

Plush snuggler BUNNY



FINISHED SIZE 41 cm / 16'' (approx.)

PLUSH YARN:

If you make the toy with two colors of yarn, you need 2 skeins of main color yarn (I used Wolans Yarns BUNNY BABY 100g / 120m (131yds) shade 100-18) and some secondary color for a head: I used Wolans Yarns BUNNY BABY 100g / 120m (131yds) shade 100-02. If you make the toy with one color yarn, you need 2 skeins.

YARN ANALOGUES:

- Yarn Art DOLCE (100g / 120m)
- Premier Yarns PARFAIT CHUNKY (100g / 120m)
- Katia BAMBI (100g / 120m)
- King Cole YUMMY (100g / 120m)
- Universal Yarn BELLA CHENILLE (100g / 120m)
- Cygnet JELLY CHUNKY CHENILLE (100g / 120m)

You can use any other plush yarn with the same weight.

If you use a different weight yarn, the size of the finished toy may change. You may also need a hook of a different size (larger or smaller).

CHOCHET HOOK: 4 mm (G6)

EXTRAS:

- toy filling or scraps fabric or yarn for stuffing
- stitch markers
- tapestry needle
- scissors
- thread for sewing details
- rose thread for embroidery nose
- 16 mm toy safety eyes OR dark thread for embroidery eyes

ABBREVIATIONS:

sc = single crochet

inc = increase

dec = decrease

sl st = slip stitch

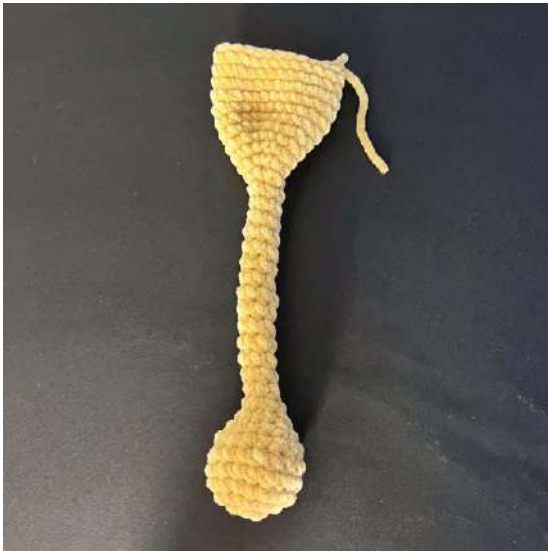
MR = magic ring

SPIRAL WAY

All details of the toy crocheted in a spiral way.

Crocheting in the spiral is the technique of working in the round in a continuous manner, without joining the separate rounds with a slip stitch.

LEGS (make 2)



Use the main color yarn.

Magic ring.

Round 1: 6sc inside MR (6)

Round 2: 6inc (12)

Round 3: (1sc, inc) x6 (18)

Rounds 4-6: 18sc (18)

Round 7: (4sc, dec) x3 (15)

Round 8: (3sc, dec) x3 (12)

Add some filler.

Round 9: (2sc, dec) x3 (9)

Round 10: (1sc, dec) x3 (6)

Rounds 11-25: 6sc (6)

Round 26: (1sc, inc) x3 (9)

Round 27: (2sc, inc) x3 (12)

Round 28: (3sc, inc) x3 (15)

Round 29: (4sc, inc) x3 (18)

Round 30: (5sc, inc) x3 (21)

