# Sweet Quiet Book



## *Sweet Quiet Book*

Book dimensions from recommended yarn: 21\*21\*6 cm. The size may vary depending on your crochet density.

### *You will need:*

#### **Yarn:**

Yarn Art Jeans (55% cotton 45% acrylic 160m/50g) or any similar yarn. Shades can be used absolutely any of the availability, here I give a list of those I used in this pattern:

Yarn Art Jeans 76, 19, 67, 11, 74, 73, 07, 62, 35, 88, 78, 71, 70, 23, 49.

Alize Cotton Gold Hobby (55% cotton, 45% acrylic, 165m/50g) 98, 15, 01

Gazzal Jeans (58% cotton, 42% acrylic, 170m/50g) 1136

Gazzal Baby Cotton (60% cotton, 40% acrylic, 165m/50g) 3432, 3448

#### **Tools:**

2.25 mm crochet hook (hook size may vary depending on your density).

Scissors, big eyed needle, steam iron, sewing pins, thin sewing needle.

#### **Extra materials:**

Canvas for embroidery ( I took the first one I found at the nearest craft store). You need about 25 \* 75 cm.

Squeaker for toys, round self-adhesive velcro or velcro tape, magnetic buttons 9 mm 3 pcs, small multi-colored buttons, a piece of tulle or organza about 10 \* 10 cm, ribbon approx 25 cm, sewing threads white, brown, dark green and to match the pages.

### *Stitch key:*

AR – Adjustable Ring (Magic Ring)

ch – chain

sc – single crochet

hdc - half double crochet

dc- sdouble crochet

sl st – slip stitch

inc – increase

dec – decrease

( ) \*n – repeat combination in brackets n times

Start crocheting squared pages. You can use any colors but pastel shades are recommended. Chain 50+1 and crochet turning rows up. Total 54 rows of 50 sc. Do not cut the yarn.



Sc around all 4 sides. Crochet 3 sc in 1 st on angles. Cut the yarn.



Make 6 squares in this way. Steam them with an iron to make them even and flat. Compare all the squares in size, it happens that the yarn of different shades of the same brand is slightly different in thickness and the dimensions can vary by 5 mm. If you find this, you need to add 1 row to the squares to make all of them equal.



### Kettle

Yarn Alize Cotton Gold Hobby 98.

Crochet spiral rounds without closing them.

- 1) 6 sc in AR
- 2) inc\*6=12 sc
- 3) (1 sc, inc)\*6=18 sc
- 4) (2 sc, inc)\*6=24 sc
- 5) (3 sc, inc)\*6=30 sc
- 6) (4 sc, inc)\*6=36 sc
- 7) (5 sc, inc)\*6=42 sc
- 8) (6 sc, inc)\*6=48 sc



9) crochet this round through the back loops:  
(7 sc, inc)\*6=54 sc

10) (8 sc, inc)\*6=60 sc



11-26) 15 rounds of 60 sc. Finish with a sl st.  
Cut the yarn.

Join yarn to the 8th round and crochet reverse  
st through the front loops half circle. Set aside.



Spout: chain 11 and close a ring with a sl st.

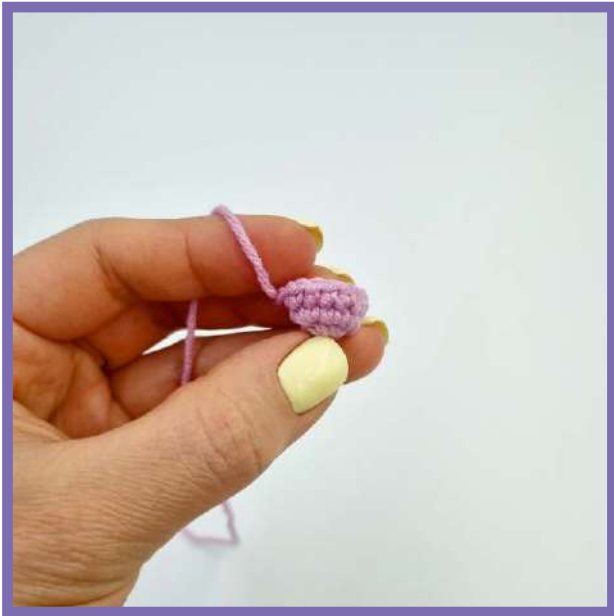


- 1) 11 sc
- 2) 5 sc, 3 sc in 1 st, 5 sc
- 3) 6 sc, 3 sc in 1 st, 6 sc

- 4) 7 sc, 3 sc in 1 st, 7 sc
  - 5) 8 sc, 3 sc in 1 st, 8 sc
  - 6) 9 sc, 3 sc in 1 st, 9 sc
  - 7) 10 sc, 3 sc in 1 st, 10 sc
- Finish with a sl st, leave a long end.



