



Hanging basket set



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Basket sizes



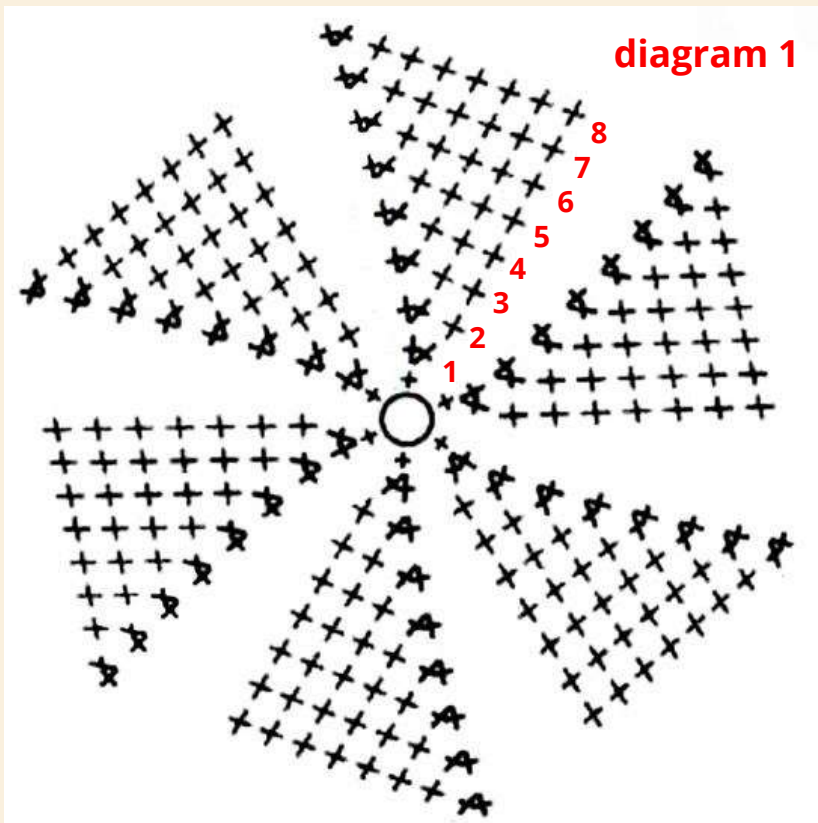
Materials

- 4-5 mm cotton, acrylic or polyester cord 250-300 meters for three baskets
- hook 5mm or 6 mm
- scissors, marker

If you use any other yarn, it will be necessary to choose a hook suitable for this yarn. The size of the baskets may vary - it depends on your crochet density and the yarn you choose. The thicker the yarn, the larger the basket.

Abbreviations

- MR** - Magic ring
- ch** - chain stitch
- sc** - single crochet
- inc** - increase (2 sc in 1 st)
- sl st** - slip stitch
- BLO** - back loops only
- dc** - double crochet
- dcdec** - dc decrease
- (...)*n** – repeat the sequense in brackets "n" times
- (...)** - amount of stitch after the row



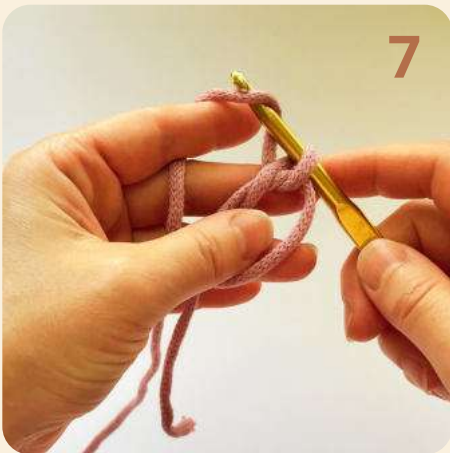
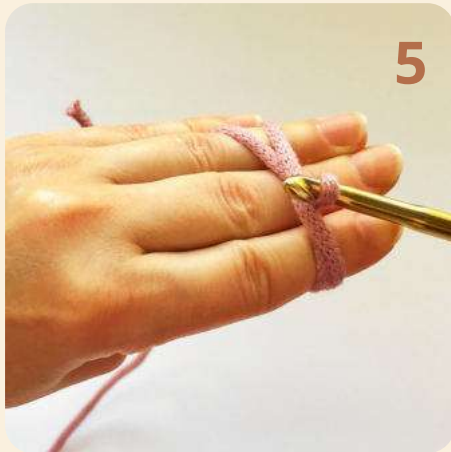
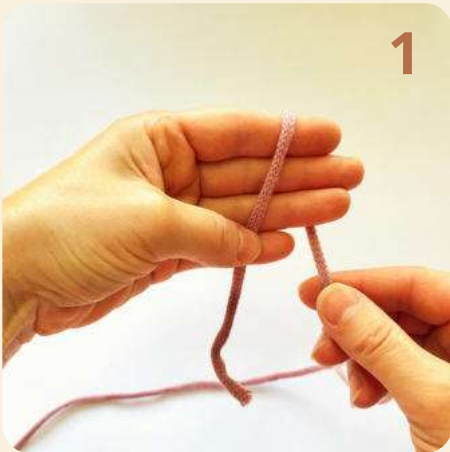

