

CROCHET PATTERN **CHICKEN AND CHICKS**



The required materials:

For Chicken

- Sport weight 4ply yarn Yarn Art Jeans (50g /160m)
- N07– beige
- N86– light yellow
- N62 – white
- N72– violet
- N91– purple
- Safety Eyes 12 mm
- 1.5 mm crochet hook
- Sewing pins
- Stuffing material, fiberfill
- Needle for sewing pieces
- Wire
- Pink pastel for toning

The height of the chicken is 20-22 cm / 7-8.5 inches, using indicated materials.

For chicks:

- Sport weight 4ply yarn Yarn Art Jeans (50g /160m)
- N86– light yellow
- N35–yellow
- Some black and red threads for embroidery
- 1.5 mm crochet hook
- Stuffing material, fiberfill

The height of the chicks is 5-6 cm / 1.5-2 inches, using indicated materials.

Terms and abbreviations (US):

MR - magic ring

ch- chain

sl st - slip stitch

(...)* – repeat instruction in brackets the given number of times

sc – single crochet

dc – double crochet

inc – increase –Two Single Crochet in one stitch

dc-inc - Double Crochet Increase - 2 Dc in one stitch

4-dc Bobble st – crochet 4 dc in one stitch with a common top (work 4 dc into the same loop, yarn over and pull through all 5 loops)

dec – decrease – two single crochets together

FLO - front loops only

BLO - back loops only



CHICKEN Body - Neck - Head

Body With Purple yarn.

1. 6sc in MR

Place row marker here.

2. 6inc (12)

3. (1sc, inc) *6 (18)

4. (2sc, inc) *6 (24)

5. (3sc, inc) *6 (30)

6. (4sc, inc) *6 (36)

7. (5sc, inc) *6 (42)

8. (6sc, inc) *6 (48)

9. (7sc, inc) *6 (54)

10. (8sc, inc) *6 (60)

11. (9sc, inc) *6 (66)

12. (10sc, inc) *6 (72)

13. (11sc, inc) *6 (78)

14. (12sc, inc) *6 (84)

15. (13sc, inc) *6 (90)

16. (14sc, inc) *6 (96)

17. (15sc, inc) *6 (102)

18.-40 102sc (23 rounds) (102)



41. *Fold the piece in half and crochet 30sc. Place row marker here.*





Crochet the neck in a spiral:

42. 42sc (42)

Stuff with fiberfill in the process.

43.-44. 42sc (2 rounds) (42)

45. *Change color to Light Yellow.*

BLO 42sc (42)

Cut the Purple yarn.

46. BLO 42sc (42)

Stuff the body-neck with fiberfill.



Head

47. 3sc, (2sc, inc) *12, 3sc (54)

48. (8sc, inc) *6 (60)

49. (9sc, inc) *6 (66)

50.-54. 66sc (5 rounds) (66)

55. (9sc, dec) *6 (60)

56. (8sc, dec) *6 (54)

Stuff with fiberfill in the process.

57.-64. 54sc (8 rounds) (54)

Insert the eyes between rounds 59-60 at a distance of 10-12 sc.

65. (7sc, dec) *6 (48)

66. (6sc, dec) *6 (42)

67. (5sc, dec) *6 (36)

68. (4sc, dec) *6 (30)

69. (3sc, dec) *6 (24)

70. (2sc, dec) *6 (18)

71. (1sc, dec) *6 (12)

Stuff the head with fiberfill.

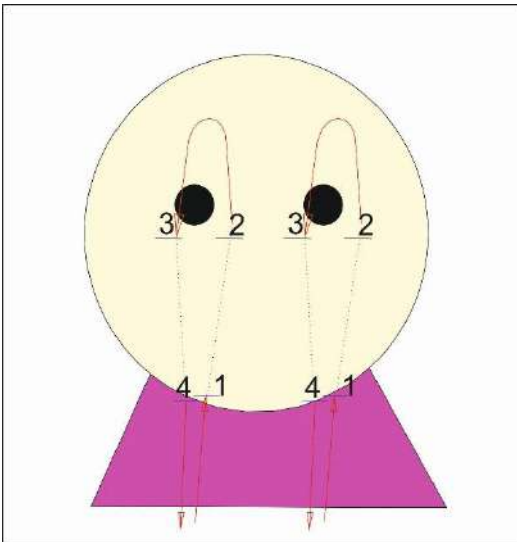
72. 6dec

Fasten off, cut the yarn, weave in the ends.