Steam the body of the kettle with an iron to make it flat.



Handle of the kettle lid:

- 1) 6 sc in AR
- 2) inc\*6=12 sc
- 3) 12 sc.

Finish with a sl st, leave a long end.

Thread the needle and go through the every second front loop of the last round.



Pull and sew the opening, do not stuff.



Sew to the kettle with the end of the yarn.



Kettle handle:  
7 sc in AR, crochet 35 spiral rounds without inc.  
Do not stuff, leave a long end. Sew the opening.



Put a squeaker inside the kettle.

Sew the bottom side of the kettle.



Sew the kettle along its contour to the page.



Sew the spout to the kettle without sewing it to the page.

Sew the handle to the kettle without sewing it to the page.



Crochet flame with orange and yellow yarn.  
Chain 10; crochet 1 sl st, 1 sc, 1 hdc, 3 dc, 1 hdc, 1 sc, 1 sl st. Cut the yarn.

Join yellow yarn and sc around, crochet 3 sc in 1 st on the tip. Leave a long end.



Make 5 pcs of different length – starting from 8, 9, 10 ch.



Sew the flame under the kettle for the lower halves.

For a burner chain 18 of grey yarn. Crochet sc on both sides of the chain, 4 sc in the first and last loop. Leave a long end.



Sew a strip under the bottom edge of the flame.  
The kettle page is ready!



## Tea Cup

Yarn Alize Cotton Gold Hobby 15.

- 1) 6 sc in AR
- 2) inc\*6=12 sc
- 3) (1 sc, inc)\*6=18 sc
- 4) (2 sc, inc)\*6=24 sc
- 5) (3 sc, inc)\*6=30 sc
- 6) (4 sc, inc)\*6=36 sc
- 7) (5 sc, inc)\*6=42 sc

8-20) 13 rounds of 42 sc. Finish with a sl st, leave a long end.



For handle 6 sc in AR and sc 20 spiral rounds without inc. Do not stuff. Leave a long end.

Cup bottom: chain 7 and sc along both sides of the chain, 4 sc in the first and last ch. Finish with a sl st, leave a long end.



Steam the cup to make it flat.



Crochet polka dots from white yarn: 6 sc in AR, sl st in the first st. Leave a long end. Make 6 pcs.



Sew the dots on the front side of the cup.



Sew the handle.



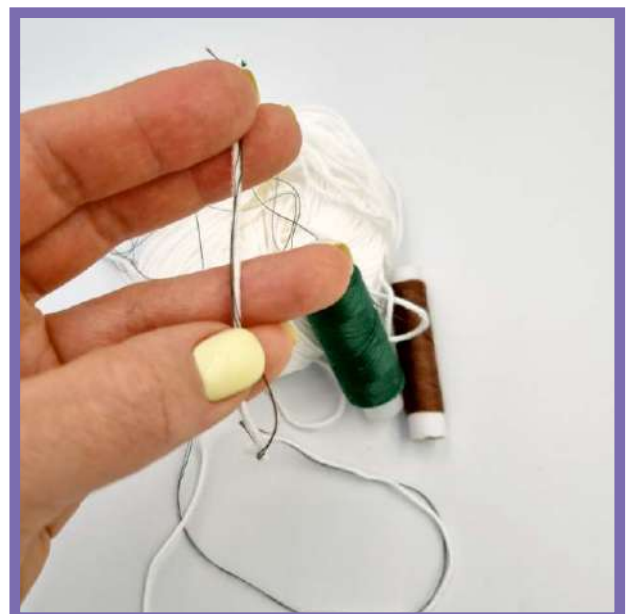
Sew the bottom.



Sew the cup to the page at the top edge of the back side.

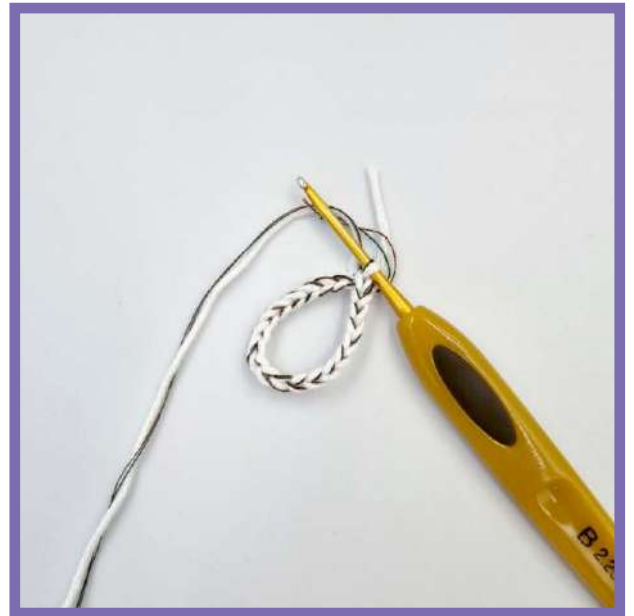


Then sew on the sides and bottom, leaving the handle free.



