CH of beg CH3.

ROUND 2: slip stitch to first space, CH3, in same SP work (2DC, CH3, 3DC): corner made, CH1,* skip next 3 DC, in next CH3 SP work (3DC, 3CH, 3 DC): corner made, CH1, rep from *twice more, skip next 3 DC, join with SS in 3rd CH of beg CH3.

ROUND 3: slip stitch into CH3 corner space, CH3 in same space, work (2DC, CH3, 3DC): corner made, CH1,* 3 DC in next space, CH1, in next CH3 corner SP work (3DC, CH3, 3DC): corner made, CH1, rep from * twice more, join with SS in 3rd CH of beg CH3.

ROUND 4: slip stitch to corner space, CH3, in same space work (2DC, CH3, 3DC): corner made, CH1, * (3DC into next space), CH1, twice, (3DC, CH3, 3DC) into next CH3 space: corner made, CH1, rep from* twice more, (3DC into next space), CH1, twice, join with SS into 3rd CH of beg CH3.

Repeat rounds until blanket is the required size. Each successive round will have one additional 3DC group between corners. For the blanket size 27"x 27" (70cm x 70cm) must be 24 rounds before border, for the size 31"x 31" (80cm x 80cm) must be 28 rounds before border.

This pattern is easily expanded to make a blanket size you need, just remember please once again: The number of the rows before border row must be even e.g. 24, 26, 28 rows etc.

BORDER: slip stitch to next 2 DC and to corner space, CH3, in same space work 10DC (11DC ON ALL CORNERS): corner made, CH1, SC into next CH1 space, CH1, work 6DC into next CH1 space, CH1, rep around the blanket. Fasten off and weave in ends.

CROCHET FLOWER

Worked in rounds without turning, use crochet hook 4.5mm.

CH 4, SS in first CH to join and form a ring.

ROUND 1: CH3, 3 TR crochet in ring, CH2, SC in ring, CH2, 3 TR crochet in ring, CH2, SC to ring, 2 petals made, make 3 petals more (5 petals flower).

ROUND 2: CH1, now work behind petals, SC to back loop in 2nd TR crochet of first petal, CH3, SC to back loop in 2nd TR crochet of second petal, repeat around on all petals, join with SS to S in first petal.

ROUND 3: SC to CH3 space, CH2, 5 TR crochet in same CH3 space, CH2, SC to same CH3 space, one petal made, SC to next CH3 space, make more 4 petals, at the end of 5th petal after SC join with SS to first SC in first petal. Fasten off and weave in ends.

Make 3 flowers. Use 1 flower for the blanket. Sew pearl bead to flower centre and sew the flower to the blankets corner.

BABY HAT SIZE 3-6 MONTHS

Use crochet hook size 4.5mm. CH 3, join with SS to first CH to form a ring.

ROUND 1: CH3 (counts as first DC throughout), DC 11 in the ring, join with SS to first CH3 of the round.

ROUND 2: CH3, DC in same ST, 2DC in each ST around, join with SS to first CH3.

ROUND 3: CH3, DC in same ST, DC in next ST, *2DC in next ST, DC in next ST, repeat from * to end of the round, join with SS to CH3.



ROUND 4: CH3, DC in next ST, 2DC in next ST, *DC in next 2 STs, 2DC in next ST, repeat from * to end of the round, join with SS to CH3.

ROUND 5: CH3, DC into same ST, * DC to next 3 STs, 2DC in next ST, repeat from * to end of the round, join with SS to CH3.

ROUNDS 6 - 7: CH3, DC to every ST of the round, join with SS to CH3.

ROUND 8: CH1, SC to next ST, *CH3, skip 2 STs, SC to next 3 STs, repeat from * to the end of the round, CH3, skip 2 STs, SC to next ST of, join with SS to first CH1.

ROUND 9: CH1, skip 1 SC ST, 5DC to next CH3 space, * skip 1 ST, SC to next ST, skip 1 ST, 5DC to next CH3 space, repeat from * to end of the round, skip 1 ST, join with SS to first CH1.

ROUND 10: SS to next 2 STs, CH1, SC to next 2 STs, *CH3, skip next 3 STs, SC to next ST (to second DC of 5DC group), SC to next 2 STs, repeat from * to end of the round, CH3, join with SS to first CH1.

ROUND 11: SS to next ST, CH1, skip 1 SC ST, 5DC to next CH3 space, * skip 1 SC ST, SC to next ST, skip 1 SC ST, 5DC to next CH3 space, repeat from * to end of the round, join with SS to first CH1.

ROUNDS 12 - 13: repeat Rounds 10 - 11.

ROUNDS 14 - 15: repeat Rounds 12 - 13. Fasten off and weave in ends.

Sew pearl bead to flower centre (optional) and sew flower to the hat.

BABY CARDIGAN SIZE 3-6 MONTHS

Use crochet hook size 4.5mm. Starting with neckline CH 52. Always count CH2 or CH3 at the beginning of the row or round as a ST.

ROW 1: DC to 4th CH from hook, 2DC to next CH, DC to next 2 CH, 2DC to next CH, DC to next 2 CH, 3DC to next CH, DC to next 2 CH, 2DC to next CH, DC to next 1 CH, 2DC to next CH, DC to next 2 CH, 3DC to next CH, DC to next 2 CH, 2DC to next CH, DC to next 2 CH, 2DC to next CH, DC to next 4 CH, 2DC to next CH, DC to next 2 CH, 2DC to next CH, DC to next 2 CH, 3DC to next CH, DC to next 2 CH, 2DC to next CH, DC to next 1 CH, 2DC to next CH, DC to next 2 CH, 3DC to next CH, DC to next 2 CH, 2DC to next CH, DC to next 2 CH, 2DC to next CH, DC to next 2 CH.

