TERMS USED**MR** - magic ring**Ch** - chain**sl st** - slip stitch**sc** - single crochet**inc** - increase (2 sc in 1 st)**dec** - decrease**BLO** - back loop only**FLO** - front loop only**MATERIALS:****Yarn:**

Light pink - Yarn Art Rapido 687

White - Yarn Art Rapido 671

Ivory - Alize Cotton Gold 67

(1 ball 100 g.- 330m (361 yrd)

Beige - Alize Cotton Gold 262


Hook: 1.5 mm and 3 mm

(or in accordance with the yarn you use)

Fiberfill for stuffing, scissors, small amount of black and white yarn to embroider details, tapestry needle.

Measurements of the toy (made with hook 1.5 mm and Yarn Art Rapido yarn): height - 16 cm (6.3 inches), diameter of the bottom - 8 cm (3.15 inches). The size of a toy will be bigger if you'll use larger hook and thick yarn.

For this pattern I use 2 different types of yarn and 2 hook sizes so the Dino can fit in to an egg. Pick any yarn you like, but make sure it has different weight and one hook is twice bigger than the other

Insert hook in both loops of R50 and only back loop of R33, grab and pull the yarn, finish as usual SC

FEET (make 2)

With light pink yarn

Round 1. 6 sc in MR (6)

Round 2. 6 inc (12)

Round 3. (1 sc; inc)*6 (18)

Round 4. (2 sc; inc)*6 (24)

Round 5. BLO 3 sc; inc; (1 sc; inc)*4; 12 sc (29)

Round 6. 29 sc (29)

Round 7. 3 sc; dec;(1 sc; dec)*4; 12 sc(24)

Round 8. 24 sc (24)

Round 9. (2 sc; dec)*6 (18) stuff the leg

Round 10. (1 sc; dec)*6 (12)

Round 11. BLO 6 dec (6) cut the yarn, close the hole, leave a tail for sewing.



Make "dimples" in the feet. Embroider with white yarn three "nails" on each foot. Sew feet to the base using front loops that were left in R 11 (of the foot) as you can see in the pictures.

Round 4. 4 sc; inc; (8 sc; inc)*5; 4 sc (60)

Round 5. (9 sc; inc)*6 (66)

Round 6-10. 66 sc (66)

Round 11. (9 sc; dec)*6 (60)

Round 12. 4 sc; dec; (8 sc; dec)*5; 4 sc (54)

Round 13. (7 sc; dec)*6 (48)

Round 14. 3 sc; dec; (6 sc; dec)*5; 3 sc (42)

Sew round 14 with round 1, fill with stuffing as you go.



MIDDLE RING

With light pink yarn

Round 1. 30 ch; slst in 1st ch (30)

Round 2. 2 sc; inc; (4 sc; inc)*5; 2 sc (36)

Round 3. (5 sc; inc)*6 (42)

Round 4. 3 sc; inc; (6 sc; inc)*5; 3 sc (48)

Round 5. (7 sc; inc)*6 (54)

Round 6. 54 sc (54)

Round 7-9. BLO 54 sc (54)

Round 10. 54 sc (54)

Round 11. (7 sc; dec)*6 (48)

Round 12. 3 sc; dec; (6 sc; dec)*5; 3 sc (42)

Round 13. (5 sc; dec)*6 (36)

Round 14. 2 sc; dec; 4 sc; dec)*5; 2 sc (30)

Sew round 14 with round 1, fill with stuffing as you go.



ARMS (make 2)**With light pink yarn****Round 1.** 6 sc in MR (6)**Round 2.** 6 inc (12)**Round 3.** (1 sc; inc)*6 (18)**Round 4.** BLO 18 sc (18)**Round 5-8.** 18 sc (18)**Round 9.** (7 sc; dec)*2 (16)**Round 10-14.** 16 sc (16)**Round 15.** (6 sc; dec)*2 (14)**Round 16-20.** 14 sc (14) fill with a little bit of stuffing**Round 21.** Fold in half and make 7 sc, fasten off, leave a tail for sewing.

