



Christmas Giftbox Cat pattern




Thank you for supporting us. Before you start, you should carefully read what you need to know and the tools to prepare. Any changes for larger/smaller sizes will be indicated at the start of each pattern piece.

Material

- Yarn Weight: Sport | Fine (2)
- Color: white, green, red, pink
- 2.5mm (C) Hook
- Stitch maker
- Sewing needle
- Scissors
- Hot gun glue
- Fiberfill

Abbreviations

- MR: Magic Ring
 - st(s): stitch(es)
 - slst: slip stitch
 - ch: Chain
 - Sk: Skip
 - SC: Single crochet
 - INC: INCrease
 - DEC: Decrease
 - FLO: Front loop only
 - BLO: Back loop only
 - DC: Double crochet
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HEAD:

Begin with White Yarn

Row 1: 8 SC in an MR (8)

Row 2: 8 INC (16)

Row 3: (SC, INC) 8 times (24)

Row 4: (2 SC, INC) 8 times (32)

Row 5: 32 SC (32)

Row 6: (7 SC, INC) 4 times (36)

Row 7: (5 SC, INC) 6 times (42)

Row 8: (6 SC, INC) 6 times (48)

Row 9-17: 48 SC (48)

Row 18: (4 SC, DEC) 8 times (40)

Row 19: (3 SC, DEC) 8 times (32)

Row 20: (2 SC, DEC) 8 times (24)

Row 21: (SC, DEC) 8 times (16)

Row 22: (SC, DEC) 5 times, SC (11)

Row 23: 5 DEC, SC (6)

Cut the yarn, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Stuffing

EARS (MAKE 2):

Begin with White Yarn

When the text is pink, switch to pink yarn

Row 1: 6 SC in an MR (6)

Row 2: (SC, INC) 3 times (9)

Row 3: 2 SC, INC, **2 SC, INC**, 2 SC, INC (12)

Row 4: 3 SC, INC, **3 SC, INC**, 3 SC, INC (15)

Row 5: 4 SC, INC, **4 SC, INC**, 4 SC, INC (18)

Cut the yarn, leaving a long tail for sewing.



BOW:

Row 1: 12 ch, start in the 3rd chain from the hook: 10 DC, turn (10)

Row 2-5: 2 Ch, 10 DC, turn (10)

Cut the yarn. Create a bow shape.



- Sew the ears onto the head: from row 4 to row 10
- Attach the eyes between rows 9 and 10, with 9 stitches between them.
- Use black yarn to embroider the nose, eyelids, and beard.
- Use yellow yarn to embroider the eyebrows.
- Secure the bow on the head with glue.



BODY:

When the text is red, switch to red yarn

Row 1: 8 SC in an MR (8)

Row 2: (3 SC in one st, SC) 4 times (16)

Row 3: (SC, 3 SC in one st, 2 SC) 4 times (24)

Row 4: (2 SC, 3 SC in one st, 3 SC) 4 times (32)

Row 5: (3 SC, 3 SC in one st, 4 SC) 4 times (40)

Row 6: (4 SC, 3 SC in one st, 5 SC) 4 times (48)

Row 7: (5 SC, 3 SC in one st, 6 SC) 4 times (56)

Row 8: (6 SC, 3 SC in one st, 7 SC) 4 times (64)

Row 9: BLO, 2 SC, (11 SC, 5 SC) 3 times, 11 SC, 3 SC (64)

Row 10-21: 2 SC, (11 SC, 5 SC) 3 times, 11 SC, 3 SC (64)

Row 22: BLO, 5 SC, 2 DEC, (12 SC, 2 DEC) 3 times, 7 SC (56)

Row 23: 4 SC, 2 DEC, (10 SC, 2 DEC) 3 times, 6 SC (48)

Row 24: 3 SC, 2 DEC, (8 SC, 2 DEC) 3 times, 5 SC (40)

Row 25: 2 SC, 2 DEC, (6 SC, 2 DEC) 3 times, 4 SC (32)

Stuffing

Row 26: SC, 2 DEC, (4 SC, 2 DEC) 3 times, 3 SC (24)

Row 27: 2 DEC, (2 SC, 2 DEC) 3 times, 2 SC (16)

Row 28: 8 DEC (8)

Cut the yarn.



ARMS (MAKE 2):

Row 1: 6 SC in an MR (6)

Row 2: (SC, INC) 3 times (9)

Row 3-7: 9 SC (15)

Cut the yarn, leaving a long tail for sewing.



- Sew the head onto the body.
- Attach the arms (without sewing through row 21).
- Crochet slip stitches into row 21.
