SPECIAL STITCHES

Increase (Inc)

One increase consists of 2 sts made into the same indicated st.

Magic Circle (MC)

See page 3 of this document for a step-by-step photo tutorial.

Mini Picot

Ch 2, sl st in the back bump of the first ch.

Picot Stitch (Picot)

Ch 3, sl st in the back bump of the first ch.

Puff Stitch (Puff)

(Yo, insert your hook into the indicated st, yo, and draw up a loop) three times. Yo, draw yarn through all 7 loops on your hook.

Surface Crochet

See page 4 of this document for a step-by-step photo tutorial.

GAUGE

Using your 4-mm crochet hook, make a MC.

Round 1. Ch 2, hdc 11 in the MC. Join the round with a sl st into the first hdc. (11 sts)

Round 2. Ch 1, hdc inc 11. Sl st to join. (22 sts)

Round 3. Ch 1, (hdc inc 1, hdc 1) 11 times. Sl st to join. (33 sts)

The three rounds should measure 2.25" (5.5 cm).



SIZE

Each square measures 5.5" (14 cm).

PATTERN NOTES

- If the pattern says "**hdc 2**", it means that you have to crochet 1 hdc into each of the next 2 sts.
- **Increases** are indicated as "hdc inc" or "dc inc" based on whether they are made with hdc or dc stitches.
- (...) – Repeat the instruction within brackets for the indicated times.
- Join each round with a sl st between the last and first st of the round (**not on top of the initial chains!**).
- The stitch count is indicated within brackets at the end of each round's instructions.
- The initial chains are not included in the stitch count.
- **See page 3 for how to change colors!!!**

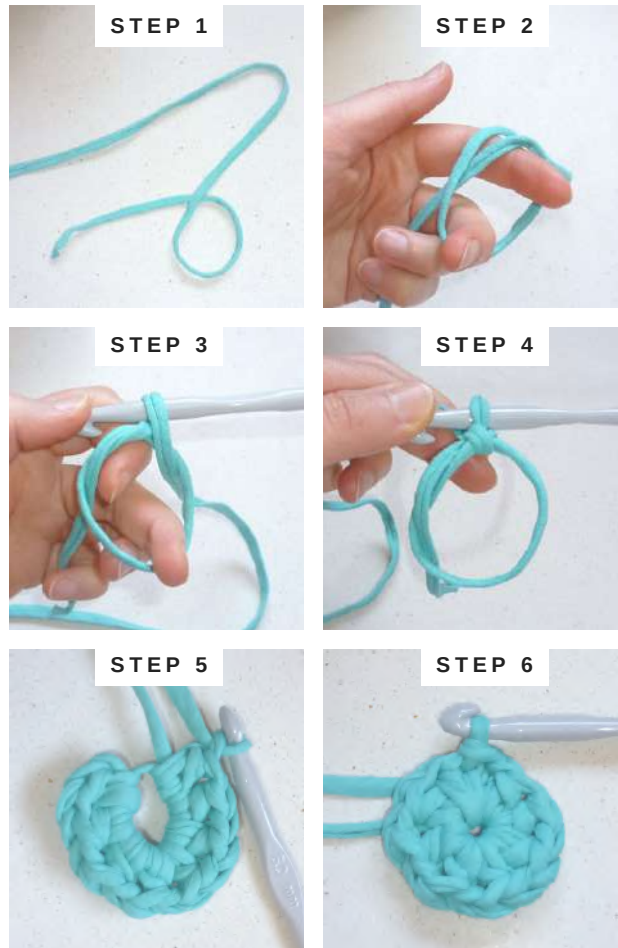

How To...

MAGIC CIRCLE

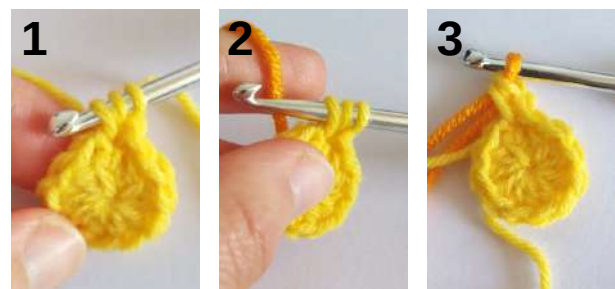
- **Step 1-2.** With your left hand (assuming you are right-handed), hold the loose end of your yarn with your pinky and ring finger. Make the yarn pass in between your thumb and index finger, and then make a loop around your index and middle finger. Bring the yarn toward the outside, like shown in the picture.
- **Step 3.** Starting from the situation pictured in panel 2, insert your crochet hook in the loop, just above your index finger. Reach for the yarn you positioned toward the outside and pull up a loop. This loop will be pretty loose and unstable.
- **Step 4.** Secure your yarn by chaining 1 or the number of chains indicated in the pattern.
- **Step 5.** Crochet your stitches into the ring as indicated in the pattern.
- **Step 6.** Close the MC by pulling the loose end. When you do this, your stitches will come close together and you can slip stitch into the top of the very first stitch you made.



HOW TO CHANGE COLOR

In this pattern, all color changes are made in the middle of a stitch.

- **Step 1.** With your current color, yo (if working a hdc or dc, otherwise for a sc skip the yo), insert your hook into the indicated st, yo and pull up a loop (three loops on your hook for a hdc/dc; two loops for a sc). This is the first half of your st.
- **Step 2.** Join your new color by simply holding it behind your work and using it as your new working yarn. Yo.
- **Step 3.** Complete your st with your new color.



In the example above, I made a color change while working in hdc.

How To...

SURFACE CROCHET

- **Step 1.** Insert your hook into the indicated st going from front to back of your work.
- **Step 2.** Position your working yarn on the back of your work.
- **Step 3-4.** On the back of your work, pick up your yarn. To do so, simply yo, and pull up a loop to the front.
- **Step 5.** With the loop you just picked up still on your hook, move your hook to the next point/st and insert it from front to back, like you did in step 1.
- **Step 6.** On the back of your work, yo, and pick up a loop. Pull the loop up to the right side.

Keep repeating steps 5-6.

Notice how your working yarn remains on the back of your work all the time!



Christmas Lights Granny Square

SQUARE

With your 4-mm hook and CA, make a MC.

Round 1. [CA] Ch 2, hdc 11 in the MC. (11 sts)

Round 2. [CA] Ch 1, hdc inc 11. (22 sts)

Round 3. [CA] Ch 1, (hdc inc 1, hdc 1) 11 times. (33 sts)

Round 4. [CA] Ch 1, hdc 1, hdc inc 1, (hdc 2, hdc inc 1) 10 times, 1 hdc. (44 sts)

Round 5. [CA] Ch 1, sc 2, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1. (dc 1, hdc 2, sc 3, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1) three times. Dc 1, hdc 2, sc 1. (13 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 6. [CA] Ch 2, dc 7. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1]. On the next side, dc 13) three times. [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1] into the last corner, dc 6. (15 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 7. [CA] Ch 2, dc 8. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 2, ch 1, dc 2]. On the next side, dc 15) three times. [Dc 2, ch 1, dc 2] into the last corner, dc 7. (19 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners)

Round 8. [CA] Ch 1, sc 10. (In the ch-1 corner, [sc 1, ch 1, sc 1]. On the next side, sc 19) three times. [Sc 1, ch 1, sc 1] into the last corner, sc 9. (21 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners).

Fasten off and weave in all your ends.

LIGHT APPLIQUE

(Make 7)

With your 3.5-mm crochet hook and color of your choice, make a MC.

Round 1. Ch 1, dc 1, hdc 5, ch 1, hdc 5, dc 1. Join the round with a sl st into the first dc. (12 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.



(Right Side facing) With your 3.5-mm hook, join grey yarn in the last dc of round 1 of the applique.

Row 1. Sc 2. (2 sts)

Fasten off leaving a short tail for sewing the 2 grey sts.

FINISHING

Draw a line crossing the granny square and to which you will attach the light appliques. You can choose your favorite shape, and you can either embroider it or use surface crochet on the wrong side.

For the latter option, turn your granny square to the wrong side. Using your 4-mm hook, join grey yarn in one of the sts on one side and surface crochet a line.

Attach the light appliques all around the line.

Weave in all your ends.

Your Christmas Lights Granny Square is ready!

Bauble Granny Square

SQUARE

With your 4-mm hook and CC, make a MC.

Round 1. [CC] Ch 2, hdc 11 in the MC. (11 sts)

Round 2. [CC] Ch 1, hdc inc 11. (22 sts)

Round 3. [CC] Ch 1, (hdc inc 1, hdc 1) 11 times. (33 sts)

Round 4. [CC] Ch 1, hdc 1, hdc inc 1, (hdc 2, hdc inc 1) 10 times, 1 hdc. Close the last st with CA. (44 sts)

Round 5. [CA] Ch 1, sc 2, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1. (dc 1, hdc 2, sc 3, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1) three times. Dc 1, hdc 2, sc 1. (13 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 6. [CA] Ch 2, dc 7. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1]. On the next side, dc 13) three times. [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1] into the last corner, dc 6. (15 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 7. [CA] Ch 2, dc 8. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 2, ch 1, dc 2]. On the next side, dc 15) three times. [Dc 2, ch 1, dc 2] into the last corner, dc 7. (19 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners)

Round 8. [CA] Ch 1, sc 10. (In the ch-1 corner, [sc 1, ch 1, sc 1]. On the next side, sc 19) three times. [Sc 1, ch 1, sc 1] into the last corner, sc 9. (21 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners).

Fasten off and weave in all your ends.

BAUBLE CAP APPLIQUE

With your 3.5-mm hook and grey yarn, ch 4.

Row 1. Sc in the second ch from your hook, Sc 2. (3 sts)

Row 2-4. Ch 1, turn. Sc 3 in the BLO

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.



FINISHING

With a length of CA, embroider a snowflake or your favorite Christmas decor motif between round 1-4 of the granny square.

Attach the cap on top of the Christmas bauble and embroider a hanger.

Weave in all your ends.

Your Christmas Bauble Granny Square is ready!



Ho Ho Ho Granny Square

SQUARE

With your 4-mm hook and CB, make a MC.

Round 1. [CB] Ch 2, hdc 11 in the MC. (11 sts)

Round 2. [CB] Ch 1, hdc inc 11. Close the last st with CA. (22 sts)

Round 3. [CA] Ch 1, (hdc inc 1, hdc 1) 11 times. (33 sts)

Round 4. [CA] Ch 1, hdc 1, hdc inc 1, (hdc 2, hdc inc 1) 10 times, 1 hdc. Close the last st with CA. (44 sts)

Round 5. [CA] Ch 1, sc 2, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1. (dc 1, hdc 2, sc 3, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1) three times. Dc 1, hdc 2, sc 1. (13 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 6. [CA] Ch 2, dc 7. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1]. On the next side, dc 13) three times. [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1] into the last corner, dc 6. (15 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 7. [CA] Ch 2, dc 8. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 2, ch 1, dc 2]. On the next side, dc 15) three times. [Dc 2, ch 1, dc 2] into the last corner, dc 7. (19 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners)

Round 8. [CA] Ch 1, sc 10. (In the ch-1 corner, [sc 1, ch 1, sc 1]. On the next side, sc 19) three times. [Sc 1, ch 1, sc 1] into the last corner, sc 9. (21 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners).

Fasten off and weave in all your ends.



LETTER O / BAUBLE APPLIQUE

(Make one with CC and one with CD)

With your 3.5-mm crochet hook, make a MC,

Round 1. Ch 2, hdc 11 in the MC. (11 sts)

Round 2. Ch 1, hdc inc 11. (22 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

BAUBLE CAP APPLIQUE

(Make 3)

With your 3.5-mm hook and yellow yarn, ch 3.

Row 1. Sl st in the second ch from your hook and in the next. (2 sts)

Row 2. Ch 1, turn. Sl st 2 in the FLO.

Row 3. Ch 1, turn. Sl st 2 in the BLO.

Weave in all your ends.

Ho Ho Ho Granny Square

LETTER H APPLIQUE

(Make one with CC, one with CD, and one with CB)

Using your 3.5-mm hook, ch 10.

Row 1. Hdc 1 in the third ch from your hook. Hdc 3 (photo 1).

Ch 8 (photo 2). Hdc 1 in the third ch from your hook, hdc 3 (photo 3).

