## What you need to know about this pattern

- The approximate size of Hermione Granger is about 9 inch / 22.5 cm.  
and the approximate size of Crookshanks is about 2.6 inch / 6.5 cm.  
(It's depend on the yarn and the crochet hook that you use)
- The most parts of the pattern are crocheted in continuous rounds. You should place a stitch marker in the last stitch of each round or use different color yarn instead.
- Crochet every stitches tightly to avoid small holes.
- Use 'invisible decrease' instead of 'normal decrease' to make your doll neater.
- Use half - color change crochet technique to make your doll have clean color.
- Stuff the doll with polyester fiberfill firmly to make your doll look more beautiful.

## 1. ARMS

2.5 mm. crochet hook

### • Left arm

Begin with skin yarn.

Rnd 1: Make magic ring 6 sc **(6)**

Rnd 2: (Sc 1, inc) x 3 **(9)**

Rnd 3: Sc in each st around **(9)**

Rnd 4: Sc 3, puff stitch, sc 1, inv dec, sc 2 **(8)**

Rnd 5-19 (15 rnds): (Grey) sc in each st  
around **(8)** - Stuff the arm with fiberfill

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.

### • Right arm

Begin with skin yarn.

Rnd 1: Make magic ring 6 sc **(6)**

Rnd 2: (Sc 1, inc) x 3 **(9)**

Rnd 3: Sc in each st around **(9)**

Rnd 4: Inv dec, sc 1, puff stitch, sc 5 **(8)**

Rnd 5-19 (15 rnds): (Grey) sc in each st  
around **(8)** - Stuff the arm with fiberfill

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.



### How to crochet a puff stitch



Wrap the yarn over the hook.



Insert the hook into the next stitch.



Yarn over again and draw up a loop.



You should have three loops on your hook.



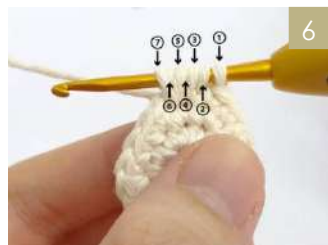
Yarn over and draw it through all the loops.



You have finished a puff stitch!



Yarn over and insert your hook through the same stitch, yarn over and then draw up another loop.



Repeat the previous step until you have seven loops on your hook.

## 2. INNER NECK

2.25 mm. crochet hook

Begin with skin yarn.

Rnd 1: Make magic ring 6 sc **(6)**

Rnd 2-10 (9 rnds): Sc in each st around **(6)**

Fasten off. Stuff the inner neck with fiberfill  
firmly and leave a long tail for sewing.



Using a yarn needle weave the yarn tail through the front loop of each remaining stitch and pull tight to close.

### 3. LEGS & BODY

2.5 mm. crochet hook

Make 2 legs, begin the left leg with black yarn and make 7 chains.

- Left leg

Rnd 1: Start in the 2nd chain from hook, then crochet inc, sc 4, sc 5 in same stitch, sc 4, inc (17)

Rnd 2: Sc 1, inc, sc 4, inc x 5, sc 4, inc, sc 1 (24)

Rnd 3: **(BLO)** sc in each st around (24)

Rnd 4: Sc in each st around (24)

Rnd 5: Sc 7, inv dec x 5, sc 7 (19)

Change color to grey yarn.

Rnd 6: Sc 5, inv dec x 2, sc 1, inv dec x 2, sc 5 (15)

Rnd 7: Sc 3, hdc dec x 2, hdc 1, hdc dec x 2, sc 3 (11) - Stuff the leg with fiberfill.

