The dolls range in size from 10" (25.5 cm) (Tweety) to 19" (48.5 cm) (Bugs Bunny). The zany Looney Tunes pals have long been a national treasure, and now you can treasure them in crochet!

■■■■□ INTERMEDIATE

Finished Size: 10" (25.5 cm)



MATERIALS

Worsted Weight Yarn: 

Yellow - 2½ ounces, 140 yards
(70 grams, 128 meters)

Orange - 1½ ounces, 85 yards
(40 grams, 77.5 meters)

Black - 2 yards (2 meters)

Crochet hook, size F (3.75 mm)

or size needed for gauge

Polyester fiberfill

Small amounts of Black, Lt Blue and White felt

Clear-drying craft glue

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 16 sc and 16 rows = 4" (10 cm)

Gauge Swatch: 4" (10 cm) square

With Yellow, ch 17.

Row 1: Sc in second ch from hook and in each ch across: 16 sc.

Rows 2-16: Ch 1, turn; sc in each sc across. Finish off.

BODY

Rnd 1 (Right side): With Yellow, ch 2, 8 sc in second ch from hook; do **not** join, place marker (see *Markers*, page 35).

Rnd 2: 2 Sc in each sc around: 16 sc.

Rnd 3: (Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc) around: 24 sc.

Rnd 4: (Sc in next 11 sc, 2 sc in next sc) twice: 26 sc.

Rnds 5-9: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 10: [Decrease (see *Sc Decrease*, page 35), sc in next 11 sc] twice: 24 sc.

Rnd 11: Sc in next 5 sc, decrease, sc in next 10 sc, decrease, sc in next 5 sc: 22 sc.

Rnd 12: (Decrease, sc in next 9 sc) twice: 20 sc.

Rnd 13: Sc in next 3 sc, decrease, sc in next 8 sc, decrease, sc in next 5 sc: 18 sc.

Rnd 14: (Sc in next 7 sc, decrease) twice: 16 sc.

Rnd 15: Sc in next 4 sc, decrease, sc in next 6 sc, decrease, sc in next 2 sc: 14 sc.

Rnd 16: (Decrease, sc in next 5 sc) twice; slip st in next sc, finish off: 12 sts.

HEAD

With Yellow, ch 5.

Rnd 1 (Right side): Sc in second ch from hook and in next 2 chs, 3 sc in last ch; working in free loops of beginning ch (*Fig. 1, page 35*), sc in next 2 chs, 2 sc in next ch; do **not** join, place marker: 10 sc.

Rnd 2: 2 Sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in each of next 3 sc, sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in each of next 2 sc: 16 sc.

Rnd 3: 2 Sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in each of next 4 sc, sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in each of next 3 sc: 24 sc.

Rnd 4: Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc, (2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc) 3 times, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 5 sc, (2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc) 3 times: 32 sc.

Rnd 5: Sc in next 6 sc, loop a short piece of contrasting color yarn around last sc made to mark front of Head, sc in next 4 sc, (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc) twice, (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc) 3 times, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc: 39 sc.

Rnd 6: Sc in next 12 sc, (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc) around: 48 sc.

Rnds 7-9: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 10: (Decrease, sc in next 14 sc) around: 45 sc.

Rnd 11: Sc in next 5 sc, decrease, (sc in next 13 sc, decrease) twice, sc in next 8 sc: 42 sc.

Rnd 12: (Sc in next 12 sc, decrease) around: 39 sc.

Rnd 13: Sc in next 6 sc, decrease, (sc in next 11 sc, decrease) twice, sc in next 5 sc: 36 sc.

Rnd 14: (Decrease, sc in next 10 sc) around: 33 sc.

Rnd 15: Sc in next 2 sc, decrease, (sc in next 9 sc, decrease) twice, sc in next 7 sc: 30 sc.

Rnd 16: (Decrease, sc in next 8 sc) around: 27 sc.

Rnd 17: Sc in next 4 sc, decrease, (sc in next 7 sc, decrease) twice, sc in next 3 sc: 24 sc.

Rnds 18-21: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 22: Decrease around; slip st in next sc, finish off leaving a long end for sewing: 12 sts.

Stuff Head firmly with polyester fiberfill, making front of Head flat and back more rounded.

Stuff Body firmly with polyester fiberfill, adding extra stuffing to "bottom" area.

Sew Head to Body, adding extra polyester fiberfill before closing to make neck firm.

CHEEK (Make 2)

Rnd 1 (Right side): With Yellow, ch 2, 8 sc in second ch from hook; do **not** join, place marker.

Rnd 2: 2 Sc in each sc around: 16 sc.

Rnd 3: (2 Sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc) around; slip st in next sc, finish off leaving a long end for sewing: 20 sts.

Using photo as a guide for placement, sew Cheeks to Rnds 18-21 of Head, leaving 3 sts between Cheeks and adding polyester fiberfill before closing.

BEAK

With Orange, ch 5.

Rnd 1: Sc in second ch from hook and in next 2 chs, 5 sc in last ch; working in free loops of beginning ch, sc in next 3 chs, 2 sc in last ch; join with slip st to first sc, finish off: 13 sc.

Fold Beak in half widthwise with wider end on top. Sew Beak to Head between Cheeks.

FOOT AND LEG (Make 2) SOLE

With Orange, ch 3.

Row 1: Sc in second ch from hook and in last ch: 2 sc.

Rows 2 and 3: Ch 1, turn; sc in each sc.

Row 4: Ch 1, turn; 2 sc in each sc: 4 sc.

Rows 5 and 6: Ch 1, turn; sc in each sc across.

Row 7: Ch 1, turn; 2 sc in first sc, sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in last sc: 6 sc.

Row 8: Ch 1, turn; sc in each sc across.

Row 9: Ch 1, turn; decrease 3 times; do **not** finish off: 3 sc.

SIDES

Rnd 1 (Right side): Ch 1, turn; sc in first sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in last sc; work 8 sc evenly spaced across end of rows; working in free loops of beginning ch, sc in next 2 chs; work 8 sc evenly spaced across end of rows; join with slip st to first sc: 22 sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, do **not** turn; hdc in first sc, 2 hdc in each of next 2 sc, hdc in next 4 sc, sc in next 12 sc, hdc in last 3 sc; join with slip st to first hdc: 24 sts.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, hdc in first 9 hdc, sc in next 12 sc, hdc in last 3 hdc; join with slip st to first hdc; do **not** finish off.

INSTEP

Row 1: Ch 1, hdc in first hdc, ★ (YO, insert hook in next hdc, YO and pull up a loop) twice, YO and draw through all 5 loops on hook; repeat from ★ once more, hdc in next hdc, slip st in next 2 hdc, leave remaining 16 sts unworked: 6 sts.

Rows 2-5: Ch 1, turn; skip first 2 slip sts, sc in next 4 sts, slip st in next 2 sts on Sides: 6 sts.

Row 6: Ch 1, turn; skip first 2 slip sts, decrease twice, slip st in next 2 sts on Sides; do **not** finish off: 4 sts.

LEG

Rnd 1: Ch 1, turn; skip first 2 slip sts, sc in next 2 sc, hdc in same sc as next slip st and in next 6 sc on Sides; do **not** join, place marker: 9 sts.

Rnds 2 and 3: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 4: Sc in each sc around; slip st in next sc, finish off leaving a long end for sewing.

Stuff Foot and Leg with polyester fiberfill. Sew Leg to Body.

To shape toes, thread yarn needle with cut ends of a doubled strand of Orange. Insert needle through top of Sole at front of Foot, and go straight through Foot and out top of Row 2 of Instep until loop protrudes from Foot. Bring yarn over Foot, and insert needle through loop; pull tightly to form toe definition. Take a couple of very small stitches to secure; insert needle inside the Foot and push it out the bottom so the yarn does not show; cut the end close to the Foot.

ARM (Make 2)

With Yellow and leaving a long end for sewing, ch 8; join with slip st to form a ring.

Rnd 1 (Right side): Ch 1, sc in each ch around; do **not** join, place marker: 8 sc.

Rnds 2-4: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 5: 5 Dc in next sc, sc in next 7 sc: 12 sts.

Rnd 6: Pull up a loop in next 5 dc, YO and draw through all 6 loops on hook (thumb made), sc in next 7 sc: 8 sts.

Rnd 7: Decrease 4 times; slip st in next st, finish off leaving a long end for sewing.

Sew remaining sts closed. Stuff Arm with polyester fiberfill. Flatten Arm, having thumbs at side, and sew across beginning ch to close; sew Arm to Body with thumbs pointing upward.

TAIL

With Yellow and leaving a long end for sewing, ch 6; join with slip st to form a ring.

Rnd 1 (Right side): Ch 1, sc in each ch around; do not join, place marker: 6 sc.

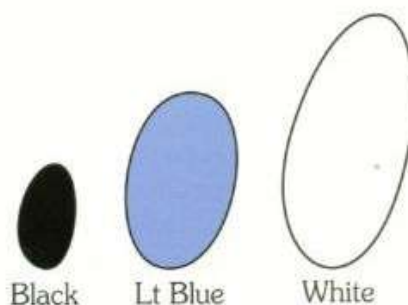
Rnds 2 and 3: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 4: (Decrease, sc in next sc) twice; slip st in next sc, finish off leaving a long end for sewing.

Sew remaining sts closed, forming a point. Using photo as a guide, flatten Tail and sew beginning ch to Body at center back of Rnd 8.



EYE PATTERNS



FINISHING

For hair, cut one 10" (25.5 cm) length and one 5" (12.5 cm) length of Black. Tie the short length in a knot around the other length, about 2½" (6.5 cm) from one end. Trim the ends of the short length to about 1½" (4 cm) and 2" (5 cm).

Thread yarn needle with the long end. Insert needle around st at center of Rnd 2 at front of Head and secure yarn at the knot. Insert the needle inside the Head and push it out the back so the yarn does not show; cut the end close to the Head.

Trace eye patterns and cut 2 pieces of each pattern from felt. Using photo as a guide, glue White Eyes to face, placing bottom just to the outside of halfway point between Cheek and beak and top curve angling outward slightly. Glue the Lt Blue pieces to the White pieces and the Black pieces to the Lt Blue pieces.

Cut a 16" (40.5 cm) length of Black and separate plies in half. Thread needle with 2 ply and add eyelashes using 3 straight stitches and eyebrows using one straight stitch for each eye.