Embroider with white yarn three "nails" on each arm. Sew arms to the small ring as you can see in the pictures



SMALL RING

With light pink yarn

Round 1. 24 ch; slst in 1st ch (24)

Round 2. (3 sc; inc)*6 (30)

Round 3. (4 sc; inc)*6 (36)

Round 4. (5 sc; inc)*6 (42)

Round 5-9. 42 sc (42)

Round 10. (5 sc; dec)*6 (36)

Round 11. (4 sc; dec)*6 (30)

Round 12. (3 sc; dec)*6 (24)

Sew **round 12** with **round 1**, fill with stuffing as you go.

HEAD

The head consists of three parts: main part, large bony frill and inner part.

MAIN PART (with light pink yarn)

Round 1. 6 sc in MR (6)

Round 3. (1 sc; inc)*6 (18)

Round 4. (5 sc; inc)*3 (21)

Round 5. (6 sc; inc)*3 (24)

Round 6. (7 sc; inc)*3 (27)

Round 7. (8 sc; inc)*3 (30)

Round 8. (9 sc; inc)*3 (33)

Round 9. (10 sc; inc)*3 (36)

Round 10. (5 sc; inc)*4; 11 sc; inc (41)

Round 11. (6 sc; inc)*4; 12 sc; inc (46)



With pink yarn start to crochet in 48 front loops of R 17:

Round 1. 5 sc; (2 inc; 10 sc)*3; 2 inc; 5 sc turn and continue to crochet in **front loops of round 19**; 5 sc; (2 inc; 10 sc)*3; 2 inc; 5 sc (112)

Round 2. 112 sc (112)

Round 3. Sew back loops of round 2, crochet FLO: dec; 4 sc; (2 inc; 12 sc)*3; 2 inc; 4 sc; 2 dec; 4 sc; (2 inc; 12 sc)*3; 2 inc; 4 sc; dec (124)

Round 4. 124 sc (124)

Round 5. Sew back loops of round 4, crochet FLO: dec; 4 sc; (2 inc; 6 sc)*6; 2 inc; 4 sc; 2 dec; 4 sc; (2 inc; 6 sc)*6; 2 inc; 4 sc; dec (148)

Round 6. 148 sc (148)

Round 7. Sew back loops of round 6, crochet FLO: 2 dec; 2 sc; (2 inc; 8 sc)*6; 2 inc; 2 sc; 4 dec; 2 sc; (2 inc; 8 sc)*6; 2 inc; 2 sc; 2 dec (168)

Round 8. 168 sc (168) fasten off.



Now we need to make 7 points on edges, they will be located in places where we made 2 inc in the R7 of the frill (photos 1-9 on page 12). Sew stitches between those points FLO, fill with stuffing as you go

POINTS on edges (7)

With white yarn

R1. BLO 4sc, turn 4 sc (8)

R2. (2 sc; dec)*2 (6)

R3. 6 sc (6) fill with stuffing, fasten off.


With pink yarn make (1

sc; inc)*4 (12) in front

loops around each point.



If you don't want to crochet all the details you may simply connect the edges with white yarn: 4sc; (1 hdc; 2 dc inc; 1 hdc; 9 sc)*6; 1 hdc; 2 dc inc; 1 hdc; 4 sc, fasten off.



Embroider eyes and eyebrows with black yarn (or sew black beads, or insert safety eyes)



INNER PART

Now return to the hole that we left between rounds 17 and 18, continue to crochet in rounds:

Round 1. BLO 24 sc (24)

Round 2-3. 24 sc (24)


Round 4. (2 sc; dec)*6 (18)

Round 5. 18 sc (18)

Round 6. (1 sc; dec)*6 (12)

Round 7. 12 sc (12)

Round 8. 6 dec (6) fasten off.



BROW HORNS (make 2)

Start with white yarn

Round 1. 6 sc in MR (6)

Round 2. 6 sc (6)

Round 3. (2 sc; inc)*2 (8)

Round 4-5. 8 sc (8)

change to light pink color

Round 6. FLO (1 sc; inc)*4 (12)
fasten off.