Rnd 8-10 (3 rnds): sc in each st around (11)

Rnd 11: Inc, sc 10 (12)

Rnd 12: Sc in each st around (12)

Rnd 13: Sc 1, inc, sc 10 (13)

Rnd 14: Sc in each st around (13)

Rnd 15: Sc 2, **change color to skin yarn**, **(BLO)** inv dec, sc 9 (12)

Rnd 16: **(BLO)** sc 2, (crochet both loops) sc 10 (12)

Rnd 17: Sc 2, inv dec, sc 3, inc x 3, sc 2 (14)

Rnd 18: Sc 2, inc, sc 3, inv dec x 3, sc 2 (12)

Rnd 19: Sc 2, inc, sc 9 (13)

Rnd 20: Sc in each st around (13)

Rnd 21: Sc 5, inc, sc 4, inc, sc 2 (15)

Rnd 22-23 (2 rnds): Sc in each st around (15)

Rnd 24: Sc 5, **(white)** sc 10 (15)

Fasten off and cut the yarn. Stuff the left leg with polyester fiberfill.

- Right leg

Make the right leg same as the left leg rnd 1- rnd 24 and stuff the right leg with polyester fiberfill but don't cut the yarn, we will continue to the body part after finished the shoe soles.

- Sole of shoes



Make 2 soles and use black yarn to make 7 chains.

Rnd 1: Start in the 2nd chain from hook, then crochet inc, sc 4, sc 5 in same stitch, sc 4, inc (17)

Rnd 2: Sc 1, inc, sc 4, inc x 5, sc 4, inc, sc 1 (24)

Slip stitch the sole and base of shoes (FLO on rnd 3 of the leg) together. (Pic 3.1 - 3.3)



Continue to crochet the body part. Starting from the right leg.

Rnd 25: Sc 9, ch 3 (Pic 3.4)

Join both legs onto the body.

Start 1st sc on the 2nd stitch of the left leg, (The left leg) sc 15, sc 3 in chains, (The right leg) sc 15, sc 3 in another side of the chains (36) and mark a new beginning point with stitch marker or different yarn color.

(Pic 3.5 - 3.9) (Please see how to join both legs onto the body diagram on page 6)

Rnd 26: Sc in each st around (36)

Rnd 27: Sc 7, inv dec, sc 16, inv dec, sc 9 (34)

Rnd 28: Sc in each st around (34)

Change color to grey yarn.

Rnd 29: Sc in each st around (34)

Rnd 30: (BLO) sc 6, inv dec, sc 15, inv dec, sc 9 (32)

Change color to red yarn.

Rnd 31: Sc in each st around (32)

Change color to grey yarn.

Rnd 32: Sc in each st around (32)

Rnd 33: Sc 6, inv dec, sc 14, inv dec, sc 8 (30)

Rnd 34-35 (2 rnds): Sc in each st around (30)

Rnd 36: Sc 6, inv dec, sc 13, inv dec, sc 7 (28)

Rnd 37: Sc in each st around (28)

Rnd 38: Sc 6, inv dec, sc 11, inv dec, sc 7 (26)

Rnd 39: Sc 5, inv dec, sc 11, inv dec, sc 6 (24)

Join both arms onto the body.

Rnd 40: (The body) sc 5, (The left arm) start at the 2nd stitch on the left arm and sc 7, (Skip last stitch on the left arm), (Skip 1 stitch on the body), (The body) sc 11, (The right arm) start at the 6th stitch on the right arm and sc 7, (Skip last stitch on the right arm), (Skip 1 stitch on the body), (The body) sc 6 (36) (Pic 3.10 - 3.14) (Please see how to join both arms onto the body diagram on page 7)

Rnd 41: Sc 2, inv dec, (sc 4, inv dec) x 2, sc 1, (white) sc 2, (grey) sc 1, inv dec, (sc 4, inv dec) x 2, sc 2 (30)

Rnd 42: (Grey) sc 13, (white) sc 4, (grey) sc 13 (30)

Rnd 43: (Grey) (sc 3, inv dec) x 2, sc 2, (white) sc 1, inv dec, sc 3, (grey) inv dec, (sc 3, inv dec) x 2 (24)

