



# Christmas Angel Amigurumi Pattern

Suggested level: Beginner

## Terms & abbreviations

Note! I use US terms.

**approx.** – approximately

**rnd** – round/row

**ch** – chain

**sc** – single crochet (in UK terminology – double crochet)

**sl st** – slip stitch

**inc** – increase (crochet 2 single crochet into 1 stitch)

**dec** – decrease (crochet 2 single crochet together in front loops only, **decrease always means invisible decrease!**)

**BLO** - back loops only

**Work in spiral unless the pattern gives different instructions!**

# Materials

- Yarn: Schachenmayr Catania 100% Cotton, 50 gr/125 m
  - A 00436 Ivory
  - B 00106 White
  - C 00226 Flieder
  - D 00206 Honey
- Beige embroidery thread for fixing the hands together
- White thread for giving a shape for the left wing
- Crochet hook: 2.5 (or 3 mm) hook
- Stuffing for toys
- Scissors
- Needle with a wide eye
- Stich marker/safety pin

**Height of the doll is appr. 10 cm**

**Creating the other angels on the pictures I used these colors** of Sch. Catania 100% Cotton, 50 gr/125 m

Yellow angel: 00208 Sun Yellow and 00438 Deep Amber

Black/Red angel: 00424 Cherry Red and 00110 Black, 00438 Deep Amber for the skin

Blue angel: 00297 Celestial (Catania Trend 2021) and 00179 Camel

## Head

Start crocheting with **yarn A (Ivory)**.

**Rnd 1:** magic ring (6)

**Rnd 2:** inc in each st around (12)

**Rnd 3:** (1 sc, inc) 6 times (18)

**Rnd 4:** (2 sc, inc) 6 times (24)

**Rnd 5:** (3 sc, inc) 6 times (30)

**Rnd 6-11:** 1 sc in each st around (30)

**Rnd 12:** (3 sc, dec) 6 times (24)

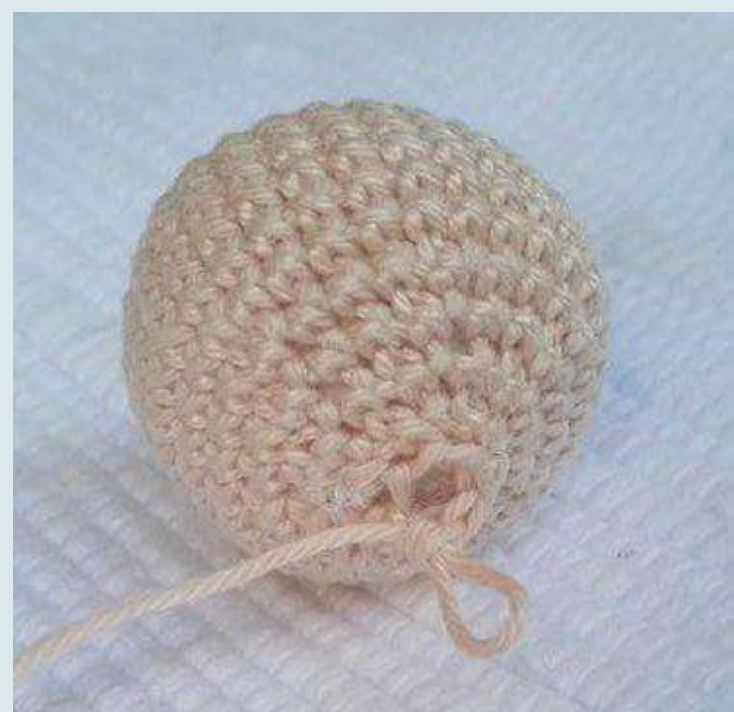
**Rnd 13:** (2 sc, dec) 6 times (18)

Start to stuff the head.

**Rnd 14:** (1 sc, dec) 6 times (12)

**Rnd 15:** dec 6 times (6)

Do not cut the yarn yet, you will cut it and hide the tail inside the head later.



## **Body**

Continue with **yarn B (White)**.

**Rnd 1:** (inc) 6 times (12)

**Rnd 2:** (1 sc, inc) 6 times (18)

Now cut yarn A (Ivory), and hide the tail inside the head. Stuff the neck well with the help of a pair of scissors.