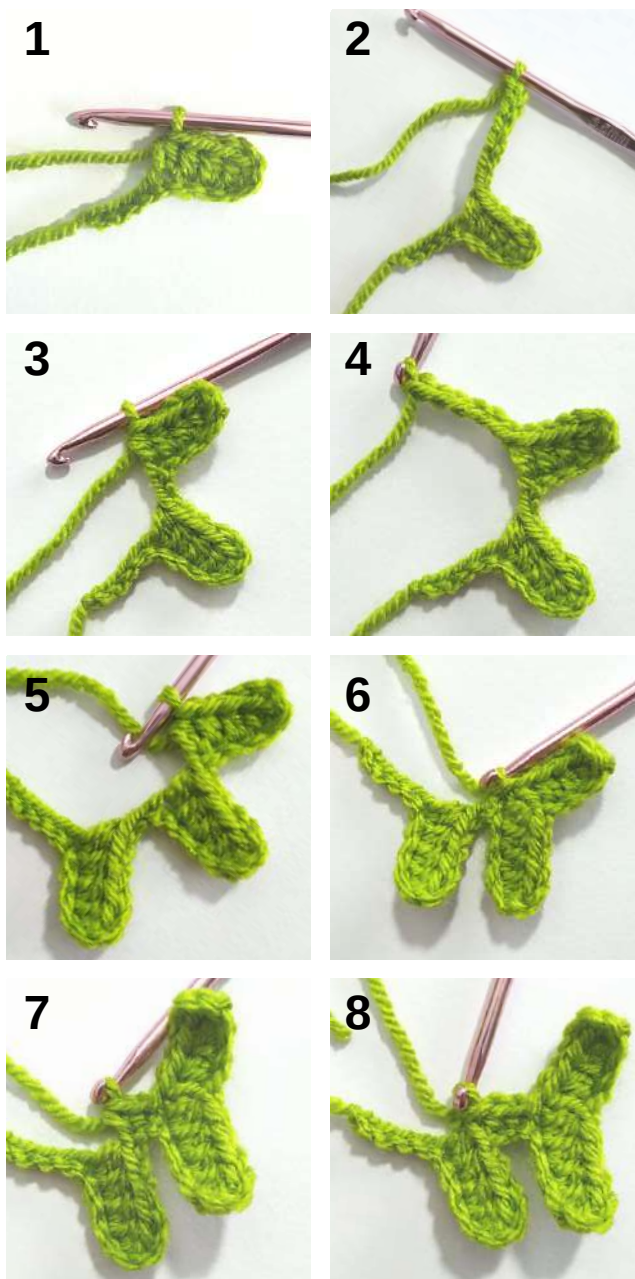
Ch 6 (photo 4). Hdc 1 in the third ch from your hook. Hdc 3 (photo 5).

Sl st into the base of the hdc in front of your hook (photo 6).

Sc 2 (photo 7), sl st into the front loop of the fourth hdc that you made in the first step (photo 8).

Hdc 4 in the remaining 4 ch of the initial ch, ch 2, sl st into the first st of the initial ch (photo 9).

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.



FINISHING

Attach the O and H appliques as shown in the picture on the previous page.

Attach a bauble cap just above each O applique and above round 2 of the granny square.

Using some CA, embroider a shiny point on the top, left side of each O applique and of round 2 of the granny square.

Fasten off and weave in all your ends.

Your Ho Ho Ho Granny Square is ready!

Peppermint Granny Square

SQUARE

With your 4-mm hook and CA, make a MC.

*Work rounds 1-3 in the round, so do not join with a sl st! All other rounds are closed with a sl st at the end!

Round 1*. [CA] Ch 2, hdc 11 in the MC. (11 sts)

Round 2*. [CA] Ch 1, hdc inc 11. (22 sts)

Round 3*. [CA] Ch 1, (hdc inc 1, hdc 1) 11 times. (33 sts)

Round 4. [CA] Ch 1, hdc 1, hdc inc 1, (hdc 2, hdc inc 1) 10 times, 1 hdc. Close the last st with CC. Sl st into the first hdc of the round to close. (44 sts)

Round 5. [CC] Ch 1, sc 2, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1. (dc 1, hdc 2, sc 3, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1) three times. Dc 1, hdc 2, sc 1. (13 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 6. [CC] Ch 2, dc 7. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1]. On the next side, dc 13) three times. [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1] into the last corner, dc 6. (15 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 7. [CC] Ch 2, dc 8. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 2, ch 1, dc 2]. On the next side, dc 15) three times. [Dc 2, ch 1, dc 2] into the last corner, dc 7. (19 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners)



Round 8. [CC] Ch 1, sc 10. (In the ch-1 corner, [sc 1, ch 1, sc 1]. On the next side, sc 19) three times. [Sc 1, ch 1, sc 1] into the last corner, sc 9. (21 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners).

Fasten off.

Spiral. With your 4-mm hook and CB, surface crochet* following the spaces between rounds 1-2, 2-3, 3-4, and 4-5 of the granny square.

*See the "How to..." section for a step-by-step tutorial on how to surface crochet.

Fasten off and weave in all your ends.



Peppermint Granny Square

Option 1

CANDY WRAP APPLIQUE

(Make Two)

With your 4-mm hook and CA, ch 5.

Row 1. [CA] Ch 1, sc in second ch from your hook and in each st across. (4 sts)

Row 2. [CA] Ch 2 (does not count as a st) and turn, [dc 2] in each st across, ch 2, sl st in the last st. (8 sts)

Fasten off CA leaving a long tail for sewing.

Join CB in the first st of Row 2.

Row 3. [CB] Sc in each st across. (8 sts)

Fasten off CB and weave in your ends.

FINISHING 1

Attach the two candy wraps on the opposite sides of the peppermint.

Your Peppermint Candy Granny Square is ready!



Option 2

LOLLIPOP STICK

With your 3.5-mm hook and CA, ch 7.

Row 1. [CA] Sc 1 in the second ch from your hook, sc 1 in each remaining ch. (6 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

LITTLE RIBBON APPLIQUE

With your 3.5-mm hook and yellow yarn, ch 30.

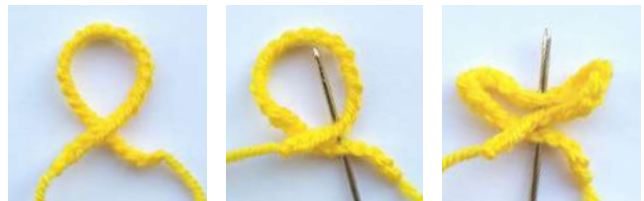
Fasten off.

FINISHING 2

Attach the stick just below round 4 going out toward the edge of your granny square.

Assemble a little ribbon (see pics below) and attach it just below round 4 of the granny square.

Your Peppermint Lollipop Granny Square is ready!



Candy Cane Granny Square

SQUARE

With your 4-mm hook and CC, make a MC.

Round 1. [CC] Ch 2, hdc 11 in the MC. (11 sts)

Round 2. [CC] Ch 1, hdc inc 11. (22 sts)

Round 3. [CC] Ch 1, (hdc inc 1, hdc 1) 11 times. (33 sts)

Round 4. [CC] Ch 1, hdc 1, hdc inc 1, (hdc 2, hdc inc 1) 10 times, 1 hdc. (44 sts)

Round 5. [CC] Ch 1, sc 2, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1. (dc 1, hdc 2, sc 3, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1) three times. Dc 1, hdc 2, sc 1. (13 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 6. [CC] Ch 2, dc 7. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1]. On the next side, dc 13) three times. [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1] into the last corner, dc 6. (15 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 7. [CC] Ch 2, dc 8. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 2, ch 1, dc 2]. On the next side, dc 15) three times. [Dc 2, ch 1, dc 2] into the last corner, dc 7. (19 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners)

Round 8. [CC] Ch 1, sc 10. (In the ch-1 corner, [sc 1, ch 1, sc 1]. On the next side, sc 19) three times. [Sc 1, ch 1, sc 1] into the last corner, sc 9. (21 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners).

Fasten off and weave in all your ends.

CANDY CANE APPLIQUE

With your 3.5-mm hook and CA, ch 31.

Row 1. Sc in the second ch from your hook. Sc 4, sc inc 1, sc 4, sc inc 1, sc 19. (32 sts)

Row 2. Ch 1, turn. Sc 21, sc inc 1, sc 2, sc inc 1, sc 7. (34 sts)

Row 3. Ch 1, turn. Sc 6, sc inc 7, sc 21. (41 sts)



Row 4. Ch 1, turn. Sc 21, sc inc 1, sc 1, sc inc 1, sc 8, sc inc 1, sc 1, sc inc 1, sc 6. (45 sts)

Row 5. Ch 1, turn. (Sc 10, sc inc 1) twice, sc 23. (47 sts)

Without turning, sc 5 along the bottom side of the candy cane applique.

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.



Candy Cane Granny Square

Candy Cane Stripes

With your 3.5-mm crochet hook and CB, surface crochet the stripes on your candy cane applique.

Weave in all your ends before sewing in the candy cane on the granny square.

HOLLY LEAF APPLIQUE

(Make 2)

With your 3.5-mm hook and CD, ch 6.

Round 1. (Sl st 2, mini picot) twice. Sl st 1, ch 1. Start working on the other loops of the initial chain. Sl st 1, (mini picot, sl st 2) twice.

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

HOLLY DRUPE APPLIQUE

(Make 3)

With your 3.5-mm hook and CB, make a MC.

Round 1. Sc 3 in the MC. (3 sts)

Fasten off and join the round using a tapestry needle.

Cut your yarn leaving a long tail for sewing.

RIBBON APPLIQUE

With your 3.5-mm hook and yellow yarn, ch 9.

Row 1. Sc 1 in the second ch from your hook and in each remaining ch. (8 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

FINISHING

Attach the candy cane applique on your granny square.

Attach the ribbon applique in the middle of the longer half. Optional: Make a little ribbon with the tails of yellow yarn.

Attach the holly leaves and drupes.

Your Candy Cane Granny Square is ready!



Christmas Tree Granny Square

SQUARE

With your 4-mm hook and CA, make a MC.

Round 1. [CA] Ch 2, hdc 11 in the MC. (11 sts)

Round 2. [CA] Ch 1, hdc inc 11. (22 sts)

Round 3. [CA] Ch 1, (hdc inc 1, hdc 1) 11 times. (33 sts)

Round 4. [CA] Ch 1, hdc 1, hdc inc 1, (hdc 2, hdc inc 1) 10 times, 1 hdc. (44 sts)

Round 5. [CA] Ch 1, sc 2, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1. (Dc 1, hdc 2, sc 3, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1) three times. Dc 1, hdc 2, sc 1. (13 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 6. [CA] Ch 2, dc 7. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1]. On the next side, dc 13) three times. [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1] into the last corner, dc 6. (15 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 7. [CA] Ch 2, dc 8. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 2, ch 1, dc 2]. On the next side, dc 15) three times. [Dc 2, ch 1, dc 2] into the last corner, dc 7. (19 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners)

Round 8. [CA] Ch 1, sc 10. (In the ch-1 corner, [sc 1, ch 1, sc 1]. On the next side, sc 19) three times. [Sc 1, ch 1, sc 1] into the last corner, sc 9. (21 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners).

Fasten off and weave in all your ends.

ORNAMENT APPLIQUE

With color of choice and your 3.5-mm crochet hook, make a MC.

Round 1. Sc 6 in the MC, join the round with a sl st into the first st. (6 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.



TINY STAR APPLIQUE

With CB and your 3.5-mm crochet hook, make a MC.

Round 1. In MC, (sc 1, picot) five times. Join the round with a sl st into the first sc.

Fasten off leaving a long tail to sew the star on your granny square.

Christmas Tree Granny Square

FIR TREE APPLIQUE

With CD and your 3.5-mm crochet hook, ch 2.

- Row 1.** Sc 1 in the first ch. (1 st)
- Row 2.** Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 1. (2 sts)
- Row 3.** Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 2. (4 sts)
- Row 4.** Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 1, sc 2, sc inc 1. (6 sts)
- Row 5.** Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 1, sc 4, sc inc 1. (8 sts)

Tie off and weave in the ends.

Join yarn in the third st from either end.

- Row 6.** Ch 1, turn. Sc 4. (4 sts)
- Row 7.** Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 4. (8 sts)
- Row 8.** Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 1, sc 6, sc inc 1. (10 sts)
- Row 9.** Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 1, sc 8, sc inc 1. (12 sts)
- Row 10.** Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 1, sc 10, sc inc 1. (14 sts)

Tie off and weave in the ends.

Join yarn in the fifth st from either end.

- Row 11.** Ch 1, turn. Sc 7. (7 sts)
- Row 12.** Ch 1, turn. (Sc inc 1, sc 1) three times, sc inc 1. (11 sts)
- Row 13.** Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 1, sc 9, sc inc 1. (13 sts)
- Row 14.** Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 1, sc 11, sc inc 1. (15 sts)
- Row 15.** Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 1, sc 13, sc inc 1. (17 sts)

Tie off and weave in the ends.

Join yarn in the fifth st from either end.

- Row 16.** Ch 1, turn. Sc 9. (9 sts)
- Row 17.** Ch 1, turn. (Sc inc 1, sc 1) four times, sc inc 1. (14 sts)
- Row 18.** Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 1, sc 12, sc inc 1. (16 sts)
- Row 19.** Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 1, sc 14, sc inc 1. (18 sts)
- Row 20.** Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 1, sc 16, sc inc 1. (20 sts)
- Row 21.** Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 1, sc 18, sc inc 1. (22 sts)

Bind off leaving a long tail for sewing.

VASE APPLIQUE (Optional)

With your 3.5-mm crochet hook and CE, ch 4

- Row 1.** Sc in the second ch from your hook, sc 2. (3 sts)
- Row 2.** Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 1, sc 2. (4 sts)
- Row 3.** Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 1, sc 3. (5 sts)
- Row 4.** Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 1, sc 4. (6 sts)

Crochet a border as follow:

- Row 5.** Ch 1, do not turn your work. Place 4 sts along the left side (or right side if you are left-handed). Ch 1, sc 3 on the bottom of the vase. Ch 1, sc 4 along the next side.

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

FINISHING

Attach your fir tree applique and if you decided to make one, attach your vase applique just below the fir tree.

With a length of grey yarn, embroider the trunk of the tree.

Decorate your Christmas tree by attaching the tiny star applique and a number of ornaments of your choice.