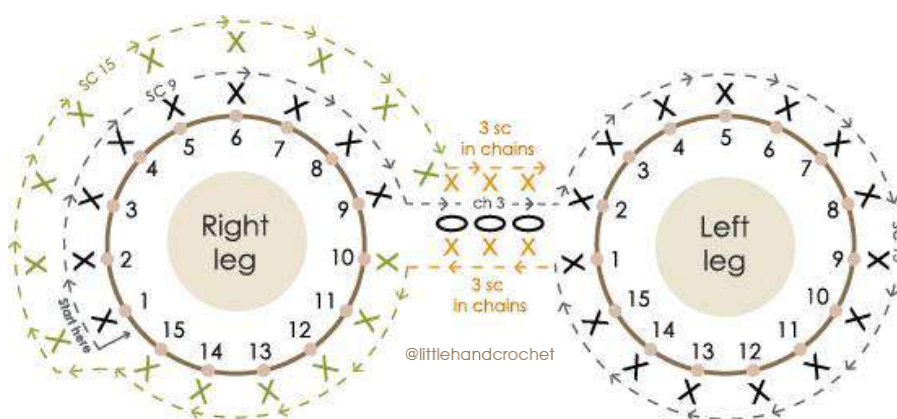
Rnd 44: (White) (sc 2, inv dec) x 6 (18)

Rnd 45: (White) (sc 1, inv dec) x 6 (12)

Rnd 46: (Skin) (BLO) (sc 4, inv dec) x 2 (10)

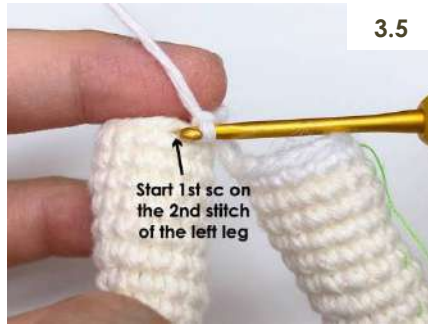
Rnd 47-48 (2 rnds): (Skin) sc in each st around (10) (Pic 3.15)

Make a shirt collar before starting the head. *(Use 1.6 mm. crochet hook)*

**Step 1:** Use yellow embroidery thread to make a surface crochet around the white part. After you finished, you may use red embroidery thread to make a surface crochet follow under the yellow thread. If you need more description please see [\(Pic 3.16 - 3.27\)](#)



**Step 2:** Make the necktie with red yarn and sew yellow thread over the red yarn. [\(Pic 3.28 - 3.30\)](#)  
*(Caution: Not to make the knot over the front loop)*



**Step 3:** *(Use 2.25 mm. crochet hook)* Locate the center point on rnd 46 of the body. Then use different thread color or stitch marker to mark the point. Hold the body upside down and use white yarn to start 1st sc on that point. [\(Pic 3.31 - 3.32\)](#)

Rnd 1: Ch 1, (sc 2, inc) x 2, sc 1, inc, sc 2, inc, sc 1, sc 1 in same st as the 1st sc, turn **(17)**

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc 8, inc, sc 8 **(18)**

Fasten off and weave in the yarn end. [\(Pic 3.33\)](#)

**Step 4:** Put the inner neck part into the body.

Rnd 70: (Sc 3, inv dec) x 6 **(24)**

Rnd 71: Sc 1, inv dec, (sc 2, inv dec) x 5, sc 1 **(18)**

Rnd 72: (Sc 1, inv dec) x 6 **(12)**

Rnd 73: Inv dec x 6 **(6)**

Finish stuffing the head firmly. Fasten off and leaving a long tail for sewing. Using a yarn needle weave the yarn tail through the front loop of each remaining stitch and pull tight to close. [\(Pic 3.35\)](#)

Continue to crochet the body part.

