

# Crochet toy pattern

## «Chipmunk»



## **ABBREVIATIONS (US)**

**MR** – magic ring

**CH** - chain

**SC** - single crochet

**DEC** – decrease (crochet two single crochet together)

**INC** - increase (2 sc in one stitch)

**SL ST** – slip stitch

**DC** – double crochet

**HDC** – half double crochet

## **NOTES**

Begin crocheting into MR and continue working in spirals without sl st and turning chain at the end of the round (until otherwise is instructed).

Stuff with fiberfill as you crochet.

Use a stitch marker or a scrap of contrasting yarn.

Review the entire pattern before you begin.

## **THE REQUIRED MATERIALS AND TOOLS:**

- ✓ Cotton Gold Alize yarn, No. 36 (ginger)
- ✓ Cotton Gold Alize yarn, No. 76 (light brown for a hat)
- ✓ Jeans YarnArt yarn, No. 7 (beige)
- ✓ Jeans YarnArt yarn, No. 70 (brown a coat)
- ✓ Jeans YarnArt yarn, No. 1 (white for a muzzle)
- ✓ Jeans YarnArt yarn, No. 70 (brown)
- ✓ Alize Softy Plus yarn, No. 199 (light brown for a collar)
- ✓ Cotton Gold Alize yarn, No. 56 (red)
- ✓ Jeans YarnArt yarn, No. 35 (yellow)
- ✓ Stuffing material (fiberfill/polyester)
- ✓ 2 mm crochet hook
- ✓ Tapestry needle for sewing the parts and sewing needle for embroidering the nostrils
- ✓ Foamiran or felt for whites
- ✓ Eye half beads D=12 mm
- ✓ Safety nose, D=15 mm sides and 17 mm the upper part of the nose
- ✓ Scissors
- ✓ Glue (Hot glue gun or model glue)

The finished product using the materials stated in this pattern is ~9.4 inches / 24 cm tall.

## HEAD

Begin with beige color yarn.

Chain 15

**Rnd 1.** Start working in the 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from hook.

13 sc, 3 sc in the last chain foundation, 12 sc, inc (30)

**Rnd 2.** inc, 12 sc, 3 inc, 12 sc, 2 inc (36)

**Rnd 3.** sc, inc, 12 sc, (sc, inc) ×3, 12 sc, (sc, inc)×2 (42)

**Rnd 4.** 2 sc, inc, 12 sc, (2 sc, inc)×3, 12 sc, (2 sc, inc)×2 (48)

**Rnd 5.** (inc, 3 sc)×6, 24 sc (54)

**Rnds 6-11.** Crochet 6 rounds with 54 sc in each round (54)

**Rnd 12.**(dec, 3 sc)×6, 24 sc (48)

**Rnd 13.** 3 sc, dec, (6 sc, dec)×5, 3 sc (42)

*Change to ginger color yarn.*

**Rnd 14.** (5 sc, dec)×6 (36)

**Rnds 15-21.** Crochet 7 rounds with 36 sc in each round (36)

*Begin to stuff the head with fiberfill. Stuff the bottom of the head firmly.*

**Rnd 22.** 2 sc, dec, (4 sc, dec)×5, 2 sc (30)

**Rnd 23.** (3 sc, dec)×6 (24)

**Rnd 24.** sc, dec, (2 sc, dec)×5, sc (18)

**Rnd 25.** (sc, dec)×6 (12)

**Rnd 26.** 6 dec (6)

Tighten the hole, break yarn and hide the tail.



**BEIGE SPOTS UNDER THE EYES (make 2 similar parts)**  
**With beige color yarn.**

Chain 7.

**Rnd 1.** Start working in the 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from hook.

5 sc, 3 sc in the last chain foundation, 5 sc, t-ch, turn (13)

**Rnd 2.** 5 sc, 3 inc, 5 sc (16)

Break yarn and hide the tail for sewing.



Cut out eye whites from foamiran, 15 mm wide and 18 mm high.  
Glue the eye half beads to the whites.



## **EARS (make 2)**

**With ginger color yarn.**

Begin working into MR.

**Rnd 1.** 6 sc into MR (6)

**Rnd 2.** (sc, inc)×3 (9)

**Rnd 3.** (2 sc, inc)×3 (12)

**Rnds 4-5.** Crochet 2 rounds with 12 sc in each round (12)

Flatten and crochet 6 sc.

***Break yarn and hide the tail for sewing.***



## MUZZLE

*Crochet with white color yarn.*

Begin working into MR.