MATERIALS

Worsted Weight Yarn:



Black - 4¹/₂ ounces, 255 yards
(130 grams, 233 meters)

White - 3¹/₂ ounces, 200 yards
(100 grams, 183 meters)

Red - 8 yards (7.5 meters)

Crochet hook, size F (3.75 mm)
or size needed for gauge

Polyester fiberfill

Plastic animal whiskers or black wire

Small amounts of Black and White felt

Clear-drying craft glue

Yarn needle



GAUGE: 16 sc and 16 rows = 4" (10 cm)

Gauge Swatch: 4" (10 cm) square

With Black, ch 17.

Row 1: Sc in second ch from hook and in each ch across: 16 sc.

Rows 2-16: Ch 1, turn; sc in each sc across.
Finish off.

BODY

With Black, ch 15; join with slip st to form a ring.

Rnd 1 (Right side): Ch 1, sc in each ch around; do not join, place marker (*see Markers, page 35*): 15 sc.

Rnd 2: 2 Sc in next sc, sc in next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 7 sc: 17 sc.

Rnd 3: Sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each sc around: 18 sc.

Rnd 4: (2 Sc in next sc, sc in next 8 sc) twice: 20 sc.

Rnd 5: Sc in next 14 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 5 sc: 21 sc.

Rnd 6: 2 Sc in next sc, sc in next 9 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each sc around: 23 sc.

Rnd 7: Sc in next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each sc around: 24 sc.

Rnd 8: (2 Sc in next sc, sc in next 11 sc) twice: 26 sc.

Rnd 9: Sc in next 18 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each sc around: 27 sc.

Rnd 10: 2 Sc in next sc, sc in next 13 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each sc around: 29 sc.

Rnd 11: Sc in next 8 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each sc around: 30 sc.

Rnd 12: (2 Sc in next sc, sc in next 14 sc) twice: 32 sc.

Rnd 13: Sc in next 22 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each sc around: 33 sc.

Rnd 14: 2 Sc in next sc, sc in next 15 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each sc around: 35 sc.

Rnd 15: Sc in next 10 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each sc around: 36 sc.

Rnd 16: 2 Sc in next sc, sc in each sc around: 37 sc.

Rnd 17: Sc in next 18 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each sc around: 38 sc.

Rnd 18: Sc in next 8 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each sc around: 39 sc.

Rnd 19: Sc in next 24 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each sc around: 40 sc.

Instructions continued on page 8.

Rnd 20: 2 Sc in next sc, sc in each sc around: 41 sc.

Rnd 21: Sc in next 20 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each sc around: 42 sc.

Rnd 22: Sc in next 10 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each sc around: 43 sc.

Rnd 23: Sc in next 26 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each sc around: 44 sc.

Rnd 24: 2 Sc in next sc, sc in each sc around: 45 sc.

Rnd 25: Sc in next 24 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each sc around: 46 sc.

Rnd 26: Sc in next 12 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each sc around: 47 sc.

Rnd 27: Sc in next 30 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each sc around: 48 sc.

Rnd 28: [Decrease (*see Sc Decrease, page 35*), sc in next 14 sc] 3 times: 45 sc.

Rnd 29: Sc in next 5 sc, decrease, (sc in next 13 sc, decrease) twice, sc in next 8 sc: 42 sc.

Rnd 30: (Sc in next 12 sc, decrease) around: 39 sc.

Rnd 31: Sc in next 6 sc, decrease, (sc in next 11 sc, decrease) twice, sc in next 5 sc: 36 sc.

Stuff Body firmly with polyester fiberfill, then continue to stuff Body as you work.

Rnd 32: (Decrease, sc in next 10 sc) around: 33 sc.

Rnd 33: Sc in next 2 sc, decrease, (sc in next 9 sc, decrease) twice, sc in next 7 sc: 30 sc.

Rnd 34: (Decrease, sc in next 8 sc) around: 27 sc.

Rnd 35: Sc in next 4 sc, decrease, (sc in next 7 sc, decrease) twice, sc in next 3 sc: 24 sc.

Rnd 36: (Decrease, sc in next 6 sc) around: 21 sc.

Rnd 37: Sc in next 3 sc, decrease, (sc in next 5 sc, decrease) twice, sc in next 2 sc: 18 sc.

Rnd 38: (Decrease, sc in next 4 sc) 3 times: 15 sc.

Rnd 39: Sc in next 2 sc, decrease, (sc in next 3 sc, decrease) twice, sc in next sc; finish off leaving a long end for sewing: 12 sc.

Finish stuffing Body with polyester fiberfill, shaping Body to be more rounded at one side to make Sylvester's chubby bottom. Sew opening at bottom closed.

Note: Loop a short piece of yarn around stitch to mark **back**.

TUMMY

With White, ch 3.

Row 1 (Right side): Sc in second ch from hook and in last ch: 2 sc.

Note: Loop a short piece of yarn around any stitch to mark Row 1 as **right** side and top edge.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn; 2 sc in each sc: 4 sc.

Rows 3 and 4: Ch 1, turn; 2 sc in first sc, sc in each sc across: 6 sc.

Row 5: Ch 1, turn; sc in each sc across.

Row 6: Ch 1, turn; sc in each sc across to last sc, 2 sc in last sc: 7 sc.

Row 7: Ch 1, turn; sc in each sc across.

Row 8: Ch 1, turn; 2 sc in first sc, sc in each sc across: 8 sc.

Rows 9-24: Repeat Rows 5-8, 4 times: 16 sc.

Rows 25-27: Ch 1, turn; sc in each sc across.

Rows 28-31: Ch 1, turn; decrease, sc in each sc across to last 2 sc, decrease: 8 sc.

Finish off.

Border: With **right** side facing, join White with sc in end of sc on Row 1 (*See Joining With Sc, page 35*); sc in end of each row across; sc in each sc across Row 31 and in end of each row across; finish off leaving a long end for sewing.

Sew Tummy to front of Body opposite back marker; remove marker.

LEG (Make 2)

With Black, ch 14; join with slip st to form a ring.

Rnd 1 (Right side): Ch 1, sc in each ch around; do **not** join, place marker: 14 sc.

Note: Mark Rnd 1 as **right** side.

Rnd 2: Sc in each sc around.

Begin working in rows.

Row 1: 2 Sc in next sc, sc in next sc, slip st in next sc, leave remaining 11 sc unworked.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn; skip first slip st, (2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc) twice, slip st in next sc: 7 sts.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn; skip first slip st, sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc and in same sc as next slip st: 8 sc.

Row 4: Do **not** turn; sc in next 9 sc on Rnd 2, sc in same sc as next slip st and in next 2 sc, (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc) twice, slip st in next sc: 20 sts.

Row 5: Ch 1, turn; skip first slip st, sc in next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc, slip st in next sc, leave last 8 sc unworked: 12 sts.

Row 6: Ch 1, turn; skip first slip st, sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc, slip st in same sc as next slip st on Row 4: 14 sts.

Row 7: Ch 1, turn; skip first slip st, sc in next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 6 sc, slip st in same sc as next slip st on Row 4: 15 sts.

Row 8: Ch 1, turn; skip first slip st, sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc, sc in next ch and in next 8 sc: 25 sts.

Row 9: Do **not** turn; sc in next ch and in next 8 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 8 sc, slip st in next sc, leave remaining 7 sc unworked: 20 sts.

Row 10: Ch 1, turn; skip first slip st, sc in next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 6 sc, slip st in next sc: 22 sts.

Row 11: Ch 1, turn; skip first slip st, sc in next 10 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 10 sc.

Begin working in rnds.

Rnd 1: Do **not** turn; sc in next ch and in next 6 sc, sc in next ch and in next 4 sc, (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 5 sc) 3 times; do **not** join, place marker: 33 sc.

Rnd 2: Sc in each sc around; slip st in next sc, finish off leaving a long end for sewing.

Using photo as guide for placement, sew large opening of Leg to Body, positioning Legs to point and curve forward so that when Sylvester stands, he is leaning forward.

FOOT

(Make 2)

SOLE

Rnd 1 (Right side): With White and leaving a long end for sewing, ch 2, 8 sc in second ch from hook; join with slip st to first sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in first sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in next sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc, 3 sc in last sc; join with slip st to first sc: 14 sc.

Rnds 3-5: Ch 1, sc in each sc around working 3 sc in center sc of each 3-sc group; join with slip st to first sc: 32 sc.

Finish off.

INSTEP

With White, ch 14; join with slip st to form a ring.

Rnd 1 (Right side): Ch 1, sc in first 2 chs, 3 sc in next ch, sc in next 3 chs, 3 sc in next ch, sc in next 2 chs, 2 sc in next ch, sc in next 2 chs, 3 sc in next ch, sc in last ch; join with slip st to first sc: 21 sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in first 3 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in next 5 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in each of next 2 sc, sc in next 3 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in last 2 sc; join with slip st to first sc: 29 sc.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, sc in first 4 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in next 7 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in last 3 sc; join with slip st to first sc: 37 sc.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, sc in each sc around; join with slip st to first sc.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, sc in first 19 sc, decrease 5 times, sc in last 8 sc; join with slip st to first sc, finish off leaving a long end for sewing: 32 sc.

With beginning yarn end on Sole, sew opening closed.

Holding pieces with **wrong** sides together and matching stitches, sew outside edges of Instep and Sole together.

Stuff Foot firmly with polyester fiberfill. Sew opening at Instep closed, gathering sts across top of Foot behind toes area.

To shape toes, thread yarn needle with cut ends of a doubled strand of Black. Using photo as a guide for stitch placement, insert needle through Sole at first toe and go straight through Foot and out Instep, pulling yarn until loop protrudes from Foot. Bring yarn over top of Foot forming toes and insert needle through loop; pull tightly. Insert needle back through Sole on outside of loop to secure and bring needle out at second toe on Sole. Bring yarn over Foot and insert needle through Instep and go straight through Foot and out Sole at same point; pull tightly. Take a couple of very small stitches to secure; insert needle inside the Foot and push it out the bottom so the yarn does not show; cut the end close to the Foot.

Stuff Legs firmly with polyester fiberfill. With Black and using photo as guide for placement, sew Foot to Leg adding more polyester fiberfill firmly to Leg before closing; wrap Black around seam 3 or 4 times to slightly indent and shape ankle; secure yarn.

RIGHT ARM LOWER ARM

With Black, ch 10; join with slip st to form a ring.

Rnd 1 (Right side): Ch 1, sc in each ch around; do **not** join, place marker: 10 sc.

Rnds 2-6: Sc in each sc around.

ELBOW

Row 1: 2 Sc in next sc, slip st in next sc, leave remaining 8 sc unworked.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn; skip first slip st, sc in next 3 sc, slip st in next sc: 4 sts.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn; skip first slip st, sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc, sc in same sc on Rnd 6 as next slip st, slip st in next sc: 6 sts.