Weave in all your ends.

Round 4. [CC] Ch 1, puff 1 in the space between the initial ch-1 and the first puff of round 3, ch 1. (puff 1 in the space between two puffs from the previous round, ch 1) 21 times. Close the last st with CA. (44 sts)

Round 5. [CA] Ch 1, sc 2, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1. (Dc 1, hdc 2, sc 3, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1) three times. Dc 1, hdc 2, sc 1. (13 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 6. [CA] Ch 2, dc 7. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1]. On the next side, dc 13) three times. [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1] into the last corner, dc 6. (15 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 7. [CA] Ch 2, dc 8. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 2, ch 1, dc 2]. On the next side, dc 15) three times. [Dc 2, ch 1, dc 2] into the last corner, dc 7. (19 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners)

Round 8. [CA] Ch 1, sc 10. (In the ch-1 corner, [sc 1, ch 1, sc 1]. On the next side, sc 19) three times. [Sc 1, ch 1, sc 1] into the last corner, sc 9. (21 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners).

Fasten off and weave in all your ends.



Wreath Granny Square

RIBBON APPLIQUE

With your 3.5-mm hook and CB, ch 52.

Row 1. Dc 1 in the third ch from your hook, dc 1, hdc 1, sc 2, sl st 5, sc 2, hdc 2, dc 2, tr 4, dc 3, hdc 1, sc 2, hdc 1, dc 3, tr 4, dc 2, hdc 2, sc 2, sl st 5, sc 2, hdc 1, dc 2. Ch 2, sl st into the initial ch.

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.



HOLLY DRUPE APPLIQUE

(Make 6 with CB and 5 with CD)

With your 3.5-mm hook, make a MC.

Round 1. Sc 3 in the MC. (3 sts)

Fasten off and join the round using a tapestry needle.

Cut your yarn leaving a long tail for sewing.

FINISHING

Assemble the ribbon. Place it with the right side facing up and fold the two sides toward the center.

Cut a length of CB yarn, fold it in two, and pass it through the center of the ribbon to block it.

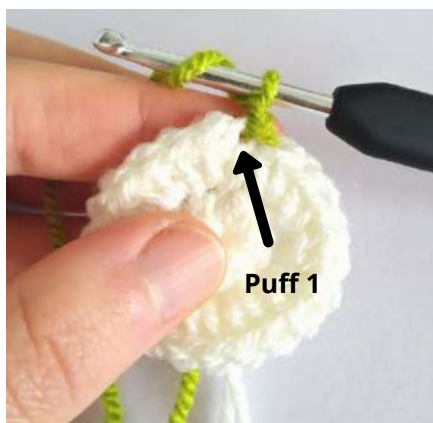

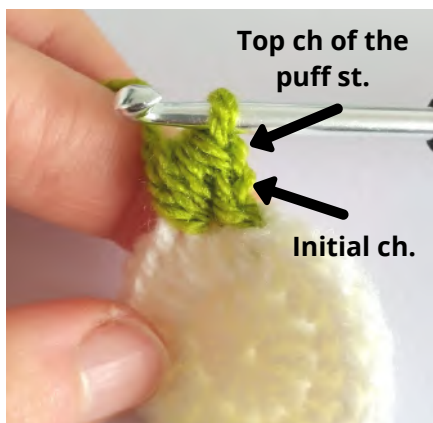

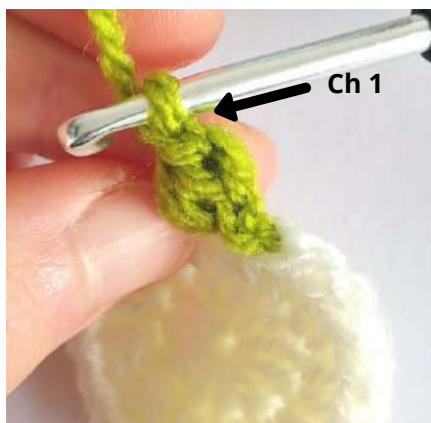

Both puff sts and ch 1 count as sts!!!

With your 4-mm hook and CB, make a MC.

Round 1. [CB] Ch 2, hdc 11 in the MC. (11 sts)

Round 2. [CB] Ch 1, hdc inc 11. (22 sts)

Round 3. [CB] Ch 1, (hdc inc 1, hdc 1) 11 times. (33 sts)

Round 4. [CB] Ch 1, hdc 1, hdc inc 1, (hdc 2, hdc inc 1) 10 times, 1 hdc. Close the last st with CC. (44 sts)

Round 5. [CC] Ch 1, sc 2, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1. (Dc 1, hdc 2, sc 3, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1) three times. Dc 1, hdc 2, sc 1. (13 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 6. [CC] Ch 2, dc 7. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1]. On the next side, dc 13) three times. [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1] into the last corner, dc 6. (15 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 7. [CC] Ch 2, dc 8. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 2, ch 1, dc 2]. On the next side, dc 15) three times. [Dc 2, ch 1, dc 2] into the last corner, dc 7. (19 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners)

Round 8. [CC] Ch 1, sc 10. (In the ch-1 corner, [sc 1, ch 1, sc 1]. On the next side, sc 19) three times. [Sc 1, ch 1, sc 1] into the last corner, sc 9. (21 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners).

Fasten off and weave in all your ends.

POMPOM APPLIQUE

With your 3.5-mm hook and CA, make a MC.

Round 1. Ch 2, hdc 11 in the MC. (11 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.



BRIM APPLIQUE

With your 3.5-mm hook and CA, ch 6.

Row 1. Sc in the second ch from your hook and each remaining ch. (5 sts)

Row 2-15. Sc in the BLO across. (5 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

FINISHING

Attach the brim applique making sure to slightly stretch the brim on the top side.

Attach the pom-pom applique on top of your hat.

Weave in all your ends.

Your Christmas Hat Granny Square is ready!

SQUARE

With your 4-mm hook and CC, make a MC.

Round 1. [CC] Ch 2, hdc 11 in the MC. (11 sts)

Round 2. [CC] Ch 1, hdc inc 11. (22 sts)

Round 3. [CC] Ch 1, (hdc inc 1, hdc 1) 11 times. (33 sts)

Round 4. [CC] Ch 1, hdc 1, hdc inc 1, (hdc 2, hdc inc 1) 10 times, 1 hdc. (44 sts)

Round 5. [CC] Ch 1, sc 2, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1. (Dc 1, hdc 2, sc 3, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1) three times. Dc 1, hdc 2, sc 1. (13 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 6. [CC] Ch 2, dc 7. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1]. On the next side, dc 13) three times. [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1] into the last corner, dc 6. (15 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 7. [CC] Ch 2, dc 8. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 2, ch 1, dc 2]. On the next side, dc 15) three times. [Dc 2, ch 1, dc 2] into the last corner, dc 7. (19 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners)

Round 8. [CC] Ch 1, sc 10. (In the ch-1 corner, [sc 1, ch 1, sc 1]. On the next side, sc 19) three times. [Sc 1, ch 1, sc 1] into the last corner, sc 9. (21 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners).

Fasten off and weave in all your ends.



Stockings Granny Square

STOCKING APPLIQUE

(Make two, one with CA and one with CB)

**See next page for step-by-step instructions.*

With your 3.5-mm hook, ch 6.

Row 1. Sc in the second ch from your hook and in each remaining ch. (5 sts)

Row 2-9. Ch 1, turn. Sc 5. (5 sts)

Row 10. Without chaining, turn your work. Sk 2, [dc 3] in the next st.

Working along the post of the last dc, [sc 1, hdc 1].

Hdc 1 in the same st where you made the 3 dc.

Sc in the next st of row 9, sl st into the last st.

Row 11-12. Ch 1, turn. Sc 5.

Row 13. Without chaining, turn your work. Sk 2, dc 6 in the next st. Sk 1, sl st into the last st.

Crocheting around the stocking:

Round 1. Ch 1, sc 3, sc inc 3, sc 9 along rows 1-9. Ch 1, sc 5 on the top of the stocking. Ch 1, sc 9 along rows 1-9. Sc 2 along rows 11-12. (Sc inc 1, sc 1) three times. Join the round with a sl st into the first sc.

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

RIBBING APPLIQUE

With your 3.5-mm hook and CA, ch 5.

Row 1. Sc in the second ch from your hook and in each ch across. (4 sts)

Row 2-8. Ch 1, turn. Sc in the BLO across. (4 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

FINISHING

Attach the two stocking appliques on your granny square.

Using a contrasting color yarn, embroider the heel, the toe, and the body of the stockings.

Attach the ribbing on one of the stockings.

With a length of yarn of the same color as the stocking appliques, embroider a hanging loop on top of both stockings.

Weave in all your ends.

Round 5. [CA] Ch 1, sc 2, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1. (dc 1, hdc 2, sc 3, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1) three times. Dc 1, hdc 2, sc 1. (13 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 6. [CA] Ch 2, dc 7. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1]. On the next side, dc 13) three times. [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1] into the last corner, dc 6. (15 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 7. [CA] Ch 2, dc 8. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 2, ch 1, dc 2]. On the next side, dc 15) three times. [Dc 2, ch 1, dc 2] into the last corner, dc 7. (19 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners)

Round 8. [CA] Ch 1, sc 10. (In the ch-1 corner, [sc 1, ch 1, sc 1]. On the next side, sc 19) three times. [Sc 1, ch 1, sc 1] into the last corner, sc 9. (21 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners).

Fasten off and weave in all your ends.



EYES & CHEEKS APPLIQUES

(Make 2 with CA and 2 with pink)

With your 3.5-mm hook and CA, make a MC.

Round 1. Sc 6 in the MC. Join the round with a sl st into the first st. (6 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

Gingerbread Man Granny Square

BOW TIE

With your 3.5-mm hook and red yarn, ch 7.

Row 1. Sc 1 in the second ch from your hook, sc in each remaining ch. (6 sts)

Row 2-4. Ch 1 and turn your work. Sc 6 in the BLO. (6 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.



The bow tie shown here was done with only 3 rows, like the green bow tie of the first gingerbread man in the previous page. The bow tie of the second gingerbread girl was done in 4 rows.

FINISHING

With a length of CA, embroider short lines between rounds 4 and 5 of the granny square.

Attach the eyes and the cheeks. Make sure that the cheeks are centered in the space between round 2 and 3 of the granny square.

With black yarn, embroider the pupils. Then, embroider the mouth following the spaces between rounds 2 and 3 of the granny square.

To obtain a nicer line, I suggest you make the mouth by surface crocheting on the wrong side of your granny square.

With a color of your choice, surface crochet a decorative line on your gingerbread man.

Attach your bow tie applique.

Weave in all your ends.

Round 5. [CC] Ch 1, sc 2, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1. (dc 1, hdc 2, sc 3, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1) three times. Dc 1, hdc 2, sc 1. (13 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 6. [CC] Ch 2, dc 7. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1]. On the next side, dc 13) three times. [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1] into the last corner, dc 6. (15 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 7. [CC] Ch 2, dc 8. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 2, ch 1, dc 2]. On the next side, dc 15) three times. [Dc 2, ch 1, dc 2] into the last corner, dc 7. (19 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners)

Round 8. [CC] Ch 1, sc 10. (In the ch-1 corner, [sc 1, ch 1, sc 1]. On the next side, sc 19) three times. [Sc 1, ch 1, sc 1] into the last corner, sc 9. (21 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners).

Fasten off and weave in all your ends.

GINGERBREAD HOUSE

With your 3.5-mm hook and CE, ch 13.