Rnd 49: **(FLO)** inc x 10 **(20)**

Rnd 50: (Sc 1, inc) x 10 **(30)**

Rnd 51: Sc 2, inc, (sc 4, inc) x 5, sc 2 **(36)**

Rnd 52: (Sc 5, inc) x 6 **(42)**

Rnd 53: Sc 3, inc, (sc 6, inc) x 5, sc 3 **(48)**

Rnd 54: (Sc 7, inc) x 6 **(54)**

Rnd 55-65 (11 rnds): Sc in each st around **(54)**

Rnd 66: (Sc 7, inv dec) x 6 **(48)**

Rnd 67: Sc 3, inv dec, (sc 6, inv dec) x 5, sc 3 **(42)**

Rnd 68: (Sc 5, inv dec) x 6 **(36)**

Rnd 69: Sc 2, inv dec, (sc 4, inv dec) x 5, sc 2 **(30)**

Stuff the head with fiberfill. *(If you use safety eyes, please insert them at this point and see page 17 for the placement)*

Sew the remaining yarn under the arms to close the gap between the arm and the body. (Pic 3.36 - 3.37)



## 4. EARS

2.25 mm. crochet hook

Make 2 ears and use skin yarn to make 2 chains.

Rnd 1: Start in the 2nd chain from hook, then crochet [sc 1, hdc 2, sc 1 in same stitch] (4)

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.



Rnd 1-3 (3 rnds): Ch 1, sc 32, slst (32)

Fasten off and leaving a long tail for sewing.

(Pic 5.5) Sew rnd 1 and the back loop of rnd 32 together. (Pic 5.6 - 5.7) Put the skirt onto the body, then sew it and the front loop of rnd 30 of the body together. (Pic 5.8 - 5.14)

Use yellow thread make a surface crochet between rnds 31 and 32. After that, use grey yarn make a surface crochet between rnds 29 and 30. (Pic 5.15)

## 5. SKIRT

2.25 mm. crochet hook

Leave dark grey yarn about 10 cm before make the chain, then make 9 chains.

Rnd 1: Start in the 2nd chain from hook, then crochet sc 5, hdc 3, turn (8)

Rnd 2: Ch 2, (BLO), hdc 6, sc 2, turn (8)

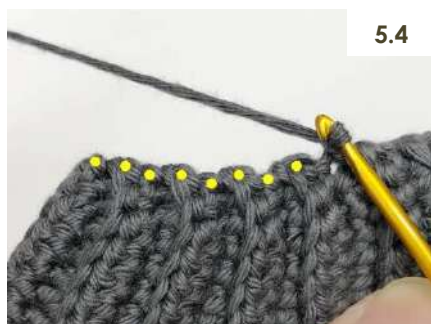
Rnd 3: Ch 1, (BLO), sc 5, hdc 3, turn (8)

Repeat rounds 2 and 3 until you have 31 rounds.

Rnd 32: Ch 2, (BLO), hdc 6, sc 2 (8) (Pic 5.1)

Slst to join the 1st stitch of rnd 1 to form loop and start to crochet the edge of skirt.

## 6. GRYFFINDOR ROBE

2.5 mm. crochet hook

Use black yarn to make 35 chains.

Rnd 1: Start 1st hdc in the 3rd chain from hook and crochet hdc in each remaining chain, turn **(33)**

Rnd 2: Ch 5, then starting on the 33rd stitch of rnd 1, (hdc inc, hdc 15) x 2, hdc inc, turn **(36)** (Pic 6.1 - 6.2)

Rnd 3: Ch 2, hdc inc, hdc 31, (yellow) hdc 1, (red) hdc 1, (black) hdc 1, hdc inc, turn **(38)**

Rnd 4: Ch 1, inc, sc 1, (yellow) sc 1, (red) sc 1, (black) sc 2, ch 6, skip 8 sts, sc 10, ch 6, skip 8 sts, sc 5, inc, turn **(24)** (Pic 6.3 - 6.5)



Rnd 5: Ch 2, hdc 7, hdc 6 in chains, hdc 10, hdc 6 in chains, hdc 7, turn **(36)**