Row 4: Ch 1, turn; skip first slip st, sc in next 5 sc, sc in same sc on Row 6 next slip st, slip st in next sc: 7 sts.

Row 5: Ch 1, turn; skip first slip st, sc in next 6 sc, sc in same sc on Row 6 as next slip st, slip st in next sc: 8 sts.

Row 6: Ch 1, turn; skip first slip st, sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc, slip st in same sc on Row 6 as next slip st: 9 sts.

Row 7: Ch 1, turn; skip first slip st, sc in next 7 sc, skip next sc, slip st in same sc on Row 6 as next slip st: 8 sts.

Row 8: Ch 1, turn; skip first slip st, sc in next 7 sc, slip st in same sc on Row 6 as next slip st; do **not** finish off: 8 sts.

UPPER ARM

Rnd 1: Ch 1, turn; skip first slip st, sc in next 7 sc, sc in next ch and in next 3 sc on Rnd 6, sc in next ch; do **not** join, place marker: 12 sc.

Rnds 2-5: Sc in each sc around; do **not** finish off.



SHOULDER

Row 1: Sc in next 4 sc, slip st in next sc, leave remaining 7 sc unworked.

Rows 2-5: Ch 1, turn; skip first slip st, sc in next 4 sc, slip st in next sc.

Finish off leaving a long end for sewing.

LEFT ARM

Work same as Right Arm through Upper Arm.

SHOULDER

Row 1: Sc in next 10 sc, slip st in next sc, leave last sc unworked.

Rows 2-4: Ch 1, turn; skip first slip st, sc in next 4 sc, slip st in next sc.

Finish off leaving a long end for sewing.

Instructions continued on page 12.



HAND (Make 2)

With White, ch 10; join with slip st to form a ring.

Rnd 1 (Right side): Ch 1, sc in each ch around; join with slip st to first sc: 10 sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 10 (for thumb), (slip st, ch 1, sc) in same sc, sc in each sc and in each ch around; join with slip st to first sc: 20 sc.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, sc in first 4 sc, 2 sc in each of next 2 sc, sc in last 14 sc; join with slip st to first sc: 22 sc.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, sc in first 5 sc, 2 sc in each of next 2 sc, sc in next 6 sc, skip next 8 sc, sc in last sc; join with slip st to first sc: 16 sc.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, sc in first 6 sc, 2 sc in each of next 2 sc, sc in next 6 sc, 2 sc in each of last 2 sc; join with slip st to first sc: 20 sc.

Rnds 6 and 7: Ch 1, sc in each sc around; join with slip st to first sc.

Finish off leaving a long end for sewing.

FINISHING HAND

Sew sides of thumb together. Flatten Rnd 7, with thumb towards side. Sew center 4 sts of Rnd 7 together, then gather 6 sts at each end of seam; secure yarn.

Stuff Hand firmly with polyester fiberfill.

To shape fingers, thread yarn needle with cut ends of a doubled strand of Black. Using photo as a guide for stitch placement, insert needle through back of Hand at first finger and go straight through Hand and out palm pulling yarn until loop protrudes from Hand. Bring yarn over top of Hand and insert needle through loop; pull tightly. Insert needle back through back of Hand on outside of loop to secure and bring needle out at second finger on back of Hand. Bring yarn over top of Hand and insert needle through palm and go straight through Hand and out back of Hand at same point; pull tightly. Take a couple of very small stitches to secure; insert needle inside the Hand and push it out so the yarn does not show; cut the end close to the Hand.

Sew Arms to Body at Shoulders, placing Elbows pointing back.

With Black, sew Hands to Arms, positioning thumbs facing up; wrap Black around wrist 3 or 4 times to slightly indent and shape wrist; secure yarn.

TAIL

With Black and leaving a long end for sewing, ch 11; join with slip st to form a ring.

Rnd 1 (Right side): Ch 1, sc in each ch around; do **not** join, place marker: 11 sc.

Stuff Tail firmly with polyester fiberfill as you work.

Rnds 2-25: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 26: Sc in each sc around; slip st in next sc, finish off.

Rnd 27: With **right** side facing, join White with sc in slip st; sc in each sc around: 11 sc.

Rnds 28 and 29: Sc in each sc around.

Rnds 30-34: Decrease, sc in each sc around: 6 sc.

Finish off.

Sew Tail to Body even with top of Legs, adding polyester fiberfill as needed.

HEAD

Rnd 1 (Right side): With Black, ch 2, 4 sc in second ch from hook; do **not** join, place marker.

Rnd 2: 2 Sc in each sc around: 8 sc.

Rnd 3: (2 Sc in next sc, sc in next sc) around: 12 sc.

Rnd 4: (2 Sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc) around: 16 sc.

Rnd 5: Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc, (sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc) 3 times, sc in next sc: 20 sc.

Rnd 6: (2 Sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc) around: 24 sc.

Rnd 7: Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc, (sc in next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc) 3 times, sc in next 3 sc: 28 sc.

Rnd 8: (2 Sc in next sc, sc in next 6 sc) around: 32 sc.

Rnd 9: Sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc, (sc in next 7 sc, 2 sc in next sc) 3 times, sc in next 4 sc: 36 sc.

Rnds 10-13: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 14: (Decrease, sc in next 4 sc) around: 30 sc.

Rnd 15: Sc in next 2 sc, decrease, (sc in next 3 sc, decrease) 5 times, sc in next sc: 24 sc.

Rnd 16: (Decrease, sc in next 2 sc) around: 18 sc.

Rnd 17: (Sc in next sc, decrease) around: 12 sc.

Rnd 18: Sc in each sc around; slip st in next sc, finish off leaving long end for sewing.

Stuff Head firmly with polyester fiberfill.

FURRY CHEEKS (Make 2)

Rnd 1 (Right side): With White, ch 2, 6 sc in second ch from hook; do **not** join, place marker.

Rnd 2: (2 Sc in next sc, sc in next sc) around: 9 sc.

Rnd 3: (2 Sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc) around: 12 sc.

Rnd 4: (2 Sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc) around: 15 sc.

Rnd 5: Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc, (sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc) twice, sc in next 2 sc: 18 sc.

Rnd 6: (2 Sc in next sc, sc in next 5 sc) around: 21 sc.

Rnd 7: Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc, (sc in next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc) twice, sc in next 4 sc: 24 sc.

Rnd 8: (2 Sc in next sc, sc in next 7 sc) around: 27 sc.

Rnd 9: Sc in each sc around.

Begin working in rows.

Row 1: Ch 1, turn; sc in first 8 sc, leave remaining 19 sc unworked.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn; 2 sc in first sc, sc in next 6 sc, 2 sc in last sc: 10 sc.

Rows 3-5: Ch 1, turn; 2 sc in first sc, sc in each sc across to last sc, 2 sc in last sc: 16 sc.

Border: Ch 1, turn; sc in each sc across, skip next 4 sc on Rnd 9, sc in next 11 sc, skip last 4 sc; join with slip st to first sc, finish off leaving a long end for sewing.

Sew 4 skipped stitches on each side to end of rows.

Instructions continued on page 14.

MUZZLE

Rnd 1 (Right side): With White, ch 2, 6 sc in second ch from hook; do **not** join, place marker.

Rnd 2: 2 Sc in each sc around: 12 sc.

Rnd 3: (2 Sc in next sc, sc in next sc) around: 18 sc.

Rnd 4: (2 Sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc) around: 24 sc.

Rnd 5: Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc, (sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc) 5 times, sc in next sc: 30 sc.

Rnd 6: Sc in each sc around.

Begin working in rows.

Row 1: Sc in next 12 sc, leave remaining 18 sc unworked.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn; 2 sc in first sc, sc in next 10 sc, 2 sc in next sc: 14 sc.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn; 2 sc in first sc, sc in each sc across to last sc, 2 sc in last sc: 16 sc.

Row 4: Ch 1, turn; sc in each sc across.

Rows 5 and 6: Ch 1, turn; decrease, sc in each sc across to last 2 sc, decrease: 12 sc.

Finish off.

Sew ends of Rows 1-3 to 3 sc on each side of Rnd 6 leaving 12 sc unjoined.

Border: With **right** side facing, skip first 10 sc on Rnd 6 of Muzzle and join White with slip st in next sc; sc in next sc and in same sc as joining; sc in end of next 3 rows; sc in next sc, 2 sc in each of next 10 sc, sc in last sc; sc in end of next 3 rows; sc in same sc as joining and in next sc; slip st in next sc, leave remaining 8 sc unworked; finish off leaving long end for sewing.

NOSE

With Red, ch 4.

Rnd 1 (Right side): Sc in second ch from hook and in next ch, 3 sc in last ch; working in free loops of beginning ch (*Fig. 1, page 35*), sc in next ch, 2 sc in next ch; join with slip st to first sc: 8 sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in next sc, 2 sc in each of next 3 sc, sc in next sc, 2 sc in each of last 2 sc; join with slip st to first sc: 14 sc.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in last 2 sc; join with slip st to first sc: 18 sc.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, sc in first 7 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each sc around to last sc, 2 sc in last sc; join with slip st to first sc: 20 sc.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, sc in each sc around; join with slip st to first sc, finish off leaving a long end for sewing.

EARS INSIDE EAR

With White, ch 7.

Row 1 (Right side): Sc in second ch from hook and in next 4 chs, 3 sc in last ch; working in free loops of beginning ch, sc in next 5 chs; do **not** join, finish off.

OUTSIDE EAR

With Black, work same as for Inside Ear; do **not** finish off.

Row 2 (Joining row): Ch 1, turn; with **wrong** sides of both pieces together and working through **both** thicknesses, sc in each sc across; finish off leaving a long end for sewing.

HEAD ASSEMBLY

Stuff Muzzle firmly with polyester fiberfill.
Sew Muzzle to Head, lining up end of flap with neck edge.

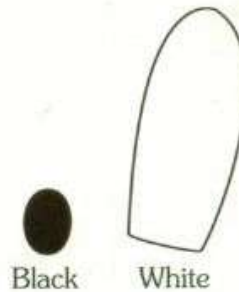
Stuff Furry Cheeks firmly with polyester fiberfill.
Sew Furry Cheeks to side of Muzzle with points facing down; sew Furry Checks to Head lining up bottom curve with neck edge.

Sew Nose to top of Muzzle, stuffing firmly with polyester fiberfill before closing.

Fold bottom edge of Ears almost in half. With Black and using photo as a guide for placement, sew across bottom fold, then sew Ears to Head.