Row 1. Sc in the second ch from your hook and in each st till the end. (12 sts)

Row 2. Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 1, sc 11. (13 sts)

Row 3. Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 1, sc 12. (14 sts)

Row 4. Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 1, sc 13. (15 sts)

Row 5. Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 1, sc 14. (16 sts)



Row 6. Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 1, sc 15. (17 sts)

Row 7. Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 1, sc 16. (18 sts)

Row 8. Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 1, sc 17. (19 sts)

Row 9. Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 1, sc 18. (20 sts)

Row 10. Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 1, sc 19. (21 sts)

Row 11. Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 1, sc 20. (22 sts)

Row 12. Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 1, sc 21. (23 sts)

Row 13. Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 1, sc 22. (24 sts)

Row 14-15. Ch 1, turn. Sc 24. (24 sts)

Row 16. Ch 1, turn. Sc dec 1, sc 20, sc dec 1. (22 sts)

Row 17. Ch 1, turn. Sc dec 1, sc 18, sc dec 1. (20 sts)

Row 18. Ch 1, turn. Sc dec 1, sc 16, sc dec 1. (18 sts)

Row 19. Ch 1, turn. Sc dec 1, sc 14, sc dec 1. (16 sts)

Row 20. Ch 1, turn. Sc dec 1, sc 12, sc dec 1. (14 sts)

Row 21. Ch 1, turn. Sc dec 1, sc 10, sc dec 1. (12 sts)

Row 22. Ch 1, turn. Sc dec 1, sc 8, sc dec 1. (10 sts)

Row 23. Ch 1, turn. Sc dec 1, sc 6, sc dec 1. (8 sts)

Row 24. Ch 1, turn. Sc dec 1, sc 4, sc dec 1. (6 sts)

Row 25. Ch 1, turn. Sc dec 1, sc 2, sc dec 1. (4 sts)

Row 26. Ch 1, turn. Sc dec 2. (2 sts)

Row 27. Ch 1, turn. Sc dec 1. (1 st)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

ICE ON THE ROOF

Notes

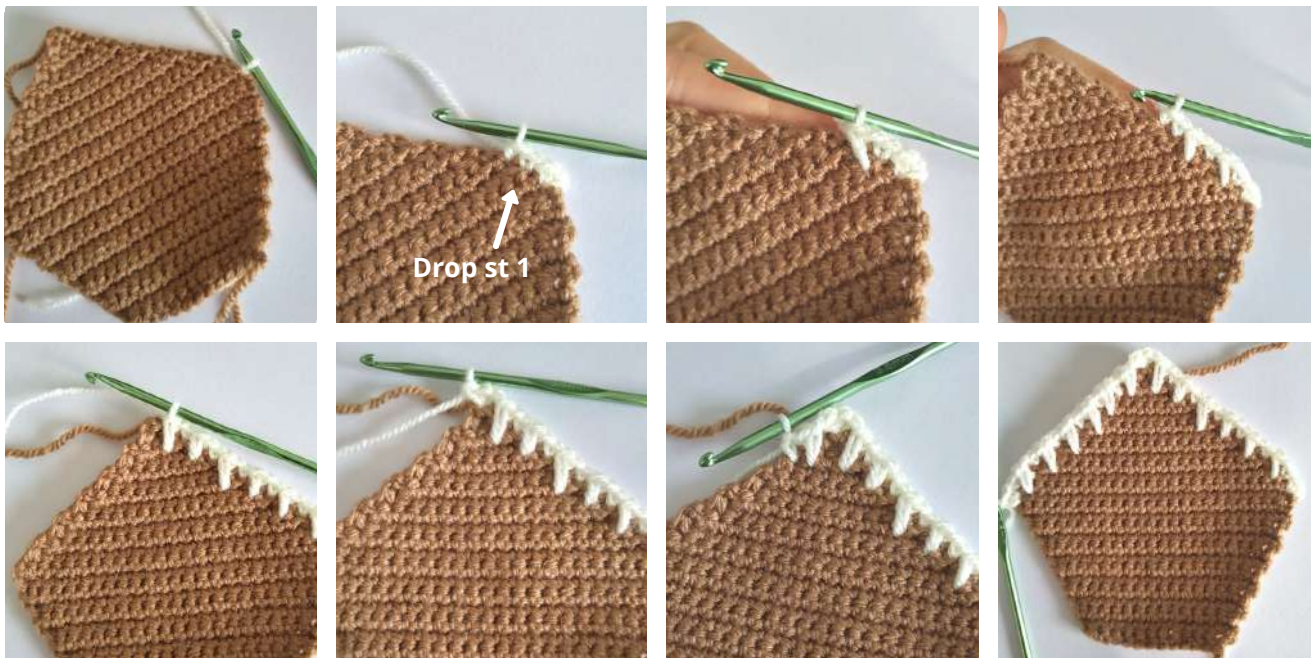
- Crochet the ice on one the sides of rows 14-27 of the gingerbread house applique.
- **Drop St:** Identify the st that corresponds to the next but is two (or three) rows below. Insert your hook into that st two (or three) rows below, yo, draw up a loop, yo, pull through both loops on your hook.
- On the first half of the roof, make your drop sts **two rows below**. On the second half of the roof, make your drop sts **three rows below**.
- On the left side of the roof (or right side if you are left-handed), pay extra attention not to miss any rows! The first sc after a drop st might be difficult to make because it goes in a row that is very well hidden by your drop st. So, move the drop st to the side with your fingers and make sure to make all your sc.

With your 3.5-mm hook, join CA on the side of row 14 of the gingerbread house applique.

Row 1.* Sc 2 on the side of row 14, sc 2, drop st 1. Without skipping the row behind the drop st, (sc 2, drop st 1) five more times. [Sc 3] in the st on row 27 of the gingerbread house. (Drop st 1, sc 2) six times. [Sc 2] on the side of row 14. (43 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing the roof on the granny square.

CANDY APPLIQUE

(Make 7)

With your 3.5-mm hook and color of choice, make a MC.

Round 1. Sc 6 in the MC. Join the round with a sl st into the first st. (6 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

WINDOW APPLIQUE

With your 3.5-mm hook and blue, ch 5.

Row 1. Sc in the second ch from your hook, sc 3. (4 sts)

Row 2-3. Ch 1, turn. Sc 4. (4 sts)

Without turning your work, crochet a border all around the window.

Border. Ch 1, sc 3 along the left side (if you are left-handed, that should be the right side), ch 1, sc 4 along the bottom, ch 1, sc 3 along the next side, ch 1, sc 4 on the top, sl st into the initial ch-1.

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

Alternatively, make one tiny star applique.

TINY STAR APPLIQUE

With your 3.5-mm crochet hook and color of your choice, make a MC.

Round 1. In MC, (sc 1, picot) five times. Join the round with a sl st into the first sc.

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.



DOOR APPLIQUE

With your 3.5-mm hook and CB, ch 22.

Row 1. Sc in the second ch from your hook, sc 6, (sc inc 1, sc 2) twice, sc inc 1, sc 7. (24 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

FINISHING

Attach the door, the candies, and the window appliques.

With a length of CA, embroider the door.

Weave in all your ends.

Your Gingerbread House Granny Square is ready!

SQUARE

With your 4-mm hook and CF, make a MC.

Round 1. [CF] Ch 2, hdc 11 in the MC. (11 sts)

Round 2. [CF] Ch 1, hdc inc 11. (22 sts)

Round 3. [CF] Ch 1, (hdc inc 1, hdc 1) 11 times. (33 sts)

Round 4. [CF] Ch 1, hdc 1, hdc inc 1, (hdc 2, hdc inc 1) 10 times, 1 hdc. Close the last st with CC. (44 sts)

Round 5. [CC] Ch 1, sc 2, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1. (dc 1, hdc 2, sc 3, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1) three times. Dc 1, hdc 2, sc 1. (13 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 6. [CC] Ch 2, dc 7. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1]. On the next side, dc 13) three times. [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1] into the last corner, dc 6. (15 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 7. [CC] Ch 2, dc 8. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 2, ch 1, dc 2]. On the next side, dc 15) three times. [Dc 2, ch 1, dc 2] into the last corner, dc 7. (19 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners)

Round 8. [CC] Ch 1, sc 10. (In the ch-1 corner, [sc 1, ch 1, sc 1]. On the next side, sc 19) three times. [Sc 1, ch 1, sc 1] into the last corner, sc 9. (21 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners).

Fasten off and weave in all your ends.



BRANDY SAUCE APPLIQUE

With your 4-mm hook and CA, ch 21.

Row 1. Sc 1 in the second ch from your hook, sc 15, sl st 4. (20 sts)

Row 2. Ch 1, turn. Sk 1, sl st 4. Ch 6, sc 1 in the second ch from your hook, sc 1, sl st 3.

Working on the sts from row 1, hdc 1, dc2tog 1.

Ch 4, sl st 1 in the second ch from your hook, sl st 2, sl st along the post of the last dc.

Working on the sts from row 1, dc2tog twice.

Ch 9, hdc 1 in the third ch from your hook, hdc 1, sc 2, sl st 3, sl st around the post of the last dc. Working on the sts from row 1, dc2tog twice.

Ch 5, sl st 1 in the second ch from your hook, sl st 3, sl st around the post of the last dc.

Working on the sts from row 1, sl st 1.

Leave the last three sts unworked.

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

pudding granny square

HOLLY LEAF APPLIQUE

(Make 2)

With your 3.5-mm hook and CD, ch 6.

Round 1. (Sl st 2, mini picot) twice. Sl st 1, ch 1. Start working on the other loops of the initial chain. Sl st 1, (mini picot, sl st 2) twice.

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

HOLLY DRUPE APPLIQUE

(Make 3)

With your 3.5-mm hook and CB, make a MC.

Round 1. Sc 3 in the MC. (3 sts)

Fasten off and join the round using a tapestry needle.

Cut your yarn leaving a long tail for sewing.

FINISHING

Sew the brandy sauce applique on top of your pudding making sure that the initial chain of the sauce applique follows the space between rounds 4 and 5 of the granny square.

Attach the holly leaf and drupe appliques.

Weave in all your ends.

Your Christmas Pudding Granny Square is ready!

Coffee Mug Granny Square

SQUARE

With your 4-mm hook and CB, make a MC.

Round 1. [CB] Ch 2, hdc 11 in the MC. (11 sts)

Round 2. [CB] Ch 1, hdc inc 11. (22 sts)

Round 3. [CB] Ch 1, (hdc inc 1, hdc 1) 11 times. (33 sts)

Round 4. [CB] Ch 1, hdc 1, hdc inc 1, (hdc 2, hdc inc 1) 10 times, 1 hdc. Close the last st with CA. (44 sts)

Round 5. [CA] Ch 1, sc 2, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1. (dc 1, hdc 2, sc 3, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1) three times. Dc 1, hdc 2, sc 1. (13 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 6. [CA] Ch 2, dc 7. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1]. On the next side, dc 13) three times. [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1] into the last corner, dc 6. (15 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 7. [CA] Ch 2, dc 8. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 2, ch 1, dc 2]. On the next side, dc 15) three times. [Dc 2, ch 1, dc 2] into the last corner, dc 7. (19 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners)

Round 8. [CA] Ch 1, sc 10. (In the ch-1 corner, [sc 1, ch 1, sc 1]. On the next side, sc 19) three times. [Sc 1, ch 1, sc 1] into the last corner, sc 9. (21 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners).

Fasten off and weave in all your ends.

CHOCOLATE STRAW

APPLIQUE

(Make Two)

With your 3.5-mm hook and CF, ch 8.

Row 1. Sc 1 in the second ch from your hook, sc 6. (7 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.



MUG DETAIL

With your 3.5-mm crochet hook and CB, ch 18.

Row 1. Sc in the second ch from your hook and in the remaining 16 ch.

Bind off leaving a long tail for sewing on the mug.

(Right Side Facing) With your 3.5-mm hook, join caramel yarn by making a sl st in the BLO of the third st from either end.

Row 2. (make all the sts in the BLO) [Caramel] Sc 1 in the next st, hdc 1, dc 1, dc2tog, dc1, dc2tog, dc 1, hdc 1, sc 1, sl st into the next st.

Row 3. (worked normally) [Caramel] Ch 1, turn your work. Sk the first st, sl st into the next sc, sc 1, hdc 5, sc 1, sl st into the next sc.

Fasten off leaving a long tail.

Coffee Mug Granny Square

MUG HANDLE APPLIQUE

With your 3.5-mm hook and CB, ch 9.

Row 1. [CB] Sc inc 1 in the second ch from your hook, sc inc 1, sc 4, sc inc 2. (12 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

For one Coffee Mug Granny Square, make one tiny fir applique or one heart applique.

TINY FIR APPLIQUE

With CA and your 3.5-mm crochet hook, ch 2.

Row 1. Sc 1 in the second ch from your hook. (1 st)

Row 2. Ch 1, turn. [Sc 3] all in the st from the previous row. (3 sts)

Row 3. Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 1, sc 2. (4 sts)

Row 4. Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 1, sc 3. (5 sts)

Row 5. Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 1, sc 4. (6 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail to sewing.

HEART APPLIQUE

With CA and your 3.5-mm crochet hook, make a MC.

Round 1. Ch 2, dc 3, hdc 1, ch 1, dc 1, ch 1, hdc 1, dc 3, ch 2, sl st into MC.

Fasten off leaving a long tail to sewing.



FINISHING

Attach the mug detail on the top half of the mug (rounds 1-4 of the granny square).

Let the mug detail bend so that you'll get a sort of 3D effect.

Also, make sure that you can still see some CB from round 4 on top of the applique.

Using CF, embroider little chocolate sprinkles on your coffee (a.k.a. rows 2 and 3 of your mug detail applique).

Attach the mug handle applique on one side of your mug.

Sew the two chocolate straws.

Decorate your mug with a tiny fir or heart applique.

Weave in all your ends.

SQUARE

With your 4-mm hook and CA, make a MC.

Round 1. [CA] Ch 2, hdc 11 in the MC. (11 sts)

Round 2. [CA] Ch 1, hdc inc 11. (22 sts)

Round 3. [CA] Ch 1, (hdc inc 1, hdc 1) 11 times. (33 sts)

Round 4. [CA] Ch 1, hdc 1, hdc inc 1, (hdc 2, hdc inc 1) 10 times, hdc 1. Close the last st with CC. (44 sts)

Round 5. [CC] Ch 1, sc 2, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1. (Dc 1, hdc 2, sc 3, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1) three times. Dc 1, hdc 2, sc 1. (13 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 6. [CC] Ch 2, dc 7. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1]. On the next side, dc 13) three times. [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1] into the last corner, dc 6. (15 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 7. [CC] Ch 2, dc 8. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 2, ch 1, dc 2]. On the next side, dc 15) three times. [Dc 2, ch 1, dc 2] into the last corner, dc 7. (19 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners)

Round 8. [CC] Ch 1, sc 10. (In the ch-1 corner, [sc 1, ch 1, sc 1]. On the next side, sc 19) three times. [Sc 1, ch 1, sc 1] into the last corner, sc 9. (21 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners).

Fasten off and weave in all your ends.