**Rnd 3:** (5 sc, inc) 3 times (21)

**Rnd 4-5:** 1 sc in each st around (21)

**Rnd 6:** (6 sc, inc) 3 times (24)

**Rnd 7-8:** 1 sc in each st around (24)

**Rnd 9:** (7 sc, inc) 3 times (27)

**Rnd 10-11:** 1 sc in each st around (27)

**Rnd 12:** (8 sc, inc) 3 times (30)

**Rnd 13-14:** 1 sc in each st around (30)

**Rnd 15:** (9 sc, inc) 3 times (33)

**Rnd 16:** (10 sc, inc) 3 times (36)

**Rnd 17-21:** 1 sc in each st around (36)

**Rnd 22:** 1 sc in each st around **BLO**  
(back loops only!) (36)



**Rnd 23:** (4 sc, dec) 6 times (30)

**Rnd 24:** (3 sc, dec) 6 times (24)

Stuff the body, but be careful!

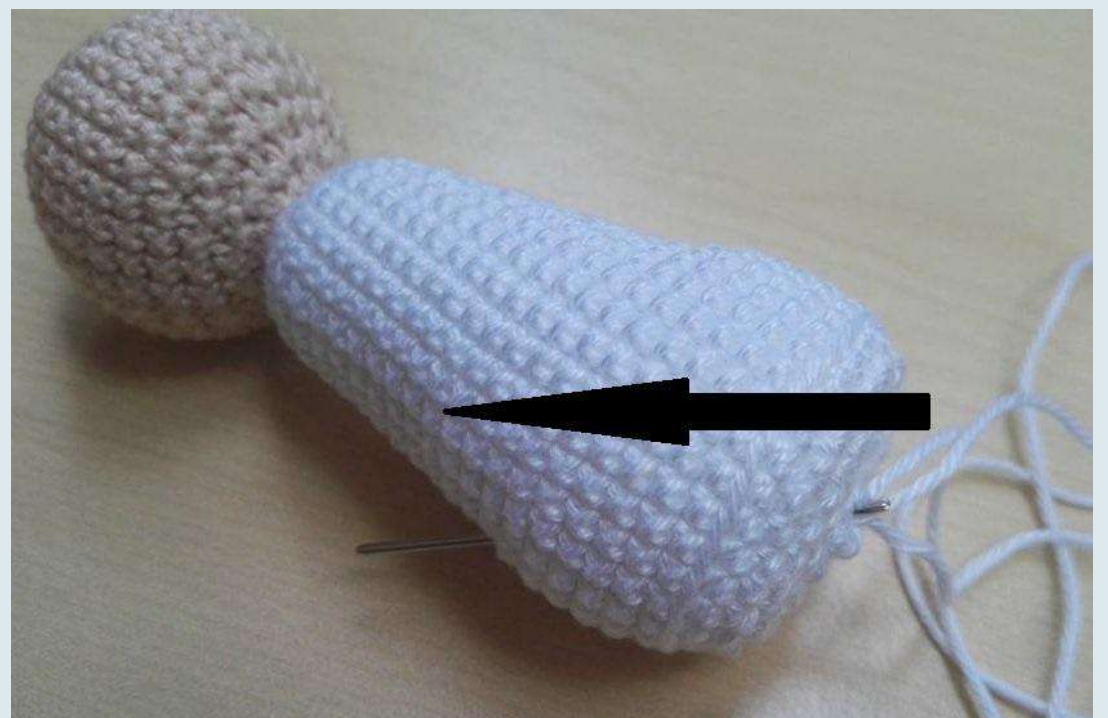
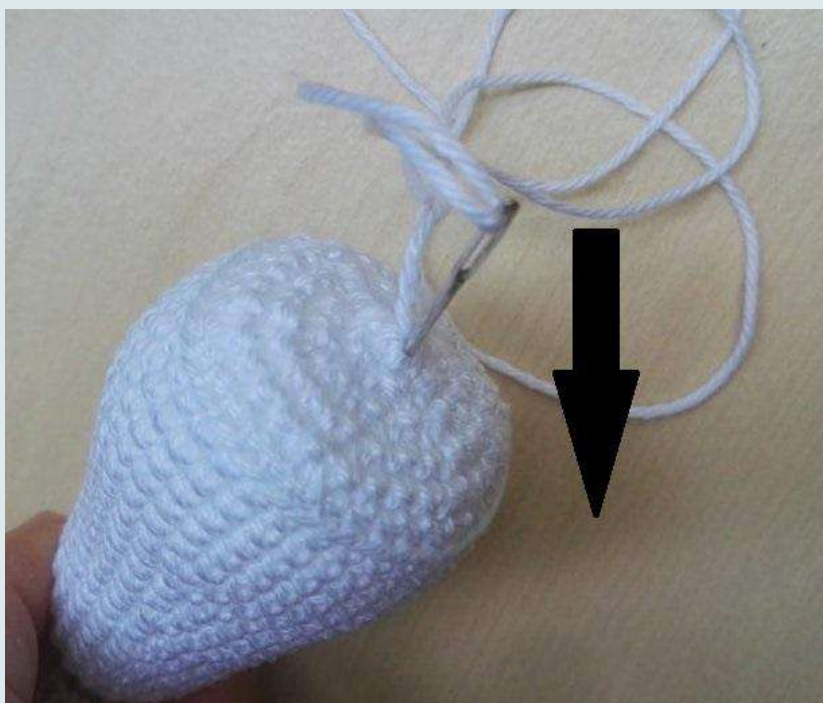
The body doesn't have to be stuffed extremely full, because it would make the base too globular/spherical.