To form mouth, thread yarn needle with cut ends of a doubled strand of White. Insert needle at one side of Muzzle at end of Border and go straight through Muzzle and emerge at opposite point on other side, pulling yarn until loop protrudes from Muzzle. Bring yarn around between Row 6 and Border where there is a definite smile line and insert needle through loop; pull tightly. Insert needle back through Muzzle on outside of loop to secure and bring needle out at center of Muzzle just under Nose. Insert needle under center of "smile" forming split sections of cat's upper lip and bring needle out at same point; pull tightly. Use tip of needle to adjust polyester fiberfill as needed. Take a couple of very small stitches to secure; insert needle inside the Muzzle and push it out so the yarn does not show; cut the end close to Muzzle.

EYE PATTERNS



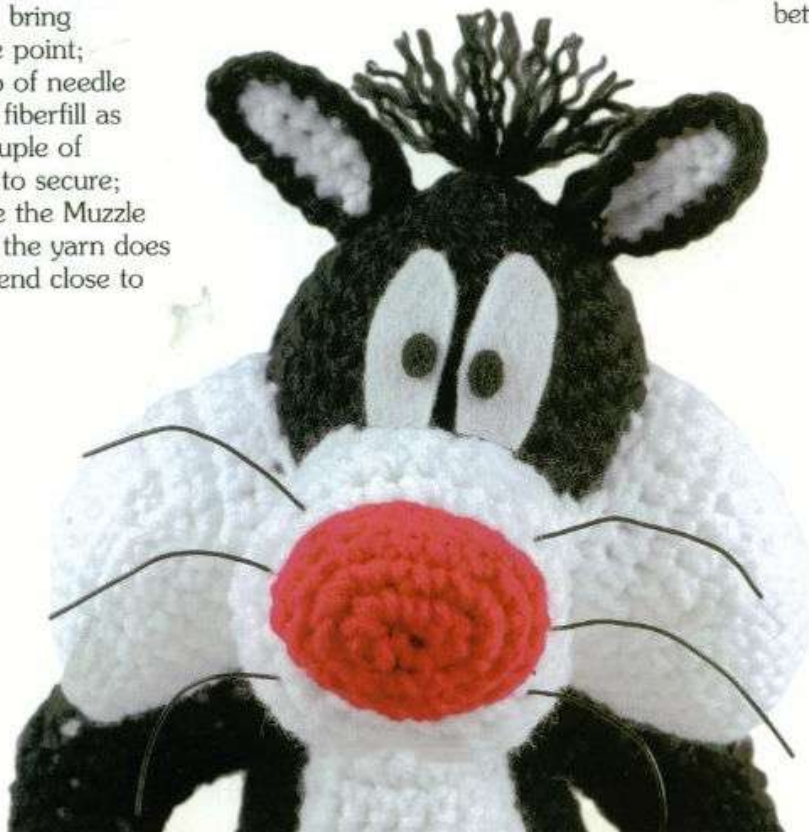
FINISHING

Trace Eye patterns and cut 2 pieces of each pattern from felt. Using photo as guide, glue White Eyes to Head; glue Black pupils to the White Eyes, placing one slightly higher than the other.

Sew Head to Body with Head almost looking upward — this will make Sylvester look straight ahead as he leans forward.

Cut 6 pieces of plastic animal whiskers or wire, each 2" (5 cm) long. Insert whiskers into face.

For hair tuft, cut four 4" (10 cm) strands of Black; Using a crochet hook, insert strands through stitch at top of Head, between Ears; tie a knot. Trim ends to 1" (2.5 cm); fray yarn slightly.




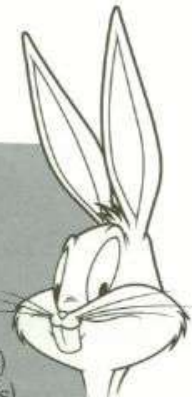

Black - 6 yards (5.5 meters)
Crochet hook, size F (3.75 mm)
or size needed for gauge
Polyester fiberfill
Plastic animal whiskers or black wire
Small amounts of Black and White felt
Small amount of white Craft Foam Sheet
Black marker
Clear-drying craft glue
Yarn needle



GAUGE: 16 sc and 16 rows = 4" (10 cm)

Gauge Swatch: 4" (10 cm) square

With Grey, ch 17.

Row 1: Sc in second ch from hook and in each ch across: 16 sc.

Rows 2-16: Ch 1, turn; sc in each sc across.
Finish off.

CROTCH

With Grey, ch 6.

Row 1 (Wrong side): Sc in second ch from hook and in each ch across: 5 sc.

Note: Loop a short piece of yarn around **back** of any stitch on Row 1 to mark **right** side.

Rows 2-4: Ch 1, turn; sc in each sc across.

Finish off.

FIRST LEG

With Grey and leaving a long end for sewing, ch 11; join with slip st to form a ring.

Rnd 1 (Right side): Ch 1, sc in each ch around; do **not** join, place marker (*see Markers, page 35*): 11 sc.

Rnds 2-12: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 13: Sc in each sc around; slip st in next sc, finish off.

SECOND LEG

Work same as First Leg through Rnd 12.

Rnd 13: Sc in each sc around; do **not** finish off; continue to mark beginning of rnd.

BODY

Rnd 1 (Joining rnd): Sc in next 4 sc; with **right** side of Crotch facing, sc in each sc across Row 4; with **right** side of First Leg facing, sc in same st as slip st and in next 3 sc, 2 sc in each of next 2 sc, sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, leave remaining 3 sc unworked; working in free loops of beginning ch on Crotch (*Fig. 1, page 35*), 2 sc in first ch, (sc in next ch, 2 sc in next ch) twice; skip next 3 sc on Second Leg, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc, 2 sc in each of next 2 sc: 35 sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in each sc around.

Rnd 3: [Decrease (*see Sc Decrease, page 35*), sc in next 9 sc] twice, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 9 sc: 35 sc.

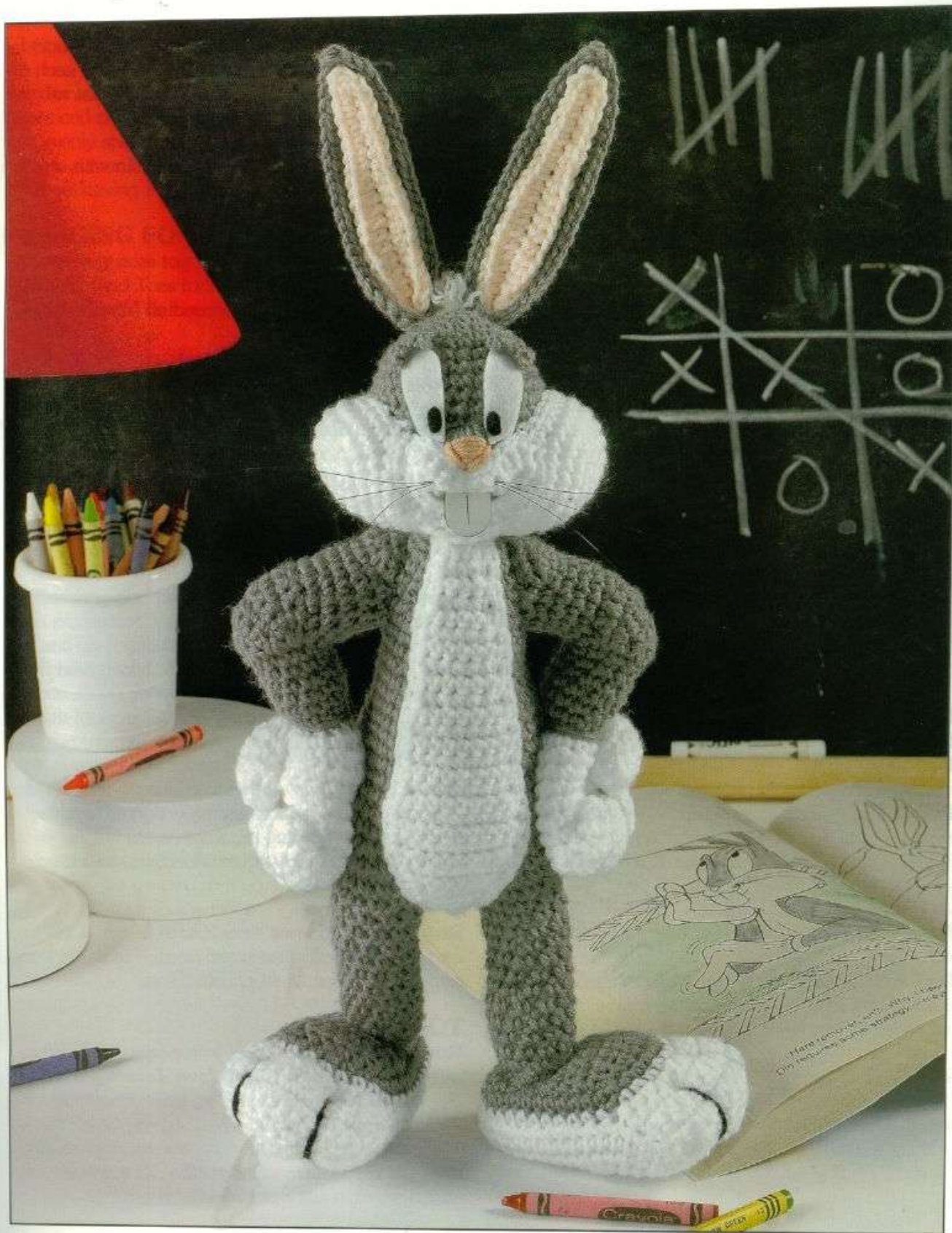
Rnds 4-10: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 11: Sc in next 15 sc, decrease 10 times: 25 sc.

Rnds 12 and 13: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 14: Decrease, sc in each sc around: 24 sc.

Rnd 15: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 16: Sc in next 11 sc, decrease, sc in each sc around: 23 sc.

Rnd 17: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 18: Decrease, sc in each sc around: 22 sc.

Rnd 19: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 20: Sc in next 10 sc, decrease, sc in each sc around: 21 sc.

Rnd 21: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 22: Decrease, sc in each sc around: 20 sc.

Rnd 23: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 24: (Sc in next sc, decrease) 6 times, sc in next 2 sc; slip st in next sc, finish off leaving a long end for sewing: 14 sts.

Sew sides of Crotch to 3 unworked stitches on each Leg. Stuff Body and Legs firmly with polyester fiberfill, rounding bottom area.

FOOT (Make 2) SOLE

With White, ch 10.