EYES & CHEEKS

(Make 2 with black yarn and 2 with pink)

With your 3.5-mm hook, make a MC.

Round 1. Sc 6 in the MC. Join the round with a sl st into the first st. (6 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.



HAT APPLIQUE

With your 3.5-mm hook and grey yarn, ch 11.

Row 1. Sc 1 in the second ch from your hook. Sc 9. (10 sts)

Row 2. Ch 1, turn. Sc 3, sc dec 2, sc 3. (8 sts)

Row 3-6. Ch 1, turn. Sc 8. (8 sts)

Row 7. Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 1, sc 6, sc inc 1. (10 sts)

Row 8. Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 1, sc 8, sc inc 1. (12 sts)

Row 9. Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 1, sc 10, sc inc 1. (14 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

HAT BAND

Using your 3.5-mm crochet hook and CB, ch 11.

Row 1. Sc in the second ch from your hook and in each remaining ch. (10 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

Snowman Granny Square

NOSE APPLIQUE

With your 3.5-mm hook and orange yarn, ch 6.

Row 1. Sl st 1 in the second ch from your hook, sl st 1, sc 3. (5 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

SCARF APPLIQUE

With your 3.5-mm hook and CB, ch 22.

Row 1. Dc 1 in the third ch from your hook. Dc 18. In the last ch, [dc 1, ch 2, sl st 1]. (20 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

FINISHING

Attach the hat applique on the snowman.

Add the hat band between rows 6 and 7 of the hat applique.

Place the black eyes between rounds 2 and 3 of the granny square at approximately half of the height of the square.

With a length of CA, embroider the pupils.

Sew the cheeks on round 5 of the granny square just below the eyes.

Attach the nose applique in between the cheeks. Make sure to sew the larger part in the middle of the face and the thinner part of the nose pointing outwards.

With a length of black yarn, embroider the mouth following the spaces between rounds 3 and 4 of the granny square.

Attach the scarf below the snowman by modeling it the way you prefer.

Using a length of CA, embroider a pompom at one or both ends of the scarf.

Weave in all your ends.

Your Snowman Granny Square is ready!

Bear Granny Square

SQUARE

With your 4-mm hook and CA, make a MC.

Round 1. [CA] Ch 2, hdc 11 in the MC. (11 sts)

Round 2. [CA] Ch 1, hdc inc 11. (22 sts)

Round 3. [CA] Ch 1, (hdc inc 1, hdc 1) 11 times. (33 sts)

Round 4. [CA] Ch 1, hdc 1, hdc inc 1, (hdc 2, hdc inc 1) 10 times, hdc 1. Close the last st with CC. (44 sts)

Round 5. [CC] Ch 1, sc 2, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1. (Dc 1, hdc 2, sc 3, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1) three times. Dc 1, hdc 2, sc 1. (13 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 6. [CC] Ch 2, dc 7. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1]. On the next side, dc 13) three times. [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1] into the last corner, dc 6. (15 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 7. [CC] Ch 2, dc 8. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 2, ch 1, dc 2]. On the next side, dc 15) three times. [Dc 2, ch 1, dc 2] into the last corner, dc 7. (19 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners)

Round 8. [CC] Ch 1, sc 10. (In the ch-1 corner, [sc 1, ch 1, sc 1]. On the next side, sc 19) three times. [Sc 1, ch 1, sc 1] into the last corner, sc 9. (21 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners).

Fasten off and weave in all your ends.

MUZZLE APPLIQUE

With your 3.5-mm hook and grey yarn, make a MC.

Round 1. Dc 12 in the MC. Join the round with a sl st into the first st. (12 sts)

Round 2. Ch 1, sc 1, sc inc 1, sc 1, hdc inc 1, dc inc 6, hdc inc 1, sc inc 1. (22 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.



HAT APPLIQUE

With your 3.5-mm hook and blue yarn, ch 4.

Brim

Row 1. Sc in the second ch from your hook. Sc 2. (3 sts)

Row 2-8. Ch 1, turn. Sc 3 in the BLO. (3 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

Body

Work the body of the hat along the long side of the brim.

With your 3.5-mm hook, join CB on the side of row 1 of the brim.

Row 1. Sc 1 on the side of each row of the brim. (8 sts)

Row 2. Ch 1, turn. Sc 8. (8 sts)

Row 3. Ch 1, turn. Sc dec 1, sc 4, sc dec 1. (6 sts)

Row 4. Ch 1, turn. Sc dec 1, sc 2, sc dec 1. (4 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

Bear Granny Square

EYES, NOSE, INNER EARS, AND POMPOMS

(Make 3 with black yarn, 2 with grey, and 3 with blue)

With your 3.5-mm hook, make a MC.

Round 1. Sc 6 in the MC. Join the round with a sl st into the first st. (6 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

EAR APPLIQUES

(Make 2)

With your 3.5-mm hook and CA, make a MC.

Round 1. Sc 6 in the MC. Join the round with a sl st into the first st. (6 sts)

Round 2. Ch 1, sc inc 6. (12 sts)

Round 3. Ch 1, sc 11. Leave the last st unworked. (11 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

Assembling

Sew one inner ear applique (in grey yarn) in the center of each ear applique.

Fasten off and weave in the grey ends.

SCARF APPLIQUE

With your 3.5-mm hook and CB, ch 22.

Row 1. Dc 1 in the third ch from your hook. Dc 18. In the last ch, [dc 1, ch 2, sl st 1]. (20 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

FINISHING

Start by attaching the ears on the sides of the head, just outside of round 4 of the granny square.

Place the hat in between the ears and sew one blue pompom on the top.

Attach the muzzle in the bottom half of the face (rounds 1-5). Make sure that the sc sts of round 2 of the muzzle are on top and the dc increases are on the bottom.

Attach the black nose applique in the center, top of the muzzle.

With a length of black yarn (or the tail of the nose applique if long enough), embroider a vertical line in the center of the muzzle. Then, embroider the mouth.

Attach the black eye appliques just above the muzzle.

With a length of CA, embroider the pupils.

Attach the scarf below the bear by modeling it the way you prefer. Attach one blue pompom at each end of the scarf.

Weave in all your ends.

Your Bear Granny Square is ready!

Penguin Granny Square

SQUARE

Note. Work rounds 1-4 in tapestry crochet. So, carry the non-working yarn inside your stitches!

With your 4-mm hook and grey yarn, make a MC.

Round 1. [Grey] Ch 2, hdc 3, [CA] hdc 5, [Grey] hdc 3 in the MC. (11 sts)

Round 2. [Grey] Ch 1, hdc inc 3, [Grey/CA] hdc inc 1, [CA] hdc inc 5, [Grey] hdc inc 2. (22 sts)

Round 3. [Grey] Ch 1, (hdc inc 1, hdc 1) 4 times. [CA] (hdc inc 1, hdc 1) 5 times, [CA/Grey] hdc inc 1. [Grey] hdc 1, hdc inc 1, hdc 1. (33 sts)

Round 4. [Grey] Ch 1, hdc 1, hdc inc 1, (hdc 2, hdc inc 1) 3 times, hdc 2. [CA] (hdc inc 1, hdc 2) 5 times. [CA/Grey] hdc inc 1. [Grey] Hdc 2, hdc inc 1, hdc 1. Close the last st with CC. (44 sts)

Round 5. [CC] Ch 2, dc inc 1, dc 1, hdc 2, sc 3, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1. (Dc 1, hdc 2, sc 3, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1) twice. Dc 1, hdc 2, sc 3, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2. Sl st into the first dc. (13 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 6. [CC] Ch 2, (dc 13. In the ch-2 corner, [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1]. four times. (15 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 7. [CC] Ch 2, dc 14. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 2, ch 1, dc 2]. On the next side, dc 15) three times. [Dc 2, ch 1, dc 2] into the last corner, dc 1. (19 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners)

Round 8. [CC] Ch 1, sc 16. (In the ch-1 corner, [sc 1, ch 1, sc 1]. On the next side, sc 19) three times. [Sc 1, ch 1, sc 1] into the last corner, sc 3. (21 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners).

Fasten off and weave in all your ends.



BEAK APPLIQUE

With your 3.5-mm hook and orange yarn, make a MC.

Round 1. In the MC, ch 1, sc 1, (hdc 1, dc 1, hdc 1, sc 1) twice, hdc 1, dc 1, hdc 1, join with a sl st into the first sc. (12 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

SCARF APPLIQUE

(The pattern is written for a scarf only made in CB. For a scarf like the one shown in the picture, alternate 2 sts with CB and 2 sts with CA)

With your 3.5-mm hook and CB, ch 22.

Row 1. Dc 1 in the third ch from your hook. Dc 18. In the last ch, [dc 1, ch 2, sl st 1]. (20 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

Penguin Granny Square

INNER EYES, CHEEKS, AND POMPOMS

(Make 2 with black yarn, 2 with pink, and 2 with CA)

With your 3.5-mm hook, make a MC.

Round 1. Sc 6 in the MC. Join the round with a sl st into the first st. (6 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

OUTER EYES

(Make 2)

With your 4-mm hook and CA, make a MC.

Round 1. Ch 2, dc 12 in the MC. Join the round with a sl st into the first st. (12 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

EAR WARMER APPLIQUE

With your 3.5-mm hook and CB, ch 32.

Row 1. Hdc 1 in the third ch from your hook, hdc 3, ch 1, sl st 22, ch 1, hdc 3. In the last ch, [hdc 1, ch 2, sl st 1]. (30 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

FINISHING

Attach the outer eyes on the grey side of the penguin (rounds 1-4 of the granny square) making sure that the bottom of the eyes is just a little below the grey/CA color change line.

Also, make sure that the two appliques touch each other.

Attach the black eye appliques on top of the outer eyes and with a length of CA, embroider the pupils.

Sew the nose applique in the middle, just below the eyes.

Attach the pink cheeks.

Sew the ear warmer applique above the penguin between rounds 5 and 6 of the granny square.

Sew the scarf below the penguin by modeling it the way you prefer. Attach one pompom in CA at each end of the scarf.

Weave in all your ends.

Your Penguin Granny Square is ready!

North Pole Granny Square

SQUARE

With your 4-mm hook and CC, make a MC.

Round 1. [CC] Ch 2, hdc 11 in the MC. (11 sts)

Round 2. [CC] Ch 1, hdc inc 11. (22 sts)

Round 3. [CC] Ch 1, (hdc inc 1, hdc 1) 11 times. (33 sts)

Round 4. [CC] Ch 1, hdc 1, hdc inc 1, (hdc 2, hdc inc 1) 10 times, hdc 1. (44 sts)

Round 5. [CC] Ch 1, sc 2, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1. (Dc 1, hdc 2, sc 3, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1) three times. Dc 1, hdc 2, sc 1. (13 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 6. [CC] Ch 2, dc 7. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1]. On the next side, dc 13) three times. [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1] into the last corner, dc 6. (15 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 7. [CC] Ch 2, dc 8. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 2, ch 1, dc 2]. On the next side, dc 15) three times. [Dc 2, ch 1, dc 2] into the last corner, dc 7. (19 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners)

Round 8. [CC] Ch 1, sc 10. (In the ch-1 corner, [sc 1, ch 1, sc 1]. On the next side, sc 19) three times. [Sc 1, ch 1, sc 1] into the last corner, sc 9. (21 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners).

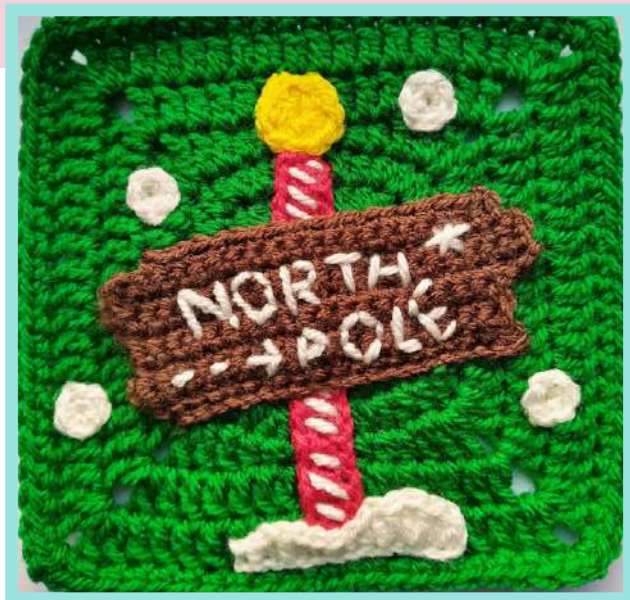

With your 3.5-mm hook and CA, ch 14.

Row 1. Sc in the second ch from your hook. Hdc 1, dc inc 2, hdc 1, sc 3, hdc 1, dc 1, hdc 1, sc 1, sl st 1. (15 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.



WOODEN SIGN APPLIQUE

With your 3.5-mm hook and CF, ch 21.

Row 1. Sc in the second ch from your hook. Sc 19. (20 sts)

Row 2. Ch 2, turn. Sc 1 in the second ch from your hook, sc 19. Leave last st unworked. (20 sts)

Row 3-4. Ch 1, turn. Sc 19. (19 sts)

Row 5. Ch 3, turn. Sc 1 in the second ch from your hook, sc 20. (21 sts)

Row 6. Ch 2, turn. Sc 1 in the second ch from your hook, sc 21. (22 sts)

Row 7. Ch 1, turn. Sc 22. (22 sts)

Row 8. Ch 1, turn. Sl st 1, sc 20. Leave last st unworked. (21 sts)

Row 9. Ch 1, turn. Sl st 1, sc 18. Leave last two sts unworked. (19 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

POLE APPLIQUE

With your 3.5-mm hook and CB, ch 23.

