

English Crochet Pattern
Clothes + garland

Final size of the toy with the recommended
materials ~ 18 cm



Recommended materials and tools:

YarnArt JEANS

Color No.: 56, 69 (1.5 skeins), 70, 29, 67, 75

Spine

Hook: 2mm

Scissors

Filler

Buttons 2 pieces

Beads red matte



Abbreviations

(US crochet terms):

- *ch* – chain stitch
- *sc* – single crochet
- *dc* – double crochet
- *inc.* – increase (2 crochets in 1 loop)
- *dec.* – decrease (2 crochets together)
- (...) - *L* times – repeat the sequence of loops in brackets *L* times
- *hdc* – half double crochet
- *dc* - double crochet

Hat:

72 *ch*, connect into a ring.

12 rounds \times 72 *sc*

13 *th*: 21 *sc*, 7 *ch*, 7 loops are skipped and starting from 8 crochet loops: 14 *sc*, 7 *ch*, 7 loops are skipped and starting from 8 crochet loops: 23 *sc*

14-15 *th*: 72 *sc*

16 *th*: (10 *sc*, *dec*) \times 6 times = 66 *sc*

17 *th*: (9 *sc*, *dec*) \times 6 times = 60 *sc*

18 *th*: (8 *sc*, *dec*) \times 6 times = 54 *sc*

19 *th*: (7 *sc*, *dec*) \times 6 times = 48 *sc*

20 *th*: (6 *sc*, *dec*) \times 6 times = 42 *sc*

21 *th*: (5 *sc*, *dec*) \times 6 times = 36 *sc*

22 *th*: (4 *sc*, *dec*) \times 6 times = 30 *sc*

23 *th*: (3 *sc*, *dec*) \times 6 times = 24 *sc*

24 *th*: (2 *sc*, *dec*) \times 6 times = 18 *sc*

25 *th*: (1 *sc*, *dec*) \times 6 times = 12 *sc*

26 *th*: (*dec*) \times 6 times = 6 *sc*

We close 6 loops.





Needles for a hat (23 details):

st row: Start 6 sc in a magic ring

2 th: (inc, 2 sc) x 2 times = 8 sc

3 th: (inc, 3 sc) x 2 times = 10 sc

4 th: (inc, 4 sc) x 2 times = 12 sc

5 -15 th: 12 sc

We fold the part in half and crochet 6 sc.

We cut the thread, fix the loop, leave the tail for further sewing to the cap.

We sew red beads on the tip.



The ball on the Christmas tree:

1st row: Start 6 sc in a magic ring

2nd row: (inc) \times 6 times = 12 sc

3rd row: (1 sc, inc) \times 6 times = 18 sc

4th row: (2 sc, inc) \times 6 times = 24 sc

5 - 8th: 24 sc

9th: (2 sc, dec) \times 6 times = 18 sc

10th: (1 sc, dec) \times 6 times = 12 sc

Stuff

11th: (dec) \times 6 times = 6 sc

We cut the thread, fix the loop, leave the tail for further sewing to the cap.

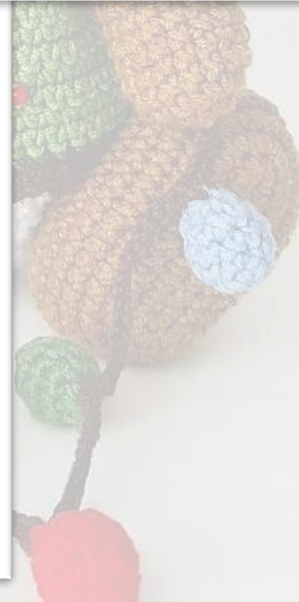
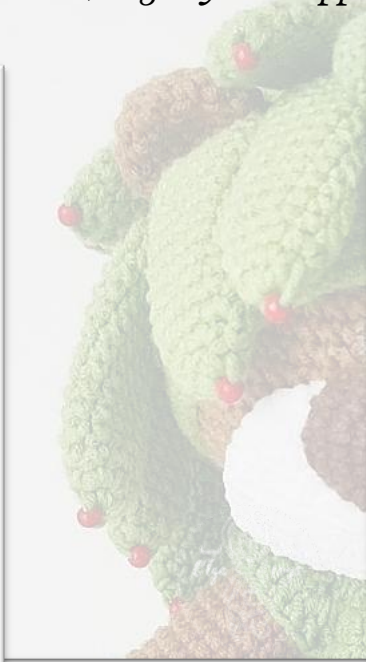


Next, we will sew needles on the hat, I will show an example already on the bear, so that it is clear.