*Tighten cheeks following the pictures below.
(see the diagram and photo below)*



Return to round 46 of the body-neck-head and work with Light Yellow yarn through front loops: sl st, (ch2, 3dc in one stitch, ch2, sl st) *20, cut the yarn and fasten off.



Return to round 46 of the body-neck-head and work with Violet yarn through front loops: sl st, (ch2, 3dc in one stitch, ch2, sl st) *20, cut the yarn and fasten off.



Beak

With Beige yarn.

1. 6sc in MR

Place row marker here.

2. 6sc

3. (1sc, inc) *3 (9)

4. (2sc, inc) *3 (12)

5. (3sc, inc) *3 (15)

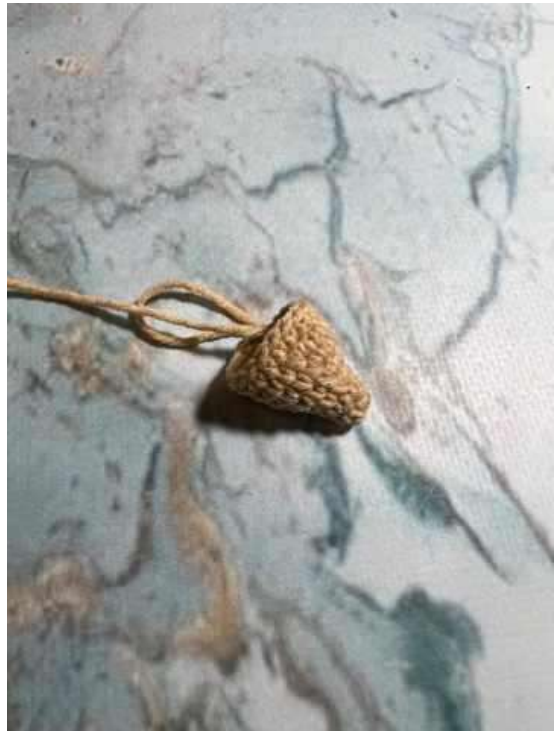
6. 15sc (15)

7. (4sc, inc) *3 (18)

8. 18sc (18)

Stuff the beak with fiberfill.

Leave a long tail for sewing.



Hens Comb



With Purple yarn.

*Chain 26. Start in the second chain from the hook: (sc, ch1, 4-dc Bobble st, ch2)*12, sc.*

Leave a long tail for sewing.

Wings (make 2)

With Violet yarn.

1. 8sc in MR

Place row marker here.

2. 8inc (16)

3. (1sc, inc) *8 (24)

4. (2sc, inc) *8 (32)

5. (3sc, inc) *8 (40)

6. (4sc, inc) *8 (48)

7. (5sc, inc) *8 (56)

8. (6sc, inc) *8 (64)

9. (7sc, inc) *8 (72)

10. (8sc, inc) *8 (80)

11. (9sc, inc) *8 (88)

12. (10sc, inc) *8 (96)

13. (11sc, inc) *8 (104)

14. (12sc, inc) *8 (112)

15. (13sc, inc) *8 (120)

16. [BLO (14sc, inc) *4],

(14sc, inc) *4 (128)

17. [BLO (15sc, inc) *4],

(15sc, inc) *4 (136)

18. Fold in half and make 68Sc through both sides, turn (68)

19. ch1, (sc, vn2, IncCch, vn2) *23, 2sc. Leave a long tail for sewing.



Return to round 16 of wings and work with Purple yarn through front loops: sl st, (ch2, 3dc-inc, ch2, sc) *30, cut the yarn and fasten off.



Return to round 16 of wings and work with Light Yellow yarn through front loops: sl st, (ch2, 3dc-inc, ch2, sc) *32, cut the yarn and fasten off.



Feets (make 2)

Toes (make 6)

With Beige yarn.

1. 8sc in MR

Place row marker here.

2.-11. 8sc (10 rounds)

12. Cut the yarn and fasten off on two toes. On the third toe, continue to crochet joining all three toes together.



Crochet in a spiral: 4sc on the second toe, 8sc on the third toe, 4sc on the second toe, 8sc on the first. Place a marker of a new round beginning (24) Stuff with fiberfill in the process.



13. 24sc (24)

14. 4sc, dec, 16sc, dec (22)

15. 2dec, 18sc (20)

16. 2dec, 16sc (18)

17. 18sc (18)

18. 6sc, ch8 (skip 8sc, start from the next stitch), 4sc (18)

19. 18sc (18)

*20. (1sc, dec) *6 (12)*



21. 6dec (6)
 22.-27. 6sc (6 rounds) (6)
 Stuff the feets with fiberfill.
 Fasten off, cut the yarn, weave in
 the yarn ends.