Rnd 1 (Right side): Sc in second ch from hook and in next 7 chs, 5 sc in last ch; working in free loops of beginning ch, sc in next 7 chs, 2 sc in next ch; join with slip st to first sc: 22 sc.

Note: Mark Rnd 1 as **right** side.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in first 8 sc, 2 hdc in each of next 5 sc, sc in next 8 sc, 3 sc in last sc; join with slip st to first sc: 29 sts.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, sc in first 7 sc, hdc in next 2 sts, 2 hdc in next hdc, (hdc in next hdc, 2 hdc in next hdc) 4 times, hdc in next sc, sc in next 8 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in last sc; join with slip st to first sc: 36 sts.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, sc in first 7 sc, hdc in next hdc, 2 hdc in next hdc, (hdc in next 2 hdc, 2 hdc in next hdc) 5 times, hdc in next sc, sc in next 8 sc, 2 sc in each of next 2 sc, sc in last sc; join with slip st to first sc: 44 sts.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, sc in each st around; join with slip st to first sc, finish off.

INSTEP

With Grey, ch 6.

Row 1 (Right side): Sc in second ch from hook and in each ch across: 5 sc.

Note: Mark Row 1 as **right** side.

Rows 2-5: Ch 1, turn; sc in each sc across.

Row 6: Ch 1, turn; 2 sc in first sc, sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in last sc: 7 sc.

Rows 7 and 8: Ch 1, turn; sc in each sc across.

Row 9: Ch 1, turn; sc in first 2 sc, hdc in next 3 sc, sc in last 2 sc.

Row 10: Ch 1, turn; sc in first sc, hdc in next 5 sts, sc in last sc.

Begin working in rnds.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, turn; sc in first sc, hdc in next 5 hdc, sc in last sc; sc in end of each row across; working in free loops of beginning ch, sc in next 5 chs; sc in end of each row across; join with slip st to first sc: 32 sts.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, do **not** turn; 2 sc in first sc, sc in next 5 hdc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each sc around; join with slip st to first sc, finish off: 34 sc.

TOES

Row 1: With **right** side of Instep facing, join White with sc in same st as joining (*see Joining With Sc, page 35*); sc in next 8 sc, leave remaining 25 sc unworked: 9 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn; sc in first 2 sc, 2 sc in each of next 5 sc, sc in last 2 sc: 14 sc.

Rows 3-6: Ch 1, turn; sc in each sc across.

Row 7: Ch 1, turn; sc in first 2 sc, decrease 5 times, sc in last 2 sc: 9 sc.

Border: Ch 1, do **not** turn; work 5 sc evenly spaced across end of rows; sc in each sc around Instep; work 5 sc evenly spaced across end of rows on Toes; sc in each sc across Row 7; join with slip st to first sc, finish off leaving a long end for sewing: 44 sc.

FINISHING FOOT

With **wrong** sides together and matching stitches, sew Instep and Toes to Sole, stuffing Foot firmly with polyester fiberfill before closing.

To form indent on Sole, thread yarn needle with a double strand of White. Insert needle through top of Instep at center of Row 4 (area where Leg will be joined) and go straight through Foot and out Sole, move over a couple of stitches and insert needle back through Foot. Pull all yarn ends tight to form indent and tie ends in a double knot. Trim ends to about 1" (2.5 cm) which will be hidden in Leg.

To shape toes, thread yarn needle with cut ends of a doubled strand of Black. Using photo as a guide for stitch placement, insert needle through Sole at first toe, and go straight through Foot and out top of Toes pulling yarn until loop protrudes from bottom of Foot. Bring yarn over Foot, and insert needle through loop; pull tightly forming toes. Insert needle back through Sole on outside of loop to secure and bring needle out at second toe on Sole. Bring yarn over Foot, and insert needle through top of Toes and go straight through Foot and out Sole at same point; pull tightly forming toes. Take a couple of very small stitches to secure; insert needle inside the Foot and push it out the bottom so the yarn does not show; cut the end close to the Foot.

Sew bottom of Legs to Instep (over knot), adding extra polyester fiberfill to Legs as needed before closing.

TUMMY

With White, ch 3.

Row 1: Sc in second ch from hook and in last ch: 2 sc.



Row 2 (Right side): Ch 1, turn; 2 sc in each sc: 4 sc.

Note: Mark Row 2 as **right** side and top edge.

Rows 3 and 4: Ch 1, turn; sc in each sc across.

Row 5: Ch 1, turn; 2 sc in first sc, sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in last sc: 6 sc.

Rows 6-9: Ch 1, turn; sc in each sc across.

Row 10: Ch 1, turn; 2 sc in first sc, sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in last sc: 8 sc.

Rows 11-16: Ch 1, turn; sc in each sc across.

Row 17: Ch 1, turn; 2 sc in first sc, sc in next 6 sc, 2 sc in last sc: 10 sc.

Rows 18-20: Ch 1, turn; sc in each sc across.

Row 21: Ch 1, turn; decrease, sc in next 6 sc, decrease: 8 sc.

Row 22: Ch 1, turn; sc in each sc across.

Row 23: Ch 1, turn; decrease, sc in next 4 sc, decrease: 6 sc.

Instructions continued on page 20.

Row 24: Ch 1, turn; sc in each sc across.

Row 25: Ch 1, turn; decrease, sc in next 2 sc, decrease: 4 sc.

Row 26: Ch 1, turn; sc in each sc across.

Row 27: Ch 1, turn; decrease twice: 2 sc.

Rows 28 and 29: Ch 1, turn; sc in each sc.

Row 30: Ch 1, turn; 2 sc in each sc: 4 sc.

Row 31: Ch 1, turn; sc in each sc across.

Border: Ch 1, turn; sc in each sc across; sc in end of each row across; working in free loops of beginning ch, sc in each ch; sc in end of each row across; join with slip st to first sc, finish off leaving a long end for sewing.

Sew Tummy to Body, placing Row 1 at neck edge and opposite end at back on Rnd 1 of Body.

TAIL FRONT

With Grey, ch 5.

Row 1: Sc in second ch from hook and in last 3 chs: 4 sc.

Row 2 (Right side): Ch 1, turn; 2 sc in first sc, sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in last sc: 6 sc.

Note: Mark Row 2 as **right** side and bottom edge.

Rows 3-5: Ch 1, turn; sc in each sc across.

Row 6: Ch 1, turn; decrease, sc in next 2 sc, decrease: 4 sc.

Rows 7 and 8: Ch 1, turn; sc in each sc across.

Row 9: Ch 1, turn; decrease twice: 2 sc.

Row 10: Ch 1, turn; sc in each sc.

Row 11: Ch 1, turn; decrease: one sc.

Border: Ch 1, turn; sc in first sc; sc in end of each row across; working in free loops of beginning ch, sc in ch at base of first sc and in next 3 chs; sc in end of each row across; join with slip st to first sc, finish off: 27 sc.

BACK

Work same as Front using White.

Hold **wrong** sides of Front and Back together, matching stitches. Using White and beginning at bottom of Tail, sew pieces together stuffing firmly with polyester fiberfill before closing; sew bottom of Tail to back edge of Tummy. Using Grey, tack Tail to back of Body.

ARM (Make 2)

LOWER ARM

With Grey and leaving a long end for sewing, ch 11; join with slip st to form a ring.

Rnd 1 (Right side): Ch 1, sc in each ch around; do **not** join, place marker: 11 sc.

Rnds 2-6: Sc in each sc around; do **not** finish off.

ELBOW

Row 1: 2 Sc in next sc, slip st in next sc, leave remaining 9 sc unworked.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn; skip first slip st, sc in next 3 sc, slip st in next sc: 4 sts.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn; skip first slip st, sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc, sc in same sc on Rnd 6 as next slip st, slip st in next sc: 6 sts.

Row 4: Ch 1, turn; skip first slip st, sc in next 5 sc, sc in same sc on Rnd 6 as next slip st, slip st in next sc: 7 sts.

Row 5: Ch 1, turn; skip first slip st, sc in next 6 sc, sc in same sc on Rnd 6 as next slip st, slip st in next sc: 8 sts.

Rows 6-8: Ch 1, turn; skip first slip st, sc in next 7 sc, slip st in same sc on Rnd 6 as next slip st; do **not** finish off.

UPPER ARM

Rnd 1: Ch 1, turn; skip first slip st, sc in next 7 sc, sc in same sc on Rnd 6 as next slip st, sc in next 4 sc, sc in next ch; do **not** join, place marker: 13 sc.

Rnds 2-5: Do **not** turn; sc in each sc around; do **not** finish off.

SHOULDER

Row 1: Sc in next 7 sc, slip st in next sc, leave remaining 5 sc unworked.

Rows 2-5: Ch 1, turn; skip first slip st, sc in next 4 sc, slip st in next sc.

Finish off leaving a long end for sewing.

LEFT HAND

With White, ch 11; join with slip st to form a ring.

Rnd 1 (Right side): Ch 1, sc in each ch around; join with slip st to first sc: 11 sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 10 (for thumb), (slip st, ch 1, sc) in same st, sc in each sc around to last sc, 2 sc in last sc; pushing ch-10 to front, join with slip st to first sc: 12 sc.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in next sc, (2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc) around; join with slip st to first sc: 18 sc.

Rnds 4-7: Ch 1, sc in each sc around; join with slip st to first sc.

FINGERS

Row 1: Ch 1, sc in first 9 sc, slip st in next sc, leave remaining 8 sc unworked: 10 sts.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn; skip first slip st, sc in next 9 sc, slip st in next sc on Rnd 7: 10 sts.

Rows 3-6: Ch 1, turn; skip first slip st, sc in next 9 sc, slip st in same sc on Rnd 7 as next slip st: 10 sts.

Begin working in rnds.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, turn; skip first slip st, sc in next 9 sc, sc in same sc on Rnd 7 as next slip st, sc in next 7 sc and in same sc as next slip st; join with slip st to first sc: 18 sc.

Rnds 2 and 3: Ch 1, do **not** turn; sc in each sc around; join with slip st to first sc.

Finish off.

THUMB

Rnd 1: Holding Left Hand with fold facing you and beginning ch at bottom; join White with sc in first ch of ch-10, sc in next ch and in each ch around; do **not** join, place marker: 10 sc.

Rnd 2: Sc in each sc around.

Rnds 3 and 4: Decrease, sc in each sc around: 8 sc.

Rnd 5: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 6: Sc in each sc around; slip st in next sc, finish off leaving a long end for sewing.

RIGHT HAND

Work same as Left Hand through Rnd 7.

