## *Bunny in carrot Crochet Pattern*



## Materials And Tools:

- Original yarn:

**Cotton yarn** Premier Yarns Cotton Fair 290m(317yads)/100g in yellow color 27-11 Lemon Drops - 20g, in white color 27-01 White - 5g.



**Plush yarn** Premier Yarns Parfait Chunky 120m (131 yds)/100g in orange color 1150-15 Tangerine – 20g, in green color 1150-49 Key Lime or 1150-06 Mint – 5g.



- Substitute yarn:

Cotton yarn Yarnart Jeans 159m(174yads)/50g in yellow color 67 - 20g, in white 01 - 5g.

Plush yarn Himalaya Dolphin Baby 120m (131 yds)/100g in orange color 80316 – 15g, in green color 80347 or 80350 – 5g.

- Hook US size B/2 (2.5 mm) for bunny and G/6 (4 mm) for carrot
- Black Safety eyes 7-8 mm (you can substitute safety eyes with buttons or simply crochet the eyes with black yarn). *You can find them on Etsy, Amazon, Joann's, AliExpress.*
- Button for carrot 15-20 mm
- Fiber fill stuffing
- Tapestry needle
- Scissors
- Pink and brown cotton yarn for embroidery

## Skill level:

Easy. Basic crocheting skills required.

You can use any yarn to make this amigurumi. For example, if you use a smaller hook and a suitable yarn, the toy will be smaller while maintaining the same proportions.

## Finished Measurements:

Approximately 4 in/10 cm high without ears and 6 in/15 cm high with ears. using original yarn and hook B/2 (2.5 mm).

## Gauge:

- 21 sc sts × 21 rows = 4 in x 4 in / 10 cm x 10 cm using hook B/2 (2.5 mm).

## ***Crochet Abbreviations (US terminology):***

dc - double crochet

dec - decrease

inc - increase

rep - repeat

rnd(s) - round(s)

sc - single crochet

sl st - slip stitch

st(s) - stitch(s)

() - rep the content of the parenthesis as many times as the number after parenthesis says.

The number after = is the total number of stitches in the rnd.

### ***Beginning:***

All pieces are worked in a spiral continuously. This means that you do not end the rnd with a slip stitch and do not start a rnd with a chain.

I start working every piece from a magic ring but you can ch2 and work the necessary number of sc in the second st from the hook.

You should crochet tight enough to prevent stuffing from sticking out.

### ***Head:***

With yellow yarn and hook B/2 (2.5 mm) make a magic ring.

Round 1: 6 sc in magic ring =6 sts

Round 2 (INC): (2 sc in next st)\*6 times =12 sts

Round 3 (INC): (sc in next 1 st, 2 sc in next st)\*6 times =18 sts

Round 4 (INC): (sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st)\*6 times =24 sts

Round 5 (INC): (sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st)\*6 times =30 sts

Rounds 6-10: sc in each st around =30 sts

Round 11 (DEC): (sc in next 3 sts, sc dec)\*6 times =24 sts

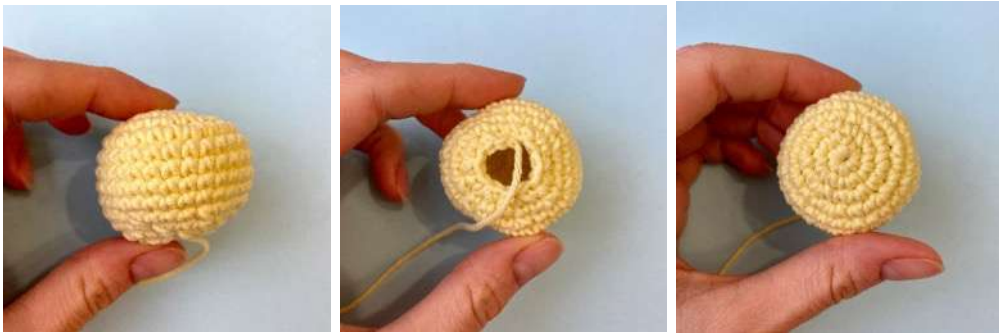
If you use safety eyes insert them between rounds 8 and 9 with 5 sts in between.