For the tea bag, join together white Gazzal Baby Cotton yarn (since it is slightly thinner than Jeans) and sewing threads in brown and dark green.

Chain 20, sl st in the first loop.



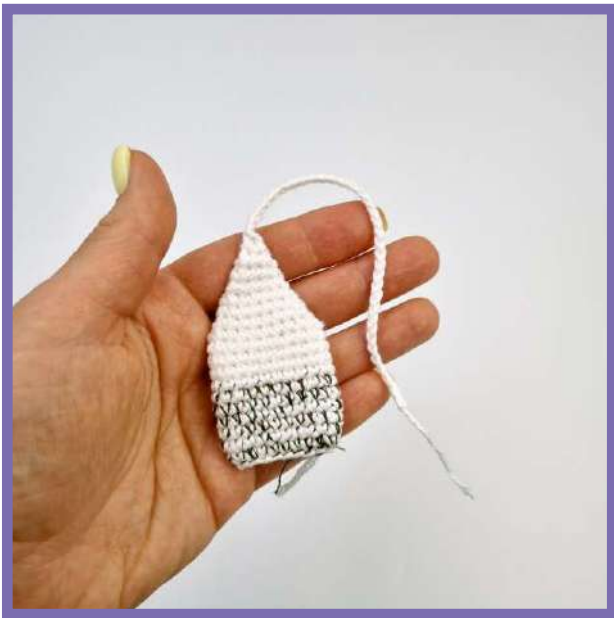
Crochet 6 spiral rounds of 20 sc. Cut the sewing threads and continue with only white yarn.



Crochet 4 rounds with white yarn.



Make 1 dec on both sides in every next round - 2 dec in a round, until there is 2 sc left.



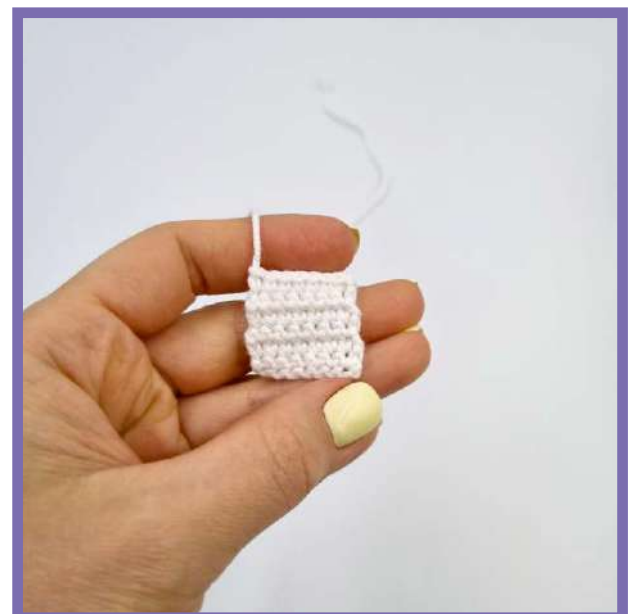
Chain 35, cut the yarn.



Sew the lower side of the tea bag.

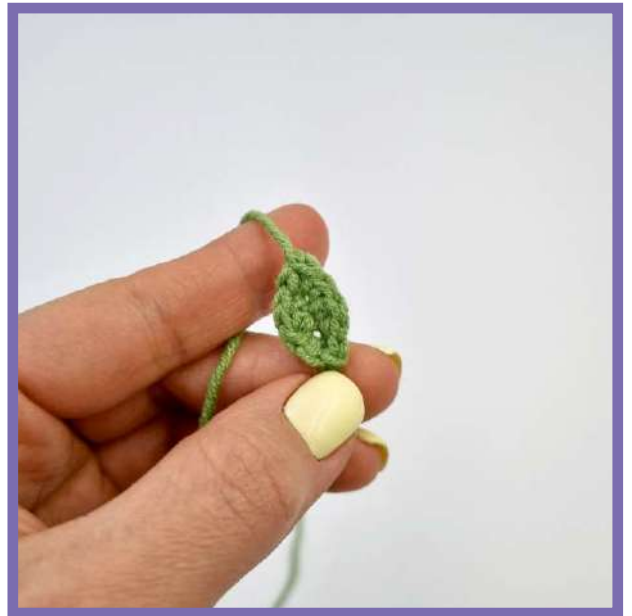


Bend the top and sew, pull the chain with a hook into the middle of the fold.