First we will sew the bottom row of needles, focusing on the holes for the ears (10 row from the bottom of the cap). In front, in the center, two needles are slightly angled so that the eyes of the toy are visible. Also on the back of the head 2 needles need to be sewn higher by 3-4 rows than the rest of the needles and also slightly at an angle:



All the other needles are sewn in a staggered order, slightly overlapping each other, sew a pompom:





Cardigan:

45 ch:

10 dc, arch (hdc, ch, hdc), 5 dc (sleeve), arch, 10 dc, arch, 5 dc (sleeve), arch, 10 dc

round: 2 ch, turning detail, 11 dc, arch, 7 dc (sleeve), arch, 12 dc, arch, 7 dc (sleeve), arch, 11 dc

Row: 2 ch, turning detail, 12 dc, 3 ch, 10 loops skip and starting from 11 loops crochet 16 dc, 3 ch, 10 loops skip and starting from 11 loops crochet 12 dc = 46 loops

Row: 1 ch, turning detail, 9 sc, (inc, 2 sc) x 9 times, 10 sc = 55 sc

Row: 1 ch, turning detail, 10 sc, (inc, 3 sc) x 9 times, 9 sc = 64 sc

(1 ch, turning detail, 64 sc) x 7 rounds

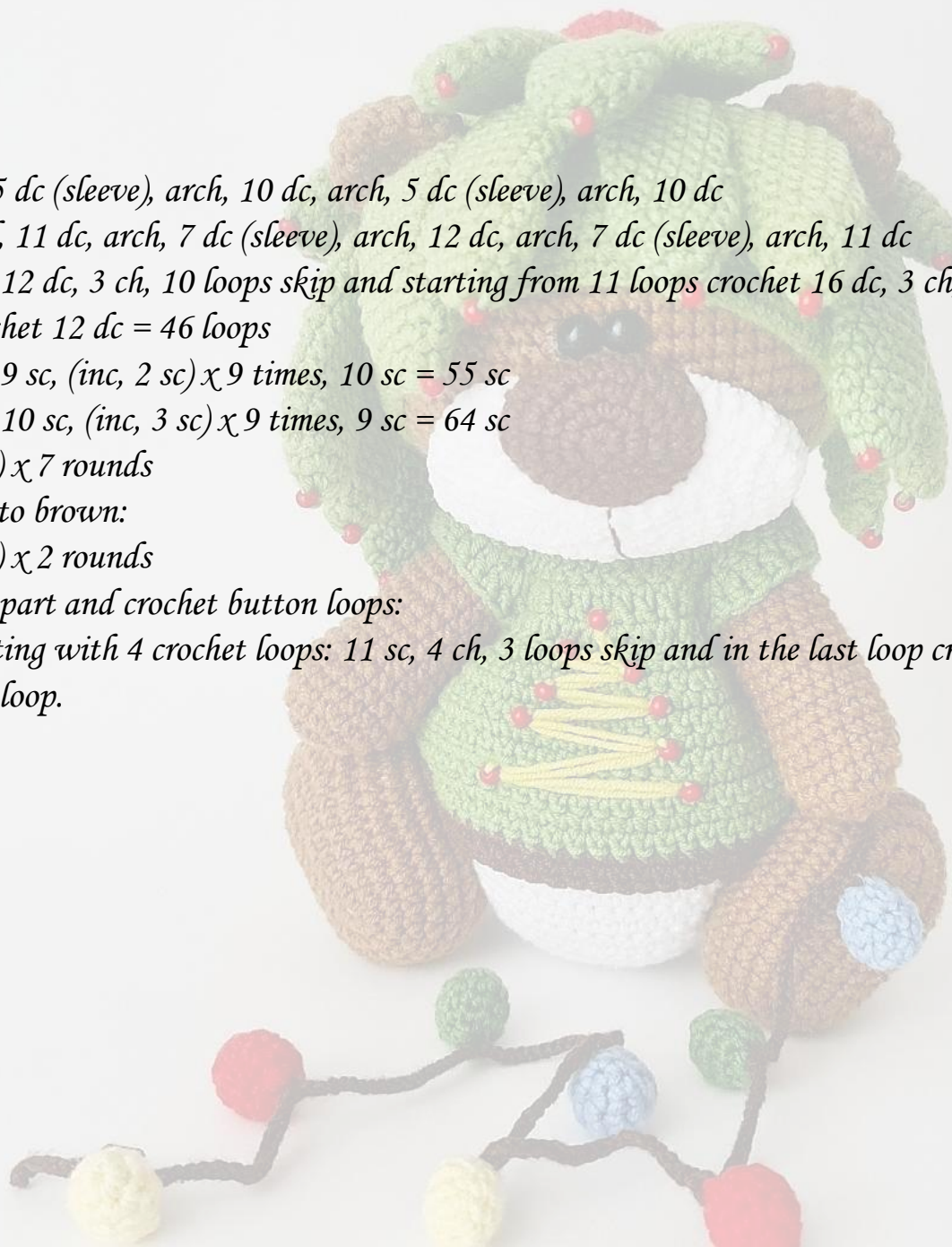
Changing the thread color to brown:

(1 ch, turning detail, 64 sc) x 2 rounds

Next, go to the side of the part and crochet button loops:

4 ch, 3 loops skip and starting with 4 crochet loops: 11 sc, 4 ch, 3 loops skip and in the last loop crochet sl st.

We cut the thread, fix the loop.





We sew buttons.

In an arbitrary form, we embroider a Christmas tree in the center of the front of the jacket and sew red beads on it.

33 ch, 32 sc

(1 ch, turning detail, 32 sc) x 2 rounds

1 ch, turning detail, 1 sc, dec, 26 sc, dec, 1 sc = 30 sc

1 ch, turning detail, 1 sc, dec, 24 sc, dec, 1 sc = 28 sc

1 ch, turning detail, 1 sc, dec, 22 sc, dec, 1 sc = 26 sc

1 ch, turning detail, 1 sc, dec, 20 sc, dec, 1 sc = 24 sc

1 ch, turning detail, 1 sc, dec, 18 sc, dec, 1 sc = 22 sc

1 ch, turning detail, 1 sc, dec, 16 sc, dec, 1 sc = 20 sc

1 ch, turning detail, 1 sc, dec, 14 sc, dec, 1 sc = 18 sc

1 ch, turning detail, 1 sc, dec, 12 sc, dec, 1 sc = 16 sc

1 ch, turning detail, 1 sc, dec, 10 sc, dec, 1 sc = 14 sc

(1 ch, turning detail, 14 sc) x 10 rounds

1 ch, turning detail, 1 sc, inc, 10 sc, inc, 1 sc = 16 sc

1 ch, turning detail, 1 sc, inc, 12 sc, inc, 1 sc = 18 sc

1 ch, turning detail, 1 sc, inc, 14 sc, inc, 1 sc = 20 sc

1 ch, turning detail, 1 sc, inc, 16 sc, inc, 1 sc = 22 sc

1 ch, turning detail, 1 sc, inc, 18 sc, inc, 1 sc = 24 sc

1 ch, turning detail, 1 sc, inc, 20 sc, inc, 1 sc = 26 sc

1 ch, turning detail, 1 sc, inc, 22 sc, inc, 1 sc = 28 sc

1 ch, turning detail, 1 sc, inc, 24 sc, inc, 1 sc = 30 sc

1 ch, turning detail, 1 sc, inc, 26 sc, inc, 1 sc = 32 sc

(1 ch, turning detail, 32 sc) x 3 rounds

We cut the thread, fix the loop.





We sew 3 rows on the sides:



Rubber band:

5 ch, 4 sc

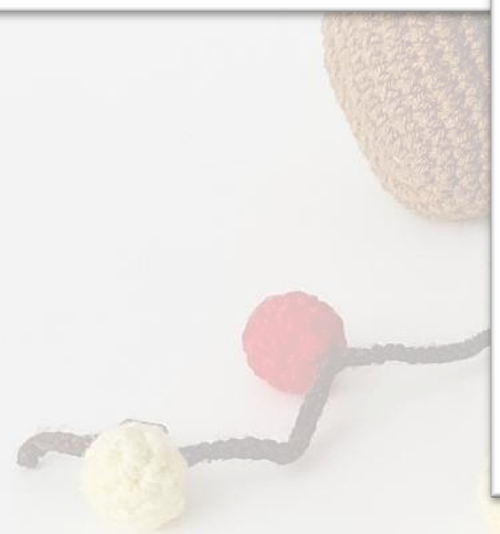
(1 ch, turning detail, 4 sc for the back of the loop) x 62 rounds