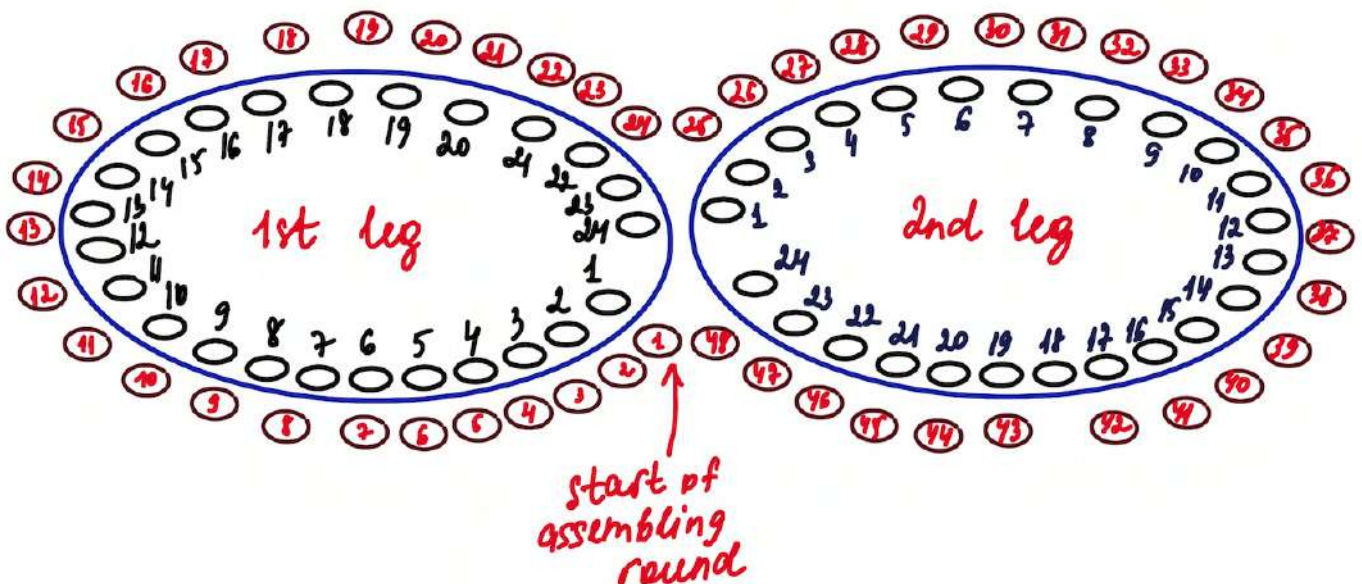
Round 31: (6sc, inc) x3 (24)

Rounds 32-36: 24sc (24)

Cut the yarn. Make the second leg in the same way, but don't cut the thread at the end.

BODY

Assembling round 1: join the 2nd leg with 1st leg (insert hook and make sc in the point where stitch 24 of the last round ended), 23sc of 1st leg, join with the leg 2 (insert hook and make sc in the point where stitch 24 of last round ended), 23sc of 2nd leg (48)



Rounds 2-5: 48sc (48)
Round 6: (6sc, dec) x6 (42)
Rounds 7-8: 42sc (42)
Round 9: (5sc, dec) x6 (36)
Rounds 10-11: 36sc (36)
Round 12: (4sc, dec) x6 (30)
Rounds 13-14: 30sc (30)
Round 15: (3sc, dec) x6 (24)
Rounds 16-17: 24sc (24)
Round 18: (2sc, dec) x6 (18)
Rounds 19-20: 18sc (18)
Round 21: (1sc, dec) x6 (12), sl st.
 Cut the yarn.
 Make knots on the legs.



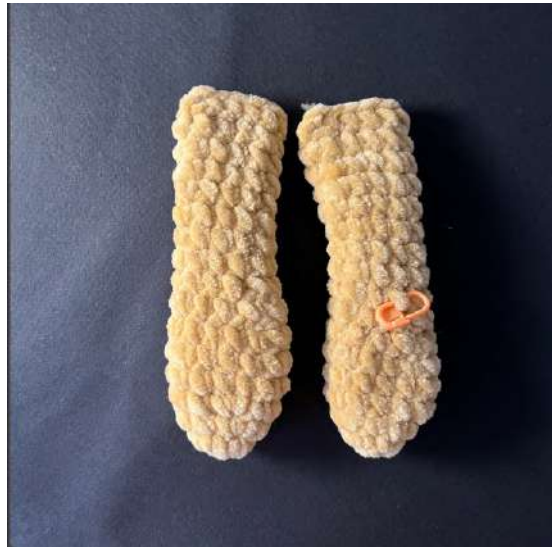
ARMS (make 2)

Use the main color yarn.
 Magic ring.
Round 1: 6sc inside MR (6)
Round 2: (1sc, inc) x3 (9)
Round 3: (2sc, inc) x3 (12)
Rounds 4-6: 12sc (12)
Round 7: 10sc, dec (11)
Round 8: 9sc, dec (10)
Rounds 9-16: 10sc (10)
 Fold and crochet the edges together 5sc. Cut the yarn.