For the label, crochet a white square 7 sc\*5 rows, leave a long end.

Crochet a small leaf with Gazzal Baby Cotton of green color: chain 6, crochet 1 sl st, 1 sc, 1 hdc, 1 sc, 1 sl st. 1 ch, turn and crochet along the bottom side of the chain: 1 sl st, 1 sc, 1 hdc, 1 sc, 1 sl st. Leave a long end.



Sew the leaf to the lable.

Sew the lable near to the cup, sew the end of the tea bag chain to it.



Crochet lemon with Jeans 67. Use a piece of yarn in a contrasting color as a marker.

- 1) 6 sc in AR
- 2) inc\*6=12 sc
- 3) (1 sc, inc)\*6=18 sc
- 4) 1 sc, inc, (2 sc, inc)\*5, 1 sc=24 sc
- 5) (3 sc, inc)\*6=30 sc
- 6) 2 sc, inc, (4 sc, inc)\*5, 2 sc=36 sc



Change yarn to the white:  
**7)** (5 sc, inc)\*6=42 sc.  
Leave a long end of the white yarn.

Change yarn to the yellow (Jeans 35):  
**8)** 3 sc, inc, (6 sc, inc)\*5, 3 sc=48 sc.  
Leave a long end.



Embroider the segments with the end of the white yarn. Crochet 2 pieces.

Fold in half one of them, sew over the edge with the end of the yellow yarn.



Sew the second lemon to the page.



Sew the hard part of the velcro onto the lemon circle.



Sew the soft part of the velcro onto the lemon slice.





Crochet refined sugar with white yarn: crochet a square 5 sc wide, 4 rows high.

Sc around, crochet 3 sc in 1 st on angles.



Make 4 pcs.

Put 2 squares wrong sides to each other and sew over the edge.



Sew 2 squares to the page.



Sew the hard part of the velcro to the page, and the soft part to the double square.



The page with a tea cup is ready!

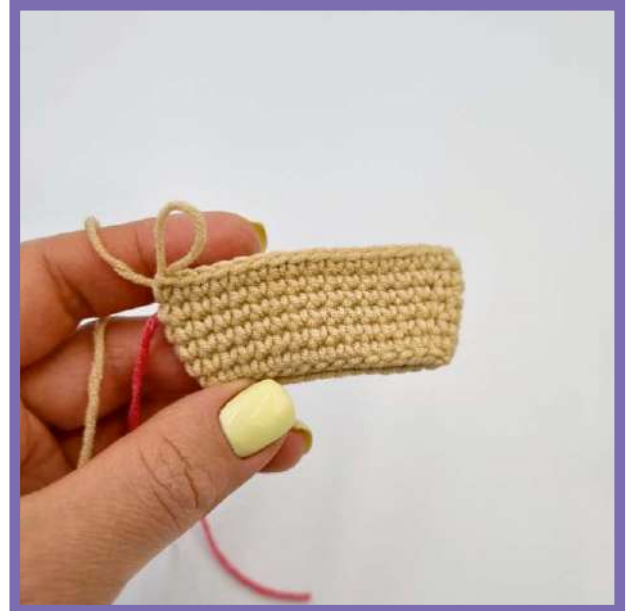


### Cupcake

Start crocheting with beige yarn.  
Chain 30, sl st in the first loop.



1-2) 2 spiral rounds of 30 sc

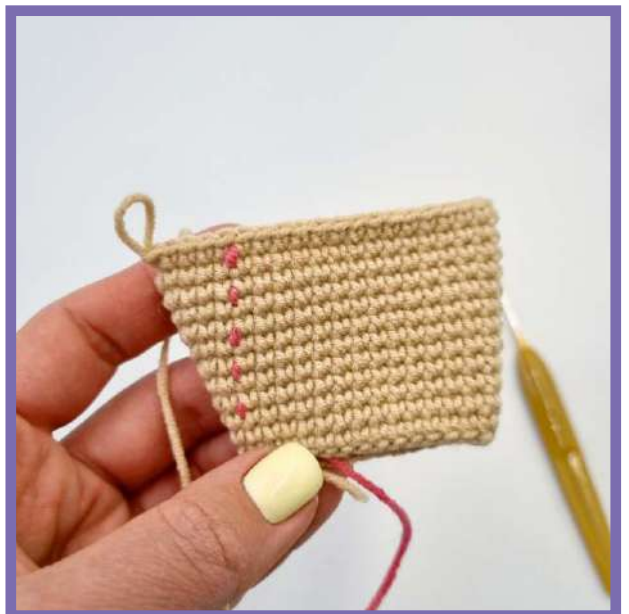


- 3) (inc, 14 sc)\*2=32 sc
- 4) 32 sc
- 5) 1 sc, inc, 15 sc, inc, 14 sc=34 sc
- 6) 34 sc