FINGERS

Row 1: Slip st in next sc, ch 1, turn; sc in first 9 sc, slip st in next sc, leave remaining 8 sc unworked: 10 sts.

Work same as Left Hand to Thumb.

THUMB

Rnd 1: Holding Right Hand with fold facing **away** from you and beginning ch at bottom; join White with sc in first ch of ch-10, sc in next ch and in each ch around; do **not** join, place marker: 10 sc.

Rnds 2-6: Work same as Left Hand.

Instructions continued on page 22.

FINISHING HANDS

Thread yarn needle with end and weave through remaining sts on Thumb; gather tightly and secure. Leave wrist open. Sew open areas of Hands together at fingers. Stuff Hand lightly with polyester fiberfill.

To shape fingers, thread yarn needle with cut ends of a doubled strand of Black. Using photo as a guide for stitch placement, insert needle through back of Hand at first finger, and go straight through Hand and out palm pulling yarn until loop protrudes from Hand. Bring yarn over top of Hand and insert needle through loop; pull tightly curling Fingers. Insert needle back through back of Hand on outside of loop to secure and bring needle out at second finger on back of Hand. Bring yarn over top of Hand and insert needle through palm and go straight through Hand and out back of Hand at same point; pull tightly curling Fingers. Take a couple of very small stitches to secure; insert needle inside the Hand and push it out so the yarn does not show; cut the end close to the Hand.

With White, fold Thumb to inside of Hand, over fingers, to form fist and tack in place.

With Grey, sew Hand to beginning ch of Arm, positioning Hand so that palm faces outward in same direction as crook of elbow; do **not** cut yarn. Stuff Arm firmly with polyester fiberfill. Wrap Grey around wrist 3 or 4 times to slightly indent and shape wrist; secure yarn.

Sew Arms to Body at Shoulders, placing Thumbs toward back and elbows pointing out. Tack back of Hands to Body.



HEAD

Rnd 1 (Right side): With Grey, ch 2, 4 sc in second ch from hook; do **not** join, place marker.

Rnd 2: 2 Sc in each sc around: 8 sc.

Rnd 3: (2 Sc in next sc, sc in next sc) around: 12 sc.

Rnd 4: (2 Sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc) around: 16 sc.

Rnd 5: Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc, (sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc) 3 times, sc in next sc: 20 sc.

Rnd 6: (2 Sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc) around: 24 sc.

Rnd 7: Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc, (sc in next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc) 3 times, sc in next 3 sc: 28 sc.

Rnd 8: (2 Sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc) around: 35 sc.

Rnds 9-12: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 13: Sc in next 17 sc, 5 dc in next sc (nose), sc in next 17 sc: 5 dc and 34 sc.

Rnd 14: Sc in next 17 sc, ★ YO, insert hook in **next** dc, YO and pull up a loop, YO and draw through 2 loops on hook; repeat from ★ 4 times **more**, YO and draw through all 6 loops on hook, sc in next 17 sc: 35 sts.

Rnd 15: (Decrease, sc in next 3 sts) around: 28 sc.

Rnd 16: (Sc in next 2 sc, decrease) around: 21 sc.

Rnd 17: (Decrease, sc in next sc) around: 14 sc.

Rnd 18: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 19: Sc in each sc around; slip st in next sc, finish off.

Stuff Head firmly with polyester fiberfill.

FACE CENTER

With White, ch 8.

Row 1: Sc in second ch from hook and in each ch across: 7 sc.

Row 2 (Right side): Ch 2 (counts as first hdc, now and throughout), turn; hdc in same st, hdc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc, hdc in next sc, 2 hdc in last sc: 9 sts.

Note: Mark Row 2 as **right** side.

Row 3: Ch 2, turn; hdc in same st and in next hdc, sc in next 2 sts, skip next sc, sc in next 2 sts, hdc in next hdc, 2 hdc in last hdc: 10 sts.

Rows 4 and 5: Ch 2, turn; hdc in same st and in next hdc, sc in next 2 sts, skip next 2 sc, sc in next 2 sts, hdc in next hdc, 2 hdc in last hdc: 10 sts.

Row 6: Ch 1, turn; 2 sc in first hdc, sc in next 8 sts, 2 sc in last hdc; finish off.

FIRST CHEEK

Rnd 1 (Right side): With White, ch 2, 6 sc in second ch from hook; do **not** join, place marker.

Rnd 2: 2 Sc in each sc around: 12 sc.

Rnd 3: (2 Sc in next sc, sc in next sc) around: 18 sc.

Rnd 4: Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, (sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) 5 times, sc in next sc: 24 sc.

Rnd 5: (2 Sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc) around: 30 sc.

Rnd 6: Sc in next 15 sc, (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc) around; slip st in next sc, finish off leaving a long end for sewing: 33 sts.

SECOND CHEEK

Work same as First Cheek through Rnd 5: 30 sc.

Rnd 6: Sc in next 15 sc, (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc) around: 33 sc.

Joining Rnd: Sc in next 15 sc; with **right** side of Center facing, sc in each sc across Row 6; with **right** side of First Cheek facing, sc in next 15 sc after slip st; slip st in next sc, finish off.

FACE ASSEMBLY

Sew Cheeks to edge of Center. Position Face on Head with dip in Center under nose on Head and aligning bottom of pieces with neck. Carefully sew Face to Head across top edge of Center; sew around both Cheeks, lightly stuffing Cheeks with polyester fiberfill.

Add a small amount of polyester fiberfill under Center piece at top to shape upper lip. Thread yarn needle with cut ends of a doubled strand of White. Insert needle at top of Center just under nose and come out 3 rows below, pulling yarn until loop protrudes from Center. Insert needle through loop; pull tightly; secure yarn. Pull polyester fiberfill up on either side of stitch. Sew remaining stitches to neck edge; secure yarn.

With Grey, sew a line for mouth under White stitch pulling yarn until upper lip protrudes.

EAR OUTSIDE

With Grey, ch 22.

Row 1: Hdc in third ch from hook and in next 16 chs (2 skipped chs count as first hdc), sc in next 2 chs, 3 sc in last ch; working in free loops of beginning ch, sc in next 2 chs, hdc in next 16 chs, 2 hdc in next ch; do **not** join: 43 sts.

Note: Mark Row 1 as **back** of Ear.

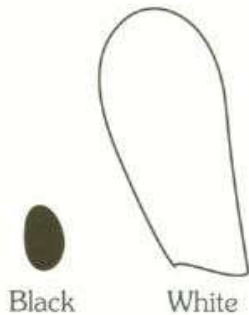
Row 2: Ch 1, turn; sc in first 4 hdc, hdc in next 11 hdc, sc in next 6 sts, (sc, ch 1, dc, ch 1, sc) in next sc, sc in next 6 sts, hdc in next 11 hdc, sc in last 4 hdc; finish off.

EYE PATTERNS



INSIDE

With Peach, ch 20.

Row 1 (Right side): Hdc in third ch from hook and in next 10 chs (**2 skipped chs count as first hdc**), sc in next 6 chs, (sc, ch 1, dc, ch 1, sc) in last ch; working in free loops of beginning ch, sc in next 6 chs, hdc in next 10 chs, 2 hdc in next ch; finish off leaving a long end for sewing.

Hold pieces with **wrong** sides together, lining up beginning chs. Using Peach and working behind Rnd 1 on Inside piece and in top of sts on Rnd 1 of Outside piece so stitching doesn't show, sew pieces together.

Fold bottom edge of Ears in half and sew across bottom fold with Grey. Sew both sides of each Ear to Head allowing Ears to stand up.

EYEBROW

 (Make 2)

With Grey, ch 4, sc in second ch from hook, 2 sc in next ch, sc in last ch; finish off.

FINISHING

For hair tuft, cut two 4" (10 cm) strands of White. Using a crochet hook, insert strands through stitch at top of Head, between Ears; tie in a knot. Trim ends to 1" (2.5 cm); fray yarn slightly.

Using Photo as guide and two strands of Dk Peach, satin stitch nose (*Figs. 2a & b, page 35*).

Sew Head to Body.

Trace Eye and Teeth patterns. Cut 2 pieces of each Eye pattern from felt and one piece of Teeth pattern from foam. Using photo as guide, glue White Eyes to Head; glue Black pupils to the White Eyes.

Using a Black marker, draw a line partway down center of Teeth and fill in round edge of Teeth. Glue Teeth to Face under upper lip.

Weave in ends carefully on eyebrows. Glue eyebrows over tops of eyes.

Cut 6 pieces of plastic animal whiskers or wire, each 2" (5 cm) long. Insert whiskers into face.

Rnds 24-29: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 30: Sc in next 14 sc, decrease (*see Sc Decrease, page 35*), (sc in next 16 sc, decrease) 3 times, sc in next 4 sc: 70 sc.

Rnd 31: (Sc in next 12 sc, decrease) around: 65 sc.

Rnd 32: Sc in next 6 sc, decrease, (sc in next 11 sc, decrease) 4 times, sc in next 5 sc: 60 sc.

Rnd 33: (Decrease, sc in next 10 sc) around: 55 sc.

Rnd 34: Sc in next 3 sc, decrease, (sc in next 9 sc, decrease) 4 times, sc in next 6 sc: 50 sc.

Rnd 35: Sc in next 4 sc, decrease, (sc in next 6 sc, decrease) 5 times, sc in next 4 sc; slip st in next sc, finish off: 44 sts.

Stuff Body firmly with polyester fiberfill, shaping it to be somewhat flat.

Flatten opening parallel with beginning ch. Skipping first 3 sts, sew seam across next 16 sts; weave yarn through remaining 6 sts on end, gather tightly and secure yarn.

Weave yarn through remaining 6 sts, adding additional polyester fiberfill to Body as needed, gather tightly and secure yarn.

HEAD

With Brown, ch 8.

Rnd 1 (Right side): Sc in second ch from hook and in next 5 chs, 5 sc in last ch; working in free loops of beginning ch, sc in next 5 chs, 4 sc in next ch; join with slip st to first sc: 20 sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in next 5 sc, 2 sc in each of next 5 sc, sc in next 5 sc, 2 sc in each of last 4 sc; join with slip st to first sc: 30 sc.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, sc in first 9 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 9 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in last sc; join with slip st to first sc: 34 sc.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, sc in first 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc, (sc in next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc) twice, sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in last 2 sc; join with slip st to first sc: 40 sc.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in next 4 sc, (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc) 7 times; do **not** join, place marker: 48 sc.

Rnds 6-9: Sc in each sc around.

Begin working in rows.

Row 1: Sc in next 18 sc, leave remaining 30 sc unworked: 18 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn; sc in first 18 sc; finish off leaving a long end for sewing.