ROW 2: CH2, turn, DC to next 10 ST, 3DC to next ST, DC to next 11 ST, 3DC to next ST, DC to next 22 ST, 3DC to next ST, DC to next 11 ST, 3DC to next ST, DC to next 11 ST.

ROW 3: CH2, turn, DC to next 11 ST, 3DC to next ST, DC to next 13 ST, 3DC to next ST, DC to next 24 ST, 3DC to next ST, DC to next 13 ST, 3DC to next ST, DC to next 12 ST.

ROW 4: CH2, turn, DC to next 12 ST, 3DC to next ST, DC to next 15 ST, 3DC to next ST, DC to next 26 ST, 3DC to next ST, DC to next 15 ST, 3DC to next ST, DC to next 13 ST.

ROW 5: CH2, turn, DC to next 13 ST, 3DC to next ST, DC to next 17 ST, 3DC to next ST, DC to next 28 ST, 3DC to next ST, DC to next 17 ST, 3DC to next ST, DC to next 14 ST.

ROW 6: CH2, turn, DC to next 14 ST, 3DC to next ST, DC to next 19 ST, 3DC to next ST, DC to next 30 ST, 3DC to next ST, DC to next 19 ST, 3DC to next ST, DC to next 15 ST.

ROW 7: CH2, turn, DC to next 15 ST, 3DC to next ST, DC to next 21 ST, 3DC to next ST, DC to next 32 ST, 3DC to next ST, DC to next 21 ST, 3DC to next ST, DC to next 16 ST.

ROW 8: CH2, turn, DC to next 16 ST, 3DC to next ST, DC to next 23 ST, 3DC to next ST, DC to next 34 ST, 3DC to next ST, DC to next 23 ST, 3DC to next ST, DC to next 17 ST.

ROW 9: CH2, turn, DC to next 18 ST, CH1, skip next 25 ST (for sleeve), DC to next 38 ST, CH1, skip next 25 ST (for sleeve), DC to next 19 ST.

ROW 10: CH2, turn, DC to next 18 ST, DC to next CH1 SP, DC to next 38 ST, DC to next CH1 SP, DC to next 19 ST.

ROWS 11 - 20: CH2, turn, DC to every ST of the row.

ROW 21: CH1, now work on the edge towards neckline corner, work evenly 30 SC along up to neckline corner, 3SC on the corner, SC across all ST of neckline, 3SC on the corner, work evenly 30 SC on the another edge towards bottom of cardigan .

ROUND 22: CH1, now work on the bottom edge of cardigan, skip 1 ST, 6DC to next ST, * skip 2 ST, SC to next ST, skip 2 ST, 6DC to next ST, repeat from * to the end of bottom edge, skip 2 ST, SS to first CH1 at the corner.

ROW 23: CH1, now work on the edge towards neckline corner, skip 1 ST, 6DC to next ST, * skip 2 ST, SC to next ST, skip 2 ST, 6DC to next ST, repeat from * 3 more times, skip 2 ST, SC to next 3 ST to the neckline corner, SS to next ST (to second ST of 3SC group STs on the corner), fasten off.

ROW 24: now work on another cardigan edge from neckline corner towards bottom of cardigan, attach yarn to neckline corner (to second ST of 3SC group on the corner of previous row), CH1, SC to next 3 ST, skip 2 ST, 6DC to next ST, * skip 2 ST, SC to next ST, skip 2 ST, 6DC to next ST, repeat from * 3 more times, skip 1 ST, SS to first CH1 on the corner of previous row, fasten off.

SLEEVES.

ROUND 1: Attach yarn at underarm CH1 SP, CH2 (count as a ST), turn, make DC to middle of horizontal DC of previous rows, DC to next 27 ST, DC to middle of horizontal DC of previous rows, join with SS to CH2. (30 ST).

ROUND 2: CH3 (count as a ST), turn, DC to all ST, join with SS.

ROUNDS 3 - 8: repeat Round 2.

ROUND 9: CH1, SC to next ST, *CH3, skip 2 ST, SC to next 3 ST, repeat from * to the end of the round, CH3, skip 2 ST, SC to next ST of, join with SS to first CH1.

ROUND 10: CH1, skip 1 SC ST, 5DC to next CH3 space, * skip 1 ST, SC to next ST, skip 1 ST, 5DC to next CH3 space, repeat from * to end of the round, skip 1 ST, join with SS to first CH1.

ROUND 11: SS to next 2 ST, CH1, SC to next 2 ST, *CH3, skip next 3 ST, SC to next ST (to second DC of 5DC group), SC to next 2 ST, repeat from * to end of the round, CH3, join with SS to first CH1.

ROUND 12: SS to next ST, CH1, skip 1 SC ST, 5DC to next CH3 space, * skip 1 ST, SC to next ST, skip 1 ST, 5DC to next CH3 space, repeat from * to end of the round, join with SS to first CH1.

ROUNDS 13 - 14: repeat Rounds 11 - 12.

ROUNDS 15 - 16: repeat Rounds 13 - 14. Fasten off and weave in ends.

Make another sleeve the same.

Sew pearl bead to flower centre (optional) and sew flower to cardigan.

Now work with satin ribbon, cut the edges at a 45-degree angle and using lighter or candle drag the very edge of the ribbon next to the flame to burn the edges to keep ribbon from fraying. Weave satin ribbon through every 3rd DC ST (approx.) of Row 1 of a cardigan.