Also stuff the head before making dec.

Round 12 (DEC): (sc in next 2 sts, sc dec)\*6 times =18 sts

Round 13 (DEC): (sc in next st, sc dec)\*6 times =12 sts

Fasten off. Leave the long tail for sewing (about 15cm)



**Important!!!!** If you use safety eyes (7-8 mm) insert them now between rounds 8 and 9 with 5 sts in between.

Stuff the head.

### **Muzzle:**

With white yarn and hook B/2 (2.5 mm) make a magic ring.

Round 1: 6 sc in magic ring =6 sts

Round 2 (INC): sc 2 in each st around=12 sts

Round 3 (INC): (sc in next st, 2 sc in next st)\*6 times =18 sts

Round 4: sc in each st around =18 sts

Join with sl st and fasten off. Leave the long tail of the yarn for sewing.



### **Ear (Make 2):**

With yellow yarn and hook B/2 (2.5 mm) make a magic ring.

Round 1: 6 sc in magic ring =6 sts

Round 2 (INC): 2 sc in each st around=12 sts

Round 3 (INC): (2 sc in next 2 sts, sc in next 4 sts)\*2 times =16 sts

Round 4 (INC): sc in next st, 2 sc in next 2 sts, sc in next 6 sts, 2 sc in next 2sts, sc in next 5 sts=20 sts

Rounds 5-9: sc in each sts around =20 sts

Round 10 (DEC): (sc dec, sc in next 8 sts)\*2 times =18 sts

Round 11 (DEC): (sc dec, sc in next 7 sts)\*2 times =16 sts

Round 12 (DEC): (sc dec, sc in next 6 sts)\*2 times =14 sts

Round 13 (DEC): (sc dec, sc in next 5 sts)\*2 times =12 sts

Round 14 (DEC): (sc dec, sc in next 4 sts)\*2 times =10 sts

Round 15 (DEC): (sc dec, sc in next 3 sts)\*2 times =8 sts

Join with sl st and fasten off. Leave the long tail of the yarn for sewing.

Rep rnds 1-15 for the second ear.



## Body:

With yellow yarn and hook B/2 (2.5 mm) make a magic ring.

Round 1: 6 sc in magic ring =6 sts

Round 2 (INC): 2 sc in each st around=12 sts

Round 3 (INC): (sc in next st, 2 sc in next st)\*6 times =18 sts

Round 4: sc in each st around =18 sts

Round 5 (INC): (sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st)\*6 times =24 sts

Rounds 6-8: sc in each st around =24 sts

Round 9 (DEC): (sc in next 2 sts, sc dec)\*6 times =18 sts

Stuff the body firmly.



Round 10: sc in each st around =18 sts

Round 11 (DEC): (sc in next st, sc dec)\*6 times =12 sts

Join with sl st and fasten off.

## Arm (Make 2):

With yellow yarn and hook B/2 (2.5 mm) make a magic ring.

Round 1: 6 sc in magic ring =6 sts

Round 2 (INC): (2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 st)\*2 times =8 sts

Round 3: sc in each st around =8 sts

Round 4 (DEC): (sc dec in next st, sc in next 2 st)\*2 times=6sts

Rounds 5-8: sc in each st around =6 sts

Stuff the arm, do not stuff it too tight.

Fold arm in half and sc two sides together with sc 3.

Fasten off, cut yarn and weave in ends. One arm is done.

Complete these steps with the second arm. Leave long tail of the yarn for sewing.



## Leg (Make 2):

With yellow yarn and hook B/2 (2.5 mm) make a magic ring.