Stuff Head firmly with polyester fiberfill. Position Head on Body, with last 2 rows slightly forward (front) and causing the back to be rounded. Sew Head to Body, adding polyester fiberfill firmly to Head before closing.

TUMMY AND CHEEKS

With Lt Brown, ch 10.

Row 1: Sc in second ch from hook and in each ch across: 9 sc.

Row 2 (Right side): Ch 1, turn; 2 sc in first sc, sc in next 7 sc, 2 sc in last sc: 11 sc.

Note: Loop a short piece of yarn around any sc on Row 2 to mark **right** side.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn; sc in each sc across.

Row 4: Ch 1, turn; 2 sc in first sc, sc in each sc across to last sc, 2 sc in last sc: 13 sc.

Rows 5-22: Repeat Rows 3 and 4, 9 times: 31 sc.

Rows 23-28: Ch 1, turn; sc in each sc across; do **not** finish off.

Instructions continued on page 28.



FIRST CHEEK

Row 1: Ch 1, turn; decrease, sc in next 11 sc, decrease, leave remaining 16 sc unworked: 13 sc.

Rows 2-4: Ch 1, turn; decrease, sc in each sc across to last 2 sc, decrease: 7 sc.

Finish off.

SECOND CHEEK

Row 1: With **wrong** side facing, join Lt Brown with slip st in next unworked sc on Row 28; decrease, sc in next 11 sc, decrease: 13 sc.

Rows 2-4: Ch 1, turn; decrease, sc in each sc across to last 2 sc, decrease: 7 sc.

Border: Ch 1, do **not** turn; sc in end of each row and in each st around entire piece; join with slip st to first sc, finish off leaving a long end for sewing.

Using photo as a guide for placement, sew piece to front of Body, stuffing piece with polyester fiberfill before closing and shaping piece to make Cheeks round.

MUZZLE

Rnd 1 (Right side): With Lt Brown, ch 2, 6 sc in second ch from hook; do **not** join, place marker.

Rnd 2: 2 Sc in each sc around: 12 sc.

Rnd 3: (2 Sc in next sc, sc in next sc) around: 18 sc.

Rnd 4: (2 Sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc) around: 24 sc.

Rnds 5 and 6: Sc in each sc around.

FIRST SIDE

Row 1: 2 Sc in next sc, (sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc) twice, slip st in next sc, leave remaining 18 sc unworked.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn; skip first slip st, sc in next 8 sc, slip st in next sc: 9 sts.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn; skip first slip st, sc in next 8 sc, slip st in same sc as next slip st; finish off.



SECOND SIDE

Row 1: With **right** side facing, skip first 6 unworked sc on Rnd 6 from First Side and join Lt Brown with sc in next sc (*see Joining With Sc, page 35*); sc in same st, (sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc) twice, slip st in next sc, leave remaining 5 sts unworked: 9 sts.

Rows 2 and 3: Repeat Rows 2 and 3 of First Side.

Stuff Muzzle with polyester fiberfill. Holding Muzzle between Cheeks, sew Muzzle in place, rounding skipped stitches at top edge and indenting skipped stitches at bottom edge.

NOSE

With Black, ch 4.

Rnd 1 (Right side): Sc in second ch from hook and in next ch, 3 sc in last ch; working in free loops of beginning ch, sc in next ch, 2 sc in next ch; join with slip st to first sc: 8 sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in next sc, 2 sc in each of next 3 sc, sc in next sc, 2 sc in each of last 2 sc; join with slip st to first sc: 14 sc.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in last 2 sc; join with slip st to first sc: 18 sc.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, sc in first 7 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each sc around to last sc, 2 sc in last sc; join with slip st to first sc: 20 sc.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, sc in each sc around; join with slip st to first sc, finish off leaving a long end for sewing.

Sew Nose to Muzzle, stuffing Nose with polyester fiberfill before closing.

LOWER LIP

With Lt Brown, ch 8.

Row 1: Sc in second ch from hook, 2 sc in each of next 5 chs, sc in last ch: 12 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn; sc in each sc across.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn; sc in first sc, decrease 5 times, sc in last sc: 7 sc.

Row 4: Ch 1, turn; sc in first sc, decrease twice, sc in last 2 sc; finish off leaving a long end for sewing: 5 sc.

Sew Lower Lip below Muzzle, stuffing Lip with polyester fiberfill before closing.

TOOTH (Make 2)

Rnd 1 (Right side): With White, ch 2, 5 sc in second ch from hook; do **not** join, place marker.

Rnd 2: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 3: Sc in each sc around; slip st in next sc, finish off leaving a long end for sewing.

Using photo as guide for placement, sew Teeth under Muzzle and next to Lower Lip, taking stitches to help Teeth curve inward.

EAR (Make 2) OUTSIDE

Row 1: With Brown, ch 4, 6 dc in fourth ch from hook (**3 skipped chs count as first dc**): 7 dc.

Row 2 (Right side): Ch 3 (**counts as first dc**), turn; dc in same st, 2 dc in next dc and in each dc across: 14 dc.

Instructions continued on page 30.



Row 3: Ch 1, turn; sc in each dc across; finish off.

INSIDE

Row 1: With Peach, ch 4, 6 dc in fourth ch from hook (**3 skipped chs count as first dc**): 7 dc.

Row 2 (Right side): Ch 1, turn; 2 sc in each dc across; finish off leaving a long end for sewing: 14 sc.

Holding pieces with **wrong** sides together, sew back of Row 2 on Inside to top of Row 2 on Outside.

Using photo as a guide for placement, fold Ear about two thirds over along flat edge. Sew Ear to Head, placing fold toward top of Head on each side.

HAIR (Make 2)

Rnd 1 (Right side): With Brown, ch 2, 6 sc in second ch from hook; do **not** join, place marker.

Rnd 2: (Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc) around: 9 sc.

Rnds 3 and 4: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 5: 2 Sc in next sc, (sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc) twice: 12 sc.

Begin working rows.

Row 1: Sc in next 3 sc, slip st in next sc, leave remaining 8 sc unworked.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn; skip first slip st, sc in next 5 sc, slip st in next sc; finish off leaving a long end for sewing.

Sew Hair to Head behind Ear, with Hair slightly showing above Ear when viewed from front.

LEG (Make 2)

With Brown, ch 13; join with slip st to form a ring.

Foundation Rnd (Right side): Ch 1, sc in each ch around; do **not** join: 13 sc.

Note: Mark Foundation Rnd as **right** side.

Begin working in rows.

Row 1: Sc in next 7 sc, slip st in next sc, leave remaining 5 sc unworked.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn; skip first slip st, sc in next 7 sc, slip st in next sc: 8 sts.

Begin working in rnds.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, turn; skip first slip st, sc in next 7 sc, sc in same sc on Foundation Rnd as next slip st and in next 4 sc, sc in same sc as next slip st; do **not** join, place marker: 13 sc.

Rnd 2: Sc in each sc around; slip st in next sc.

Begin working in rows.

Row 1: Ch 1, turn; skip first slip st, sc in next 6 sc, slip st in next sc, leave remaining 5 sc unworked: 7 sts.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn; skip first slip st, (sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc) 3 times, slip st in same sc on Rnd 2 as next slip st: 10 sts.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn; skip first slip st, sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc, (sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc) twice, sc in last 2 sc, slip st in same sc on Rnd 2 as next slip st: 13 sts.

Rows 4-6: Ch 1, turn; skip first slip st, sc in each sc across, slip st in same sc as next slip st: 13 sts.

Row 7: Ch 1, turn; skip first slip st, (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc) 3 times, skip next slip st, slip st in next sc on Rnd 2: 16 sts.

Row 8: Ch 1, turn; skip first slip st, (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc) 3 times, skip next slip st, slip st in next sc on Rnd 2: 19 sts.

Row 9: Ch 1, turn; skip first slip st, (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 5 sc) 3 times, slip st in same sc as next slip st: 22 sts.

Row 10: Ch 1, turn; skip first slip st, (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 6 sc) 3 times, skip next slip st, sc in next 3 sc on Rnd 2: 27 sc.

Begin working in rnds.

Rnd 1: Do **not** turn; sc in each sc around; do **not** join, place marker.

Rnd 2: Sc in each sc around; slip st in next sc, finish off leaving a long end for sewing.

Stuff Leg firmly with polyester fiberfill. Sew larger opening of Legs over "corners" of lower Body, with bend (knees) pointing outward and slightly forward.

FOOT (Make 2)

Rnd 1 (Right side): With Brown, ch 2, 6 sc in second ch from hook; do **not** join, place marker.

Rnd 2: 2 Sc in each sc around: 12 sc.

Rnd 3: (2 Sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc) around: 15 sc.

Rnd 4: (2 Sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc) around: 18 sc.

Rnds 5-10: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 11: (2 Sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc) around: 24 sc.

Rnd 12: (2 Sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc) around: 30 sc.

Rnd 13: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 14: ★ Sc in next 10 sc, hdc in next sc, 2 hdc in each of next 3 sc, hdc in next sc; repeat from ★ once **more**: 36 sts.

Rnd 15: Decrease around; slip st in next sc, finish off leaving long end for sewing: 18 sts.

Stuff Foot firmly with polyester fiberfill. Flatten last rnd and sew opening closed.

To shape toes, thread yarn needle with cut ends of a doubled strand of Brown. Using photo as a guide for stitch placement, insert needle through bottom of Foot at first toe, and go straight through Foot and out top pulling yarn until loop protrudes from bottom of Foot. Bring yarn over Foot, and insert needle through loop; pull tightly forming toes. Insert needle back through bottom of Foot on outside of loop to secure and bring needle out at second toe on bottom of Foot. Bring yarn over Foot, and insert needle through top of Foot and go straight through Foot and out bottom of Foot at same point; pull tightly forming toes. Take a couple of very small stitches to secure; insert needle inside the Foot and push it out the bottom so the yarn does not show; cut the end close to the Foot.

Sew Foot to opening of Leg with toes pointing outward. Place feet on table and press down on Body to accentuate crouch position.

ARM (Make 2)

With Brown and leaving a long end for sewing, ch 13; join with slip st to form a ring.

Rnd 1 (Right side): Ch 1, sc in each ch around; do **not** join, place marker: 13 sc.

Rnds 2-5: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 6: 2 Sc in next sc, sc in each sc around: 14 sc.

Rnd 7: Sc in next 7 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each sc around: 15 sc.

Rnd 8: Sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each sc around: 16 sc.

Rnd 9: 2 Sc in next sc, sc in each sc around: 17 sc.

