

CHRISTMAS BELLS

Crochet pattern



CROCHET ABBREVIATIONS (US):

MG – magic ring

CH – chain

SC – single crochet

INC – increase (make 2 sc into one loop)

DEC– decrease (two sc together through front loops)

SL ST – slip stitch

(...)*8 – work instructions within brackets as many times as directed

(18) – the number of sc in the row

THE REQUIRED MATERIALS:

DK weight yarn - Yarn Art Jeans (55% cotton/45% acrylic; 50 g/160 m)

- Yarn Art Jeans № 35 (yellow) – bells
- Yarn Art Jeans № 82, 90 (dark green, red) – leaves, berries
- 2.25 mm crochet hook
- Stuffing material (fiberfill/ polyester)
- Tapestry needle
- Scissors
- Stitch marker (a scrap of contrasting yarn)
- Tambourine 2 pieces

NOTE! Yarn consumption, size, and appearance of the toy depend on crochet density and how you hold the yarn.

The presented toy is crocheted with V and X look single crochet:

(First, you grab yarn over the hook, and for making the second stitch grab it under the hook).

The finished product using the materials specified in this template has a size of ~4.7*5.1 inches with a loop.

Make sure you crochet tight enough; otherwise, the stuffing will show through the holes.

Crochet the toy in continuous spirals without turning chains.

BELLS (make 2)

Yarn - YarnArt Jeans No. 03 (yellow)

Rnd 1: 6 into MR

Rnd 2: 6 inc (12)

Rnd 3: (1 sc, inc)*6 (18)

Rnd 4: (2 sc, inc)*6 (24)

Rnd 5: (3 sc, inc)*6 (30)

Rnds 6-7: 30 sc (2 rounds)

Rnd 8: (4 sc, inc)*6 (36)

Rnds 9-14: 36 sc (6 rounds)

Rnd 15: (5 sc, inc)*6 (42)

Rnds 16-19: 42 sc (4 rounds)

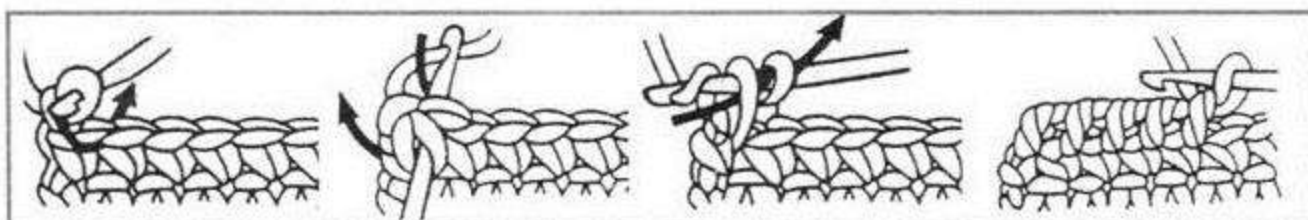
** Crochet the next row with Crab (Reverse) stitch*

Rnd 20: 42 sc (Crab stitch), 1 sl st

Break yarn. Pull tightly. Hide the tail inside.



Crab (Reverse) stitch





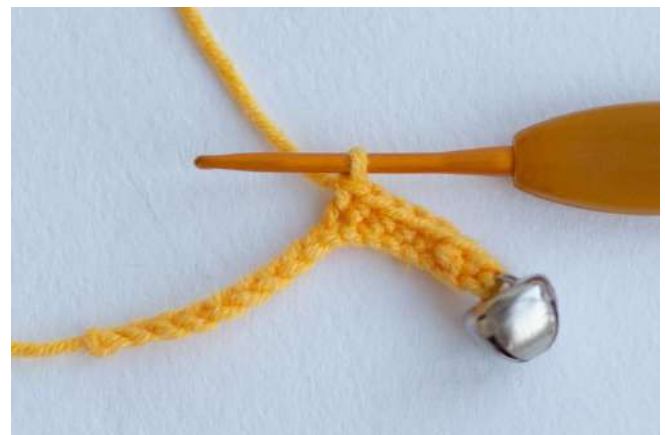
Break yarn. Pull tightly. Hide the tail inside.

