

CROCHET PATTERN

BUNNY'S HOUSE



The required materials:

- Lace weight / 1ply yarn Vita Pelican (50g /330m)
- N3854 – pink
- N3951 – white
- N3952 – black
- N3954 – light brown
- N3966 – orange
- N3976 – beige
- N3995 – green
- N3973 – brown
- N4011 – gray
- N4002 – purple
- N4335 – light green
- 1 mm crochet hook
- Stuffing material, fiberfill
- Needle for sewing pieces together
- Glue eyes (4mm) – 2 pairs
- Super glue
- Pink pastel for toning
- Black acrylic paint
- Scissors

When using the indicated materials, the height of bunny's is 7-8 cm/ 3 inches; the diameter of the Flower Meadow is 20 cm/ 7-8 inches, the size of the carrot house: long is 12 cm/ 5 inches, wide is 5 cm/ 2 inches, high is 6 cm/2.5 inches.

Terms and abbreviations (US):

MR - magic ring

ch- chain

(...)* – repeat stitches in brackets the given number of times

sc – single crochet

3 sc inc – crochet 3 sc in one stitch

inc – increase – Two Single Crochet in one stitch

dec – decrease – two single crochet together

dc – double crochet

dc-inc - Double Crochet Increase - 2 Dc in one stitch

tr – treble crochet

tr cluster – crochet 4 tr in one stitch with a common top

sl st - slip stitch

4-dc Bobble st – crochet 4 dc in one stitch with a common top (work 4 dc into the same loop, yarn over and pull through all 5 loops)

FLO - front loops only

BLO - back loops only

9. (1sc, dec) *6, 12sc (24)

10.-14. 24sc (5 rounds) (24)

15. (2sc, dec) *6 (18)

16. 18sc (18)

Stuff with fiberfill in the process.



Head

17. 18inc (36)

18. (5sc, inc) *6 (42)

19.-23. 42sc (5 rounds) (42)

24. (5sc, dec) *6 (36)

25. (4sc, dec) *6 (30)

26.-29. 30sc (4 rounds) (30)

30. (3sc, dec) *6 (24)

Stuff the head with fiberfill.

31. (2sc, dec) *6 (18)

32. (1sc, dec) *6 (12)

33. 6dec

Fasten off, cut the yarn, weave in the yarn ends.



Hind legs (make 2)

With Pink yarn.

1. Chain 6. Start in the second chain from the hook: inc, 3sc, 3sc in the last chain, 4sc (12)
2. Change color to White.
2inc, 3sc, 3inc, 3sc, inc (18)
3. 8sc, (4-dc Bobble st, sc) *3, 4sc (18)

Stuff with fiberfill in the process.

4. 4sc, 6dec, 2sc (12)
5. (2sc, dec) *3 (9)
6. (1sc, dec) *3 (6)
- 7.-10. 6sc (4 rounds) (6)

Fasten off, cut the yarn, weave in the yarn ends.



Ears (make 2)

With White yarn.

1. 6sc in MR
Place row marker here.
2. (1sc, inc) *3 (9)
3. 9sc (9)
4. (2sc, inc) *3 (12)
5. 12sc (12)
6. (1sc, inc) *6 (18)
- 7.-10. 18sc (4 rounds) (18)
11. (1sc, dec) *6 (12)
12. -16. 12sc (5 rounds) (12)
17. 6dec (6)
18. 6sc. Do not stuff.
Leave a long tail for sewing.



Front legs (make 2)

With White yarn.

1. 6sc in MR

Place row marker here.

2.-3. 6sc (2 rounds) (6)

Stuff with fiberfill in the process.

4. inc, 5sc (7)

5.-8. 7sc (4 rounds) (7)

9. 3sc, dec, 2sc (6)

Fasten off, cut the yarn, weave in the yarn ends.



Tail

With White yarn.

1. 6sc in MR

Place row marker here.

2. 6inc (12)

3. 12sc (12)

