

# CROCHET PATTERN FUNNY ACORN



## **The required materials:**

### **For Hedgehog**

- Sport weight 4ply yarn Alize Cotton Gold (100g /330m)  
N21 – gray  
N493 – brown
- DK Light Worsted faux fur yarn YarnArt Mink (50g /75m)  
N347 – pink
- 1.75 mm crochet hook
- Stuffing material, fiberfill
- Needle for sewing pieces

**The length of the hedgehog is 10-11 cm/4.0-4.5 inches, using indicated materials.**

### **For acorn**

- Sport weight 4ply yarn Alize Cotton Gold (100g /330m)  
N35 – dark green  
N493 – brown  
N118 – bright green  
N612 – light green
- Sport weight 4ply yarn Alize Cotton Gold Tweed (100g /330m)  
N262 –beige
- 1 Button
- Plastic (I use plastic folders)
- Needle for sewing pieces
- 1.75 mm crochet hook
- Stuffing material, fiberfill

**Acorn size: height is 15cm/6.0 inches, width is 10cm/4.0 inches, using the indicated materials.**

## Terms and abbreviations (US):

**MR - magic ring**

**ch- chain**

**(...)\* – repeat the space in brackets the given number of times**

**sc – single crochet**

**dc – double crochet**

**hdc– Half double crochet**

**dc-inc - Double Crochet Increase - 2 Dc in one stitch**

**inc – increase –Two Single Crochet in one stitch**

**dec – decrease – two single crochets together**

**dc2tog – crochet 2dc together**

**sl st - slip stitch**

**FLO - front loops only**

**BLO - back loops only**

## Hedgehog Toy

### Head-Body

With Gray yarn.

1. 6sc in MR

Place row marker here.

2. 6sc (6)

3. 6inc (12)

4. 12inc (24)

5.-6. 24sc (2 rounds)

7. Attention! Crochet in jacquard technique from Rnd 7 to 10. Add Pink faux fur yarn (Yarn Art Mink). (these stitches are highlighted in purple)

12sc, 12sc (24)

8.-9. 12sc, 12sc (2 rounds) (24)



10. 12sc, 6dec (18)

11. Continue crocheting with Gray yarn.

1sc, dec, 1sc, 5inc, 1sc, 4dec (18)

12. 12sc, 3dec (15)

13.-19. 15sc (7 rounds)

Stuff with fiberfill.

20. 7dec, 1sc (8)

21. 4dec

Fasten off, cut the yarn, weave in the yarn ends.



### Legs (make 4)

With Gray yarn.

1. 8sc in MR

Place row marker here.

2. 2sc, 2dec, 2sc (6)

3.-6. 6sc (4 rounds) (6)

Stuff the legs with fiberfill.

Fasten off, cut the yarn, weave in the yarn ends.



### Ears (make 2)

With Gray yarn.

6sc in MR, sl st.

Leave a long tail for sewing.