Magic Ring step by step

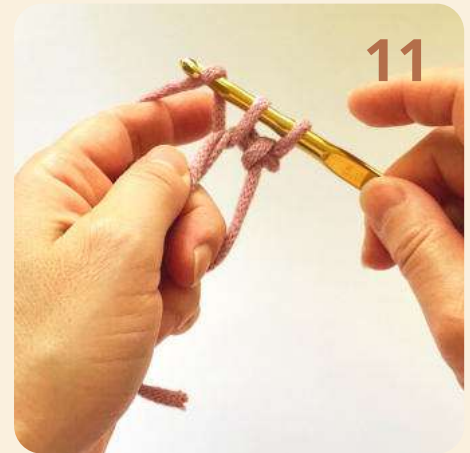


Small basket

Make MR: ch1, 6 sc (pic.9-13). Pull the ring (pic.14). Crochet in a spiral. Place a stitch marker in the first stitch of the first round (move it each round).

Work along **diagram 1**.

When work BLO, also crochet in the 3rd back loop of each stitch to make your work tighter (*pic. 15-17*)



1 round: work BLO, 6 inc (**12**) hide the end inside stitches then cut it off *(pic. 18-25)*



2 round: work BLO (sc, inc)*6 **(18)** *(pic. 26)*

3 round: work BLO (2 sc, inc)*6 **(24)** *(pic. 27)*

4 round: work BLO (3 sc, inc)*6 **(30)** *(pic. 28)*

5 round: work BLO (4 sc, inc)*6 **(36)** *(pic. 29)*



6 round: work BLO, ch2, 35 dc, sl st in the second ch **(36)** *(pic. 30-33)*

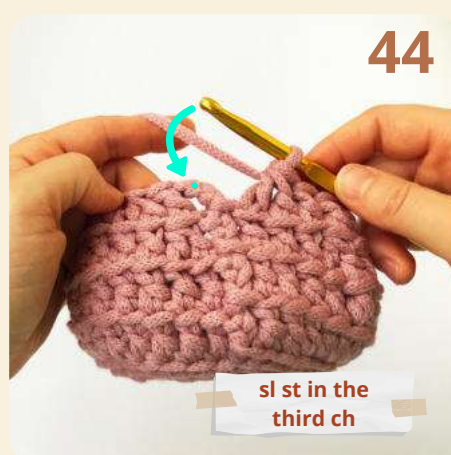
7 round: work BLO, ch3, 35 dc, sl st in the third ch **(36)** *(pic. 34-36)*



8 round: work BLO, ch3, (dcdec, 3 dc)*7, sl st in the third ch **(29)** (pic. 37-42)

9 round: work BLO, ch3, dc, (dcdec, 3 dc)*5, dcdec, sl st in the third ch **(23)**

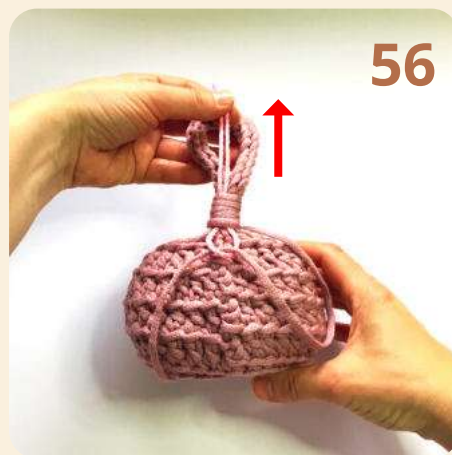
Do not fasten off. Then we will crochet a hanging loop (pic. 43-45)



- make ch25 (pic. 46)
- sl st in the stitch at the base (pic. 46)
- sl st in each st of the row and along the hanging loop
- cut off the yarn, leaving the end about 40 inches. Fasten off at the base of the hanging loop: pull the thread into the stitch. (pic. 51-53)



- take a piece of thread about 10 inches, put as it is shown on the picture
- tightly wrap it with the cord first to the upper part, then to the bottom
- insert the end of the cord in the loop of the thread.
- pull the end of the thread up, pull out the cord and cut it off



Medium basket

Make MR: ch1, 6 sc (pic.58). Pull the ring (pic.59). Crochet in a spiral. Place a stich marker in the first stitch of the first round (move it each round). See pages 3-4 for detailed photos