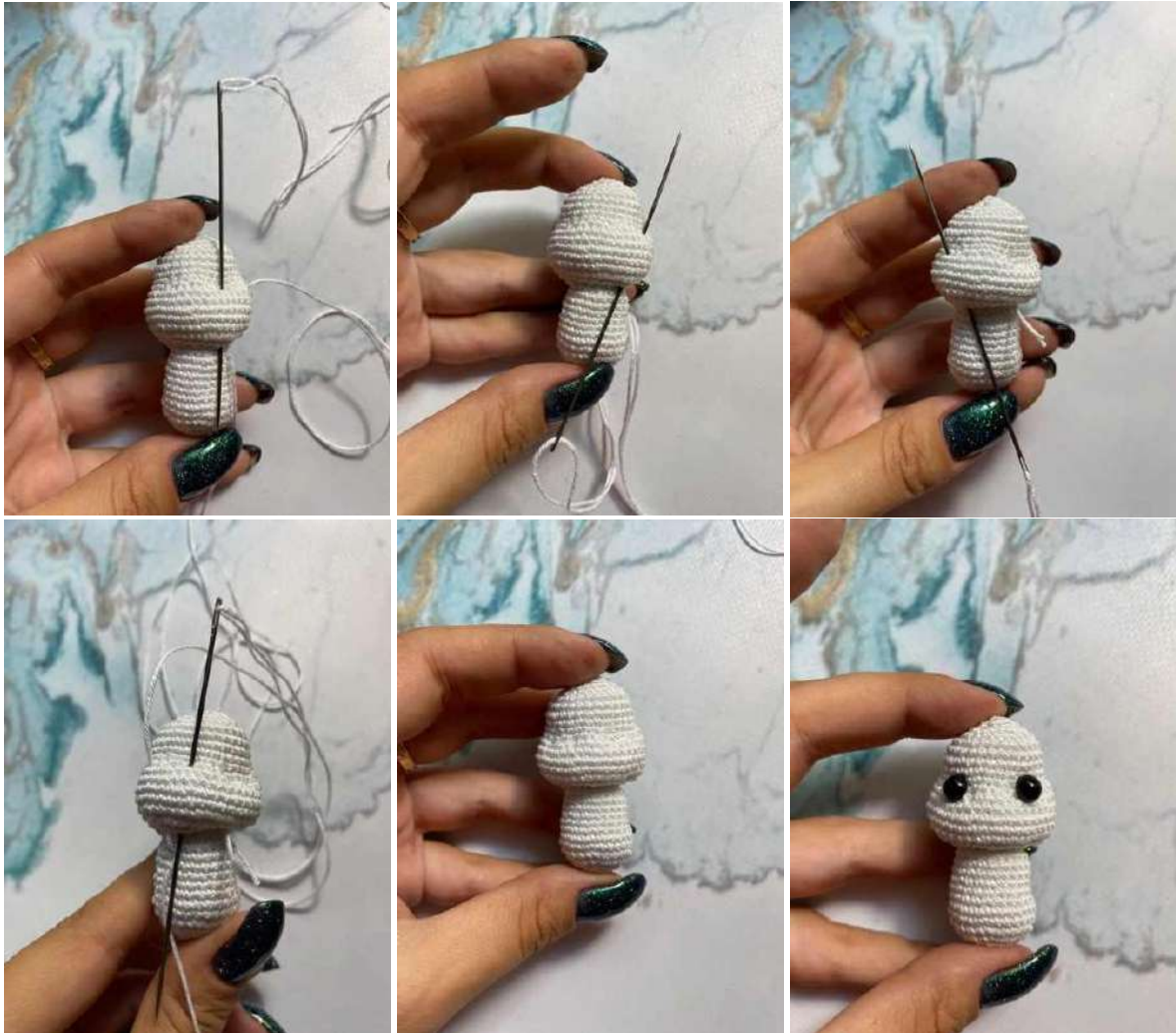
4. 6dec

Stuff with fiberfill.

Leave a long tail for sewing.



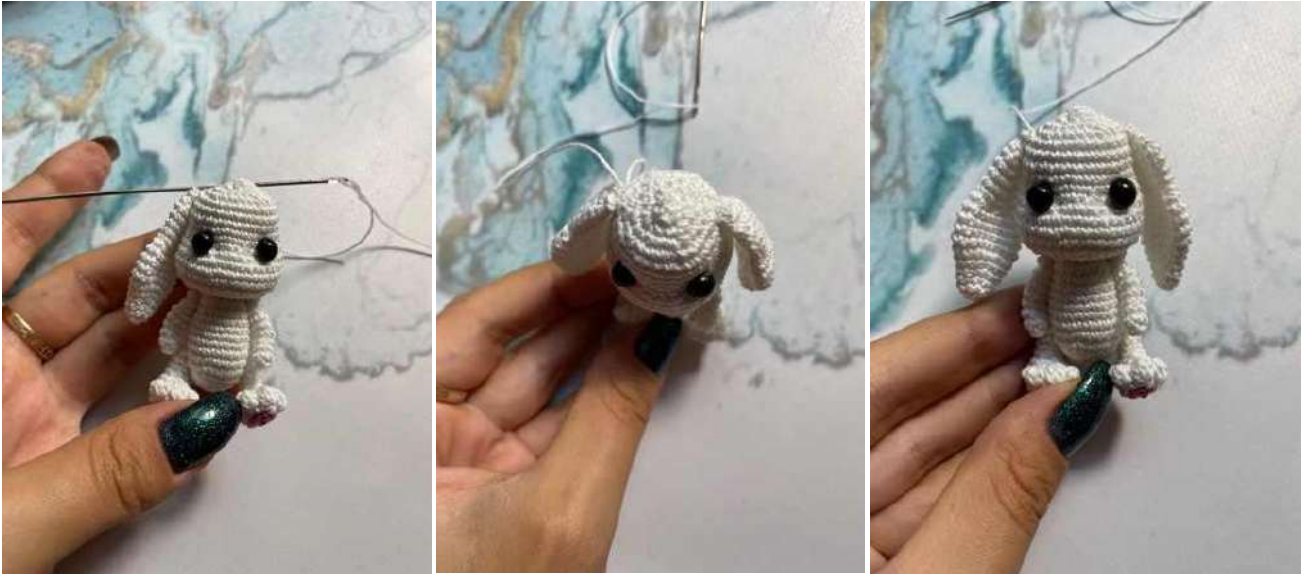
**Tighten cheeks following the pictures below.
Glue the eyes between rounds 23-24 at a distance of 6-8 sc.**



Fasten the legs and arms with a thread mount. Attach the legs and arms using a long needle and thread (look at the pictures below). Sew the tail to the body.



Sew the ears to the head.



Embroider a nose with pink thread. Embroider the outlines of the nose, mouth and eyebrows with a black thread. Use pink pastel to paint the cheeks and the inside of the ears.

11. -14. 12sc (4 rounds) (12)

15. 6dec (6)

Do not stuff.

Leave a long tail for sewing.

5.-8. 7sc (4 rounds) (7)

9. 3sc, dec, 2sc (6)



Fasten off, cut the yarn, weave in the yarn ends.

Hind legs (make 2)

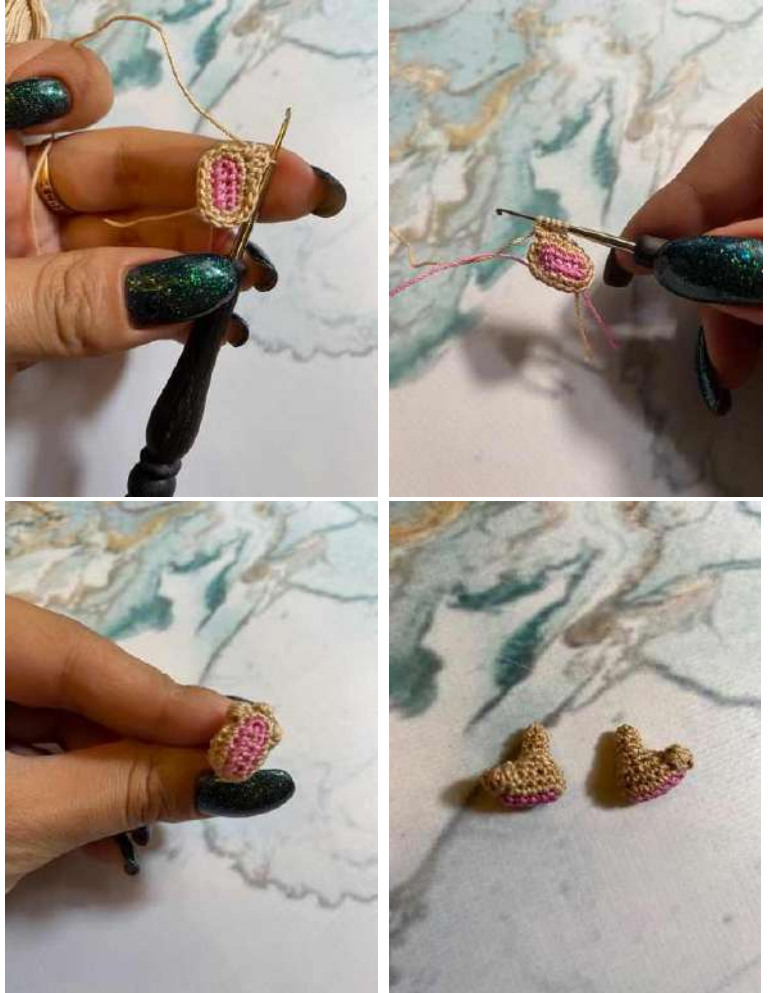

1. Chain 6. Start in the second chain from the hook: inc, 3sc, 3sc in the last chain, 4sc (12)
2. Change color to Beige.
2inc, 3sc, 3inc, 3sc, inc (18)
3. 8sc, (4-dc Bobble st , sc) *3, 4sc (18)

Stuff with fiberfill in the process.