**Rnd 1.** 6 sc into MR (6)

**Rnd 2.** (sc, inc)×3 (9)

**Rnd 3.** (2 sc, inc)×3 (12)

**Rnd 4.** (3 sc, inc)×3 (15)

**Rnd 5.** 2 sc, inc, (4 sc, inc)×2, 2 sc (18)

**Rnd 6.** (5 sc, inc)×3 (21)

**Rnd 7.** 3 sc, inc, (6 sc, inc)×2, 3 inc (24)

**Rnd 8.** 24 inc (24)

*Break yarn and hide the tail for sewing.*



## NOSE FOR SECOND CHIPMUNK

*Crochet with red color yarn.*

Chain 4.

**Rnd 1.** Start working in the 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from hook.

inc, sc, 3 sc in the last chain foundation, 2 sc (8)

**Rnd 2.** 2 inc, sc, 3 inc, sc, inc (14)

**Rnd 3.** 14 sc.

*Break yarn and hide the tail for sewing.*



Insert safety nose in the second round. Make sure, that the bottom part of the nose is in the center of MR (*see photo*).  
For Dale, sew the nose once the muzzle is sewn on.



## MUZZLE DESIGN

*Assemble the head of the chipmunks.*

*The right side of the head is where we have made increases in round 5 and decreases in round 12 of the head.*

Sew beige spots between rounds 13 and 21 of the head. The distance between them is 8-10 mm.

Sew the muzzle between rounds 7-14. Previously, stuff the muzzle with fiberfill.

Glue the whites with eyes to beige spots, as guided in the photo.



Sew the nose between MR and round 4 for the second chipmunk.



## MUZZLE SCULPTING

Sculpt the cheeks for the chipmunk.

Mark the points, as shown in **photos 1, 2** and sculpt through these points with beige thread.

Insert the needle in point 1, draw out in point 2, insert the needle in point 3, draw out in point 4, insert the needle in point 5 and come back in point 1. Pull the tails from point 1 and tie them into a knot, as shown in **photo 3**. Hide the knot in point 1.



Sew the ears between rounds 22-23.



***Make the forelock for the second chipmunk.***

Cut 14 threads 5 cm/1.9 inches long and tie them in the center with a thread (*photo 1*).

Brush the forelock and attach it to the head (*photo 3*).



## LEGS AND BODY

*Crochet with ginger color yarn.*

Chain 6

**Rnd 1.** Start working in the 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from hook - *photo 1*

Continue crocheting 4 sc, 3 sc in one stitch, 3 sc, inc (12)

**Rnd 2.** inc, 3 sc, 3 inc, 3 sc, 2 inc (18)

**Rnd 3.** sc, inc, 3 sc, (sc, inc)×3, 3 sc, (sc, inc)×2 (24) - *photo 2*

**Rnds 4-5.** Work 2 rounds with 24 sc in each round (24)

**Rnd 6.** 6 sc, (sc, dec)×4, 6 sc (20)

**Rnd 7.** 6 sc, 4 dec, 6 sc (16)

**Rnd 8.** 4 sc, 4 dec, 4 sc (12)

*Stuff the ready part with fiberfill – photo 3.*



*Keep the marker symmetrically as you crochet.*



**Rnds 9-10.** Work 2 rounds with 12 sc in each round (12)

**Rnd 11.** (sc, inc)×6 (18)

**Rnd 12.** 18 sc (18)

**Rnd 13.** (2 sc, inc)×6 (24)

**Rnds 14-15.** Work 2 rounds with 24 sc in each round (24)

**Rnd 16.** crochet 7 sc, pull the hook out (do not close stitch), and break yarn (*see photo 3*).

*Crochet the second leg similar to the first up to round 16.*

**Rnd 1 of the second leg.** Crochet 17 sc, do not break yarn.

*In round 16, make sure that the feet point forward you as you join them. You may crochet 8 sc to the first leg in round 17 instead of 7 sc and 16 sc to the second leg instead of 17 sc.*



***Continue joining the legs.***

Chain 3, insert the hook into the loop of the first leg (***photo 1***) and the next stitch after the loop (***photo 2***). Grab the working yarn and crochet three loops on the hook as one stitch (***photos 3,4***).



Continue crocheting 24 sc to the first leg, 3 sc to the chain, and 7 sc to the second leg.

Place the marker/ scrap of contrasting yarn on this point to indicate the beginning of the round.