- 7) 1 sc, inc, 16 sc, inc, 15 sc=36 sc
- 8) 36 c
- 9) 2 sc, inc, 17 sc, inc, 15 sc=38 sc
- 10) 38 sc
- 11) 3 sc, inc, 18 sc, inc, 15 sc
- 12) 40 sc

13) Crochet to the side fold 4 sc, 1 sl st.  
Cut the yarn.



Crochet the top part with pink yarn:

- 1) 6 sc in AR
- 2) inc\*6=12 sc
- 3) (1 sc, inc)\*6=18 sc
- 4) (2 sc, inc)\*6=24 sc
- 5) (3 sc, inc)\*6=30 sc
- 6) (4 sc, inc)\*6=36 sc
- 7) (5 sc, inc)\*6=42 sc



8-14) 7 rounds of 42 sc.  
Leave a long end.



Sew the top to the bottom through the both loops of the beige part and back loops of the pink part.



Join pink yarn to the front loops of the last pink round and crochet shells: skip 1 st, 5 dc in 1 st, skip 1 st, 1 sc. Repeat 5 times.





Steam well the cupcake.



Sew the bottom side.



Crochet glaze with white yarn:

- 1) 6 sc in AR
- 2) inc\*6=12 sc
- 3) (1 sc, inc)\*6=18 sc
- 4) (2 sc, inc)\*6=24 sc
- 5) (3 sc, inc)\*6=30 sc

Crochet shells on a half circle: (skip 1 st, 5 dc in 1 st, skip 1 st, 1 sc)\*4. Cut the yarn, leave a long end.



Embroider multicolored sprinkles and sew on the cupcake, folding back the half circle without shells.



Crochet cherry with red yarn: 6 sc in AR, inc\*6.  
Sew on the cupcake.

Crochet a beige rectangle 20 sc wide and 10 rows high.



Sew the rectangle to the back side of the cupcake along the long sides, leave the shorts sides opened.



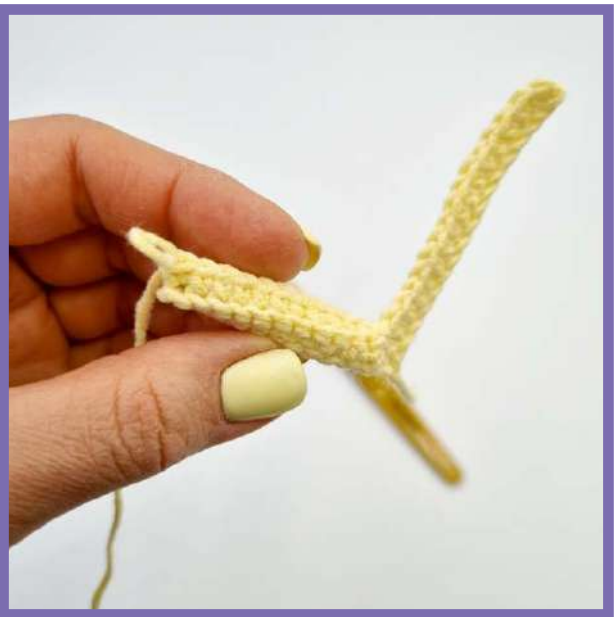


Crochet the paper liner with Jeans 88.

1) Chain 16, crochet 15 sc.



2) Next, we will crochet rows perpendicular to the initial strip. Chain 12, crochet 11 sc, 1 sl st in the next loop of the base.



3) Crochet this and all the next rounds through the back loops only. Do not make turning chain, crochet 11 sc.



4) 1 turning chain, 11 sc. Skip 1 st of the base, 1 sl st in the next st.

Repeat from point 2 to point 4. When crocheting from the base to the edge, do not make turning ch. When crocheting from the edge to the base, make the turning ch, and change the fixation to the base every other time: into the next st and through one. Leave a long end.



Crochet a strip 48 sc\*5 rows with light green. Sew one end to the top edge of the page.

Pass the strip under the rectangle on the backside of the cupcake.



Sew the second end to the bottom of the page.



Sew the linen to the page along its sides and bottom, leaving the top opened.

Crochet multicolored bumps (use any yarn colors):

1) 6 sc in AR

2) inc\*6=12 sc

3-4) 2 rounds of 12 sc.

Finish with a sl st, leave a long end.