4. 4sc, 6dec, 2sc (12)
5. (2sc, dec) *3 (9)
6. (1sc, dec) *3 (6)
- 7.-9. 6sc (3 rounds) (6)

Fasten off, cut the yarn, weave in the yarn ends.



Tail

With Beige yarn.

1. 6sc in MR
Place row marker here.
2. 6inc (12)
3. 12sc (12)
4. 6dec

Stuff with fiberfill.

Leave a long tail for sewing.



Tighten cheeks following the pictures below.



Sew the head to the body.



Fasten the legs and arms with a thread mount. Attach the front legs and hind legs using a long needle and thread (look at the pictures below). Sew the tail to the body.



Sew the ears to the head.



Embroider a nose with a pink thread. Embroider the outlines of the nose, mouth and eyebrows with a black thread. Glue eyes between rounds 10-11 at a distance of 6-8 sc.



Use pink pastel to paint the cheeks and the inside of the ears.

Ears (make 2)

With Gray yarn.

1. 6sc in MR

Place row marker here.

2. 6sc (6)

3. (1sc, inc) *3 (9)

4. 9sc (9)

5. (2sc, inc) *3 (12)

6.-7. 12sc (2 rounds) (12)

8. 6dec (6)

Do not stuff.

Leave a long tail for sewing.



Hind legs (make 2)

With Pink yarn.

1. 8sc in MR

Place row marker here.

2. Change color to Gray.

8sc (8)

3. 2sc, 2dec, 2sc (6)

Stuff with fiberfill in the process.

4.-7. 6sc (4 rounds)

Fasten off, cut the yarn, weave in the yarn ends.



Front legs (make 2)

With Gray yarn.

1. 6sc in MR

Place row marker here.

2.-6. 6sc (5 rounds) (6)

Stuff with fiberfill in the process.

Fasten off, cut the yarn, weave in the yarn ends.

3. (1sc, inc) *6 (18)

4.-7. 18sc (4 rounds) (18)

8. (1sc, dec) *6 (12)

9.-11. 12sc (3 rounds)

Stuff with fiberfill in the process.

Head

12. 12inc (24)

13.-15. 24sc (3 rounds) (24)

16. (2sc, dec) *6 (18)

17.-19. 18sc (3 rounds)

20. (1sc, dec) *6 (12)

Stuff the head with fiberfill.

21. 6dec

Fasten off, cut the yarn, weave in the yarn ends.



Tail

With Gray yarn.

1. 6sc in MR

Place row marker here.

2. (1sc, inc) *3 (9)

3. 9sc (9)

4. (1sc, dec) *3 (6)

Stuff with fiberfill.

Leave a long tail for sewing.



Fasten the legs and arms with a thread mount. Attach the front legs and hind legs using a long needle and thread (look at the pictures below).



Sew the tail to the body. Sew the ears to the head. Embroider a nose with a pink thread. Embroider a mouth and eyes with a black thread. Use pink pastels to paint the cheeks and the inside of the ears.



Newborn envelope

With White yarn.

Work in rows.

1. Chain 13. From the second chain on the hook: 12sc, turn (12)
- 2.-36. ch1, 12sc, turn (35 rows) (12)
37. ch1, dec, 8sc, dec, turn (10)
38. ch1, 10sc, turn (10)
39. ch1, dec, 6sc, dec, turn (8)
40. ch1, 8sc, turn (8)
41. ch1, dec, 4sc, dec, turn (6)
42. ch1, 6sc

Fasten off, cut the yarn, weave in the yarn ends.



Fold the envelope in half and crochet around with pink yarn, connecting the part on the sides: ch1, (sc, 3dc in one stitch) * 26.

Cut the yarn and fasten off.

Put the bunny into the envelope

Fasten off, cut the yarn, weave in the yarn ends.



Inner (small) leaves (make 4)

With Green yarn.

Work in rows.

1. 5sc in MR, turn

2. ch1, 2sc, 3sc inc, 2sc, turn (7)

3. ch1, sc, inc, sc, 3sc inc, sc, inc, sc, turn (11)

4. ch1, 2sc, inc, 2sc, 3sc inc, 2sc, inc, 2sc, turn (15)

5. ch1, 3sc, inc, 3sc, 3sc inc, 3sc, inc, 3sc, turn (19)



6. ch1, 4sc, inc, 4sc, 3sc inc,
4sc, inc, 4sc, turn (23)
Leave a long tail for sewing.