Row 1. Sc in the second ch from your hook. Sc 21. (22 sts)

Row 2. Ch 1, turn. Sc 22. (22 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

North Pole Granny Square

LIGHT BULB APPLIQUE

With your 3.5-mm hook and yellow yarn, make a MC.

Round 1. Ch 1, hdc 11 in the MC. Join the round with a sl st into the first st. (11 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

SNOWFLAKE APPLIQUE

(Make 4 or more)

With your 3.5-mm hook and CA, make a MC.

Round 1. Sc 6 in the MC. Join the round with a sl st into the first st. (6 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

FINISHING

Attach the pole applique. Place the base of the pole in the middle of Round 7 of the granny square. Make sure that the applique is vertically centered.

With a length of CA, embroider diagonal lines along the pole.

Sew the light bulb applique on top of the pole.

Place the snow pile applique between Rounds 7 and 8 of the granny square, covering the first st of the pole applique.

Using a length of CA, embroider the wooden sign applique. Weave in the CA ends.

With the long CF tail, sew the wooden sign applique on the granny square.

Attach the snowflake appliques.

Weave in all your ends.

Your North Pole Granny Square is ready!

Santa Claus Granny Square

SQUARE

With your 4-mm hook and vintage pink, make a MC.

Round 1. [V. Pink] Ch 2, hdc 11 in the MC. (11 sts)

Round 2. [V. Pink] Ch 1, hdc inc 11. (22 sts)

Round 3. [V. Pink] Ch 1, (hdc inc 1, hdc 1) 11 times. (33 sts)

Round 4. [V. Pink] Ch 1, hdc 1, hdc inc 1, (hdc 2, hdc inc 1) 10 times, hdc 1. Close the last st with CC. (44 sts)

Round 5. [CC] Ch 1, sc 2, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1. (Dc 1, hdc 2, sc 3, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1) three times. Dc 1, hdc 2, sc 1. (13 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 6. [CC] Ch 2, dc 7. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1]. On the next side, dc 13) three times. [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1] into the last corner, dc 6. (15 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 7. [CC] Ch 2, dc 8. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 2, ch 1, dc 2]. On the next side, dc 15) three times. [Dc 2, ch 1, dc 2] into the last corner, dc 7. (19 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners)

Round 8. [CC] Ch 1, sc 10. (In the ch-1 corner, [sc 1, ch 1, sc 1]. On the next side, sc 19) three times. [Sc 1, ch 1, sc 1] into the last corner, sc 9. (21 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners).

Fasten off and weave in all your ends.

HAT BRIM APPLIQUE

With your 3.5-mm hook and CA, ch 18.

Row 1. Dc 1 in the third ch from your hook. Dc 14, In the last ch, [dc 1, ch 2, sl st]. (16 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.



HAT APPLIQUE

With your 3.5-mm hook and CB, ch 18.

Row 1. Dc 1 in the third ch from your hook. Dc 15. (16 sts)

Row 2. Ch 10, turn. Working on the 10 ch you just made, sc 1 in the second ch from your hook, sc 2, hdc 2, hdc inc 1, dc 3.

Working on the sts from Row 1, dc inc 5, dc 2, dc inc 1, dc 2, dc inc 2, dc 1, hdc 1, sc 1, sl st. (34 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

EYES, NOSE, & POMPOM

(Make 3 with CA and 1 with CB)

With your 3.5-mm hook, make a MC.

Round 1. Sc 6 in the MC. Join the round with a sl st into the first st. (6 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

Santa Claus Granny Square

BEARD APPLIQUE

With your 3.5-mm hook and CA, ch 26.

Row 1. Sc 1 in the second ch from your hook, sc 3, hdc 3, dc inc 1, (dc 4, dc inc 1) twice, hdc 3, sc 4. (28 sts)

Fasten off.

With the right side facing up, hold your work so that the two ends of yarn are on your left (if you are left-handed, the two ends of yarn will be on your right).

Join CA in the first hdc st of row 1.

Row 2. Sc 1 in the second hdc from row 1. In the next st, [sc 1, hdc 1]. Dc inc 1, dc 2, dc inc 1, dc 6, dc inc 1, dc 2, dc inc 1, [hdc 1, sc 1] in the next st, sc 1, sl st 1. (25 sts)

Fasten off.

Holding your work with the right side up, join CA in the first dc of row 2.

Row 3. Sl st 1 in the next dc. Sc 1, hdc 1, dc 4, tr inc 1, picot 1, dc inc 1, dc 4, hdc 1, sc 1, sl st 2. (20 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

MOUSTACHE APPLIQUE

With your 3.5-mm hook and CA, ch 12.

Row 1. Sc 1 in the second ch from your hook. Hdc 1, dc 2, sc 1, sl st 1, sc 1, dc 2, hdc 1. In the last ch, [sc 1, ch 1, sl st 1]. (11 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

FINISHING

First, attach the beard applique. Then, model the moustache applique by bending it in the center and sew it so that it partly covers the top row of the beard.

Place the nose applique (in CB) in the center of the moustache and attach the eyes just above the nose.

Attach the hat applique and then the brim applique. Make sure to slightly curve the brim so that it touches the beginning of the beard on both sides.



With a length of black yarn, embroider the pupils and the mouth.

Using some CA, embroider the eyebrows.

Weave in all your ends.

With your 4-mm hook and Vintage Pink yarn, make a MC.

Round 1. [V. Pink] Ch 2, hdc 11 in the MC. (11 sts)

Round 3. [V. Pink] Ch 1, (hdc inc 1, hdc 1) 11 times. (33 sts)

Round 4. [V. Pink] Ch 1, hdc 1, hdc inc 1, (hdc 2, hdc inc 1) 10 times, hdc 1. Close the last st with CA. (44 sts)

Round 5. [CA] Ch 1, sc 2, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1. (Dc 1, hdc 2, sc 3, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1) three times. Dc 1, hdc 2, sc 1. (13 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 6. [CA] Ch 2, dc 7. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1]. On the next side, dc 13) three times. [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1] into the last corner, dc 6. (15 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 7. [CA] Ch 2, dc 8. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 2, ch 1, dc 2]. On the next side, dc 15) three times. [Dc 2, ch 1, dc 2] into the last corner, dc 7. (19 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners)

Round 8. [CA] Ch 1, sc 10. (In the ch-1 corner, [sc 1, ch 1, sc 1]. On the next side, sc 19) three times. [Sc 1, ch 1, sc 1] into the last corner, sc 9. (21 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners).

Fasten off and weave in all your ends.

BUN APPLIQUE

With your 4-mm hook and grey yarn, make a MC.

Round 1. Ch 2, dc 8, hdc 4 in the MC. Sl st to join the round.

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.



HAIR APPLIQUES

Smaller Half

With your 3.5-mm hook and grey yarn, ch 7.

Round 1. Sc 1 in the second ch from your hook. hdc 1, dc 2, hdc 1, sc 1, ch 1. Start working on the other loops of the initial ch. Sc 6, ch 1. Sl st into the first sc to close the round.

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

Bigger Half

With your 3.5-mm hook and grey yarn, ch 7.

Round 1. Sc 1 in the second ch from your hook. hdc 1, dc 2, hdc 1, sc 1, ch 1. Start working on the other loops of the initial ch. Sc 1, hdc 1, dc 2, hdc 1, sc 1, ch 1. Sl st into the first sc to close the round.

Round 2. Ch 1, hdc 1, hdc inc 4, [dc 4] in the next st. Ch 1, hdc 2 along the post of the last dc. Hdc 1 in the same st where you made the 4 dc sts. Sk the ch-1 space, sl st 3, sc inc 3. In the next ch-1 space, [sc 1, ch 1, sc 1]. Sl st into the first hdc to join the round.

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

Grandma Claus Granny Square

EYES & CHEEKS

(Make 2 with CA and 2 with pink yarn)

With your 3.5-mm hook, make a MC.

Round 1. Sc 6 in the MC. Join the round with a sl st into the first st. (6 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

HAIR TIE APPLIQUE

With your 3.5-mm hook and CB, ch 7.

Row 1. Sc 1 in the second ch from your hook, sc 5. (6 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

FINISHING

Start by placing the hair appliques on the top half of head (Rounds 1-4 of the granny square).

- Attach the smaller half on the right of the head with the side made of sc sts on the bottom.
- Attach the bigger half on the left with the 4-dc tip on the bottom.
- Place the bun applique in the middle just above Round 4 of the granny square with the 4 hdc toward the bottom. Try not to leave any gaps between the bun and the hair appliques.
- Sew the hair tie applique between the bun and the hair appliques.

Place the eyes and cheeks appliques.

With a length of black yarn, embroider the pupils and the mouth.

Weave in all your ends.

Round 1. [CA] Ch 2, hdc 11 in the MC. (11 sts)

Round 4. [CA] Ch 1, hdc 1, hdc inc 1, (hdc 2, hdc inc 1) 10 times, hdc 1. (44 sts)

Round 5. [CA] Ch 1, sc 2, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1. (Dc 1, hdc 2, sc 3, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1) three times. Dc 1, hdc 2, sc 1. (13 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 6. [CA] Ch 2, dc 7. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1]. On the next side, dc 13) three times. [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1] into the last corner, dc 6. (15 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 7. [CA] Ch 2, dc 8. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 2, ch 1, dc 2]. On the next side, dc 15) three times. [Dc 2, ch 1, dc 2] into the last corner, dc 7. (19 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners)

Round 8. [CA] Ch 1, sc 10. (In the ch-1 corner, [sc 1, ch 1, sc 1]. On the next side, sc 19) three times. [Sc 1, ch 1, sc 1] into the last corner, sc 9. (21 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners).

Fasten off and weave in all your ends.

PRESENT 1 APPLIQUE

With your 3.5-mm hook and blue yarn, ch 8.

Row 1. Sc 1 in the second ch from your hook. Sc 6. (7 sts)

Row 2-6. Ch 1, turn. Sc 7. (7 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.



PRESENT 2 APPLIQUE

With your 3.5-mm hook and CB, ch 11.

Row 1. Sc 1 in the second ch from your hook. Sc 9. (10 sts)

Row 2-4. Ch 1, turn. Sc 10. (10 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

PRESENT 3 APPLIQUE

With your 3.5-mm hook and orange yarn, ch 11.

Row 1. Sc in the second ch from your hook, sc 9. (10 sts)

Row 2-3. Ch 1, turn. Sc 10. (10 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

Join yellow yarn in the BLO of the second st from either end of row 3.

Row 4. Sc 8 in the BLO. Leave the last st unworked. (8 sts)

Row 5. Ch 1, turn. Sc 8. (8 sts)

Row 6. Ch 1, turn. Sc dec 1, sc 6. (7 sts)

Row 7-8. Ch 1, turn. Sc 7. (7 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

Presents Granny Square

PRESENT 4 APPLIQUE

With your 3.5-mm hook and CC, ch 19.

Row 1. Sc in the second ch from your hook, sc 17. (18 sts)

Row 2. Ch 1, turn. Sc 18. (18 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

Join CD in the BLO of the second st from either end of row 2.

Row 3. Sc 16 in the BLO. Leave the last st unworked. (16 sts)

Row 4-5. Ch 1, turn. Sc 16. (16 sts)

Row 6. Ch 1, turn. Sc dec 1, sc 14. (15 sts)

Row 7. Ch 1, turn. Sc dec 1, sc 13. (14 sts)

Row 8. Ch 1, turn. Sc 14. (14 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

FINISHING

Attach your present appliques on the granny square and decorate them with little ribbons and bows.

Weave in all your ends.

Round 3. [Skin C.] Ch 1, (hdc inc 1, hdc 1) 11 times. (33 sts)

Round 4. [Skin C.] Ch 1, hdc 1, hdc inc 1, (hdc 2, hdc inc 1) 10 times, hdc 1. Close the last st with CA. (44 sts)

Round 5. [CA] Ch 1, sc 2, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1. (Dc 1, hdc 2, sc 3, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1) three times. Dc 1, hdc 2, sc 1. (13 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 6. [CA] Ch 2, dc 7. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1]. On the next side, dc 13) three times. [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1] into the last corner, dc 6. (15 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 7. [CA] Ch 2, dc 8. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 2, ch 1, dc 2]. On the next side, dc 15) three times. [Dc 2, ch 1, dc 2] into the last corner, dc 7. (19 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners)

Round 8. [CA] Ch 1, sc 10. (In the ch-1 corner, [sc 1, ch 1, sc 1]. On the next side, sc 19) three times. [Sc 1, ch 1, sc 1] into the last corner, sc 9. (21 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners).

Fasten off and weave in all your ends.

EARS

Crochet the ears by working around the post of the indicated sts on round 4 of the granny square.

Right Ear

With your 3.5-mm hook, join Skin C. around the post of the 10th st.



Row 1. [Picot 1, hdc 1] around the post of the same st where you joined, [sc 1, sl st 1] around the post of the next st (11th st).

Fasten off.

Bring the tails to the back of your work and weave in your ends.