Work along **diagram 1** (page 2)

When work BLO, also crochet in the 3rd back loop of each stitch to make your work tighter (page 4, pic 15-17)

1 round: work BLO, 6 inc (**12**) hide the end inside stitches then cut it off (pic. 58-61)

2 round: work BLO (sc, inc)*6 (**18**) (pic. 62)

3 round: work BLO (2 sc, inc)* 6 (**24**) (pic. 63)

4 round: work BLO (3 sc, inc)* 6 (**30**) (pic. 64)

5 round: work BLO (4 sc, inc)*6 (**36**) (pic. 65)

6 round: work BLO (5 sc, inc)*6 (**42**) (pic. 66)

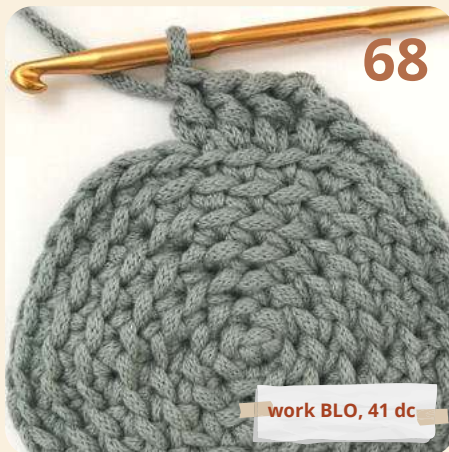

6 round

42 stitches in the round

7 round: work BLO, ch2, 41 dc, sl st in the second ch (42) *(pic. 67-70)*

8-9 rounds: work BLO, ch3, 41 dc, sl st in the third ch (42) *(pic.71-74)*



10 round: work BLO, ch3, (dcdec, 3 dc)*8, dc, sl st in the third ch **(34)** *(pic.75-80)*

11 round: work BLO, ch3, dc (dcdec, 3 dc)*6, dcdec, sl st in the third ch **(27)**

Do not fasten off. Then we will crochet a hanging loop. *(pic.81)*



- make ch25 (pic.82)
- sl st in the stitch at the base (pic.82)
- sl st in each st of the row and along the hanging loop (pic.83-89)
- cut off the yarn, leaving the end about 40 inches. Fasten off at the base of the hanging loop: pull the thread into the stitch. (pic.90)



- take a piece of thread about 10 inches, put as it is shown on the picture (pic.93)
- tightly wrap it with the cord first to the upper part, then to the bottom (pic.94-95)
- insert the end of the cord in the loop of the thread. (pic.96)
- pull the end of the thread up, pull out the cord and cut it off (pic.97-99)



Large basket

Make MR: ch1, 6 sc (pic.9-13). Pull the ring (pic.100). Crochet in a spiral. Place a stitch marker in the first stitch of the first round (move it each round). See pages 3-4 for detailed photos
Work along **diagram 1** (page 2)

When work BLO, also crochet in the 3rd back loop of each stitch to make your work tighter (page 4, pic 15-17)

1 round: work BLO, 6 inc (**12**) hide the end inside stitches then cut it off (pic.100-102)

2 round: work BLO (sc, inc)*6 (**18**) (pic.103) **3 round:** work BLO (2 sc, inc)* 6 (**24**) (pic.104)

4 round: work BLO (3 sc, inc)* 6 (**30**) (pic.105) **5 round:** work BLO (4 sc, inc)*6 (**36**) (pic.106)

6 round: work BLO (5 sc, inc)*6 (**42**) (pic.107) **7 round:** work BLO (6 sc, inc)*6 (**48**) (pic.108)



8 round: work BLO, ch2, 47 dc, sl st in the second ch **(48)** *(pic.109-112)*

9-11 (3) rounds: work BLO, ch3, 47 dc, sl st in the third ch **(48)** *(pic.113-117)*



12 round: work BLO, ch3, (dcdec, 3 dc)*9, dcdec, sl st in the third ch **(38)** *(pic.118)*

13 round: work BLO, ch3, dc (dcdec, 3 dc)*7, dc, sl st in the third ch. **(31)**

Do not fasten off. Then we will crochet a hanging loop. *(pic.119)*

- make ch25 *(pic.120)*

- sl st in the stitch at the base *(pic.120)*

- sl st in each st of the row and along the hanging loop *(pic.121-123)*



- cut off the yarn, leaving the end about 40 inches. Fasten off at the base of the hanging loop: pull the thread into the stitch. *(pic.124-126)*
- take a piece of thread about 10 inches, put as it is shown on the picture *(pic.127)*
- tightly wrap it with the cord first to the upper part, then to the bottom *(pic.128-129)*
- insert the end of the cord in the loop of the thread. *(pic.130)*
- pull the end of the thread up, pull out the cord and cut it off *(pic.131)*