Outer (large) leaves (make 4)

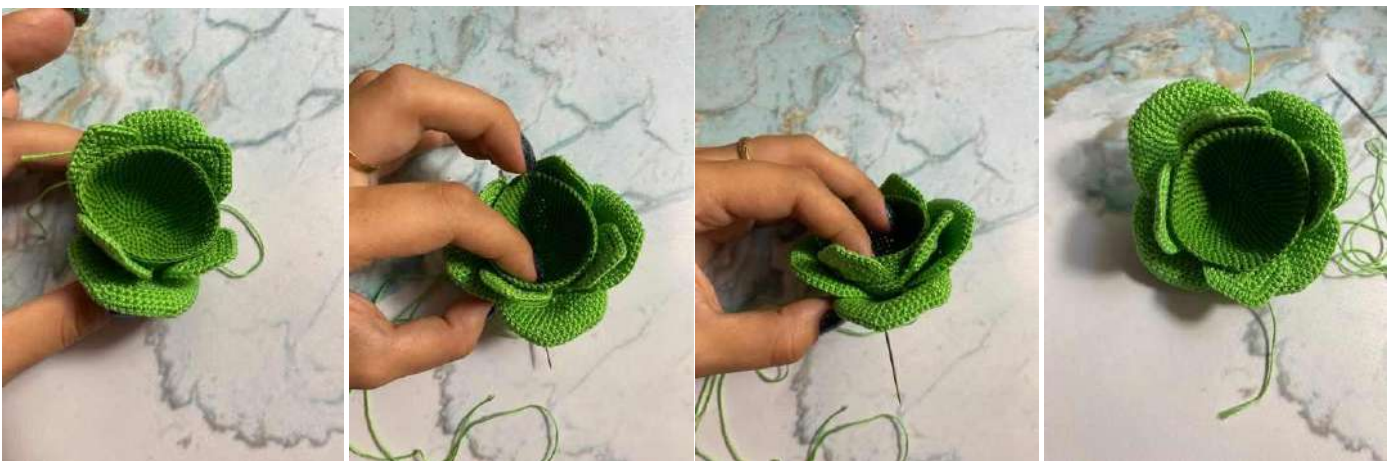
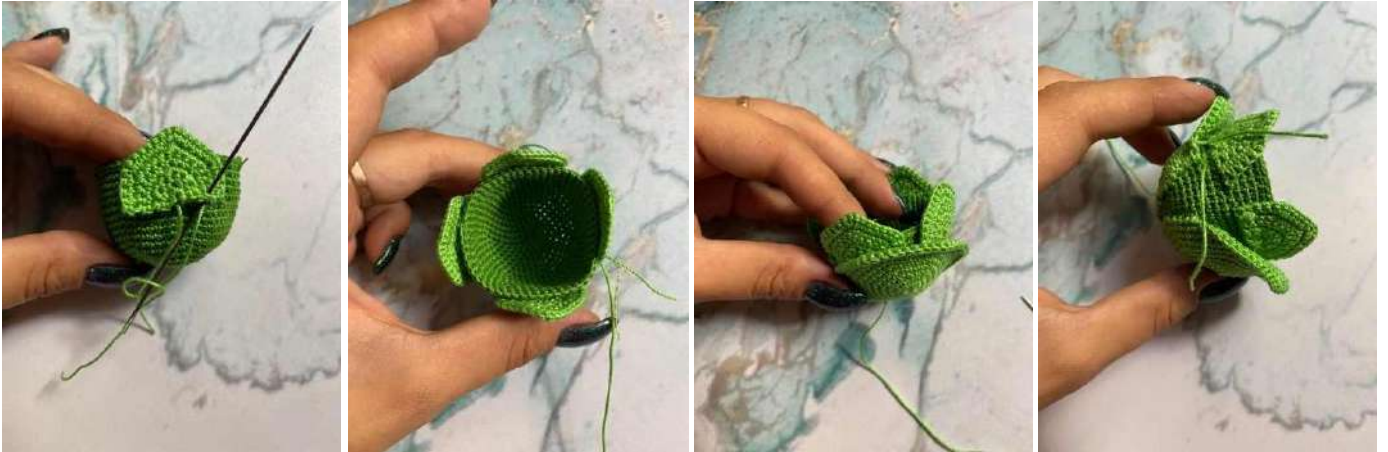

Stuff with fiberfill.

4. ch1, 2sc, inc, 2sc, 3sc inc, 2sc, inc, 2sc, turn (15)



5. ch1, 3sc, inc, 3sc, 3sc inc, 3sc, inc, 3sc, turn (19)
 6. ch1, 4sc, inc, 4sc, 3sc inc, 4sc, inc, 4sc, turn (23)
- Leave a long tail for sewing.

Outer (large) leaves (make 4)

With Green yarn.

