

CROCHET PATTERN

BABY CAT



The required materials:

- Sport weight 4ply yarn Yarn Art Jeans (50g /160m)
- N14 – blue
- N19 – lilac
- N20 – pink
- N53 – black
- N62 – white
- N68 – gray
- N70 – brown
- N71 – beige
- 1.75 mm crochet hook
- Safety Eyes 12mm
- Stuffing material, fiberfill
- Cardboard
- Tape
- Needle for sewing pieces

The height of the cat is 12 cm/4.7 inches, if used indicated materials.

Basket size: height 13cm/5.1 inches, length 16cm/6.2 inches, width 7.5cm/4.7 inches, using the indicated materials.

Terms and abbreviations (US):

MR - magic ring

ch- chain

sc – single crochet

dc – double crochet

dc-inc - Double Crochet Increase - 2 Dc in one stitch

inc – increase –Two Single Crochet in one stitch

dec – decrease – two single crochet together

sl st - slip stitch

4-dc Bobble st – crochet 4 dc in one stitch with a common top (work 4 dc into the same loop, yarn over and pull through all 5 loops)

FPdc – Front post double crochet

BPdc – Back post double crochet

BLO - back loops only

BABY CAT TOY

Tail

With white yarn.

1. 6sc in MR

Place row marker here.

2.-3. 6sc (2 rounds)

4. Change color to gray.

Next, alternate gray and white colors each 1 round.

6sc

5.-10. 6sc (6 rounds)

Leave a long tail for sewing.



Legs (make 2)

With pink yarn.

1. 6sc in MR

Place row marker here.

2. Change color to gray.

6pp (12)

3. (1sc, inc) *6 (18)

4. (1sc, 4-dc Bobble st) *4,
10sc (18)

5. 6dec, 6sc (12)

6. 2dec, 8sc (10)

7. 2dec, 6sc (8)

8. 8sc

Stuff the legs with fiberfill.

9. (3sc, inc) *2 (10)

10. (4sc, inc) *2 (12)


11. 12sc

12. 6dec



Fasten off, cut the yarn, weave in the ends.

Embroider the pads on the legs with pink thread.



Body-Head

Body

With gray yarn.

1. 6sc in MR

Place row marker here.

2. 6inc (12)

3. (1sc, inc) *6 (18)

4. (2sc, inc) *6 (24)

5. (3sc, inc) *6 (30)

6.-9. 30sc (4 rounds)

10. (3sc, dec) *6 (24)

11.-12. 24sc (2 rounds)

13. (2sc, dec) *6 (18)

14.-16. 18sc (3 rounds)

Stuff the body with fiberfill.

Head

17. 18inc (36)

18. (5sc, inc) *6 (42)

19.-24. 42sc (6 rounds)



25. (5sc, dec) *6 (36)

26.-27. 36sc (2 rounds)

Insert the eyes between rounds
26-27 at a distance of 10-12 sc.

28. (4sc, dec) *6 (30)

29.-30. 30sc (2 rounds)

31. (3sc, dec) *6 (24)

Stuff the head with fiberfill.

32. (2sc, dec) *6 (18)

33. (1sc, dec) *6 (12)

34. 6dec (6)

Fasten off, cut the yarn, weave
in the ends.



Arms (make 2)

With gray yarn.

1. 7sc in MR

Place row marker here.

2. -8. 7sc (7 rounds)

Stuff the arms with fiberfill.

Fasten off, cut the yarn, weave
in the yarn ends.



Tighten cheeks following the pictures below.



Ears (make 2)

Crochet 2 pieces in gray and 2 pieces in pink color. Work in rows

1. Ch5. Start from the second chain on the hook: 4sc, turn (4)
2. Ch1, dec, 2sc, turn (3)
3. Ch1, dec, 1sc, turn (2)
4. Ch1, dec (1)

Cut the yarn on the pink pieces. Cut the pink yarn, weave in ends. Do not cut the Gray yarn, Place gray and pink pieces wrong sides together, with gray yarn crochet though both pieces:

5sc along one side, inc in the corner, 5sc along other side. Leave a long tail for sewing.



Fasten the legs and arms with a thread mount. Attach the legs and arms using long needle and thread (look at the pictures below)



Sew the ears to the head. Sew the tail to the body.



Embroider the whites of the eyes and eyebrows with white thread.



Embroider the nose with pink thread. Embroider the outline of the nose, eyelids and mouth with black thread.



The Baby Cat -toy is ready ☺

Nappy

With white yarn.

1. 6sc in MR

Place row marker here.

2. 6inc (12)

3. (1sc, inc) *6 (18)

4. (2sc, inc) *6 (24)

5. (3sc, inc) *6 (30)

6. ch4 (skip 4sc, start from the next stitch), 3sc, ch8 (skip 8sc, start from the next stitch), 4sc, ch8 (skip 8sc, start from the next stitch), 3sc (30)

7. 4sc on the chain, 3sc, 8sc on the chain, 4sc, 8sc on the chain, 3sc (30)

8.-10. 30sc (3 rounds)

Cut the yarn.