Left Ear

With your 3.5-mm hook, join Skin C. around the post of the 34th st.

Row 1. Sc around the post of the same st. [Hdc 1, picot 1, sl st 1] around the post of the next st.

Fasten off.

HAT APPLIQUE

With your 3.5-mm hook and CB, ch 2.

Row 1. Sc inc 1 in the first ch. (2 sts)

Row 2. Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 2. (4 sts)

Row 3. Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 1, sc 2, sc inc 1. (6 sts)

Row 4. Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 1, sc 4, sc inc 1. (8 sts)

Row 5. Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 1, sc 6, sc inc 1. (10 sts)

Row 6. Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 1, sc 8, sc inc 1. (12 sts)

Row 7. Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 1, sc 10, sc inc 1. (14 sts)

Do not fasten off.

Border

Without turning your work, crochet the border along the sides of rows 1-7.

Row 8. Ch 1, (sc inc 1, sc 1) three times. Sc inc 1 on the side of row 1, ch 1, sc inc 1 on the other side of row 1. (Sc 1, sc inc 1) three times.

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

HAT BRIM APPLIQUE

With your 3.5-mm hook and CC, ch 17.

Row 1. Sc 1 in the second ch from your hook, sc 15. (16 sts)

Row 2. Ch 1, turn. (Sc 1, hdc 1, [dc 1, ch 2, sl st] all in the next st, sl st 1) four times.

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

EYES & CHEEKS

(Make 2 with CA and 2 with pink yarn)

With your 3.5-mm hook, make a MC.

Round 1. Sc 6 in the MC. Join the round with a sl st into the first st. (6 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

HAIR APPLIQUE

Option 1

With your 3.5-mm hook and hair color of your choice, ch 12.

Row 1. Sc 1 in the second ch from your hook, sc 10. (11 sts)

Row 2. Ch 1, turn. Sc 8. Leave the last 3 sts unworked. (8 sts)

Row 3. Ch 1, turn. Sl st 4, sc 1, hdc 1, sl st 2.

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

Option 2

(It does not include the pigtails)

With your 3.5-mm hook and hair color of your choice, ch 12.

Row 1. Sc 1 in the second ch from your hook. Sc 1. (Ch 5, [sc 3] in the second ch from your hook, [sc 3] in each of the next 3 ch. Working on the initial ch, sc 2) seven times. Working on the initial ch, sc 2. (7 curls and 16 sc)

Round 4. [CF] Ch 1, (hdc inc 1, hdc 2) twice, hdc inc 1, hdc 1. [CE] Hdc 1, (hdc inc 1, hdc 2) eight times. Close the last st with CA. (44 sts)

Round 5. [CA] Ch 2, dc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1, (dc 1, hdc 2, sc 3, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1) three times. Dc 1, hdc 2, sc 3, hdc 2, dc 1, dc 1 in the first st. (13 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 6. [CA] Ch 2, dc 1. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1]. On the next side, dc 13) three times. [Dc 1, ch 2, dc 1] into the last corner, dc 12. (15 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 7. [CA] Ch 2, dc 2. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 2, ch 1, dc 2]. On the next side, dc 15) three times. [Dc 2, ch 1, dc 2] into the last corner, dc 13. (19 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners)

Round 8. [CA] Ch 1, sc 4. (In the ch-1 corner, [sc 1, ch 1, sc 1]. On the next side, sc 19) three times. [Sc 1, ch 1, sc 1] into the last corner, sc 15. (21 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners).

Fasten off and weave in all your ends.



NOSE

With your 3.5-mm hook and CB, make a MC.

Round 1. Hdc 11 in the MC. Join the round with a sl st into the first st.

Fasten off leaving a long tails for sewing.

ANTLERS

With your 3.5-mm crochet hook and CF, ch 6.

Row 1. Sl st 1 in the second ch from your hook, sl st 1. (Ch 3, sl st in the second ch from your hook, sl st 1. Sl st into the ch where you made the second sl st of the row) twice. Sl st 3 into the the remaining chains.

Fasten off leaving a long tails for sewing.

CHEEKS

With your 3.5-mm hook and pink yarn, make a MC.

Round 1. Sc 6 in the MC. Join the round with a sl st into the first st.

Fasten off leaving a long tails for sewing.

Reindeer Granny Square

EARS

(Right Side Facing)

Using your 3.5-mm hook, join CE around the post of the last st in CF of round 4 for the right ear, or around the initial ch 1 of round 4 for the left ear.

Ch 4.

Row 1. Sc in the second ch from your hook, hdc 2. Sl st around the post of the next st on round 4 of the granny square.

Fasten off and weave in your ends.

FINISHING

Using CA, embroider the spots on the forehead of the reindeer.

Attach the nose just below the center of the granny square.

Sew the cheeks on the sides of the nose.

Sew the antlers on top of the head in between the ears.

Using a length of black yarn, embroider the eyes and the mouth.

Weave in all your ends.

SQUARE

With your 4-mm hook and CC, make a MC.

Round 1. [CC] Ch 2, hdc 11 in the MC. (11 sts)

Round 2. [CC] Ch 1, hdc inc 11. (22 sts)

Round 3. [CC] Ch 1, (hdc inc 1, hdc 1) 11 times. (33 sts)

Round 4. [CC] Ch 1, hdc 1, hdc inc 1, (hdc 2, hdc inc 1) 10 times, hdc 1. (44 sts)

Round 5. [CC] Ch 1, sc 2, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1. (Dc 1, hdc 2, sc 3, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1) three times. Dc 1, hdc 2, sc 1. (13 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 6. [CC] Ch 2, dc 7. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1]. On the next side, dc 13) three times. [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1] into the last corner, dc 6. (15 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 7. [CC] Ch 2, dc 8. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 2, ch 1, dc 2]. On the next side, dc 15) three times. [Dc 2, ch 1, dc 2] into the last corner, dc 7. (19 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners)

Round 8. [CC] Ch 1, sc 10. (In the ch-1 corner, [sc 1, ch 1, sc 1]. On the next side, sc 19) three times. [Sc 1, ch 1, sc 1] into the last corner, sc 9. (21 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners).

Fasten off and weave in all your ends.

BOW APPLIQUE

With your 3.5-mm hook and CB, ch 52.

Row 1. Dc 1 in the third ch from your hook, dc 1, hdc 1, sc 2, sl st 5, sc 2, hdc 2, dc 2, tr 4, dc 3, hdc 1, sc 2, hdc 1, dc 3, tr 4, dc 2, hdc 2, sc 2, sl st 5, sc 2, hdc 1, dc 2. Ch 2, sl st into the initial ch.

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.



BELL APPLIQUE

(Make 2)

With your 3.5-mm hook and yellow yarn, make a MC.

Round 1. Ch 2, dc 12 in the MC. Sl st into the first st to join the round. (12 sts)

Round 2. Ch 2, dc inc 12. Join with a sl st. (24 sts)

Round 3. Ch 1, sc inc 8, hdc 1, [dc 1, tr 1] in the next st. Ch 1. On the side of the tr, sc 1, hdc 1. Hdc inc 1, sc 4, hdc inc 1. In the next st, [tr 1, dc 1]. Ch 1, sl st along the post of the last dc. Hdc inc 1 in the next st, sc 1, sc inc 5. Join the round with a sl st. (45 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

Join grey yarn in the BLO of the second sc of the four on the bottom. Work all the sts of Row 1 in the BLO.

Row 1. Ch 1, [sc 1, hdc 1] in the same st where you joined, [hdc 1, sc 1, sl st 1] in the next st. (5 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

Bells Granny Square

FINISHING

Assemble the bow. Place it with the right side facing up and fold the two sides backward toward the center.

Cut a length of CB yarn, fold it in two, and pass it through the center of the bow to block it.



Sew the two bell appliques in the center of your granny square, slightly overlapping at the top.

Attach your bow on top of the bells in the middle.

Round 3. [Caramel] Ch 1, (hdc inc 1, hdc 1) 11 times. Close the last st with CF. (33 sts)

Round 4. [CF] Ch 1, hdc 1, hdc inc 1, (hdc 2, hdc inc 1) 10 times, hdc 1. Close the last st with CC. (44 sts)

Round 5. [CC] Ch 1, sc 2, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1. (Dc 1, hdc 2, sc 3, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1) three times. Dc 1, hdc 2, sc 1. (13 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 6. [CC] Ch 2, dc 7. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1]. On the next side, dc 13) three times. [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1] into the last corner, dc 6. (15 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 7. [CC] Ch 2, dc 8. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 2, ch 1, dc 2]. On the next side, dc 15) three times. [Dc 2, ch 1, dc 2] into the last corner, dc 7. (19 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners)

Round 8. [CC] Ch 1, sc 10. (In the ch-1 corner, [sc 1, ch 1, sc 1]. On the next side, sc 19) three times. [Sc 1, ch 1, sc 1] into the last corner, sc 9. (21 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners).

Fasten off and weave in all your ends.



SPINES

With your 4-mm hook, join CF around the post of the fifth st of round 4 of the granny square.

Row 1. Working around the post of the next st (st 6 of round 4), [sl st 1, picot 1, sl st 1]. Sl st 1 around the posts of each of the next 2 sts. ([Sl st 1, picot 1, sl st 1], sl st 2) 10 times. [Sl st 1, picot 1, sl st 1], sl st 1.

Fasten off and weave in your ends.



Hedgehog Granny Square

NOSE APPLIQUE

With your 3.5-mm hook and black yarn, make a MC.

Round 1. Ch 1, sc 1, hdc 1, sc 2, hdc 1, sc 1. Sl st into the first st to join the round. (6 sts).

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

SCARF APPLIQUE

(The pattern is written for a scarf only made in CB. For a scarf like the one shown in the picture, alternate 2 sts with CB and 2 sts with CC)

With your 3.5-mm hook and CB, ch 22.

Row 1. Dc 1 in the third ch from your hook. Dc 18. In the last ch, [dc 1, ch 2, sl st 1]. (20 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

EAR WARMER APPLIQUE

With your 3.5-mm hook and CB, ch 32.

Row 1. Hdc 1 in the third ch from your hook, hdc 3, ch 1, sl st 22, ch 1, hdc 3. In the last ch, [hdc 1, ch 2, sl st 1]. (30 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.



FINISHING

Attach the nose just a little below the center of the granny square.

With a length of black yarn, embroider the eyes and the mouth.

Sew the ear warmer and scarf appliques.

Weave in all your ends.

Your Hedgehog Granny Square is ready!

Apple Granny Square

SQUARE

With your 4-mm hook and CB (for the full apple) or caramel (for a half apple), make a MC.

Round 1. [CB/Caramel] Ch 2, hdc 11 in the MC. (11 sts)

Round 2. [CB/Caramel] Ch 1, hdc inc 11. (22 sts)

Round 3. [CB/Caramel] Ch 1, (hdc inc 1, hdc 1) 11 times. (33 sts)

Round 4. [CB/Caramel] Ch 1, hdc 1, hdc inc 1, (hdc 2, hdc inc 1) 10 times, hdc 1. Close the last st with CC. (44 sts)

Round 5. [CC] Ch 1, sc 2, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1. (Dc 1, hdc 2, sc 3, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1) three times. Dc 1, hdc 2, sc 1. (13 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 6. [CC] Ch 2, dc 7. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1]. On the next side, dc 13) three times. [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1] into the last corner, dc 6. (15 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 7. [CC] Ch 2, dc 8. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 2, ch 1, dc 2]. On the next side, dc 15) three times. [Dc 2, ch 1, dc 2] into the last corner, dc 7. (19 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners)

Round 8. [CC] Ch 1, sc 10. (In the ch-1 corner, [sc 1, ch 1, sc 1]. On the next side, sc 19) three times. [Sc 1, ch 1, sc 1] into the last corner, sc 9. (21 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners).

Fasten off and weave in all your ends.

STEM APPLIQUE

With your 3.5-mm hook and CF, ch 5.

Row 1. Sc 1 in the second ch from your hook. Sc 3. (4 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.



LEAF APPLIQUE

With your 3.5-mm hook and CD, ch 5.

Round 1. Sl st 1 in the second ch from your hook. Sc 1, hdc 1. In the last ch, [dc 1, ch 2, sl st 1, ch 2, dc 1]. Start working on the other loops of the initial ch. Hdc 1, sc 1, sl st 1. Ch 1, sl st into the first st to join the round.

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

FINISHING - FULL APPLE

Attach the stem in the middle, top of the apple, and the leaf applique next to the petiole.

Fasten off and weave in all your ends.

Your Full Apple Granny Square is ready!

Apple Granny Square

FINISHING - HALF APPLE

With your 4-mm crochet hook and CB, surface crochet following the spaces between rounds 4 and 5 of the granny square.

In the middle, top of the apple, make an indent to accommodate the stem and give your apple a more realistic look.

Attach the stem inside the indent you made on the top and sew the leaf applique next to the stem.

With a length of CF, embroider two seeds in the center of the granny square.

Fasten off and weave in all your ends.

Your Half Apple Granny Square is ready!



Acorn Granny Square

SQUARE

With your 4-mm hook and CE, make a MC.