3. (1sc, inc) *6 (18)

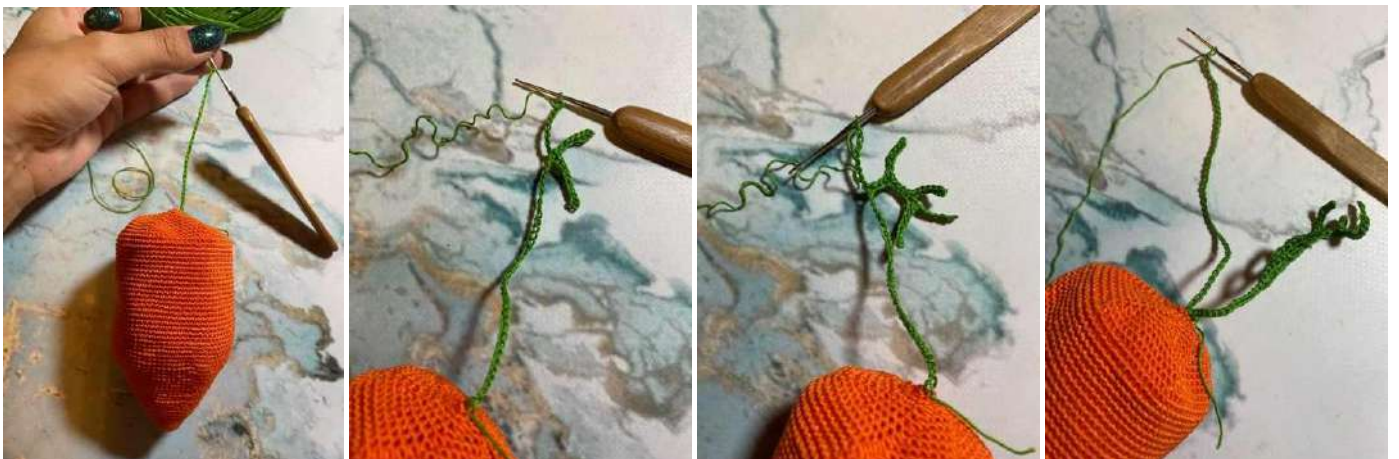
Attach the Orange yarn to the corner of the door and crochet around: 54 sc, cut the yarn.

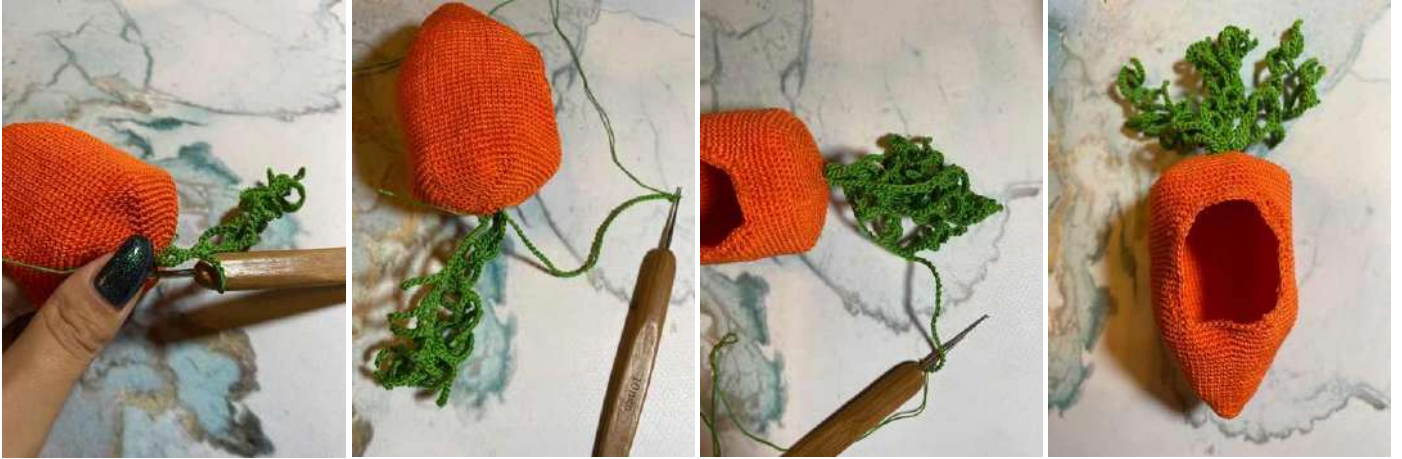


Greens



Attach the green yarn to front loops of the last round of the carrot (round 63), work in a spiral (from round 63 to 64):
(sl st into front loop, ch45, from the second chain: 6sl st, 1st leaf (ch7, from the second chain: 6 sl st), return to the green – 4sl st, 2nd leaf (ch7, from the second chain: 6 sl st), on the green – 4sl st, 3rd leaf (ch7, from the second chain: 6 sl st), on the green – 6sl st, 4th leaf (ch7, from the second chain: 6 sl st), on the green– 6sl st, 5th leaf (ch7, from the second chain: 6 sl st), on the green– 6sl st, 6th leaf (ch7, from the second chain: 6 sl st), on the green – 6sl st, 7th leaf (ch7, from the second chain: 6 sl st), on the green – 6sl st, sl st into front loop)* 14. Cut the yarn and fasten off.