At this stage from the feets Return to
 round 18. Crochet around from a
 corner of the hole (see foto below):
 1. 16sc (16). Place row marker
 here.

2.-3. 16sc (2 rounds) (16)
 4. Change color to Purple.
 Cut the Beige yarn.

16sc (16)

5. (7sc, inc) *2 (18)

6. (2sc, inc) *6 (24)

Stuff the feets with fiberfill very
 strong.

Pin the feets to the chicken with
 pins, it should stand straight.



If the feet bend under the weight of the trunk, insert a wire into them.



Sew the beak to the head.



Embroider the whites of the eyes with white thread.



Embroider the upper eyelids with beige thread: make two stitches and wind the thread on them.



Sew the hens comb to the head. It should be located exactly in the center of the head.



*Sew the wings to the chicken.
Use pins to pin the wings symmetrically on each side. Sew it in a
semicircle so that the wing turns out to be a pocket.*



*Pin the feet to the body with pins, make sure that the chicken is standing
flat. If necessary, insert the wire into the feet.*



Apply pink pastel to tin the cheeks.



Hat

With White yarn. Work in rounds with turns.

1. 6sc in MR, sl st, turn

Place row marker here.

2. ch1, 6inc, sl st, turn (13)

*3. ch1, (1sc, inc) *6, sl st, turn (19)*

*4. ch1, (2sc, inc) *6, sl st, turn (25)*

*5. ch1, (3sc, inc) *6, sl st, turn (31)*

6. ch1, 30sc, sl st, turn (31)

*7. ch1, (4sc, inc) *6, sl st, turn (37)*

*8. ch1, (5sc, inc) *6, sl st, turn (43)*

*9. ch1, (6sc, inc) *6, sl st, turn (49)*

10. ch1, 48sc, sl st, turn (49)

*11. ch1, (7sc, inc) *6, sl st, turn (55)*

*12. ch1, (8sc, inc) *6, cc, nobopom*

(61)

*13. ch1, (9sc, inc) *6, sl st, turn (67)*

14. ch1, 54sc, turn (54)

15.-20. Ch1, 54sc, turn (6 rows)

(54)



21. *ch1, (1sc, ch2 (skip 2sc, start from the next stitch) *17, sc, ch1 (skip 1sc, start from the next stitch), sc, turn (54)*
22. *ch1, (3dc in one st) *54 (162)*
23. *ch1, (inc, sl st) *81.*
Cut the yarn and fasten off.



Crochet the cord with Violet yarn:

Chain 131, From the second chain on the hook: 130sl st.

Stretch the cord through the stitches of round 21 around the hat.

Put a hat on the chicken 😊



CHICK

The number of chickens is at your discretion. I made 3 of them.

With Yellow/ Light Yellow yarn.

1. 6sc in MR

Place row marker here.

2. 6inc (12)

3. 3inc, 3sc, 3inc, 3sc (18)

*4. (1sc, inc) *2, 3sc, (inc, 1sc) *3,*

4sc, inc (24)

5.-7. 24sc (3 rounds) (24)

*8. (2sc, dec) *6 (18)*

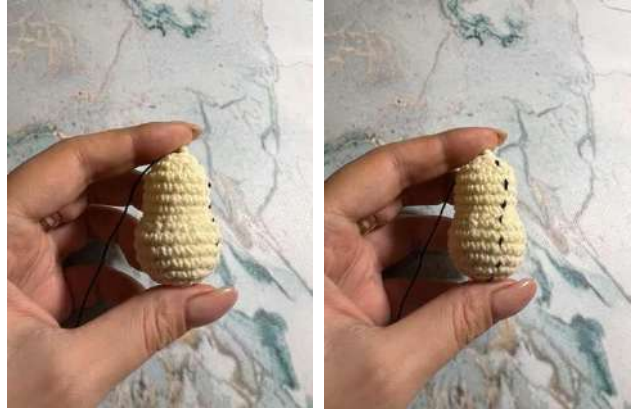
9.-13. 18sc (5 rounds) (18)

Stuff the body-head with fiberfill.

*14. (1sc, dec) *6 (12)*

15. 6dec

Fasten off, cut the yarn, weave in the ends.



Embroider the feet with red thread. Embroider the beak with red thread. Embroider the eyes with black thread.