**Rnd 25:** dec 12 times (12)

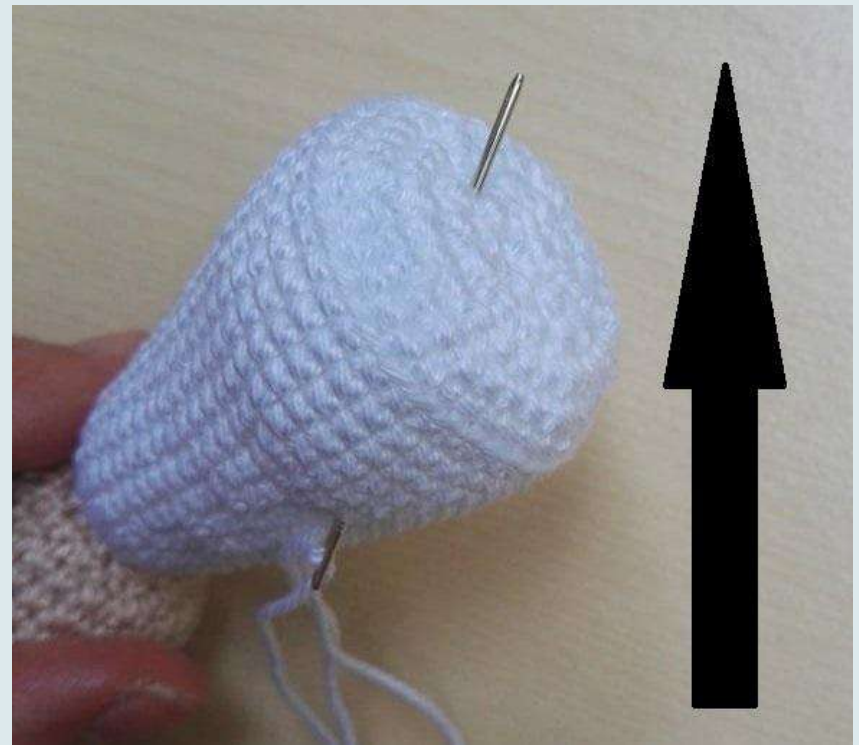
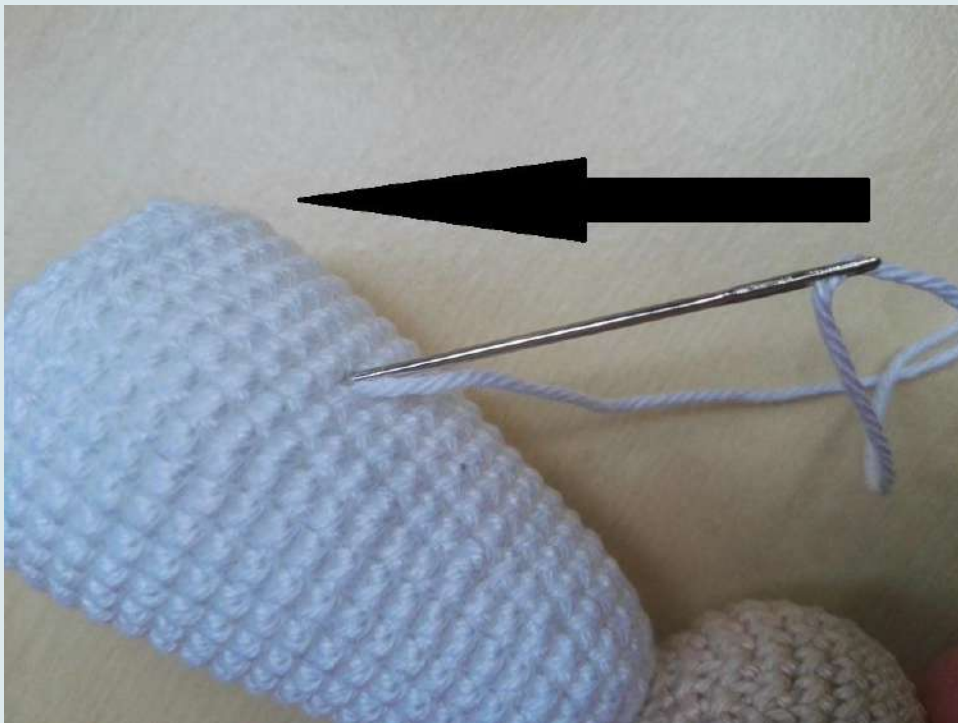
**Rnd 26:** dec 6 times (6)

Fasten off leaving very long tail.

Pass the yarn back up through the body, coming out in one side of the angel.



Drive the yarn back again through the body to the bottom: stick the needle into the **same hole** where you drove out the yarn, coming out next to the middle hole of the bottom (not in the middle point, choose a hole next to the center) and pull it tight.



Pass the yarn through the body again from the middle point of the bottom and drive it out from a different hole at an other side of the angel. Drive back the yarn from the same hole where it came out this time, and pull it tight after it had come out next to the center of the bottom. Repeat this technique 5-6 times, and always work on a different side of the body.





Finally, hide the end of the yarn inside the body and secure it.

This method ensures that your the angel could stand on her feet without any help. 😊



Turn the angel head down and join with **yarn C (Flieder)** into the first front loop of Rnd 22 of the body, and **make slip stitches into every front loops of this round. Crochet these slip stitches especially loosely**, otherwise you tighten the dress' lower part.



Fasten off leaving very long tail. **Embroider few little stars on the dress with this same yarn** on the left side of the front side of the body. Back side is where you started the rounds, this point helps to choose the best position for the embroidery mission. Finally, hide the end of the yarn inside the body.



## Arms (2 pieces)

Start with **yarn A (Ivory)**.

**Rnd 1:** magic ring (5)

**Rnd 2:** 1 sc in each st around (5)

**Change color**, continue with **yarn color B (White)**! You can hide the ends of both yarns inside the hands with a help of a pair of scissors.

**Rnd 3-10:** 1 sc in each stitch around (5)

Crochet it again, then sew together the hole in the end of the arms.

Stick them on the body between Rnds 2 and 3, and sew them on.



**Optional:** sew together the 2 hands in front of the body with beige embroidery thread, creating a „praying posture”. Hide the ends of the thread inside the arms, and cut down the rest.

## Wings (2 pieces)

Start with **yarn B (White)** and **work in spiral** in the first 2 rounds.

**Rnd 1:** magic ring (7)

**Rnd 2:** inc 7 times (14)



This is the base of the wings, you have to make it twice.

Continue in a back and forth direction from this point.



**Left wing of the angel:** continue working with the same yarn. Make a **slip stitch into the next sc of the base.**

**Rnd 3:** 13 ch, turn, 10 sc from the 3rd ch from the hook, sl st into the next sc of the base/ring

**Rnd 4:** turn, 9 sc into the previous rnd of the wing, 3 ch, turn, skip this 3 ch, 9 sc the way back, sl st into the next sc of the base/ring



**Rnd 5:** turn, 8 sc into the previous rnd of the wing, 3 ch, turn, skip this 3 ch, 8 sc the way back, sl st into the next sc of the base/ring

**Rnd 6:** turn, 7 sc into the previous rnd of the wing, 3 ch, turn, skip this 3 ch, 7 sc the way back, sl st into the next sc of the base/ring.

**Rnd 7:** turn, 6 sc into the previous rnd of the wing, 3 ch, turn, skip this 3 ch, 6 sc the way back, sl st into the next sc of the base

**Rnd 8:** turn, 5 sc into the previous rnd of the wing, 3 ch, turn, skip this 3 ch, 5 sc the way back

Fasten off and leave a very-very long tail for sewing.



**Right wing of the angel:** continue working with yarn B (White). **Crochet a base again, but this time fasten off and cut the yarn.**



**Join with yarn B (White) to the 6th sc from the sc you have made the fasten off into. This point is signed by the needle on the picture.** You can count the next rounds of right wing from here as you see on the picture. Rnd 8 has to be made in the last sc before the ending point of the basic circle.