Window With White yarn.

1. 6sc in MR

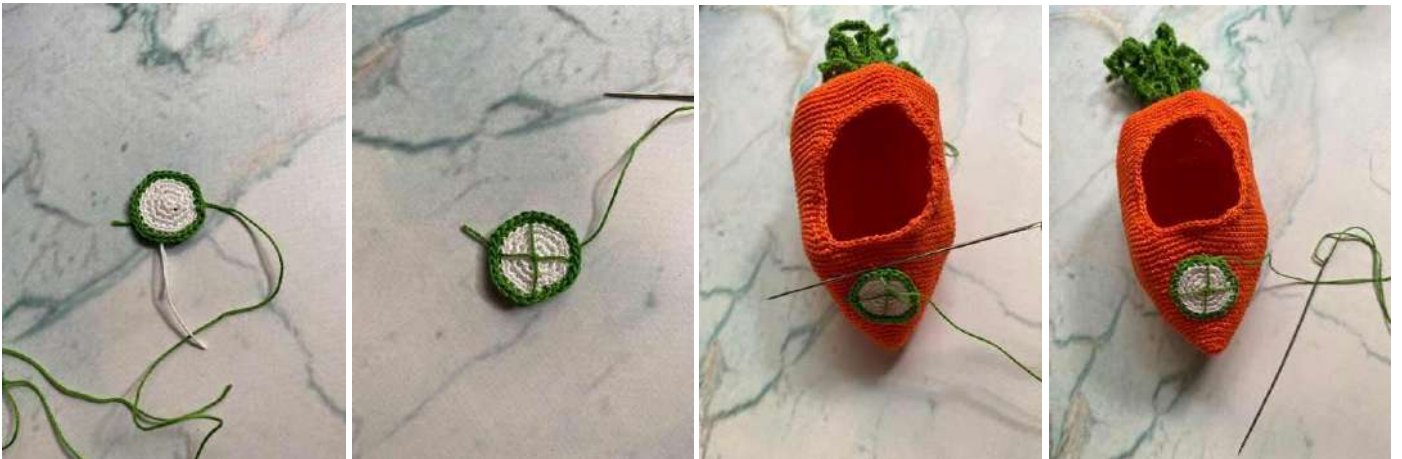
Place row marker here.

2. 6inc (12)

3. (1sc, inc) *6 (18)

4. (2sc, inc) *6 (24)

5. Change color to Green. (3sc, inc) *6 (30). Leave a long tail for sewing. Sew the window to the carrot house (see photo) and embroider the partition at the window. Use black acrylic paint to draw stripes on the carrot house.



Ladder

Steps (make 3)

With Brown yarn.

1. 6sc in MR

Place row marker here.

2.-11. 6sc (11 rounds) (6)

Stuff with fiberfill in the process.

Leave a long tail for sewing.

Base (make 2)

With Brown yarn.

1. 6sc in MR

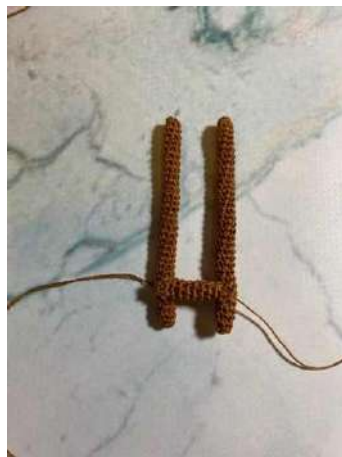
Place row marker here.

2.-30. 6sc (29 rounds) (6)

Fasten off, cut the yarn, weave in the yarn ends.



Sew the steps to the base.

Work in rows.

1. Chain 11. Start from the second chain on the hook: 10sc, turn (10)

2.-5. ch1, 10sc, turn (4 rows)
 (10)

Leave a long tail for sewing.



Sew the pieces of the track to the clearing, alternating beige with brown.



Flower (Make 5)

Crochet 3 purple flowers with a white center and 2 pink flowers with a white center.