Put on a nappy on the cat.



With lilac yarn.

1. 6sc in MR

Place row marker here.

2. 6inc (12)

3. (1sc, inc) *6 (18)


4. (2sc, inc) *6 (24)

5. (3sc, inc) *6 (30)

6. (4sc, inc) *6 (36)

7. (ch8 (skip 8sc, start from the next stitch), 10sc into the base) *2 (36)

Cap



8. 8sc on the chain, 10sc, 8sc on the chain, 10sc (36)
 9.-11. 36sc (3 rounds)
 12. (1sc, dc-inc) *18
 Cut the yarn.
 Put on a cap on the cat.



Small Bottle

- With white yarn.
 1. 6sc in MR
 Place row marker here.
 2. 6inc (12)
 3. BLO 12sc
 4. Change color to blue. 12sc
 5.-7. 12sc (3 rounds)
 Cut out a circle from thick cardboard and put it on the bottom.
 8. Change color to white. 12sc
 9. 12sc
 Stuff the bottle with fiberfill.
 10. BLO 6dec
 11.-12. 6sc.
 Cut the yarn.
 Embroider the inscription "Milk" on the blue part of the bottle with a black thread.



Pillow

Crochet 2 pieces in white color.
Work in rows.

1. Chain 15. Start in the second chain from the hook:
14sc, turn (14)

2.-12. Ch1, 14sc, turn (11 rows)

Cut the yarn.

Place both pieces together and
crochet them together:

Attach blue yarn

(sc, dc-inc) *24

Stuff the pillow with fiberfill.

Fasten off, cut the yarn, weave
in the yarn ends.



Blanket

With white yarn. Work in rows.

1. Ch 30. Start in the second chain from the hook: 29sc, turn (29)

2. Attention! Crochet in
Jacquard colour changing
technique from Rnd 2 to 9.
Change colour to blue yarn
(these stitches are highlighted
in red)

ch2, (4dc, 1dc) *5, 4dc, turn (29)

3. ch2, 3sc, (3dc, 2dc) *5, 1dc
turn (29)



4. Continue with White yarn.
ch2, 3dc, (BPdc , 1sc, BPdc ,
2dc) *5, 1dc (29)
5. ch2, (4dc, **1dc**) *5, 4dc, turn
(29)
6. ch2, 3sc, (**3dc**, 2dc) *5, 1dc
turn (29)
7. Continue with White yarn.
ch2, 3dc, (FPdc , 1sc, FPdc,
2dc) *5, 1dc (29)
8. ch2, (4dc, **1dc**) *5, 4dc, turn
(29)
9. ch2, 3sc, (**3dc**, 2dc) *5, 1dc
turn (29)
10. Continue with White yarn.
ch2, 3dc, (BPdc , 1sc, BPdc ,
2dc) *5, 1dc (29)
11. ch1, 29sc.
- 12. Change colour to Blue and
crochet around the blanket
(border)
(Sc, Dc-Inc) *44**
- Fasten off, cut the yarns, weave
in the ends.



BASKET

Recommendations:

- ✓ Depending on chosen yarn and crochet density, the size of the piece may differ.
- ✓ Cut the base of thick cardboard to the size of the resulting pieces.
- ✓ All pieces are attached along the outer border.
- ✓ Wrap all cardboard elements with adhesive tape.

Crochet 2 pieces one in blue and one beige color. Work in rows

1. Chain 33. Start from the second chain on the hook: inc, 30sc, inc, turn (34)

2.- 22. Ch1, 34sc, turn (21 rows) (34)

23. ch1, dec, 30sc, dec (32)

Continue crocheting from the second beige piece.


Connect the pieces

Cut a rectangle from the cardboard and put it between the two pieces. Wrap the cardboard paper with tape.

Crochet both pieces together: 108sc.

Fasten off, cut the yarn, weave in the ends.

Base



Side part

Crochet 1 pieces in blue and 1 pieces in beige color. Work in rows.

1. Chain 15. From the second chain on the hook: 14sc, turn (14)

2.-108. ch1, 14sc, turn (107 rows)

Fold in half and make 14sl st through both sides.

Cut the yarn.

Connect the pieces

Place one Blue side piece inside the other beige side piece.


Connect the two pieces together by using beige yarn and single crochet, (108sc) (see photo below)

Repeat process on other side using Brown yarn and reverse single crochet (108 reverse sc). Cut the yarn.



Assembly:

**Attach the piece to the base in a circle.
Attach the Side part to the base with brown yarn by
crocheting reverse 108sc. Cut the yarn.**



Handle

With brown yarn.

1. 8sc in MR

Place row marker here.

Stuff with fiberfill gradually.

2.-72. 8sc (71 rounds)

Leave a long tail for sewing.



Sew the handle to the bag.