Make the second arm in the same way in rounds 1-6.
Round 7: dec, 10sc (11)
Round 8: dec, 9sc (10)

Rounds 9-16: 10sc (10)

Fold and crochet the edges together 5sc. Cut the yarn.



HEAD

Start with secondary color yarn.

Magic ring.

Round 1: 6sc inside MR (6)

Round 2: 6inc (12)

Round 3: (1sc, inc) x6 (18)

Round 4: (2sc, inc) x6 (24)

Round 5: (3sc, inc) x6 (30)

Round 6: (4sc, inc) x6 (36)

Rounds 7-8: 36sc (36)

Change yarn to the main color.

Rounds 9-15: 36sc (36)

If you use the safety eyes, attach them between rounds 10 and 11 (leave 8 stitches between the eyes).

Round 16: (4sc, dec) x6 (30)

Round 17: (3sc, dec) x6 (24)

Fill the head with filler.

Round 18: (2sc, dec) x6 (18)

Round 19: (1sc, dec) x6 (12)

Add more filler to the head.

Round 20: 6dec (6)

Cut the yarn, pull the hole. Hide the end of the thread inside the head.



EARS (make 2)

Use the main color yarn.

Magic ring.

Round 1: 6sc inside MR (6)

Round 2: (1sc, inc) x3 (9)

Round 3: (2sc, inc) x3 (12)

Round 4: (3sc, inc) x3 (15)

Round 5: (4sc, inc) x3 (18)

Round 6: (5sc, inc) x3 (21)

Round 7: (6sc, inc) x3 (24)

Rounds 8-14: 24sc (24)

Round 15: (6sc, dec) x3 (21)

Rounds 16-17: 21sc (21)

Round 18: (5sc, dec) x3 (18)

Rounds 19-20: 18sc (18)

Round 21: (4sc, dec) x3 (15)

Rounds 22-23: 15sc (15)

Round 24: (3sc, dec) x3 (12)

Rounds 25-26: 12sc (12)

Fold and crochet the edges together 6sc. Cut the yarn.



TAIL

Use the main color yarn.

Magic ring.

Round 1: 6sc inside MR (6)

Round 2: 6inc (12)

Round 3: 12sc (12)

Round 4: (2sc, dec) x3 (9)

Cut the yarn.



FINISHING THE TOY

1. Sew the head to the body. Sew the arms to the body, leave 4 stitches between the arms. Sew the tail to the back.



2. Sew the ears to the head between rounds 17 and 18.

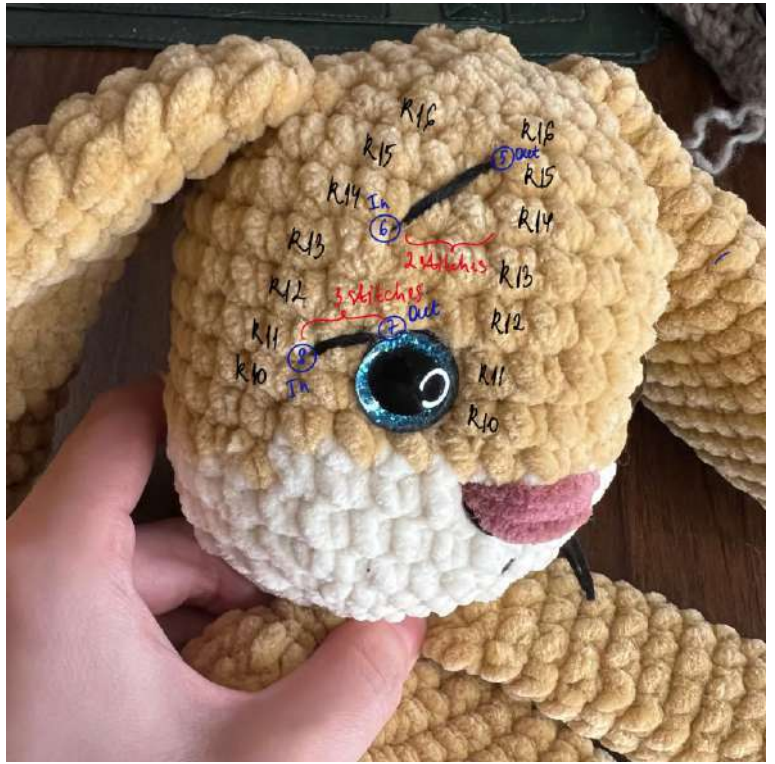


3. Embroider the nose with pink thread between rounds 8 and 9. I got a nose 5 stitches wide. You can use any yarn you have (plush or cotton or acrylic). Hide the end of the thread inside the head.