Round 1. [CE] Ch 2, hdc 11 in the MC. (11 sts)

Round 2. [CE] Ch 1, hdc inc 11. (22 sts)

Round 3. [CE] Ch 1, (hdc inc 1, hdc 1) 11 times. (33 sts)

Round 4. [CE] Ch 1, hdc 1, hdc inc 1, (hdc 2, hdc inc 1) 10 times, hdc 1. Close the last st with CC. (44 sts)

Round 5. [CC] Ch 1, sc 2, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1. (Dc 1, hdc 2, sc 3, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1) three times. Dc 1, hdc 2, sc 1. (13 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 6. [CC] Ch 2, dc 7. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1]. On the next side, dc 13) three times. [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1] into the last corner, dc 6. (15 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 7. [CC] Ch 2, dc 8. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 2, ch 1, dc 2]. On the next side, dc 15) three times. [Dc 2, ch 1, dc 2] into the last corner, dc 7. (19 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners)

Round 8. [CC] Ch 1, sc 10. (In the ch-1 corner, [sc 1, ch 1, sc 1]. On the next side, sc 19) three times. [Sc 1, ch 1, sc 1] into the last corner, sc 9. (21 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners)

Fasten off and weave in all your ends.

CUPULE APPLIQUE

With your 3.5-mm hook and CF, ch 12.

Round 1. Dc 1 in the third ch from your hook. Dc 8, [dc 6] in the last ch. Crocheting on the other side of the initial ch, dc 8, [dc 5] in the last st. Join the round with a sl st into the first st.



Round 2. Ch 1, sc 1, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 2, dc 1, hdc 2, sc 1, sl st 2, sc inc 1, [sc 3], sc 10, [sc 3], sc inc 1, sl st 2.

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

Stalk

Join CF in the second st of the first dc inc of round 2. Ch 4.

Row 1. Sc 1 in the second ch from your hook. Sc 2, sl st into the next st on round 2 of the acorn top.

Fasten off and weave in your ends.

FINISHING

Attach the cupule applique so that it covers the top half of rounds 1-4 of the granny square.

With CE, embroider a little pointy tip on the bottom of the acorn (between rounds 4 and 5 of the granny square).

Fasten off and weave in all your ends.

Your Acorn Granny Square is ready!

Lantern Granny Square

SQUARE

With your 4-mm hook and yellow yarn, make a MC.

Round 1. [Yellow] Ch 2, hdc 11 in the MC. (11 sts)

Round 2. [Yellow] Ch 1, hdc inc 11. (22 sts)

Round 3. [Yellow] Ch 1, (hdc inc 1, hdc 1) 11 times. Close the last st with CA. (33 sts)

Round 4. [CA] Ch 1, hdc 1, hdc inc 1, (hdc 2, hdc inc 1) 10 times, hdc 1. (44 sts)

Round 5. [CA] Ch 1, sc 2, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1. (Dc 1, hdc 2, sc 3, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1) three times. Dc 1, hdc 2, sc 1. (13 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 6. [CA] Ch 2, dc 7. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1]. On the next side, dc 13) three times. [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1] into the last corner, dc 6. (15 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 7. [CA] Ch 2, dc 8. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 2, ch 1, dc 2]. On the next side, dc 15) three times. [Dc 2, ch 1, dc 2] into the last corner, dc 7. (19 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners)

Round 8. [CA] Ch 1, sc 10. (In the ch-1 corner, [sc 1, ch 1, sc 1]. On the next side, sc 19) three times. [Sc 1, ch 1, sc 1] into the last corner, sc 9. (21 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners).

Fasten off and weave in all your ends.

LANTERN APPLIQUE

Top Part

With your 3.5-mm hook and grey yarn, ch 2.

Row 1. Sc 3 in the first ch. (3 sts)

Row 2. Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 1, sc 1, sc inc 1. (5 sts)

Row 3. Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 1, sc 3, sc inc 1. (7 sts)

Row 4. Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 1, sc 5, sc inc 1. (9 sts)



Row 5. Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 1, sc 7, sc inc 1. (11 sts)

Row 6. Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 1, sc 9, sc inc 1. (13 sts)

Row 7. Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 1, sc 11, sc inc 1. (15 sts)

Row 8. Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 1, sc 13, sc inc 1. (17 sts)

Row 9. Ch 1, turn. Sc inc 1, sc 15, sc inc 1. (19 sts)

Row 10. Ch 1, turn. Hdc 19. (19 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

Base

With your 3.5-mm hook and grey yarn, ch 11.

Row 1. Sc 1 in the second ch from your hook and in each remaining ch. (10 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

CANDLE APPLIQUE

With your 3.5-mm hook and CB, ch 5.

Row 1. Sc 1 in the second ch from your hook, sc 1, hdc 2. (4 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

Lantern Granny Square

HOLLY LEAF APPLIQUE

(Make 2)

With your 3.5-mm hook and CD, ch 6.

Round 1. (Sl st 2, mini picot) twice. Sl st 1, ch 1. Start working on the other loops of the initial chain. Sl st 1, (mini picot, sl st 2) twice.

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

HOLLY DRUPE APPLIQUE

With your 3.5-mm hook and CB, make a MC.

Round 1. Sc 3 in the MC. (3 sts)

Fasten off and join the round using a tapestry needle.

Cut your yarn leaving a long tail for sewing.

FINISHING

Attach the base of the lantern applique in the center of the bottom side between rounds 5 and 6 of the granny square.

Sew the top part of the lantern applique just above the center of the granny square with the tip pointing up.

With a length of light grey yarn, embroider two lines on the top part of the lantern to give it a sort of 3D effect.

With your 4-mm crochet hook and grey yarn, surface crochet the central frame of the lantern.

Attach the candle applique right above the base of the lantern.



With a length of black yarn, embroider a short wick, and with orange yarn, embroider a little flame.

Attach the holly leaves and the drupe on the side of the lantern.

With a length of yellow yarn, embroider a few decorative stars around the lantern.

Weave in all your ends.

Your Lantern Granny Square is ready!

Angel Granny Square

SQUARE

With your 4-mm hook and skin color of your choice, make a MC.

Round 1. [Skin C.] Ch 2, hdc 11 in the MC. (11 sts)

Round 2. [Skin C.] Ch 1, hdc inc 11. (22 sts)

Round 3. [Skin C.] Ch 1, (hdc inc 1, hdc 1) 11 times. (33 sts)

Round 4. [Skin C.] Ch 1, hdc 1, hdc inc 1, (hdc 2, hdc inc 1) 10 times, hdc 1. Close the last st with CA. (44 sts)

Round 5. [CA] Ch 1, sc 2, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1. (Dc 1, hdc 2, sc 3, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1) three times. Dc 1, hdc 2, sc 1. (13 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 6. [CA] Ch 2, dc 7. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1]. On the next side, dc 13) three times. [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1] into the last corner, dc 6. (15 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 7. [CA] Ch 2, dc 8. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 2, ch 1, dc 2]. On the next side, dc 15) three times. [Dc 2, ch 1, dc 2] into the last corner, dc 7. (19 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners)

Round 8. [CA] Ch 1, sc 10. (In the ch-1 corner, [sc 1, ch 1, sc 1]. On the next side, sc 19) three times. [Sc 1, ch 1, sc 1] into the last corner, sc 9. (21 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners).

Fasten off and weave in all your ends.



HALO APPLIQUE

With your 3.5-mm hook and yellow yarn, ch 20. Sl st into the first ch to form a ring. Make sure not to twist your ch.

Round 1. Ch 1, [sc 3], sc 1, sl st 7, sc 1, [sc 3], sc 1, sl st 7, sc 1. Join the round with a sl st into the first sc. (24 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

WING APPLIQUES

With your 3.5-mm hook and wing color of your choice, ch 10.

Left Wing

Round 1. Sl st 1 in the second ch from your hook. Sl st 1, sc dec 1, hdc 1, dc dec 1, dc 1, [dc 8] all in the last ch. Working on the other side of the initial ch, dc 1, hdc 1, sc 4, sl st 2, ch 1, sl st into the first st to join the round.

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

Angel Granny Square

Right Wing

Round 1. Sl st 1 in the second ch from your hook. Sl st 1, sc 4, hdc 1, dc 1, [dc 8] all in the last ch. Working on the other side of the initial ch, dc 1, dc dec 1, hdc 1, sc dec 1, sl st 2, ch 1, sl st into the first st to join the round.

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

HAIR APPLIQUE

With your 3.5-mm hook and CB, ch 14.

Row 1. Sc inc 1 in the second ch from your hook. Sc inc 1, sc 1, [sc 3], sc 3, sc dec 3. Sl st into the last ch of the initial ch.

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

EYES & CHEEKS

(Make 2 with CA and 2 with pink yarn)

With your 3.5-mm hook, make a MC.

Round 1. Sc 6 in the MC. Join the round with a sl st into the first st. (6 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

FINISHING

Attach the wings just below the face of the angel (rounds 1-4 of the granny square).

Attach the eyes and the cheeks.

With a length of black yarn, embroider the pupils and the mouth.



Let the hair applique bend in the point where you made 3 sts into the same ch, and sew it on the forehead of the angel.

Sew the halo applique.

Weave in all your ends.

Your Angel Granny Square is ready!

Grinch Granny Square

SQUARE

With your 4-mm hook and CD, make a MC.

Round 1. [CD] Ch 2, hdc 11 in the MC. (11 sts)

Round 2. [CD] Ch 1, hdc inc 11. (22 sts)

Round 3. [CD] Ch 1, (hdc inc 1, hdc 1) 11 times. (33 sts)

Round 4. [CD] Ch 1, hdc 1, hdc inc 1, (hdc 2, hdc inc 1) 10 times, hdc 1. Close the last st with CA. (44 sts)

Round 5. [CA] Ch 1, sc 2, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1. (Dc 1, hdc 2, sc 3, hdc 2, dc 1, dc inc 1, ch 2, dc inc 1) three times. Dc 1, hdc 2, sc 1. (13 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 6. [CA] Ch 2, dc 7. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1]. On the next side, dc 13) three times. [dc 1, ch 2, dc 1] into the last corner, dc 6. (15 sts on each side and ch-2 at the corners)

Round 7. [CA] Ch 2, dc 8. (In the ch-2 corner, [dc 2, ch 1, dc 2]. On the next side, dc 15) three times. [Dc 2, ch 1, dc 2] into the last corner, dc 7. (19 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners)

Round 8. [CA] Ch 1, sc 10. (In the ch-1 corner, [sc 1, ch 1, sc 1]. On the next side, sc 19) three times. [Sc 1, ch 1, sc 1] into the last corner, sc 9. (21 sts on each side and ch-1 at the corners).

Fasten off and weave in all your ends.

EYEBROW APPLIQUES

With your 3.5-mm hook and black yarn, ch 9.

Left Eyebrow

Row 1. Sc 1 in the first ch from your hook, sc 3, sl st 4.

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.



Right Eyebrow

Row 1. Sl st 1 in the first ch from your hook, sl st 3, sc 4.

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

EYE APPLIQUES

(Make 2)

With your 3.5-mm hook and yellow yarn, ch 3.

Round 1. Dc 6 on the first ch you made. Ch 1, sc 2 along the side of the last dc you made. Sc 1 in the first ch you made (where you made the dc 6), sc 2 in the 2 ch of the starting ch. Ch 1, sl st into the first dc to join the round.

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

INNER EYES, NOSE, CHEEKS & POMPOM

(Make 3 with black yarn, 2 with CC, and 1 with yellow yarn for the pompom)

With your 3.5-mm hook, make a MC.

Round 1. Sc 6 in the MC. Join the round with a sl st into the first st. (6 sts)

Grinch Granny Square

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

HAIR (OPTIONAL)

With your 3.5-mm hook, join CD around the post of st 44 from Round 4 of the granny square.

(Row 1 is worked around the posts of the sts from round 4 of the granny square)

Row 1. Ch 3, dc 1 around the post of st 44, picot 1, hdc 1 around the initial ch 1 of round 4, picot 1, sc 1 around the post of st 1.

Fasten off and weave in your ends.

HAT APPLIQUE

With your 3.5-mm hook and CB, ch 18.

Row 1. Dc 1 in the third ch from your hook. Dc 15. (16 sts)

Row 2. Ch 10, turn. Working on the 10 ch you just made, sc 1 in the second ch from your hook, sc 2, hdc 2, hdc inc 1, dc 3.

Working on the sts from Row 1, dc inc 5, dc 2, dc inc 1, dc 2, dc inc 2, dc 1, hdc 1, sc 1, sl st. (34 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

HAT BRIM APPLIQUE

With your 3.5-mm hook and CA, ch 18.

Row 1. Dc 1 in the third ch from your hook. Dc 14, In the last ch, [dc 1, ch 2, sl st]. (16 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

SCARF APPLIQUE

With your 3.5-mm hook and CB, ch 22.



Row 1. Dc 1 in the third ch from your hook. Dc 18. In the last ch, [dc 1, ch 2, sl st 1]. (20 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

FINISHING

If you didn't crochet the hair, attach the hat applique just above round 4 of the granny square. Then, sew the brim on top of row 1 of the hat and the pompom at the tip of the hat.

Attach the eye appliques slightly above the center of the granny square, and sew one inner eye applique on top of each eye.

Attach the eyebrows just above the eyes.

With a length of CA, embroider the pupils in the center of the inner eyes.

Sew the nose and the cheek appliques.

With a length of black yarn, embroider the mouth and a line connecting the center of the mouth to the nose.

Attach the scarf applique.

Weave in all your ends.

Your Grinch Granny Square is ready!
