

*Bunny Booties
Pattern*

Skill Level - Intermediate



Materials Needed

- Yarn Vita cotton Lily 100% mercerized cotton, 1.75oz(50g)/137 yds(125m)
Sizes 9/10cm – 1 hank. Sizes 11/12cm – 1.5 hank
You can substitute yarn, just make sure that it matches original proportions

Suggested substitute yarn

Scheepjes Catona, Schachenmayr Catania, Patons Grace

- Crochet hook C/2 or B/1 (2.5mm or 2mm), OR
SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE

- Scissors
- Tapestry needle or smaller crochet hook
- Shoelaces 55 cm (I use macrame cord 100% polyester 3-4mm).

Gauge

26 dc x 13 rows = 4”(10cm)

TAKE TIME TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE!

Abbreviations (US terminology)

- ch – chain
- cont – continue
- rnd(s) – round(s)
- BOR – beginning of the round
- dc – double crochet
- hdc – half double crochet
- sc – single crochet
- bpdc – back post double crochet
- fpdc – front post double crochet
- sl st – slip stitch
- dc2tog – dc 2 together
- inc – increase (2 sc in one st)
- st(s) – stitch(es)
- RS – right side
- WS – wrong side
- The number in parenthesis at the end of each rnd is the total number of sts in the rnd.

! Number of stitches is provided below according to the size as follows:

0-3months / 3-6 months / 6-9 months / 9-12 months

ch 19 / 22 / 25 / 28

0-3 months – foot length approx 3.5”(9 cm)

3-6 months – foot length approx 3.9”(10 cm)

6-9 months – foot length approx 4.3”(11 cm)

9-12 months – foot length approx 4.7”(12 cm)

! Measure the baby’s foot for better fit.

Instructions

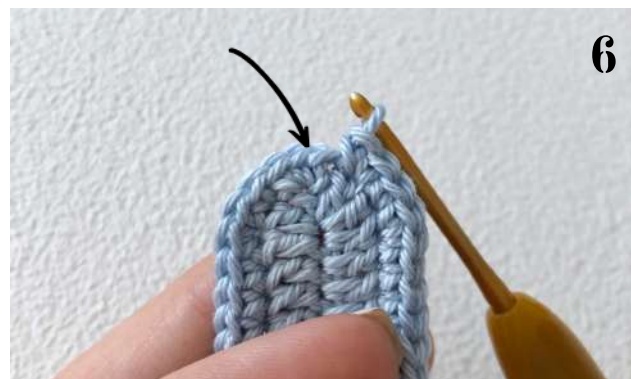
Sole

Rnd 1: Ch 19/22/25/28. 2dc in the 4th st from the hook, dc in next 14/17/20/23 sts, 6dc in the last st, cont to work along the opposite side of the chain, dc in next 14/17/20/23 sts, 3dc in the last st (pic.3). Finish with sl st in ch (pic.4). (40/46/52/58 sts).





Rnd 2: ch1 (do not count as st), 2sc in the same st, sc in next st, 2sc in next st, sc in next 5 sts, hdc in next 2 sts, dc in next 7/10/13/16 sts, 2dc in each of next 6 st, dc in next 7/10/13/16 sts, hdc in next 2 sts, sc in next 5 sts, 2sc in next st, sc in next st, 2 sc in the last st. Finish with sl st in 1st sc. (pic.6) (50/56/62/68 sts).



Rnd 3: ch3 (counts as 1 dc), dc in the same st, [dc in next st, 2dc in next st] 2 times], dc in next 14/17/20/23 sts, [2dc in next st, dc in next st] 6 times], dc in next 14/17/20/23 sts, 2dc in next st, [dc in next st, 2dc in next st] 2 times]. Finish with sl st in ch. (pic.7). (62/68/74/80 sts). Do not cut yarn. The sole is ready.

Sidepiece

Rnd 1: Cont to work with RS facing you, sc, inserting the hook not in the st but under the post of dc of the previous rnd of the sole. RS is inside the bootie.

Work as follows: ch1 (do not counts as st), sc in next 62/68/74/80 post of dc. Finish with sl st in 1st sc. (62/68/74/80 sts)

Rnd 2: ch2 (do not counts as st), dc in next 62/68/74/80 sts. Finish with sl st in 1st dc. (62/68/74/80 sts)

Rnds 3-4: ch1 (do not counts as st), sc in every sts. Finish with sl st in 1st sc. (62/68/74/80 sts). Fasten off and cut yarn. The sidepiece is ready.