Rnd 10: Sc in next 8 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each sc around: 18 sc.

Instructions continued on page 32.

Rnd 11: Sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each sc around: 19 sc.

Rnd 12: 2 Sc in next sc, sc in each sc around: 20 sc.

Rnd 13: Sc in next 10 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each sc around: 21 sc.

SHOULDER

Row 1: Sc in next 10 sc, slip st in next sc, leave remaining 10 sc unworked.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn; skip first slip st, sc in next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc, slip st in next sc: 12 sts.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn; skip first slip st, sc in next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 5 sc, slip st in same sc on Rnd 13 as next slip st: 13 sts.

Row 4: Ch 1, turn; skip first slip st, (sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc) twice, sc in next 2 sc, slip st in same sc on Rnd 13 as next slip st: 15 sts.

Row 5: Ch 1, turn; skip first slip st, sc in next 7 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 6 sc, slip st in same sc on Rnd 13 as next slip st: 16 sts.

Row 6: Ch 1, turn; skip first slip st, sc in each sc across, slip st in same sc on Rnd 13 as next slip st: 16 sts.

Border: Ch 1, turn; skip first slip st, sc in next 15 sc, sc in same sc on Rnd 13 as next slip st and in next 9 sc, sc in next ch; slip st in next sc, finish off leaving a long end for sewing: 26 sts.

Stuff Arms with polyester fiberfill, forming muscles at upper Arms. Sew Arms to Body, placing Shoulder at top and across back, and adding stuffing to Shoulder before closing.

HAND (Make 2) INDEX FINGER

Rnd 1 (Right side): With Brown, ch 2, 6 sc in second ch from hook; do **not** join, place marker.

Rnd 2: (2 Sc in next sc, sc in next sc) 3 times: 9 sc.

Rnds 3-5: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 6: Sc in each sc around; slip st in next sc, finish off.

MIDDLE FINGER

Rnd 1 (Right side): With Brown, ch 2, 7 sc in second ch from hook; do **not** join, place marker.

Rnd 2: Sc in next sc, (2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc) 3 times: 10 sc.

Rnds 3-5: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 6: Sc in each sc around; slip st in next sc, finish off.

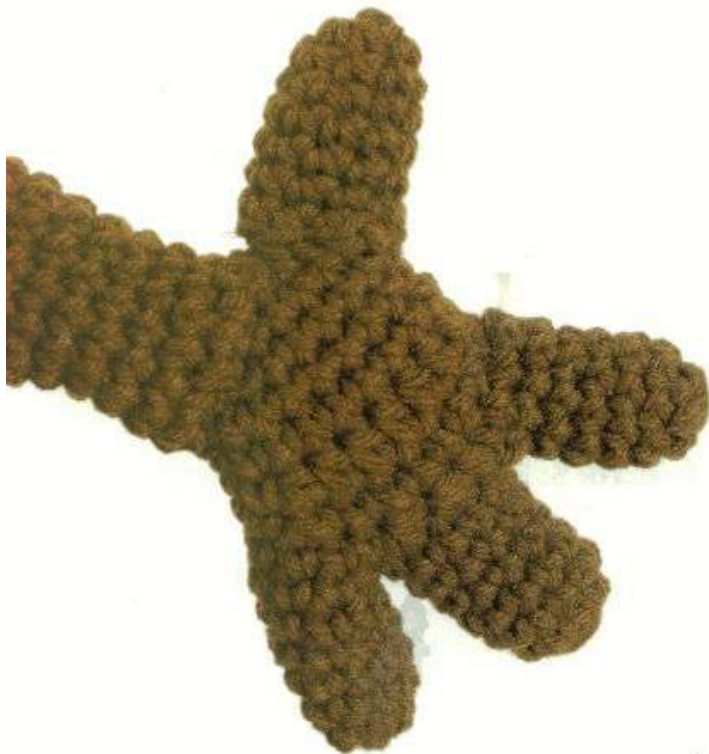
LITTLE FINGER

Rnd 1 (Right side): With Brown, ch 2, 6 sc in second ch from hook; do **not** join, place marker.

Rnd 2: (2 Sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc) twice: 8 sc.

Rnds 3 and 4: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 5: Sc in each sc around; do **not** finish off.



PALM

Rnd 1 (Right side): With **right** side of Middle Finger facing, sc in same sc as slip st on Rnd 6 and in next 4 sc, with **right** side of Index Finger facing, sc in same sc as slip st on Rnd 6 and in next 8 sc, sc in remaining 5 sc on Middle Finger; do **not** join, place marker: 27 sc.

Rnd 2: Sc in next 6 sc, decrease, † hdc in next sc, ★ (YO, insert hook in **next** sc, YO and pull up a loop) twice, YO and draw through all 5 loops on hook; repeat from ★ once **more** †, sc in next 2 sc, decrease twice, sc in next 3 sc, repeat from † to † once: 20 sts.

Rnd 3: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 4: Decrease, sc in next 3 sc, hdc in next 6 sc, sc in next 4 sc, hdc in next 5 sc: 19 sts.

Rnd 5: Hdc in next sc, sc in each st around.

Rnds 6-8: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 9: Sc in each sc around; slip st in next sc, finish off.

THUMB

Rnd 1 (Right side): With Brown, ch 2, 7 sc in second ch from hook; do **not** join, place marker.

Rnd 2: Sc in next sc, (2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc) 3 times: 10 sc.

Rnds 3-6: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 7: Sc in each sc around; slip st in next sc, finish off leaving a long end for sewing.

Stuff Hand with polyester fiberfill. Flatten Rnd 9 of Palm and sew opening closed, adding polyester fiberfill as needed before closing. Stuff Thumb and sew it over one corner of Palm (on same side as index finger). Sew opening of Arm over other corner of Palm with Thumb facing up.

TAIL

Rnd 1 (Right side): With Brown, ch 2, 4 sc in second ch from hook; do **not** join, place marker.

Rnds 2 and 3: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 4: 2 Sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc: 5 sc.

Rnds 5 and 6: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 7: 2 Sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc: 6 sc.

Rnds 8 and 9: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 10: 2 Sc in next sc, sc in next 5 sc: 7 sc.

Rnd 11: Sc in each sc around.

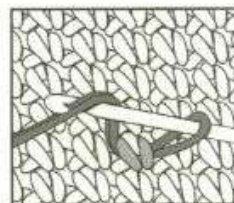
Rnd 12: Sc in each sc around; slip st in next sc, finish off leaving a long end for sewing.

TAIL HAIR

Cut thirty two 4" (10 cm) strands of Brown. Hold 2 strands of yarn together; fold in half. Using a crochet hook, draw the folded end up through tip of Tail and pull the loose ends through the folded end (**Fig. A**); draw the knot up **tightly**. Curve tail slightly and add all strands in same manner along outer edge. Trim strands to 1¹/₂" (4 cm).

Sew tail to center back of Body.

EYEBROW

With Black, ch 14.

Row 1 (Right side): Sc in second ch from hook and in next 5 chs, 2 sc in next ch, sc in last 6 chs; finish off leaving a long end for sewing.

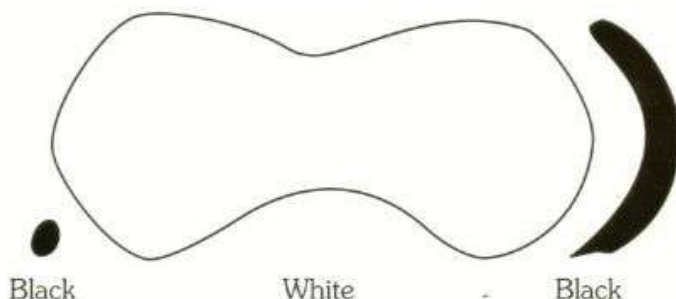
FINISHING

For topknot, cut eleven 7" (18 cm) strands of Brown.

Add one strand at a time to top of Head in same manner as for Tail, arranging them in a group rather than in a line. Trim strands to 2 1/2" (6.5 cm).

Trace eye patterns and cut one piece from White felt and 2 pieces of each pattern from Black felt. Using photo as guide for placement, place White piece on Face and trim as needed so bottom edge fits right around Muzzle and along Cheeks; glue in place. Glue Black crescents along outer edge of eyes. Glue Eyebrow over top of White felt. Glue Black pupils to the White eyes.

GAUGE

Exact gauge is **essential** for proper size. Before beginning your Character, make the sample swatch given in the individual instructions in the yarn and hook specified. After completing the swatch, measure it, counting your stitches and rows carefully. If your swatch is larger or smaller than specified, **make another, changing hook size to get the correct gauge**. Keep trying until you find the size hook that will give you the specified gauge.

MARKERS

Markers are used to help distinguish the beginning of each round being worked. Place a 2" (5 cm) scrap piece of yarn before the first stitch of each round, moving marker after each round is complete.

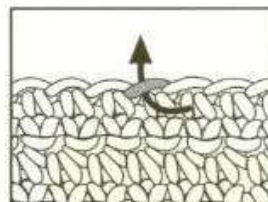
JOINING WITH SC

When instructed to join with sc, begin with a slip knot on hook. Insert hook in stitch or space indicated, YO and pull up a loop, YO and draw through both loops on hook.

FREE LOOPS OF A CHAIN

When instructed to work in free loops of a chain, work in loop indicated by arrow (*Fig. 1*).

SC DECREASE

(*abbreviated decrease*)

Pull up a loop in next 2 sts **or** in first 2 sts at the beginning of a row or rnd, YO and draw through all 3 loops on hook (**counts as one sc**).

SATIN STITCH

Satin Stitch is a series of straight stitches worked side by side so they touch but do not over lap (*Fig. 2a*), or entering and exiting the same hole (*Fig. 2b*). Using yarn, come up at odd numbers and go down at even numbers.

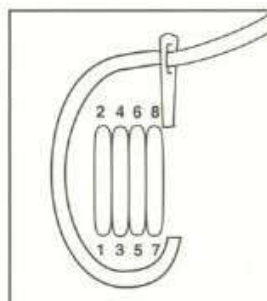
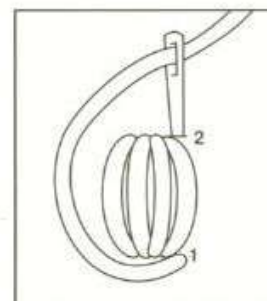

Any brand of Medium/Worsted Weight Yarn may be used. It is best to refer to the yardage/meters when determining how many balls or skeins to purchase. Remember, to arrive at the finished size, it is the GAUGE/TENSION that is important, not the brand of yarn.