1. 5sc in MR

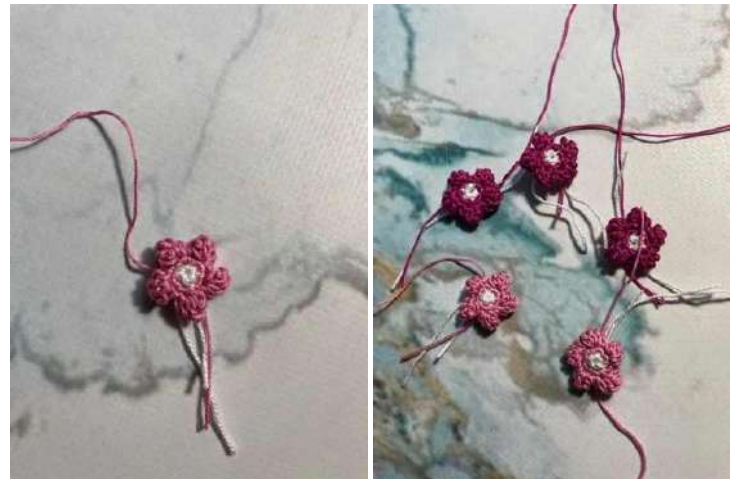
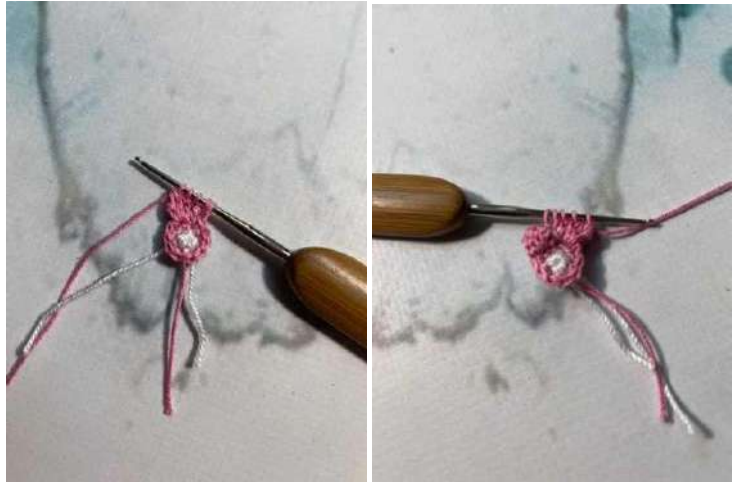
Place row marker here.

2. Change color.

5inc (10)

3. (4-tr cluster, ch1, sc) *5

Leave a long tail for sewing.



Leaves (make 9)

With Green yarn

1. Chain 7, from the second chain from the hook: sl st, sc, 2dc, sc, (sc, dc, sc) in the last chain, sc, 2dc, sc, sl st.

Leave a long tail for sewing.



**Sew flowers near the track.
Sew the leaves to the flowers.**



The basket / Carrot basket

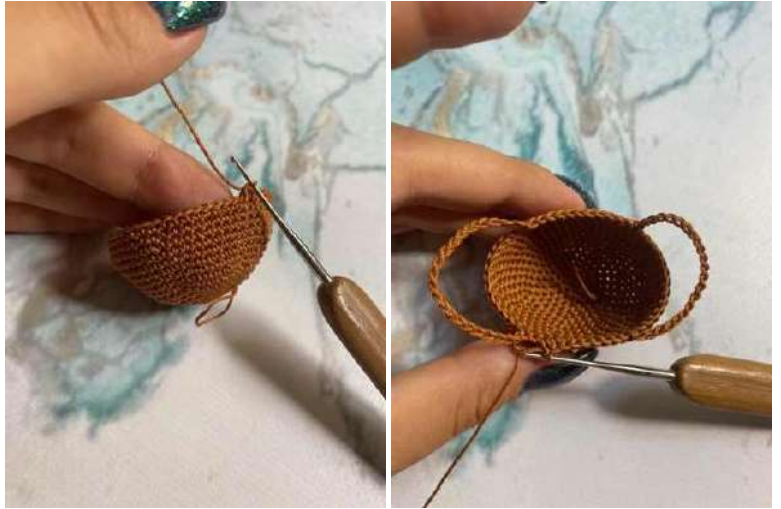

With Orange yarn

1. 6sc in MR

Place row marker here.

2. 6sc (6)

3. (1sc, inc) *3 (9)

4. 9sc (9)

5. (2sc, inc) *3 (12)

6. 12sc (12)

7. (3sc, inc) *3 (15)

8.-10. 15sc (3 rounds) (15)



Stuff with fiberfill in the process.

11. (3sc, dec) *3 (12)

12. 6dec

Fasten off, cut the yarn, weave in the ends.

Crochet the tops in green (3 pieces per carrot): ch16, from the second chain from the hook: 15sc.

Leave a long tail for sewing.

Sew the tops to the carrot.



**Use black acrylic paint to draw stripes on the carrot.
Put the carrot in the basket.**