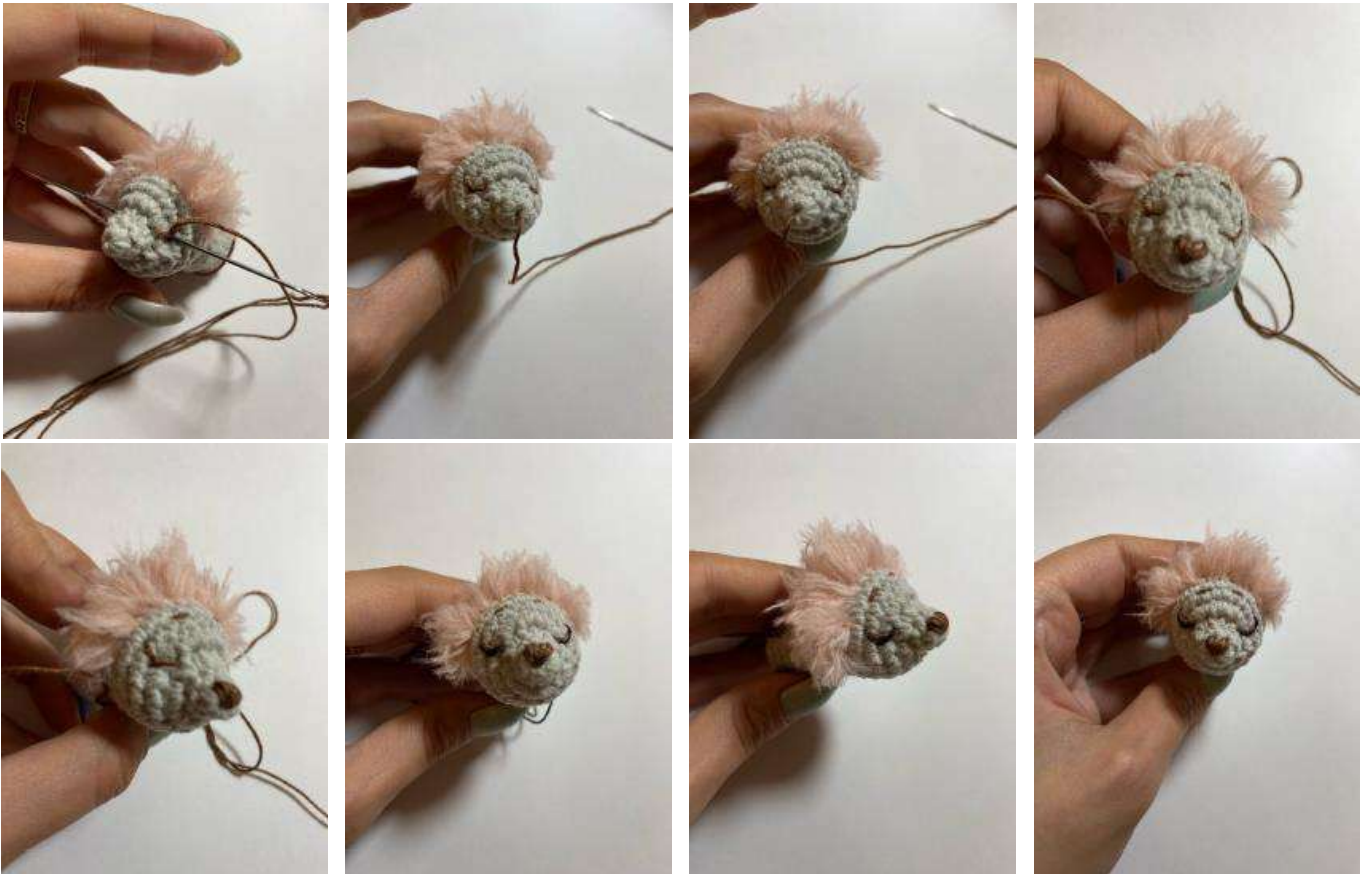


## Tail

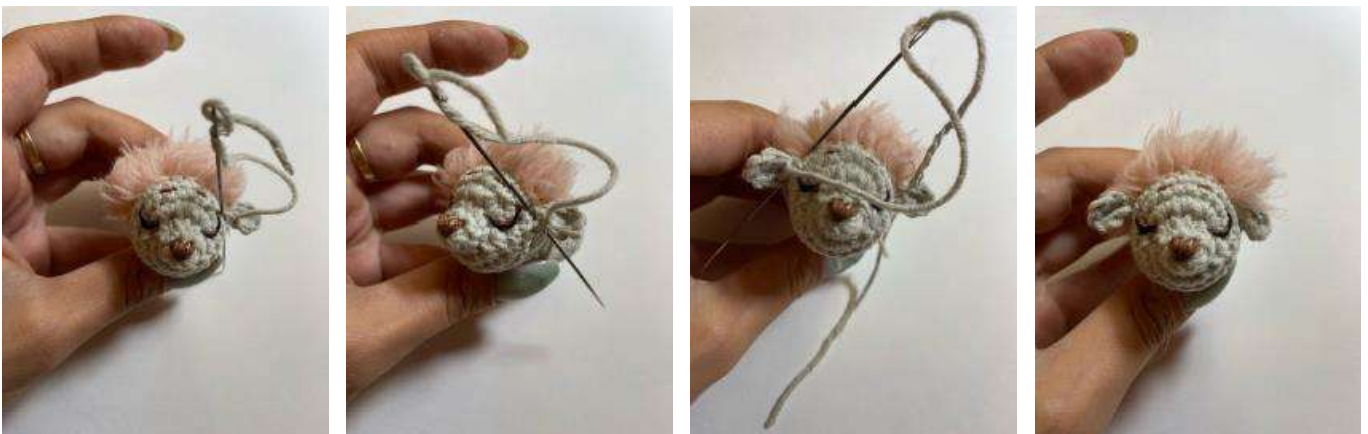
With Gray yarn.  
Chain 4, from the second chain  
on the hook: 3sl st.  
Leave a long tail for sewing.



**Embroider eyes, nose and eyebrows with brown yarn (see photo).**



**Sea the ears to the head.**



### Sew the tail to the body.



**Fasten the legs with a thread mount. Attach the legs using a long needle and thread (look at the pictures below).**



### Fur

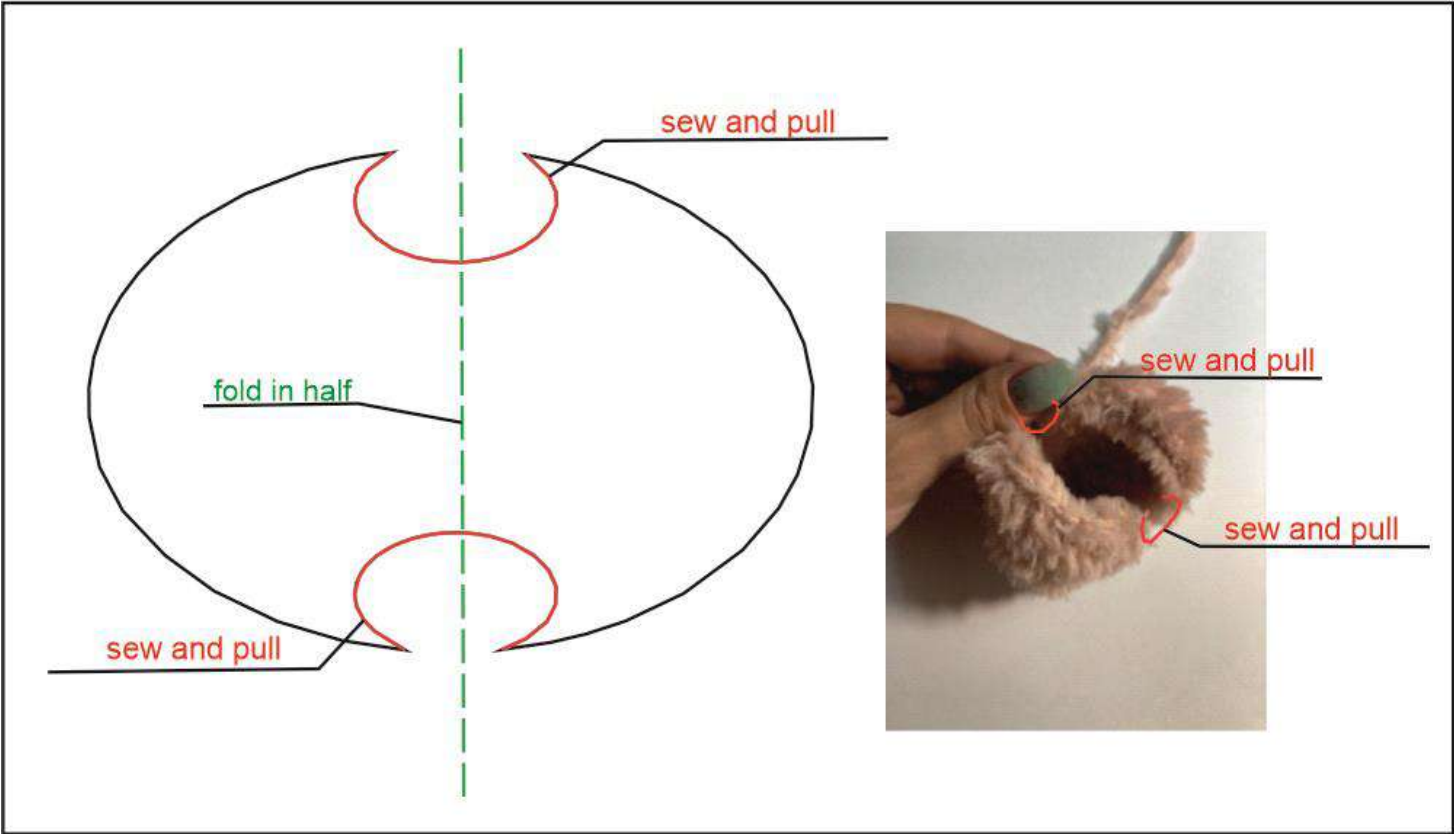
With faux fur pink yarn (Yarn Art Mink). Work in rows.

1. Chain 21. From the second chain on the hook: 2sl st, 4hdc, 8dc, 4hdc, 2sl st, turn (20)
  - 2.-22. ch1, 2sl st, 4hdc, 8dc, 4hdc, 2sl st, turn (21 rows) (20).
- Fasten off, cut the yarn, weave in the yarn ends.





**Pull the base of the part on each side so that the part is curled into a circle.**



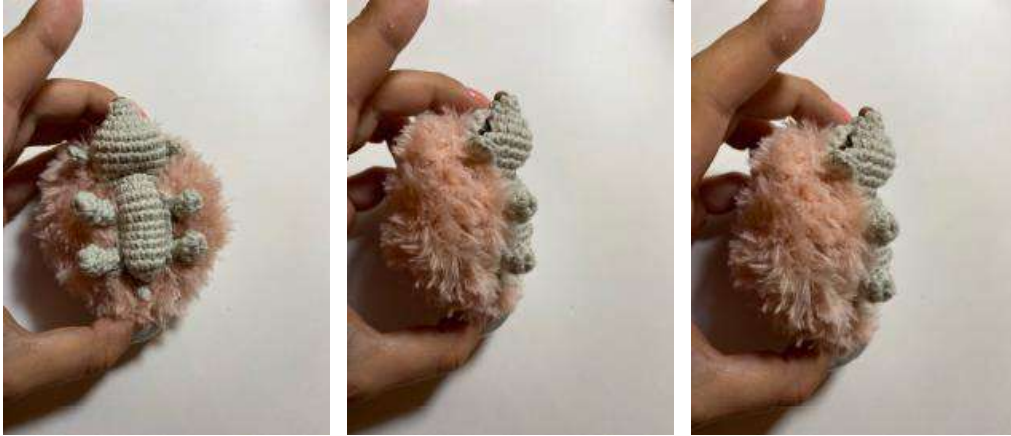


**Fold the part in half, trying it on a hedgehog. Mark the places before the beginning of the forelegs and the end of the hind legs, make straps so that the fur is worn on the hedgehog like a backpack.**



**Put the fur on the hedgehog and check that the hedgehog bend freely into a ball .**

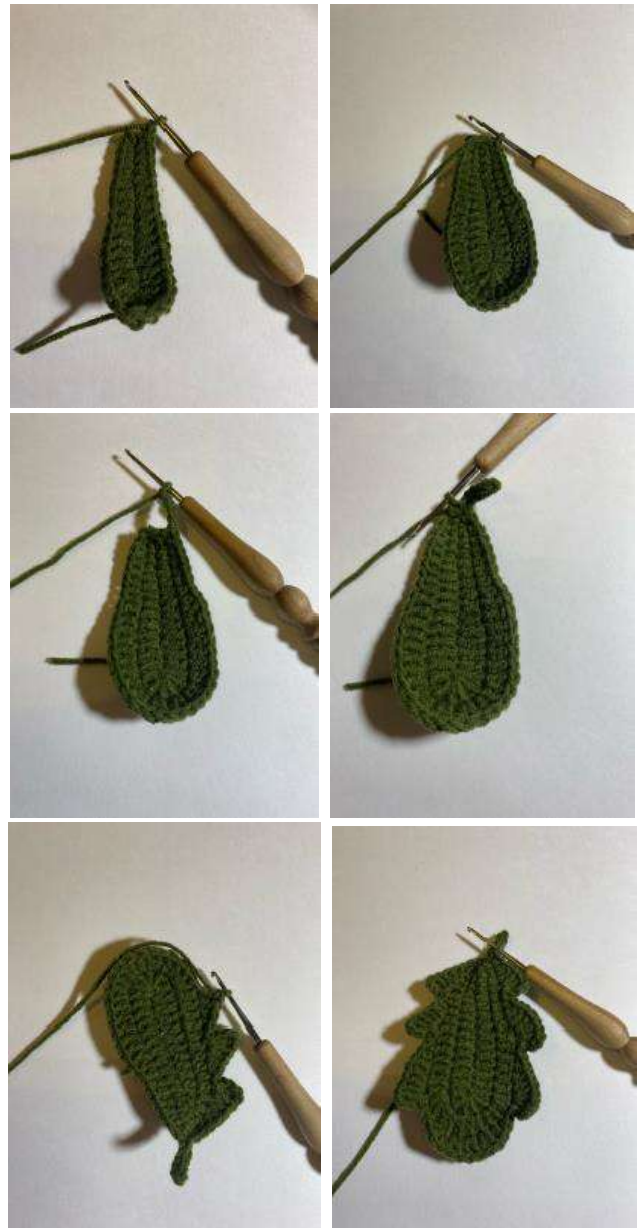




## Leaf-bed

With Dark green yarn. Crochet in a spiral.

1. Chain 16. From the second chain on the hook: 4sc, 4hdc, 6dc, 6dc in the last chain, 6dc, 4hdc, 4sc (34)
2. 2sc, 6hdc, 6dc, 6dc-inc, 6dc, 6hdc, 2sc (40)
3. ch6, 5sl st on the chain, 2sc, hdc, dc, (3dc, ch3, sl st in the one chain ), sl st, sc, hdc, dc, (3dc, ch4, sl st) in one stitch, sl st, sc, hdc, 2dc (3dc, ch4, sl st) in one stitch, sl st, hdc, 4dc-inc, hdc, sl st, (sl st, ch4, 3dc) in one stitch, 2dc, hdc, sc, sl st, (sl st, ch4, 3dc) in one stitch, dc, hdc, sc, sl st, (sl st, ch3, 3dc) in one stitch, dc, hdc, sc, sl st. Fasten off, cut the yarn, weave in the yarn ends.



## ACORN

### Inner part

With Light Green yarn.

Work in rounds with turns.

1. 6sc in MR, sl st, turn (7)
2. ch1, 6inc, sl st, turn (13)
3. ch1, (1sc, inc ) \*6, sl st, turn (19)
4. ch1, (2sc, inc) \*6, sl st, turn (25)
5. ch1, (3sc, inc) \*6, sl st, turn (31)
6. ch1, (4sc, inc) \*6, sl st, turn (37)
7. ch1, (5sc, inc) \*6, sl st, turn (43)
8. ch1, (6sc, inc) \*6, sl st, turn (49)
9. ch1, (7sc, inc) \*6, sl st, turn (55)
10. ch1, (8sc, inc) \*6, sl st, turn (61)
11. ch1, (9sc, inc) \*6, sl st, turn (67)
12. ch1, (10sc, inc) \*6, sl st, turn (73)
13. ch1, (11sc, inc) \*6, sl st, turn (79)
14. ch1, (12sc, inc) \*6, sl st, turn (85)
15. ch1, 84sc, sl st, turn (85)
16. Form the opening in acorn.  
Work in rows. Ch1, 64sc, turn (64)



- 17.-27. Ch1, 64sc, turn (11 rows) (64)
28. ch1, inc, 62sc, inc, turn (66)
29. ch1, inc, 64sc, inc, turn (68)
30. ch1, inc, 66sc, inc, ch14, sl st with the beginning of the row, turn (66) Work in rounds with turn
31. ch1, 70sc, 14sc on the chain, sl st, turn (85)
32. ch1, 84sc, sl st, turn (85)
33. Change color to Brown. ch1, 84sc, sl st, turn (85)
- 34.-37. ch1, 84sc, sl st, turn (4 rows) (85)
38. ch1, (12sc, dec) \*6, sl st, turn (79)
39. ch1, 78sc, sl st, turn (79)
40. ch1, (11sc, dec) \*6, sl st, turn (73)
41. ch1, 72sc, sl st, turn (73)
42. ch1, (10sc, dec) \*6, sl st, turn (67)
43. ch1, 66sc, sl st, turn (67)
44. ch1, (9sc, dec) \*6, sl st, turn (61)
45. ch1, 60sc, sl st, turn (61)
46. ch1, (8sc, dec) \*6, sl st, turn (55)
47. ch1, (7sc, dec) \*6, sl st, turn (49)
48. ch1, (6sc, dec) \*6, sl st, turn (43)



49. ch1, (5sc, dec) \*6, sl st, turn (37)

50. ch1, (4sc, dec) \*6, sl st, turn (31)

51. ch1, (3sc, dec) \*6, sl st, turn (25)

52. ch1, (2sc, dec) \*6, sl st, turn (19)

53. ch1, (1sc, dec) \*6, sl st, turn (13)

54. 6dec

Fasten off, cut the yarn, hide the ends.



### External part

With Beige yarn.

Work in rounds with turns.

1. 6sc in MR, sl st, turn (7)

2. ch1, 6inc, sl st, turn (13)

3. ch1, (1sc, inc) \*6, sl st, turn (19)

4. ch1, (2sc, inc) \*6, sl st, turn (25)

5. ch1, (3sc, inc) \*6, sl st, turn (31)

6. ch1, 30sc, sl st, turn (31)

7. ch1, (4sc, inc) \*6, sl st, turn (37)

8. ch1, (5sc, inc) \*6, sl st, turn (43)

9. ch1, (6sc, inc) \*6, sl st, turn (49)

10. ch1, 48sc, sl st, turn (49)

11. ch1, (7sc, inc) \*6, sl st, turn (55)



12. ch1, (8sc, inc) \*6, sl st, turn (61)
13. ch1, (9sc, inc) \*6, sl st, turn (67)
14. ch1, 66sc, sl st, turn (67)
15. ch1, (10sc, inc) \*6, sl st, turn (73)
16. ch1, (11sc, inc) \*6, sl st, turn (79)
17. ch1, (12sc, inc) \*6, sl st, turn (85)
18. ch1, 84sc, sl st, turn (85)
19. Form the opening in acorn.  
Ch1, 64sc, turn (64) Work in rows
- 20.-30. ch1, 64sc, turn (11 rows) (64)
31. ch1, inc, 62sc, inc, turn (66)
32. ch1, inc, 64sc, inc, turn (68)
33. ch1, inc, 66sc, inc, ch14, sl st with the beginning of the row, turn (66) Work in rounds with turn
34. ch1, 70sc, 14sc on the chain, sl st, turn (85)
35. ch1, 84sc, sl st, turn (85)
36. Change color to Brown.  
BLO ch1, (5sc, 4dc in one stitch) \*14, sl st, turn (127)
37. ch1, (2dc2tog, 3sc, dec)\*14, sl st, turn (85)



38. ch1, 2sc, (4dc in one stitch, 5sc) \*13, 4dc in one stitch, 3sc, sl st, turn (127)

39. ch1, 1sc, dec, 2dc2tog, (dec, 3sc, 2dc2tog) \*13, 2sc (85)

40. ch1, (5sc, 4dc in one stitch) \*14, sl st, turn (127)

41. ch1, (2dc2tog, 3sc, dec, 2dc2tog, 1sc, 2dec) \*6, (2dc2tog, 3sc, dec) \*2, sl st, turn (79)

42. ch1, 2sc, 4dc in one stitch, (5sc, 4dc in one stitch) \*12, 3sc, sl st, turn (118)

43. ch1, sc, dec, (2dc2tog, 1sc, 2dec, 2dc2tog, 3sc, dec) \*6, 2dc2tog, 2sc, sl st, turn (73)

44. ch1, (5sc, 4dc in one stitch) \*12, sl st, turn (109)

45. ch1, (2dc2tog, 3sc, dec, 2dc2tog, 1sc, 2dec) \*6, sl st, turn (67)

46. ch1, (4dc in one stitch, 5sc) \*11, sl st, turn (99)

47. ch1, (dec, 3sc, 2dc2tog, 2dec, 1sc, 2dc2tog) \*5, sc, 2dec, 2dc2tog, sl st, turn (61)

48. ch1, 3sc, (4dc in one stitch, 7sc, dec) \*5, 4dc in one stitch, 4sc, dec, sl st, turn (73)

49. ch1, 3sc, dec, (2dc2tog, dec, 4sc, dec) \*5, 2dc2tog, dec, 1sc, sl st, turn (49)



50. ch1, 1sc, (4dc in one stitch, 5sc, dec) \*5, 4dc in one stitch, 4sc, dec, sl st, turn (61)

51. ch1, dec, 1sc, dec, 2dc2tog, (dec, 2sc, dec, 2dc2tog) \*5, 1sc, sl st, turn (37)

52. ch1, (4sc, dec) \*6, sl st, turn (31)

53. ch1, (3sc, dec) \*6, sl st, turn (25)

54. ch1, (2sc, dec) \*6, sl st, turn (19)

55. ch1, (1sc, dec) \*6, sl st, turn (13)

56. 6dec

Fasten off, cut the yarn, hide the end of the thread.



**Insert the inner part into the outer one, aligning the opening.**

**Put a little fiberfill in the lower part of the acorn between the pieces.**

**Attach the beige yarn and connect the pieces along the opening: 68sc.**

**Cut the yarn and fasten off.**



## Handle

With Brown yarn.

1. 6sc in MR

Stuff with fiberfill in the process.

2. -46. 6sc (45 rounds)

Leave a long tail for sewing.



## Doors (make 2)

Crochet 4 pieces in Brown color. Work in rows.

1. Chain 19. Start from the second chain on the hook: 18sc, turn (18)

2.-10. ch1, 18sc, turn (9 rows). Continue crocheting from the second piece.

Cut a rectangle from plastic and put it between two pieces.

Crochet with Brown yarn through both pieces:

16sc, inc in the corner, 10sc, inc in the corner, 16sc, inc in the corner, 10sc, inc in the corner.

Fasten off, cut the yarn, weave in the ends.



**Sew the doors on the sides of the entrance.  
Sew on a button for fastening. Make a button loop on the other  
door. Fasten the doors.**



**Fold the handle in half and sew it into the center of the top brown part  
of the acorn.**



## DECORATION AND DESIGN

### Small leaves (make 2)

Crochet 1 piece in Bright green and 1 piece in Dark green. Work in rounds.

1. Ch16. Start from the second chain on the hook: 3sc, 3hdc, 8dc, 6dc in the last chain, 8dc, 3hdc, 3sc (34)

2. Ch4, Start from the second chain on the hook: 3sl st, sl st, sc, hdc, dc, (3dc, ch3, sl st in the first chain), sc, 2hdc, dc, (3dc, ch4, sl st in the first chain), 2sc, 2hdc, 6dc-inc, 2hdc, 2sc, (sl st, ch4, 3dc in one stitch), dc, 2hdc, sc, (sl st, ch3, 3dc in one stitch), dc, hdc, sc, sl st.

Leave a long tail for sewing.



## Big leaves (make 2)

Crochet 1 piece in Bright green and 1 piece in Light green.  
Work in rounds.

Work in rounds.

1. Ch22. Start from the second chain on the hook: 5sc, 7hdc, 8dc, 6dc in the last chain, 8dc, 7hdc, 5sc (46)

2. Ch5, Start from the second chain on the hook: 4sl st, 2sc, hdc, dc, (3dc, ch3, sl st in the first chain), sl st, 2sc, hdc, dc, (3dc, ch4, sl st in the first chain), sl st, sc, hdc, 2dc, (3dc, ch4, sl st in the first chain), sl st, sc, hdc, 6dc-inc, hdc, sc, sl st, (sl st, ch4, 3dc in one stitch), 2dc, hdc, sc, sl st, (sl st, ch4, 3dc in one stitch), dc, hdc, 2sc, sl st, (sl st, ch3, 3dc in one stitch), dc, hdc, 2sc.

Leave a long tail for sewing.



**Sew the big leaves around the handle first, then sew the small leaves over the big leaves.**
