Clothes

Final size of the toy with the recommended
materials ~ 18 cm

Recommended materials and tools:

YarnArt JEANS

Color №: 01, 33, 42, 63, 35

Spine

Hook: 2mm

Scissors

Filler

Buttons 2 pieces

Second glue

Rhinestones



Abbreviations

(US crochet terms):

- *ch* – chain stitch
- sc* – single crochet
- dc* – double crochet
- inc.* – increase (2 crochets in 1 loop)
- dec.* – decrease (2 crochets together)
- (...)* - \mathcal{L} times – repeat the sequence of loops in brackets \mathcal{L} times
- *hdc* – half double crochet

Hat:

White thread:

72 ch, connect into a ring.

1 th: 72 sc

We change the color of the thread to pink;

2 th: 72 sc

We change the color of the thread to white:

3 th: 72 sc

We change the color of the thread to blue:

4-6 th: 72 sc

We change the color of the thread to white:

7- 12 th: 72 sc

13 th: 21 sc, 7 ch, 7 loops are skipped and starting from 8 crochet loops: 14 sc, 7 ch, 7 loops are skipped and starting from 8 crochet loops: 23 sc

We change the color of the thread to blue:

14-15 th: 72 sc

16 th: (10 sc, dec) x 6 times = 66 sc

We change the color of the thread to white:

17 th: (9 sc, dec) x 6 times = 60 sc

We change the color of the thread to pink;

18 th: (8 sc, dec) x 6 times = 54 sc

We change the color of the thread to white:

19 th: (7 sc, dec) x 6 times = 48 sc

20 th: (6 sc, dec) x 6 times = 42 sc

21 th: (5 sc, dec) x 6 times = 36 sc

22 th: (4 sc, dec) x 6 times = 30 sc

23 th: (3 sc, dec) x 6 times = 24 sc

24 th: (2 sc, dec) x 6 times = 18 sc

25 th: (1 sc, dec) x 6 times = 12 sc

26 th: (dec) x 6 times = 6 sc

We close 6 loops.







By popular demand, I decided to give another instruction on crochet clothes. I noticed that the thickness of the thread can vary and it depends on the batch of threads. Thus, sometimes the bear does not come out the same size as mine and, unfortunately, the clothes on it turn out to be large. To find out whether the clothes will be big or not is very simple, measure your bear's clothes before starting crochet, if his size is smaller than mine, then this instruction will suit you more. I hope for your understanding and awareness that I cannot predict what thickness of thread you will have. Thanks for understanding.

Hat:

66 ch, connect into a ring.

10 rounds \times 66 sc

11 th: 18 sc, 7 ch, 7 loops are skipped and starting from 8 crochet loops: 14 sc,
7 ch, 7 loops are skipped and starting from 8 crochet loops: 20 sc

12 th: 66 sc

13 th: (9 sc, dec) \times 6 times = 60 sc

14 th: (8 sc, dec) \times 6 times = 54 sc

15 th: (7 sc, dec) \times 6 times = 48 sc

16 th: (6 sc, dec) \times 6 times = 42 sc

17 th: (5 sc, dec) \times 6 times = 36 sc

18 th: (4 sc, dec) \times 6 times = 30 sc

19 th: (3 sc, dec) \times 6 times = 24 sc

20 th: (2 sc, dec) \times 6 times = 18 sc

21th: (1 sc, dec) \times 6 times = 12 sc

22 th: (dec) \times 6 times = 6 sc

We close 6 loops.

In any form, we embroider snowflakes on the cap, so that the snowflakes are thinner, we take a thread of two, the distance between the snowflakes is 5 loops:



Detail on the cap:

1 th row: Start 6 sc in a magic ring

2 th row: (inc) x 6 times = 12 sc

3 th row: (1 sc, inc) x 6 times = 18 sc

4 th row: for the back of the loop: 18 sc

5-6 th row: 18 sc

Trim the thread, fix the loop.



Next, crochet 28 ch, insert it into the detail of the cap and fix it:



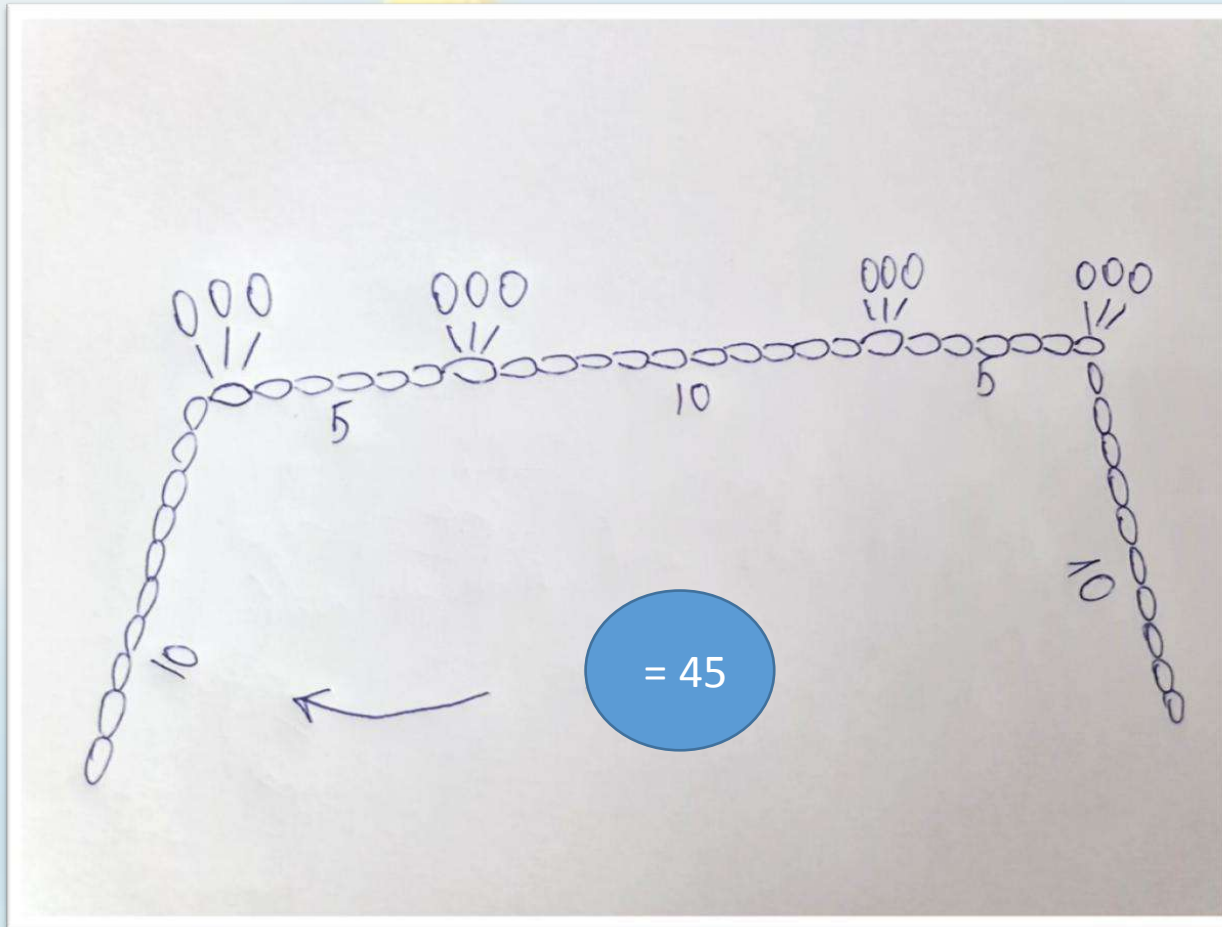
Stuff to the part and sew it on the top of the hat:



Cardigan:

45 *ch*:

10 *dc*, *arch* (*hdc*, *ch*, *hdc*), 5 *dc* (*sleeve*), *arch*, 10 *dc*, *arch*, 5 *dc* (*sleeve*), *arch*, 10 *dc*



round: 2 ch, turning detail, 11 dc, arch, 7 dc (sleeve), arch, 12 dc, arch, 7 dc (sleeve), arch, 11 dc

Row: 2 ch, turning detail, 12 dc, 3 ch, 10 loops skip and starting from 11 loops crochet 16 dc, 3 ch, 10 loops skip and starting from 11 loops crochet 12 dc = 46 loops

Row: 1 ch, turning detail, 9 sc, (inc, 2 sc) x 9 times, 10 sc = 55 sc

Row: 1 ch, turning detail, 10 sc, (inc, 3 sc) x 9 times, 9 sc = 64 sc

(1 ch, turning detail, 64 sc) x 7 rounds

Next, go to the side of the part and crochet button loops:

4 ch, 3 loops skip and starting with 4 crochet loops: 10 sc, 4 ch, 3 loops skip and in the last loop crochet sl st.

We cut the thread, fix the loop.





Applique on the jacket (2 details):

1 th row: Start 6 sc in a magic ring

2 th row: (inc) x 6 times = 12 sc

3 th row: (1 sc, inc) x 6 times = 18 sc

We change the color of the thread to yellow:

4 th row: 4 sc, 1 vn, 1 ch, turning detail, 4 sc.

Trim the thread, fix the loop.

Addition to the application on the jacket (2 details):

15 ch.

Trim the thread, fix the loop.