**Rnd 17.** 17 sc, 3 sc to the chain, 34 sc (54)

**Rnd 18.** 54 sc (54)

**Rnd 19.** (8 sc, inc)×6 (60)

**Rnds 20-22.** Work 3 rounds with 60 sc in each round (60)

**Rnd 23.** (8 sc, dec)×6 (54)

**Rnd 24.** 54 sc (54)

**Rnd 25.** (7 sc, dec)×6 (48)

**Rnds 26-27.** Work 2 rounds with 48 sc in each round (48)

**Rnd 28.** (6 sc, dec)×6 (42)

**Rnds 29-30.** Work 2 rounds with 42 sc in each round (42)

**Rnd 31.** (5 sc, dec)×6 (36)

**Rnds 32-33.** Work 2 rounds with 36 sc in each round (36)

**Rnd 34.** (4 sc, dec)×6 (30)

**Rnds 35-36.** Work 2 rounds with 30 sc in each round (30)

**Rnd 37.** (3 sc, dec)×6 (24)

**Rnds 38-39.** Work 2 rounds with 24 sc in each round (24)

**Rnd 40.** (2 sc, dec)×6 (18)

***Break yarn and hide the tail.***



## **PAWS (make 2)**

*Crochet with ginger color yarn.*

*Stuff with fiberfill as you crochet.*

Begin crocheting into MR.

**Rnd 1.** 8 sc into MR (8)

**Rnd 2.** 8 inc (16)

**Rnds 3-8.** Work 6 rounds with 16 sc in each round (16)

**Rnd 9.** 3 dec, 10 sc (13)

**Rnd 10.** sc, dec, 10 sc (12)

**Rnds 11-14.** Work 4 rounds with 12 sc in each round (12)

**Rnd 15.** dec, 10 sc (11)

**Rnd 16.** dec, 9 sc (10)

**Rnd 17.** 10 sc (10)

**Rnd 18.** (sc, inc )×5 (15)

**Rnds 19-20.** Work 2 rounds with 15 sc in each round(15)

**Rnd 21.** (sc, dec)×5 (10)

**Rnd 22.** 5 dec (5)

*Break yarn and hide the tail.*



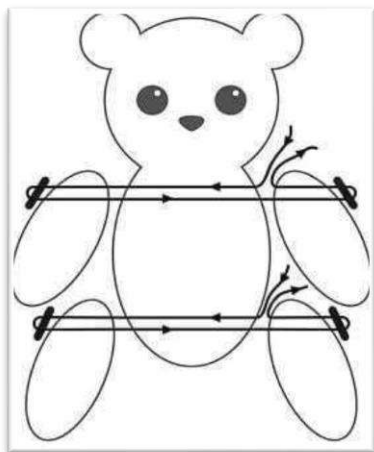
## ASSEMBLY

Sew the head to the body. Stuff the neck with fiberfill firmly and make sure that the head does not tilt.

I stuff the neck as sewing the head to the body.

Attach the arms between rounds 36-37 using a thread jointing, as guided in the figure with a bear. The thick part of the arm is the top. Mark the position of the arms with a knitting needle before joining the arms to the body.

**Please make sure that the arms are bent forward.**



## HAT

With light brown color yarn.

Begin work into MR.

**Rnd 1.** 6 sc into MR (6)

**Rnd 2.** 6 inc (12)

**Rnd 3.** (sc, inc)×6 (18)

**Rnd 4.** sc, inc, (2 sc, inc)×5, sc (24)

**Rnd 5.** (3 sc, inc)×6 (30)

**Rnd 6.** 30 sc (30)

**Rnd 7.** (4 sc, inc)×6 (36)

**Rnds 8-11.** Work 4 rounds with 36 sc in each round (36)

*Begin to make the holes for the ears.*

**Rnd 12.** chain 4, skip 4 stitches and continue crocheting 14 sc, chain 4 and skip 4, continue crocheting 14 sc (36)



**Rnd 13.** Crochet 3 sc and inc to the chain, (3 sc, inc)×3, 2 sc, crochet to the chain as follows: sc, inc, 2 sc, and continue crocheting to the hat: sc, inc, (3 sc, inc)×3 (45)



**Rnd 14.** (4 sc, inc)×9 (54)

**Rnd 15-16.** Work 5 rounds with 54 sc in each round (54)

**Rnd 17.** (5 sc, inc)×9 (63)

**Rnds 18-19.** Work 2 rounds with 63 sc in each round (63)

*Secure yarn <https://cloud.mail.ru/public/oC6A/rvvt1WARz>*

*Break yarn and hide the tail (photo 2).*



Crochet the stripe between rounds 11 and 12 of the hat using brown color yarn.