SHORT HORN (make 1)

Start with white yarn

Round 1. 6 sc in MR (6)

Round 2. 6 sc (6)

Round 3. (2 sc; inc)*2 (8)

Round 4. 8 sc (8)

change to light pink color

Round 5. FLO (1 sc; inc)*4 (12)
fasten off.

Fill with stuffing and sew horns as in the pictures using back loops of round 5 (brow horns) and back loops of round 4 (short horn)

For the Triceratops we will need "spots"(optional) of three different sizes: large, medium and small.



LARGE SPOT (make 1)

With purple yarn

Round 1. 6 sc in MR (6)

Round 2. 6 inc (12)

Round 3. (1 sc; inc)*6 (18)

fasten off, leave long tail for sewing.

MEDIUM SPOTS (make 2)

With purple yarn

Round 1. 6 sc in MR (6)

Round 2. 6 inc (12)

fasten off, leave long tail for sewing.

SMALL SPOTS (make 3)

With purple yarn

Round 1. 6 sc in MR (6)

fasten off, leave long tail for sewing.



Sew spots in random order to the tail rings and back of the head, pin it before sewing. You may skip this part if you don't like sewing

With ivory yarn using 3 mm crochet hook

Crochet the egg with fishing line.

First, burn the tip of the fishing line with a lighter so that a ball forms at the end. It will not let the fishing line slip out of crocheting.

From the second round apply a fishing line and crochet so that fishing line lays under the stitches.

The shape of the detail will depend on the tension of the fishing line. At the end of each round, tighten the fishing line a little so that you get the shape of an egg and not a flat circle.



After you finish the top and the bottom of the egg, cut the fishing line, leave a short end.

Gently burn the end of the fishing line and quickly press it to the crocheting. Melted fishing line will stick to the yarn. Crochet few more sc to close the line and complete with a slst, cut the yarn, leave a tail for sewing. Sew the top and the bottom of an egg.

LARGE SPOT (oval)**Make with beige yarn****Round 1.** 6 sc in MR (6)**Round 2.** 6 inc (12)**Round 3.** 1 sc; 2 inc; 4 sc; 2 inc; 3 sc (16)**Round 4.** 1 sc; 4 inc; 4 sc; 4 inc; 3 sc (24)**Round 5.** 4 sc; 2 inc; 10 sc; 2 inc; 6 sc (16)**Round 6.** 4 sc; 4 inc; 10 sc; 4 inc; 6 sc (24)**Round 7.** 8 sc; 2 inc; 16 sc; 2 inc; 8 sc (16)**Round 8.** 8 sc; 4 inc; 16 sc; 4 inc; 8 sc (24)

fasten off, leave long tail for sewing.

Sew spots in random order to the egg, pin it before sewing. Sew a half of the large spot to the top of the egg, sew velcro to the other half of the spot.

**MEDIUM SPOT (oval)****With beige yarn****Round 1.** 6 sc in MR (6)**Round 2.** 6 inc (12)**Round 3.** 1 sc; 2 inc; 4 sc; 2 inc; 3 sc (16)**Round 4.** 1 sc; 4 inc; 4 sc; 4 inc; 3 sc (24)**Round 5.** 4 sc; 2 inc; 10 sc; 2 inc; 6 sc (16)**Round 6.** 4 sc; 4 inc; 10 sc; 4 inc; 6 sc (24)**Round 7.** (6 sc; inc)*6 (48) fasten off, leave a long tail.**SMALL SPOT (oval)****With beige yarn****Round 1.** 6 sc in MR (6)**Round 2.** 6 inc (12)**Round 3.** 1 sc; 2 inc; 4 sc; 2 inc; 3 sc (16)**Round 4.** 1 sc; 4 inc; 4 sc; 4 inc; 3 sc (24)**Round 5.** (3 sc; inc)*6 (30) fasten off, leave a long tail.