Thread the needle and pass through the every second front loop of the last round.

Do not stuff, pull and sew the opening.



Sew the bumps on the free space with the end of the thread.



The cupcake page is ready!



### Ice Cream

Crochet the ice cream cup with beige yarn. Chain 30, sl st in the first loop. Work closing rounds, not spiral.



1) 3 ch, 29 dc

Next, we will alternate ordinary dc with front post dc. Front post dc crochet like this: the hook is not inserted into the upper loops of the st, but in front of the work under the post (vertical part) of the st.

2) 2 ch, (1 fp dc, 1 dc)\*14, 1 fp dc



3-6) 2 ch, (1 fp dc, 1 dc)\*14, 1 fp dc



7) 2 ch, (1 fp dc, dc inc)\*14, 1 fp dc



8) 2 ch, (1 fp dc, 2 dc)\*14, 1 fp dc, 1 dc



9-11) sc 3 rounds without inc. Cut the yarn.



Thread the beige yarn into the needle and stitch through both layers between the 6th and 7th rounds.



Sew the bottom side of the cup.



Crochet ice cream balls with Jeans 78, 71 and Alize Cotton Gold Hobby 01.

- 1) 6 sc in AR
- 2) inc\*6=12 sc
- 3) (1 sc, inc)\*6=18 sc
- 4) 1 sc, inc, (2 sc, inc)\*5, 1 sc=24 sc
- 5) (3 sc, inc)\*6=30 sc
- 6) 2 sc, inc, (4 sc, inc)\*5, 2 sc=36 sc
- 7) (5 sc, inc)\*6=42 sc

Crochet 1 sc after the last inc, finish with a sl st, cut the yarn.



Make another one in the same way, leave a long end.



Attach a magnetic button, its thin part, to one of the circles.





Put 2 circles wrong sides together and sew over the edge.

Sew through with small stitches around the button.



Make ice cream ball of 3 colors.



At the last moment I decided to add sprinkles on the vanilla ice cream. Better do it before sewing.

In the same color as the balls, crochet a rectangle: 6 rows of 20 sc.



Chain 19, 1 sc in the last st of the row.

Crochet 20 sc on this chain, then sc 3 rows more.



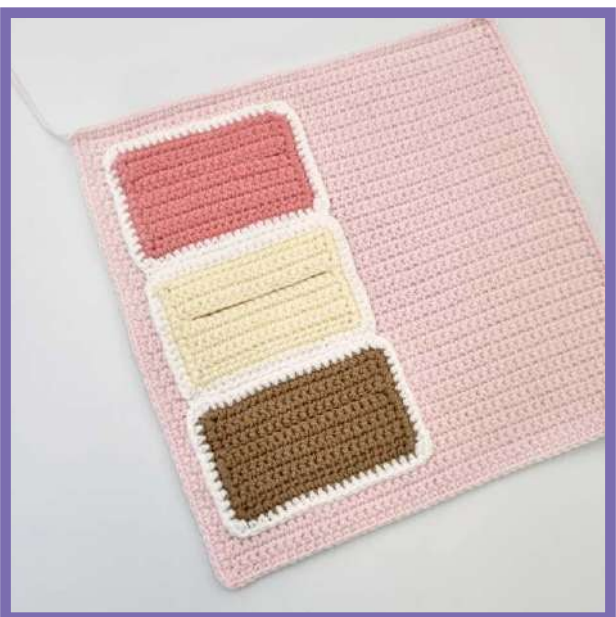
Sc around all 4 sides, crocheting 3 sc in 1 st on angles. Cut the yarn.



Sc around with white yarn, crocheting 3 sc in 1 st on angles.



Make such pieces of all 3 colors.



Sew the rectangles to the page close to each other. Don't forget to embroider the sprinkles before sewing!



Sew the cup on the right: bottom, sides and back side of the top edge.



Attach the thick parts of magnetic buttons over the cup. Arrange them so that the ice cream circles do not overlap 2 buttons at once.



Ice cream page is ready!



## Lollipop

Yarn Yarn Art Jeans 62, 35, Gazzal Jeans 1136.

In order for the lollipop to spin, you need to leave a hole in the center. Chain 6, sl st in the first loop.



1) Join coral yarn and crochet 1 white sc + 1 coral sc in every st

Let me remind you how to change the yarn color correctly: leave the last sc unfinished (2 loops on the hook)



and pull these 2 loops with another color.





2) 2 white sc in every white sc, 1 coral sc in every coral sc.

3) White: 1 inc, 1 sc. Coral: 1 sc.



4) Join yellow yarn. White sector: 1 white sc, 1 yellow sc, 1 white sc. 2 coral sc in every coral sc.