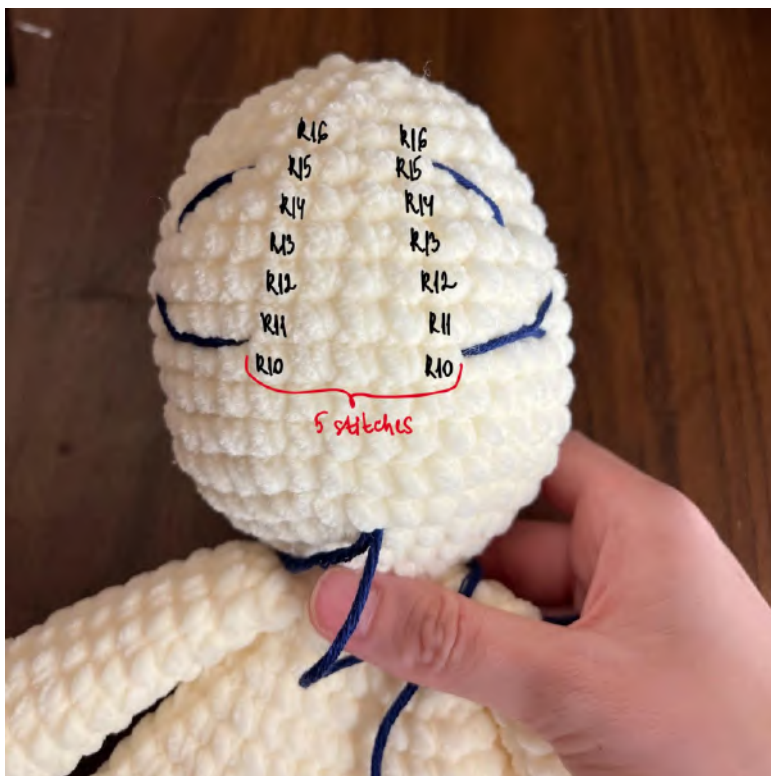


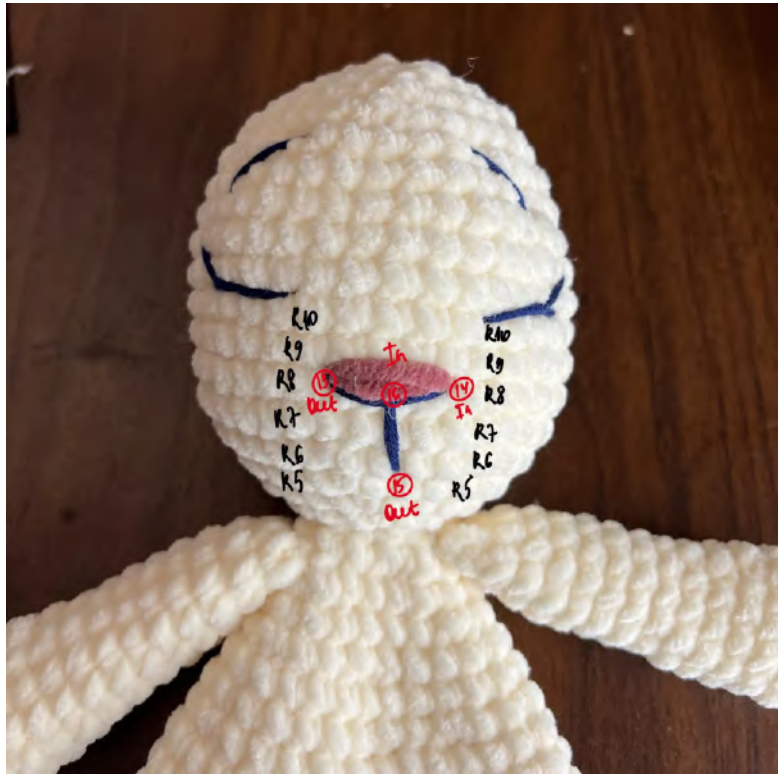
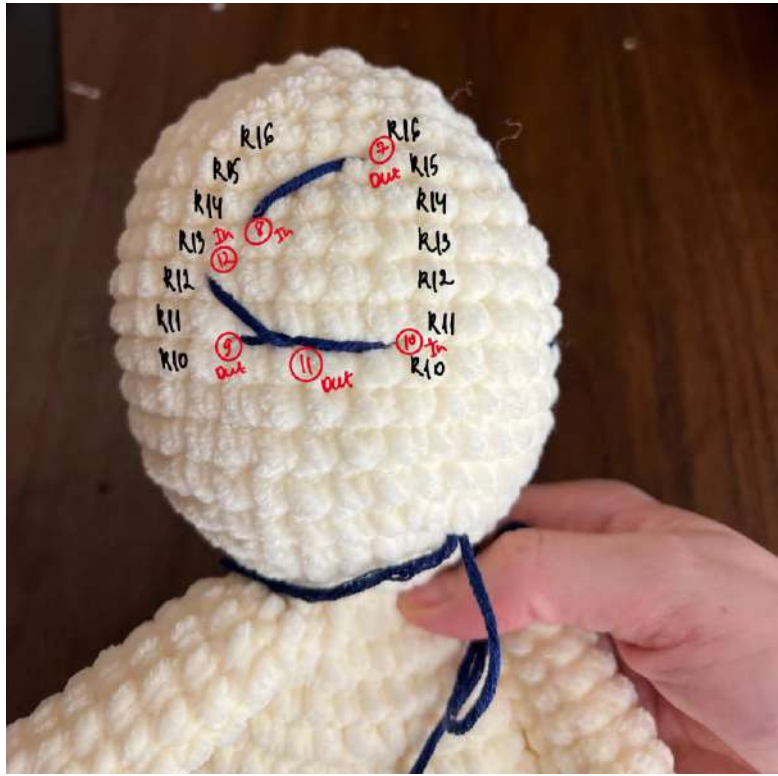
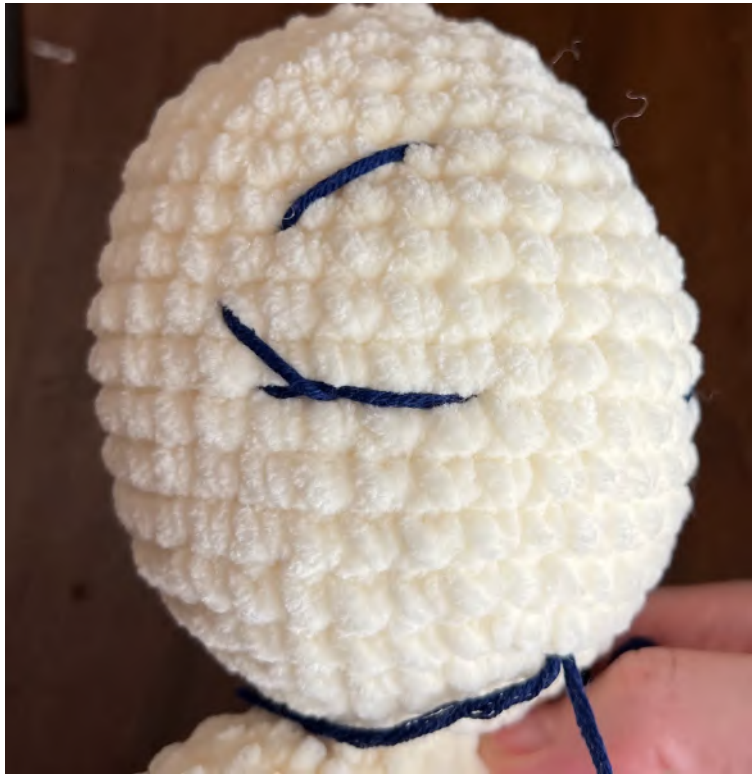
4. Embroider the nose, the eyelashes and the brows with dark thread.





If you don't use the safety eyes, embroidery the eyes, the nose and the brows with dark thread.





5. Tighten the muzzle with the thread of the main color.