We glue the applications on the jacket and decorate them with rhinestones:





Cowards, we use blue thread:

33 ch, 32 sc

(1 ch, turning detail, 32 sc) x 2 rounds

1 ch, turning detail, 1 sc, dec, 26 sc, dec, 1 sc = 30 sc

1 ch, turning detail, 1 sc, dec, 24 sc, dec, 1 sc = 28 sc

1 ch, turning detail, 1 sc, dec, 22 sc, dec, 1 sc = 26 sc

1 ch, turning detail, 1 sc, dec, 20 sc, dec, 1 sc = 24 sc

1 ch, turning detail, 1 sc, dec, 18 sc, dec, 1 sc = 22 sc

1 ch, turning detail, 1 sc, dec, 16 sc, dec, 1 sc = 20 sc

1 ch, turning detail, 1 sc, dec, 14 sc, dec, 1 sc = 18 sc

1 ch, turning detail, 1 sc, dec, 12 sc, dec, 1 sc = 16 sc

1 ch, turning detail, 1 sc, dec, 10 sc, dec, 1 sc = 14 sc

(1 ch, turning detail, 14 sc) x 10 rounds

1 ch, turning detail, 1 sc, inc, 10 sc, inc, 1 sc = 16 sc

1 ch, turning detail, 1 sc, inc, 12 sc, inc, 1 sc = 18 sc

1 ch, turning detail, 1 sc, inc, 14 sc, inc, 1 sc = 20 sc

1 ch, turning detail, 1 sc, inc, 16 sc, inc, 1 sc = 22 sc

1 ch, turning detail, 1 sc, inc, 18 sc, inc, 1 sc = 24 sc

1 ch, turning detail, 1 sc, inc, 20 sc, inc, 1 sc = 26 sc

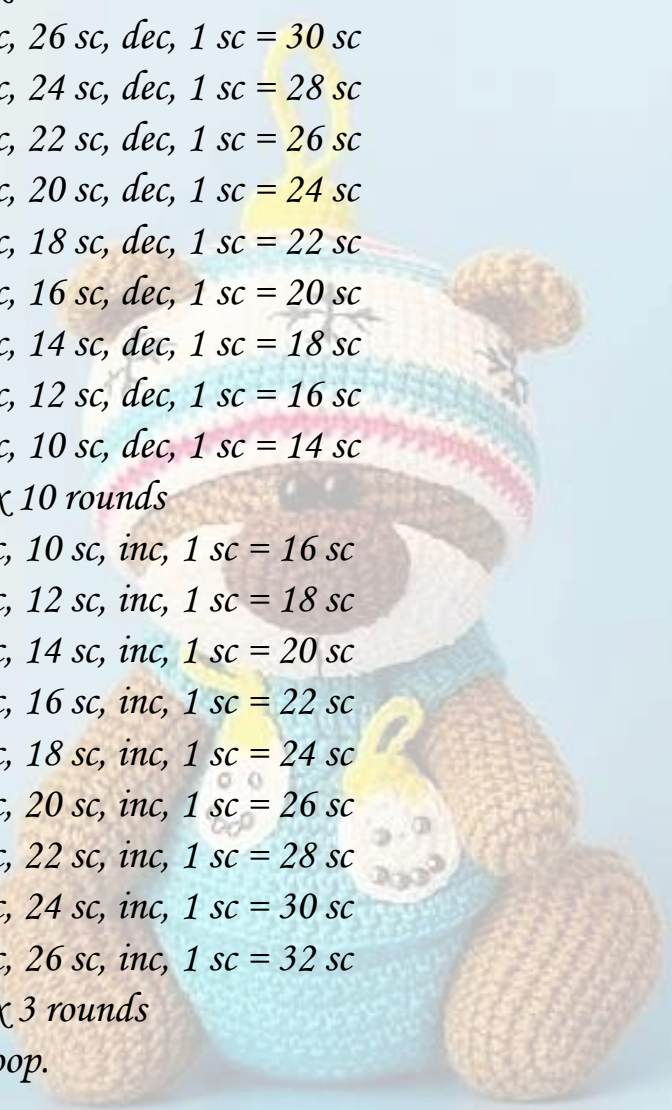
1 ch, turning detail, 1 sc, inc, 22 sc, inc, 1 sc = 28 sc

1 ch, turning detail, 1 sc, inc, 24 sc, inc, 1 sc = 30 sc

1 ch, turning detail, 1 sc, inc, 26 sc, inc, 1 sc = 32 sc

(1 ch, turning detail, 32 sc) x 3 rounds

We cut the thread, fix the loop.





We sew 3 rows on the sides:



Rubber band:

5 ch, 4 sc

(1 ch, turning detail, 4 sc for the back of the loop) x 62 rounds



Next, we fold the elastic band and crochet 4 sc in half:



Next, crochet on the top of the part 1 row 62 sc:



Next, we apply an elastic band to the underpants and crochet 1 row 62 sc (underpants + elastic band):



Crochet holes for feet 1 row sc:
