

The Christmas Penguin



MATERIALS

- 4mm crochet hook.
 - 7mm toy safety eyes.
 - Needle for sewing.
 - Toy stuffing (fiberfill).
 - Stitch marker.
 - Scissors.
 - Chunky yarn size 4-5mm (E.g: Himalaya Velvet, Himalaya Dolphin Baby)
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NOTES

- Make the invisible decrease stitches to have a better results.
- Add toy stuffing according to instruction of each part.
- Stitches should be close together so that when the finished toy is stuffed, the stuffing doesn't come out through gaps in the stitches.
- The pattern includes color change techniques, bobble stitch technique and the X stitch technique for single crochet stitch. It is important to master these techniques to ensure the finished product resembles the pattern.
- Finished size: the finished toy is approximately 11cm (~ 4.3 inch) high.

ABBREVIATIONS

MR	-	magic ring
st(s)	-	stitch(es)
ch	-	chain stitch
sc	-	single crochet stitch
hdc	-	half double crochet stitch
dc	-	double crochet stitch
inc	-	increase (2 single crochet sts into the same stitch)
dec	-	decrease (crochet together 2 single crochet sts with 1 st)
bo2	-	bobble stitch - 2 double crochet into one stitch
bo3	-	bobble stitch - 3 double crochet into one stitch
BLO	-	work stitch through back loop only
FLO	-	work stitch through front loop only
rnd(s)	-	round(s)
[...]	-	number of stitches should have at the end of each round
(...) x ...	-	repeat instructions x times

PENGUIN NO.1

Start in red yarn.

Rnd 1: 8sc in MR [8]

Rnd 2: 8inc [16]

Rnd 3: (sc, inc) x 8 [24]

Rnd 4: 24sc [24]

Rnd 5: (2sc, inc) x 8 [32]

Change to gray yarn.

(Note: From rnd 6 to rnd 10, use **white yarn in pink word**, **yellow yarn in yellow word**, **gray yarn in black word**)

Rnd 6: BLO 32sc [32]

Rnd 7: 11sc, **3sc**, 4sc, **3sc**, 11sc [32]

Rnd 8: 10sc, **5sc**, 2sc, **5sc**, 10sc [32]

Rnd 9: 10sc, **6sc**, **bo2**, **6sc**, 9sc [32]

(*bo2: bobble stitch - 2 double crochet into one stitch*)

Rnd 10: 10sc, **13sc**, 9sc [32]

Change to light gray yarn.

(Note: From rnd 11 to rnd 21, use **gray yarn in green word**, **light gray yarn in black word**)

Rnd 11: (3sc, inc) x 8 [40]

Rnd 12 - 15: 40sc [40]

Rnd 16: 16sc, **bo3**, 8sc, **bo3**, 14sc [40]

(*bo3: bobble stitch - 3 double crochet into one stitch*)

Rnd 17: 40sc [40]

Rnd 18: (3sc, dec) x 8 [32]

Rnd 19: (2sc, dec) x 8 [24]

Rnd 20: (sc, dec) x 8 [16]

Stuff the penguin firmly with fiberfill.

Rnd 21: 8dec [8]

Fasten off, leaving the yarn tail.

Using the yarn needle, weave the yarn tail through the front loop of each remaining stitch and pull it tight to close.

Insert the 7mm safety eyes between rounds 8 and 9, 6 stitches apart.

Use powder plush for the cheeks.



Make the hat brim:

Note: The first stitch of the round will be always in the same stitch as the chain.
Turn the penguin, working in the FLO stitches of Round 6, insert white yarn: ch 2, 32dc, slst.

Fasten off and weave in the yarn tail.

Make the pompom:

Start in white yarn with a radius of 1cm.
Then sew it to the top of the penguin.

Make the wing:

Start in gray yarn.

Rnd 1: 6sc in a MR [6]

Rnd 2: 2sc, 2inc, 2sc [8]

Rnd 3: 8sc [8]

Rnd 4: 3sc, 2inc, 3sc [10]

Flatten the opening of the arm and sew through both layers to close the opening.
Fasten off. Leave a long tail for sewing. Pin and sew the wing on both side of the penguin between rnd 10 and rnd 11.

PENGUIN NO.2

Start in gray yarn.

Rnd 1: 8sc in MR [8]

Rnd 2: 8inc [16]

Rnd 3: (sc, inc) x 8 [24]

Rnd 4: 24sc [24]

Rnd 5: (2sc, inc) x 8 [32]

(Note: From rnd 6 to rnd 10, use **white yarn in pink word**, **yellow yarn in yellow word**, **gray yarn in black word**)

Rnd 6: 32sc [32]

Rnd 7: 11sc, **3sc**, 4sc, **3sc**, 11sc [32]

Rnd 8: 10sc, **5sc**, 2sc, **5sc**, 10sc [32]

Rnd 9: 10sc, **6sc**, **bo2**, **6sc**, 9sc [32]

(*bo2: bobble stitch - 2 double crochet into one stitch*)

Rnd 10: 10sc, **13sc**, 9sc [32]

Change to green yarn.

(Note: From rnd 11 to rnd 15, use **white yarn in purple word**, **green yarn in black word**)

Rnd 11: BLO (3sc, inc) x 8 [40]

Rnd 12: (2sc, **2sc**) x 10 [40]

Rnd 13: 40sc [40]

Rnd 14: (**2sc**, 2sc) x 10 [40]

Rnd 15: 40sc [40]

(Note: From rnd 16 to rnd 21, use **yellow yarn in green word, green yarn in black word**)

Rnd 16: 16sc, **bo3**, 8sc, **bo3**, 14sc [40]

(*bo3: bobble stitch - 3 double crochet into one stitch*)

Rnd 17: 40sc [40]

Rnd 18: (3sc, dec) x 8 [32]

Rnd 19: (2sc, dec) x 8 [24]

Rnd 20: (sc, dec) x 8 [16]

Stuff the penguin firmly with fiberfill.

Rnd 21: 8dec [8]

Fasten off, leaving the yarn tail. Using the yarn needle, weave the yarn tail through the front loop of each remaining stitch and pull it tight to close.

Insert the 7mm safety eyes between rounds 8 and 9, 6 stitches apart.

Use powder plush for the cheeks.



Make the wing:

Start in gray yarn.

Rnd 1: 6sc in a MR [6]

Rnd 2: 2sc, 2inc, 2sc [8]

Rnd 3: 8sc [8]

Rnd 4: 3sc, 2inc, 3sc [10]

Flatten the opening of the arm and sew through both layers to close the opening. Fasten off. Leave a long tail for sewing. Pin and sew the wing on both side of the penguin between rnd 10 and rnd 11.

Make the scarf:

Start in red yarn. Ch 56.

Fasten off and weave in the yarn tail.

PENGUIN NO.3

Start in gray yarn.

Rnd 1: 8sc in MR [8]

Rnd 2: 8inc [16]

Rnd 3: (sc, inc) x 8 [24]

Rnd 4: 24sc [24]

Rnd 5: (2sc, inc) x 8 [32]

(Note: From rnd 6 to rnd 10, use **white yarn in pink word**, **yellow yarn in yellow word**, **gray yarn in black word**)

Rnd 6: 32sc [32]

Rnd 7: 11sc, **3sc**, 4sc, **3sc**, 11sc [32]

Rnd 8: 10sc, **5sc**, 2sc, **5sc**, 10sc [32]

Rnd 9: 10sc, **6sc**, **bo2**, **6sc**, 9sc [32]

(*bo2: bobble stitch - 2 double crochet into one stitch*)

Rnd 10: 10sc, **13sc**, 9sc [32]

Change to brown yarn.

Rnd 11: BLO (3sc, inc) x 8 [40]

Rnd 12: 40sc [40]

Change to white yarn.

Rnd 13: 40sc [40]

Change to brown yarn.

Rnd 14 - 15: 40sc [40]

(Note: From rnd 16 to rnd 21, use **yellow yarn in green word**, **brown yarn in black word**)

Rnd 16: 16sc, **bo3**, 8sc, **bo3**, 14sc [40]
(*bo3: bobble stitch - 3 double crochet into one stitch*)

Rnd 17: 40sc [40]

Rnd 18: (3sc, dec) x 8 [32]

Rnd 19: (2sc, dec) x 8 [24]

Rnd 20: (sc, dec) x 8 [16]

Stuff the penguin firmly with fiberfill.

Rnd 21: 8dec [8]

Fasten off, leaving the yarn tail. Using the yarn needle, weave the yarn tail through the front loop of each remaining stitch and pull it tight to close.

Insert the 7mm safety eyes between rounds 8 and 9, 6 stitches apart. Use powder plush for the cheeks.



Make the wing:

Start in gray yarn.

Rnd 1: 6sc in a MR [6]

Rnd 2: 2sc, 2inc, 2sc [8]

Rnd 3: 8sc [8]

Rnd 4: 3sc, 2inc, 3sc [10]

Flatten the opening of the arm and sew through both layers to close the opening. Fasten off. Leave a long tail for sewing. Pin and sew the wing on both side of the penguin between rnd 10 and rnd 11.

Make the ear cover (make 2):

Start in red yarn.

Rnd 1: 8sc in a MR [8]

Rnd 2: 8inc [16]

Change to white yarn.

Rnd 3: BLO 16sc [16]

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.