**Rnd 3:** 13 ch, turn, 10 sc from the 3rd ch from the hook, sl st into the next sc of the base/ring

**Rnd 4:** turn, 9 sc into the previous rnd of the wing, 3 ch, turn, skip this 3 ch, 9 sc the way back, sl st into the next sc of the base/ring

**Rnd 5:** turn, 8 sc into the previous rnd of the wing, 3 ch, turn, skip this 3 ch, 8 sc the way back, sl st into the next sc of the base/ ring

**Rnd 6:** turn, 7 sc into the previous rnd of the wing, 3 ch, turn, skip this 3 ch, 7 sc the way back, sl st into the next sc of the base/ring

**Rnd 7:** turn, 6 sc into the previous rnd of the wing, 3 ch, turn, skip this 3 ch, 6 sc the way back, sl st into the next sc of the base/ring

**Rnd 8:** turn, 5 sc into the fi previous rnd of the wing, 3 ch, turn, skip this 3 ch, 5 sc the way back



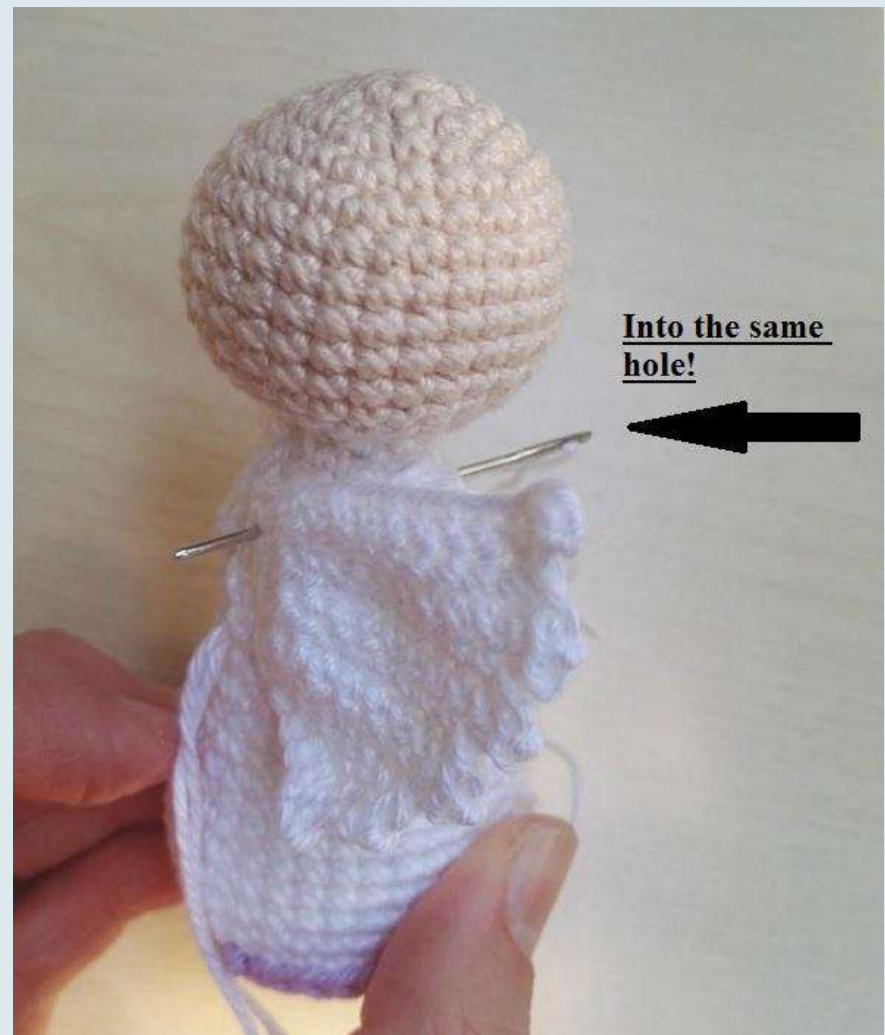
Fasten off and leave a very long tail for sewing. **Sew together the 2 wings in the middle line.**





**Give a shape to the LEFT wing:** using the needle and white thread, make little stitches in the the chainlink of Rnd 3 in a back and forth direction. Start in the line of the chainlink itself, and come back in the stitches of the 10 single crochet you made in the chains. Then pull the thread a little, just to bend it inward a little. Cut the thread and tie up with the other end of it. **With the help of this method, the left wing can lay on the shoulder of the angel as the right wing does it by itself. Because of its position left wing needs a little help for it, but right wing can lay on the right shoulder naturally.**

Sew the wings on the back of the angel. Make it with little stitches or you can sew them across the body, but be careful! In the front side of the body always stick the needle back into the **SAME** hole you drove it out from.



And here it is the result of your work. 😊



## Hair

Start with **yarn D (Honey)**.

First, crochet a wig cap. Try it on the head a few times during making it. If it is too tight, make looser stitches, but if it is too loose, you can crochet tighter.

**Rnd 1:** magic ring (6)

**Rnd 2:** inc in each st around (12)

**Rnd 3:** (1 sc, inc) 6 times (18)

**Rnd 4:** (2 sc, inc) 6 times (24)

**Rnd 5:** (3 sc, inc) 6 times (30)

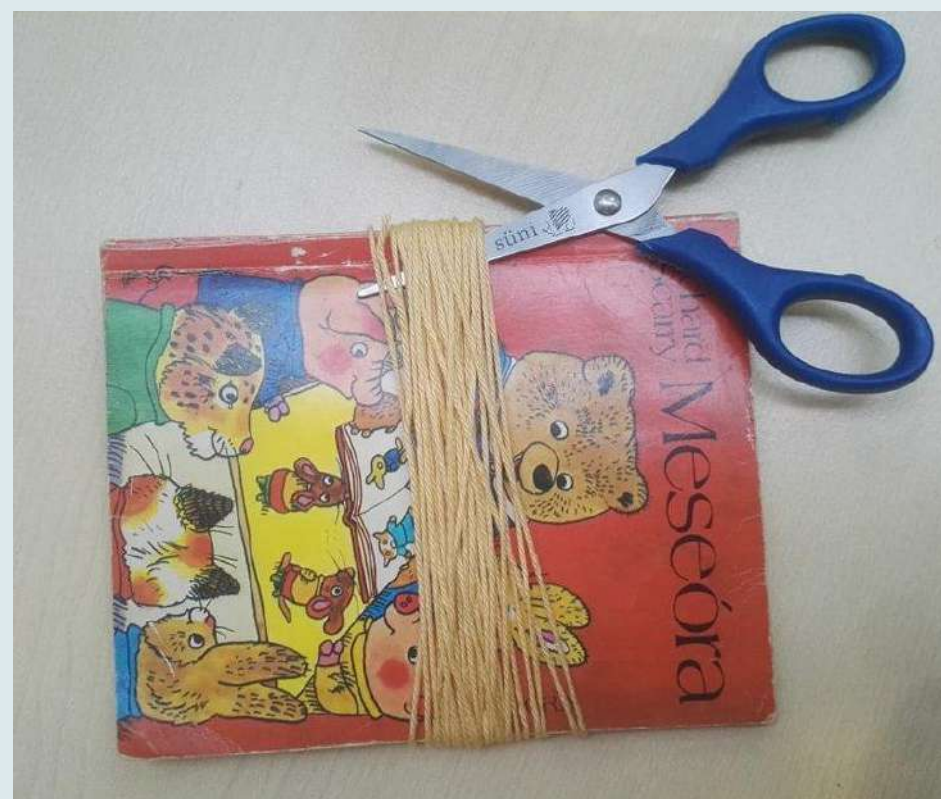
**Rnd 6-12:** 1 sc in each st around (30)



Fasten off and leave long tail for sewing. Sew the cap on the head with little stitches.



Now create long hair using **yarn D (Honey)**. Take a book (appr. 11-12 cm wide) and roll the yarn around it 30 times. Cut the yarn aside.



Fold in half the yarn strands, and thread each piece in the stitches of Rnd 12 (the last rnd) of the hair cap. Insert the crochet hook through a stitch on the bottom edge of the hair cap. Pull one of the yarn strands partway through the stitch.



Pull the tail ends of the yarn through the loop and tighten well. Continue this method in each stitch around.



Part the doll's hair in the middle, and braid them on both side. Tie them up with a long honey thread.



Tie the 2 braids up firmly in one ponytail. Tie it close to the nape (the back side of the neck/head). Once that is done, take out the 2 pieces of yarn in the ends of each braid. Finally, with a pair of scissors trim the end of the hair. You don't have to make a perfect straight line, but cut down the extremely long pieces.



Or you can create a different haircut, of course, just like I created for the rest of my angels