Attach yarn, as guided in *photo 1*, and crochet 31 sl st. Move the stripe in one round above to finish crocheting it at the beginning, as shown in *photo 2*. Complete crocheting 5 sl st.

Break yarn, secure and hide the tail, as shown in video <https://cloud.mail.ru/public/irrQ/npDXocDR7> )



## COAT/SHIRT

*Crochet with **brown** or **red** color yarn.*

*Work in back and forth rows.*

Chain 20.

**Row 1.** Start working in the second chain from hook.

19 sc, t-ch, turn (19)

**Rows 2-7 (6 rows).** 19 sc, t-ch, turn (19)

*Make the armholes.*

**Rows 8-11 (4 rows).** 11 sc, t-ch, turn (11)

**Row 12.** 11 sc, chain 9, turn (11) - *photo 1.*

**Row 13.** Start working in the second chain from hook.

8 sc to the chain, 11 sc, t-ch, turn (19) - *photo 2.*



**Row 14.** 19 sc, t-ch, turn (19)

**Row 15.** 8 sc, 5 HDC, 6 DC, t-ch, turn (19)

**Row 16.** 19 sc, t-ch, turn (19)

**Row 17.** 8 sc, 5 HDC, 6 DC, t-ch, turn (19)

**Row 18.** 19 sc, t-ch, turn (19)

**Row 19.** 8 sc, 5 HDC, 6 DC, t-ch, turn (19)

**Row 20.** 19 sc, t-ch, turn (19)

**Row 21.** 8 sc, 5 HDC, 6 DC, t-ch, turn (19)

**Row 22.** 19 sc, t-ch, turn (19)

**Row 23.** 8 sc, 5 HDC, 6 DC, t-ch, turn (19)

**Row 24.** 19 sc, t-ch, turn (19)

**Row 25.** 8 sc, 5 HDC, 6 DC, t-ch, turn (19)

**Rows 26-27 (2 rows).** 19 sc, t-ch, turn (19)

***Make the armhole for the second sleeve.***

**Rows 28-31 (4 rows).** 11 sc, t-ch, turn (11)

**Row 32.** 11 sc, chain 9, turn (11)

**Row 33.** Start working in the second chain from hook.

8 sc to the chain, 11 sc, t-ch, turn (19)

**Rows 34-38 (5 rows).** 19 sc, t-ch, turn (19)

**Row 39.** 18 sc, inc (20)

***Do not break yarn.***



*Continue crocheting along the perimeter of the coat.*

*Crochet sc to sc and inc to DC (photo 1).*

**Row 1.** See *photo 4* before to start crocheting.

12 sc, (inc, sc)×6, 12 sc, inc, 18 sc, inc, 7 sc and continue joining the armholes (*photos 2, 3*).

15 sc and join the second armhole, 6 sc, inc, 17 sc, sl st.

Break yarn and hide the tail.



## SLEEVES

*With brown or red color yarn.*

*The right sleeve – attach yarn, as shown in photo 1.*

*The left sleeve – attach yarn, as shown in photo 2.*

Continue crocheting around the armhole of the second sleeve.

**Rnd 1.** 23 sc, sc in the first stitch (24)

**Rnd 2.** 24 sc (24)

**Rnd 3.** 5 sc, 3 dec, 8 sc, 3 inc, 2 sc (24)

**Rnds 4-5.** Work 2 rounds with 24 sc in each round (24)

*If you crochet a red shirt then break yarn and hide the tail (photo 3).*

*Embroider the patterns, as shown in photo 4.*

*Continue crocheting the coat.*

**Rnd 6.** 3 sc, 3 dec, 15 sc (21)

**Rnds 7-8.** Work 2 rounds with 21 sc in each round (21)

**Rnd 9.** 2 sc, 3 dec, 13 sc (18)

**Rnds 10-13.** Work 4 rounds with 18 sc in each round (18)

Break yarn, secure, and hide the tail.



## COLLAR

*With Alize Softy Plus yarn in light brown color.* Count 8 stitches from the bottom of the coat (*photo 1*), attach yarn and continue crocheting 3 sc, 3 HDC, 4 DC, 2 inc (crochet DC inc), 28 DC, 2 inc, 4 DC, 3 HDC, 3 sc, sl st  
Break yarn and hide the tail.



*Dress up our chipmunks and enjoy the work done!*