5) Inc in all odd white sectors (make inc in 6 white sectors from 12).



6) Inc in all even white sectors. We should get 2 sc in all white sectors.



7) Make inc in the yellow sector. So we get 2 sc in all sectors.



8) Inc in all odd white sectors (inc, 1 sc).

9) Inc in all even white sectors. So we get 3 sc in all white sectors and 2 sc in all colored sectors.



10-11) Crochet 2 rounds without changing.



12) Dec in all odd white sectors.  
13) Dec in all even white sectors.  
So we get 2 sc in all sectors.

Cut the coral and yellow yarn, leave only white. Do not stuff!

14) (6 sc, dec)\*6=42 sc

15) (5 sc, dec)\*6=36 sc

16) (4 sc, dec)\*6=30 sc

17) (3 sc, dec)\*6=24 sc

18) (2 sc, dec)\*6=18 sc

19) (1 sc, dec)\*6=12 sc

20) dec\*6. Cut the yarn, do not sew the opening.



Steam well with an iron.

Crochet lollipop stick with white yarn: chain 25, sc around both sides of the chain, 4 sc in the first and last loop. Leave a long end.



Attach the stick to the page with pins, having previously passed the ribbon under it.



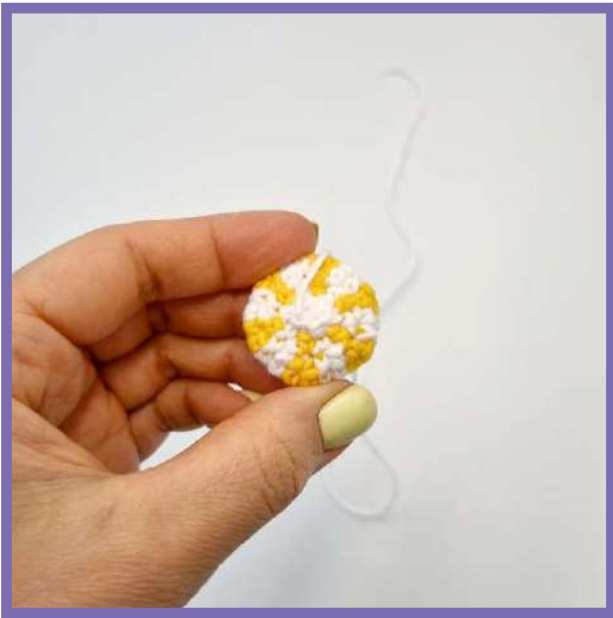
Sew the stick with the ribbon.  
Tie the bow and secure with a few stitches.

Crochet mint candies with white+any colored yarn.

- 1) 6 sc in AR with white yarn
- 2) join yellow yarn, crochet 1 white sc+1 yellow sc in every st.
- 3) 2 white sc in every white sc, 1 yellow sc in every yellow sc.
- 4) 2 yellow sc in every yellow sc, 1 white sc in every white sc.



- 5) 1 round without inc, do not stuff.



- 6) dec in every yellow sector
- 7) dec in every white sector, cut the yellow yarn
- 8) 6 dec with white yarn.

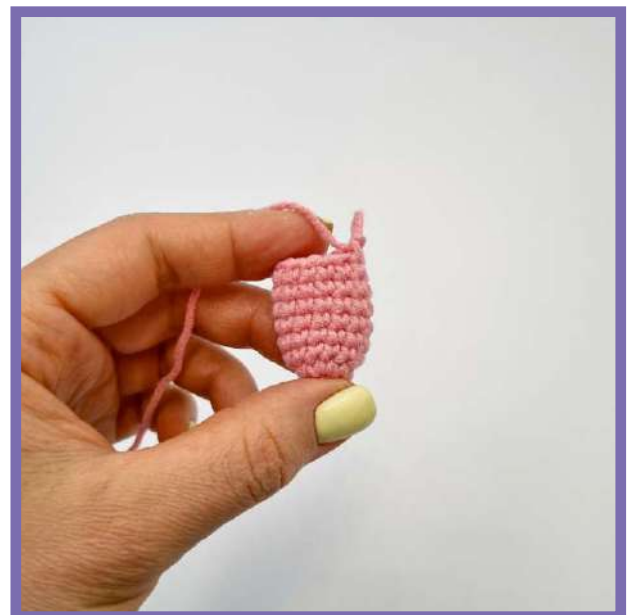
Make 3 pcs in different colors.



Candy (any colored yarn):

- 1) 6 sc in AR
- 2) inc\*6=12 sc

3-8) 6 rounds of 12 sc, do not stuff.



9) dec\*6=6 sc



10) 3 ch, 2 dc in every st, finish with a sl st.