Round 1: 6 sc in magic ring =6 sts

Round 2 (INC): 2 sc in each st around=12 sts

Round 3 (INC): (2 sc in next st, sc in next 3 st)\*3 times =15 sts

Round 4 (DEC): sc in next 2 st, (sc dec)\*4 times, sc in next 5 st =11 sts

Round 5 (DEC): sc in next 2 st, (sc dec)\*2 times, sc in next 5 sts =9 sts

Rounds 6-8: sc in each st around =9 sts

Stuff the leg. Do not stuff it very firmly.

Round 9 (DEC): (sc in next st, sc dec)\*3 times =6 sts

Fold the leg in half and sc two sides together with sc 3.

Fasten off, cut yarn and weave in ends. One leg is done.

Complete these steps with the second leg. Leave long tail of the yarn for sewing.



## **Belly:**

With white yarn and hook B/2 (2.5 mm) make a ch6.

Row 1: sc in the second st from the hook, sc in the next 3 stitches, 3sc in the last stitch. Working on other side of your chain: sc in the next 3 stitches, 2sc in the last st = 12 sts

Row 2: 2sc in the first stitch, sc in the next 3 stitches, 2 sc in the next 3 stitches, sc in the next 3 stitches, 2sc in the next 2 stitches = 18 sts

Join with sl st, I leave the long tail of the yarn for sewing.



## **Tail:**

With white yarn and hook B/2 (2.5 mm) make a magic ring.

Round 1: 6 sc in magic ring = 6 sts

Round 2 (INC):(sc in next st, 2 sc in next st)\*3 times =9 sts

Join with sl st and fasten off. Leave the long tail of the yarn for sewing.

## **Bunny Assembly:**

1. If you use safety eyes, you must insert them when you crocheted the head or

sew the eyes to the head between rounds 8 and 9 with 5 sts in between.

2. Sew the head to the body (round 13 of the head to sts from round 11 of the body).

*!!! To head does not dangle, fill the body and neck strongly and sew twice.*

3. Sew arms to the body between 10 and 11 rounds of the body.



4. Sew legs to the body between 3 and 4 rounds of the body.

*!!!Try to stick the needle in the same place that will help to keep limbs flexible.*

5. Sew the tail to the body between 2 and 5 rounds of the body.



6. Sew the ears to the top of the head, make a couple of stitches to sew them together.
7. Sew the the muzzle between rounds 8 and 13 of the head. Stuff a little in sewing process.



8. Embroider nose with pink yarn and eyebrows with brown yarn between rounds 4 and 8 with 3 sts between.
9. Sew the belly between rounds 3 and 11 of the body.



## **Carrot:**

With orange plush yarn and hook G/6 (4 mm) make a magic ring.

Round 1: 6 sc in magic ring = 6 sts

Round 2: sc in each st around = 6 sts

Round 3 (INC): 2 sc in each st around = 12 sts

Round 4: sc in each st around = 12 sts

Round 5 (INC): (sc in next st, 2 sc in next st)\*6 times = 18 sts

Round 6: sc in each st around = 18 sts

Round 7 (INC): (sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st)\*6 times = 24 sts

Rounds 8-15: sc in each st around = 24 sts

Check that the width and height of the carrot are enough to fit the bunny!!!

Round 16: sc in next 6 sts, Ch 24 = 30 sts

Round 17: sc in next 6 sts, sc in next ch 9, skip ch 6 (buttonhole), sc in next ch 9  
= 24 sts

Rounds 18-21: sc in each st around = 24 sts

Round 22 (DEC): (sc in next 2 sts, sc dec)\*6 times =18 sts

Round 23 (DEC): (sc in next st, sc dec)\*6 times =12 sts

Round 24 (DEC): sc dec\*6 times =6 sts

Fasten off, cut yarn and weave in ends.

With green plush yarn and hook G/6 (4 mm) make the leaves.

Make sl st in the round 24 of the carrot, (ch 10, sl st in the same st)\*repeat 3 times.

Fasten off, cut yarn and weave in ends.

Sew the button in the middle between rounds 13 and 14.



*That's all. Your toy is ready!*