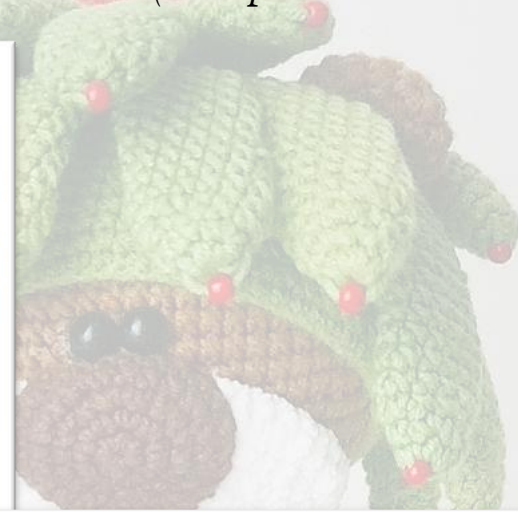
Next, we fold the elastic band and crochet 4 sc in half:



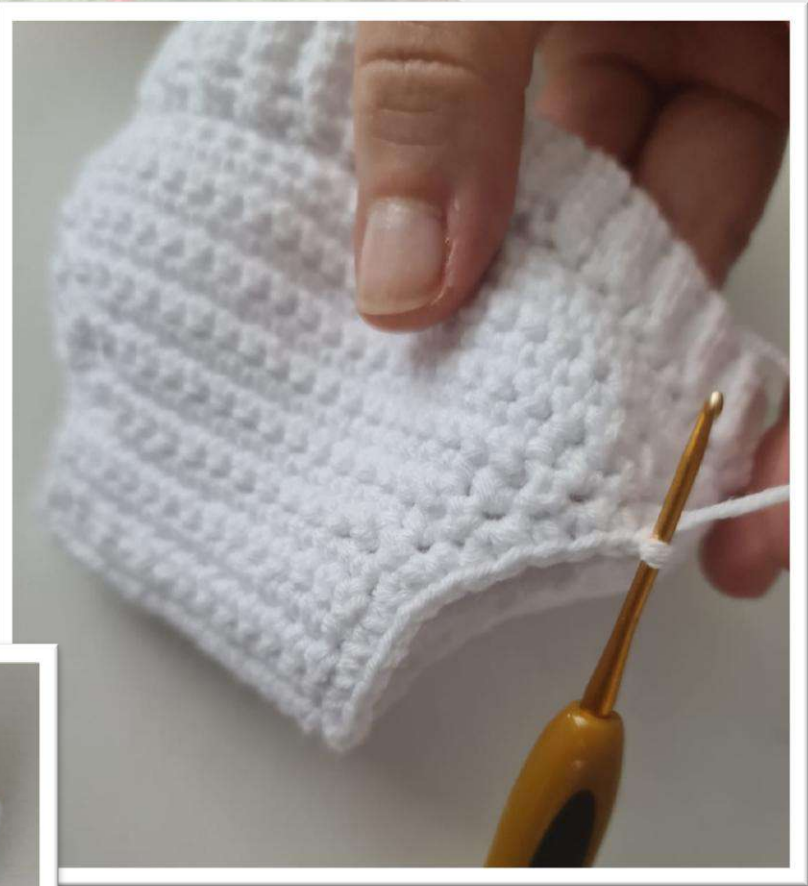
Next, crochet on the top of the part 1 row 62 sc:



Next, we apply an elastic band to the underpants and crochet 1 row 62 sc (underpants + elastic band):



Crochet holes for feet 1 row sc:



Garland: Balls (2 pieces of each color = 8 pieces):

1st row: Start 6 sc in a magic ring

2th row: (1 sc, inc) x 3 times = 9 sc

3 – 4th row: 9 sc

5th row: (1 sc, dec) x 3 times = 6 sc

Stuff and we close 6 loops.



Next, we will connect the balls. We take a brown thread and a crochet: 18 ch, take the first ball, grab 1 loop on the ball and a crochet 1 sc, then again 18 ch and take the ball again, grab 1 loop and a crochet 1 sc and so on to the end. After the last crochet ball, another 18 ch, at the end we fix the loop, cut the thread.