Attach yarn to the beginning of crocheting (to the AR) and crochet the tail in the same way at the other end.



Make 3 pcs in different colors.



Add small multicolored buttons.  
Cover with lollipop is ready!

To make the lollipop spin, sew it on with a button. Insert the needle into the hole of the button, and then exactly into the central hole of the lollipop and sew to the page. Repeat several times. The needle should not go through the lollipop itself, only through the hole in the center. Sew small candies around.



### Donut

With beige yarn chain 54, sl st in the first loop.

1) 4 sc, inc, (8 sc, inc)\*5, 4 sc=60 sc



- 2) (9 sc, inc)\*6=66 sc
- 3) 5 sc, inc, (10 sc, inc)\*5, 5 sc=72 sc
- 4) (11 sc, inc)\*6=78 sc
- 5) 6 sc, inc, (12 sc, inc)\*5, 6 sc=84 sc
- 6) (13 sc, inc)\*6=90 sc



- 7) 7 sc, inc, (14 sc, inc)\*5, 7 sc=96 sc
  - 8) (15 sc, inc)\*6=102 sc
  - 9) 8 sc, inc, (16 sc, inc)\*5, 8 sc=108 sc
  - 10) (17 sc, inc)\*6=114 sc
  - 11) 9 sc, inc, (18 sc, inc)\*5, 9 sc=120 sc
  - 12) (19 sc, inc)\*6=126 sc
  - 13) 10 sc, inc, (20 sc, inc)\*5, 10 sc=132 sc.
- Finish with a sl st, leave a long end.  
Steam with an iron.

Crochet glaze with brown yarn (Jeans 70):  
chain 60, sl st in the first loop.

- 1) (9 sc, inc)\*6=66 sc
- 2) 5 sc, inc, (10 sc, inc)\*5, 5 sc=72 sc
- 3) (11 sc, inc)\*6=78 sc
- 4) 6 sc, inc, (12 sc, inc)\*5, 6 sc=84 sc
- 5) (13 sc, inc)\*6=90 sc
- 6) 7 sc, inc, (14 sc, inc)\*5, 7 sc=96 sc
- 7) (15 sc, inc)\*6=102 sc
- 8) 8 sc, inc, (16 sc, inc)\*5, 8 sc=108 sc
- 9) (17 sc, inc)\*6=114 sc, finish with a sl st, do not cut the yarn.





Skip 2 st, 6 dc in the third st, skip 2 st, 1 sc.

Repeat around. Leave a long end. Steam with an iron.



Embroider multicolored sprinkles on the glaze.

Sew the glaze on the donut.



Cut out a 10\*10 cm square from a fine tulle or organza and sew it in the center of the page, placing the buttons inside.



Sew a donut on top so that all the buttons are inside the circle.

The back cover with donut is done!



### Assembly

Sc 1 round with peach yarn around all pages, crochet 3 sc in 1 st on angles.



Use an ordinary embroidery canvas to make pages harder. Cut out a square from the canvas to fit the page without last peach round.



Sew the canvas along the entire perimeter with sewing threads. Make small stitches on the front side. Also sew the canvas with a few stitches around the objects.



Put together the page with the cup and the cover. The canvas is sewn only to the page with the cup! Sew with peach yarn over the edge along 3 sides, except the left side (the side of the binding)



Sew with small stitches with sewing thread through both pages around the objects. It is especially desirable to sew around velcro and magnetic buttons, because those places can be stretched.

Along the left edge (the side of the binding), sew the pages not over the edge, but stepping back 1 row from the edge.



Sew the canvas to the pages with the cupcake and ice cream.

Next, in pairs, sew the cupcake page with the kettle page, and ice cream with a donut. Sew 3 sides over the edge, and stitch the side of the binding stepping back 1 row from the edge.



Join peach yarn to the right edge of the cup page and sc 1 row through the front loops.



Sc 3 rows more through the both loops.  
Leave a long end.

At the central page with the cupcake/kettle  
crochet the same strip of 4 rows on both sides  
on the binding side.



At the last page/back cover crochet the same strip  
only on the side of the ice cream.

Join the cup and kettle pages with these strips  
overlapping and sew along the right edge.



Turn to the cover side and sew the strip of the kettle page to the back loops of the cup page. Not to the cover!



Also sew on the top and the bottom.



Join the last page/cover in the same way.





On the spine, sew together the back loops of the central page.

Join yarn to the left side of the front cover and sc through both loops.



Cs 12 straight rows.

Cut a piece of canvas and sew inside the spine.



Sew the free edge of the spine to the back cover.



Also sew the top and bottom sides of the spine.



Hooray, our wonderful book is ready!