BELL LANGUAGE

Chain 16 with blue yarn. Using a smaller hook, pull the thread into the eye of the bell to grab and pull the thread.



Start working in the second chain from hook **15 sc**. Break yarn.



We attach the finished language to the bell. Tie all the threads.



Tie both bells together.



LEAF (make 4)

Yarn - YarnArt Jeans No. 82 (dark green)

Chain 15, crochet to the chain foundation. Start working in the second chain from hook - **13 sc, 3 sc in 1 stitch.**

Continue crocheting on the other side of the chain foundation.

– **12 sc, 3 sc in 1 stitch.**

Rnd 2: (3 sc, chain 3, 1 sc in the previous stitch)***4**, 3 sc, chain 3, 1 sc in the previous stitch, (3 sc, chain 3, 1 sc in the previous stitch)***4**, 2 sc, 2 sl st.

Break yarn, leaving a long tail for sewing.



** Iron the part with steam if it is uneven.
To do this, put a damp cloth on top of a crochet garment and steam it off for a few seconds.*

BERRIES (make 3)

Yarn - YarnArt Jeans No. 90 (red)

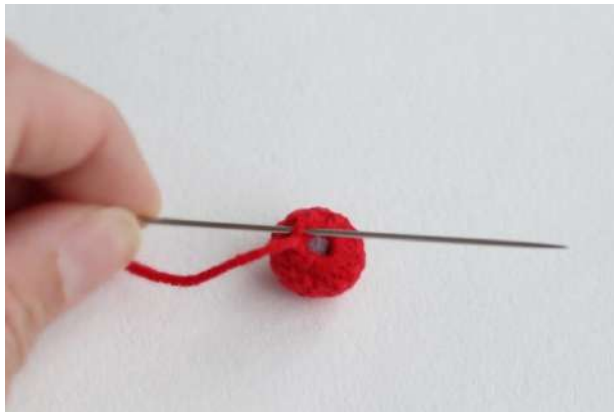
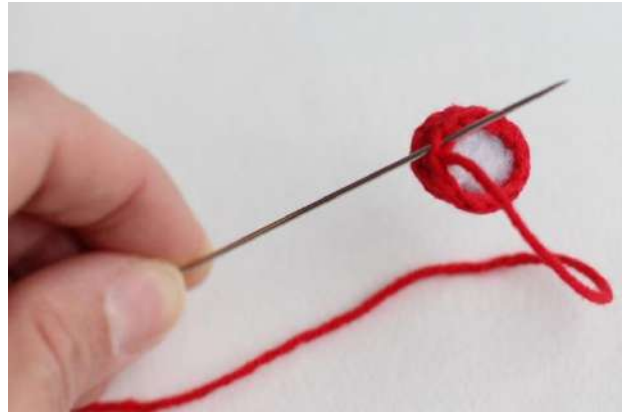
Rnd 1: 6 into MR

Rnd 2: 6 inc (12)

Rnd 3-6: 12 sc (4 rounds)

Complete stuffing with fiberfill.

Tighten the hole using a tapestry needle.



ASSEMBLY

1. Sew four leaves together.



2. Using a needle, remove all the threads from the bell to the back of the sheet and tie them together.



3. Sew the berries.



LOOP

Yarn - YarnArt Jeans No. 82 (dark green)

Rnd 1: Chain 41, turn and continue crocheting on the other side of the chain.

Rnd 2: 40 sc, 1 cp, turn

Rnd 3: 40 sc



Cut off the long end of the thread. Use a needle to connect the ends. With the remaining piece of thread, sew the loop to the back of the leaves, thereby hiding all the protruding threads.