*If the baby's foot is roly poly or has a high arches, I recommend repeat round 3 1-2 more times to make higher sidepiece.



Toe (sizes 9/10 cm)

Toe worked back and forth in rows, shaping with decreases.

Row 1(WS): Join yarn at 16th/17th st from the BOR, ch2, dc in next st, [dc2tog 15/17/ times].

Row 2(RS): ch2, turn, dc in next st, [dc2tog 7/8/ times].



Row 3(WS): ch 2, turn, dc7tog/ dc8tog. Do not cut yarn. Toe is ready.



Toe (sizes 11/12 cm)

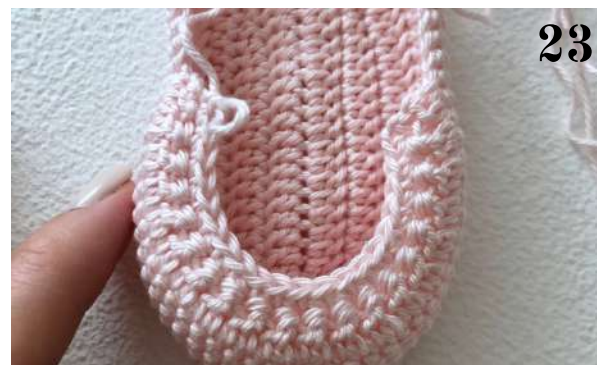
Toe worked back and forth in rows, shaping with decreases.

Row 1(WS): Join yarn at 18th/19th st from the BOR, ch2, dc in next st, [dc2tog 19/21 times].

Row 2(RS): ch1, turn, sc in each of next 20/22 sts.



Row 3(WS): ch2, turn, dc in next st, [dc2tog 9/10 times].

Row 4(RS): ch 2, turn, dc9tog/ dc10tog. Do not cut yarn. Toe is ready.



The upper part (sizes 9/10 cm)

Rnd 1: Continue to work with wrong rounds.

Ch 2 (counts as 1 dc), dc 6 in horizontal sts of the toe (pic. 26). Work DC's along the whole length until we reach the opposite side toe, dc 5 in horizontal sts of the toe (pic. 28). Finish with sl st post ch. (42/44 sts).



Rnds 2-4: Work all next rnds alternating bpdc and fpdc. Ch2, *bpdc in next st, fpdc in next st; rep from *, round ending with bpdc. (42/44 sts). Finish with sl st post ch. Fasten off, cut yarn, weave in all tails.

The upper part (sizes 11/12 cm)

Rnd 1: Continue to work with wrong rounds.

Ch 2 (counts as 1 dc), turn, dc 6 in horizontal sts of the toe (pic. 33). Work DC's along the whole length until we reach the opposite side toe, dc 7 in horizontal sts of the toe (pic. 35). Finish with sl st post ch. (48/50 sts).



Rnds 2-5: Work all next rnds alternating bpdc and fpdc. Ch2, *bpdc in next st, fpdc in next st; rep from *, round ending with bpdc. (48/50 sts). Finish with sl st post ch. Fasten off, cut yarn, weave in all tails.

Ears (Make 4)

Ears are worked in a continuous spiral. Do not join in the rnd, just work sc in the next st. Place marker or use contrasting color yarn to mark BOR.

Rnd 1 - 6 sc in magic ring (6)

Rnd 2 - [inc, sc 2] * 2 (8)

Rnd 3 - [inc, sc 3] * 2 (10)

Rnd 4 - [inc, sc 4] * 2 (12)

Rnd 5 - [inc, sc 5] * 2 (14)

Rnd 6 - [inc, sc 6] * 2 (16)

Rnd 7 - [inc, sc 7] * 2 (18)

Rnd 8 - [inc, sc 8] * 2 (20)

Rnds 9-18 - sc 20, 10 rounds (20)

Fold the ear in half and sc 9 sts along the edge, by connecting opposite sts. Now fold the ear in half again and sew as shown in the pic. 42. Fasten off. Leave a long tail for sewing.

Assembly

Sizes 9/10 cm

Sew the ears to the sts indicated in the pic. 44.

To prevent the ears from falling forward, sew the back of the ears to the fpdc and bpdc as shown in the pic. 47-48.

Sizes 11/12 cm

Sew the ears to the sts indicated in the pic. 50.

To prevent the ears from falling forward, sew the back of the ears to the fpdc and bpdc as shown in the pic. 53-54.

Using a crochet hook, insert the shoelaces into the last rnd, weaving the shoelaces around the upper part.