Rnd 6: Ch 2, hdc inc, hdc 34, hdc inc, turn **(38)**

Rnd 7: Ch 2, hdc in each st around, turn **(38)**

Rnd 8: Ch 2, hdc inc, hdc 36, hdc inc, turn **(40)**

Rnd 9: Ch 2, hdc in each st around, turn **(40)**

Rnd 10: Ch 2, hdc inc, hdc 38, hdc inc, turn **(42)**

Rnd 11: Ch 2, hdc in each st around, turn **(42)**

Rnd 12: Ch 2, hdc inc, hdc 40, hdc inc, turn

**(44)**

Rnd 13: Ch 2, hdc in each st around, turn **(44)**

Rnd 14: Ch 2, hdc inc, hdc 42, hdc inc, turn

**(46)**

Rnd 15: Ch 2, hdc in each st around, turn **(46)**

Rnd 16: Ch 2, hdc inc, hdc 44, hdc inc, turn

**(48)**

Rnd 17: Ch 2, hdc in each st around, turn **(48)**

Rnd 18: Ch 2, hdc inc, hdc 46, hdc inc, turn

**(50)**

Rnd 19: Ch 2, hdc in each st around, turn **(50)**

Rnd 20: Ch 1, inc, sc 48, inc, turn **(52)**

Rnd 21: Ch 1, sc 4, hdc 4, dc 4, tr 28, dc 4,

hdc 4, sc 4, turn **(52)**

Rnd 22: Ch 1, inc, sc 4, hdc 4, dc 3, dc inc,

dc 6, dc inc, dc 12, dc inc, dc 6,

dc inc, dc 3, hdc 4, sc 4, inc **(58)**

Fasten off and weave in the yarn end.

• **Sleeves** (use 2.25 mm. crochet hook)

Using a new black yarn start at the left corner of each sleeve. [\(Pic 6.7 - 6.10\)](#)

Rnd 1: Ch 2, hdc 18, slst **(18)**

Rnd 2: Ch 2, hdc in each st around, slst **(18)**

Rnd 3: Ch 2, hdc 13, hdc inc, hdc 1, hdc inc, hdc 2, slst **(20)**

Rnd 4: Ch 2, hdc in each st around, slst **(20)**

Rnd 5: Ch 2, hdc 13, hdc inc, hdc 2, hdc inc, hdc 3, slst **(22)**

Rnd 6: Ch 2, hdc in each st around, slst **(22)**

Rnd 7: Ch 2, hdc 13, hdc inc, hdc 3, hdc inc, hdc 4, slst **(24)**

Rnd 8: Ch 2, hdc in each st around, slst **(24)**

Rnd 9: Ch 1, sc in each st around, slst **(24)**

Rnd 10: Ch 2, dc 16, hdc 2, sc 4, hdc 2, slst **(24)**

Fasten off and weave in the yarn end. Sew 5 mm black bead between rnds 2 and 3 on the right side of the robe. [\(Pic 6.11 - 6.12\)](#)

## 7. SCARF

2.25 mm. crochet hook

Use red yarn to make 6 chains.

Rnd 1: Start in the 3rd chain from hook and crochet hdc in each remaining chain, turn **(4)**

Rnd 2: Ch 2, hdc in each st around, turn **(4)**

Change color to yellow yarn.

Rnd 3-4 (2 rnds): Ch 2, hdc in each st around, turn **(4)**

Change color to red yarn.

Rnd 5-6 (2 rnds): Ch 2, hdc in each st around,



turn **(4)**

Repeat rounds 3 to 6 until you have 50 rounds (25 stripes). Make sure that the start and the end on the same color stripes. Fasten off and weave in the yarn end.

### • Tassels

Adding 4 tassels for both end edge of the scarf. (Pic 7.1 - 7.6)

Cut two 8 cm lengths of yellow yarn and red yarn.



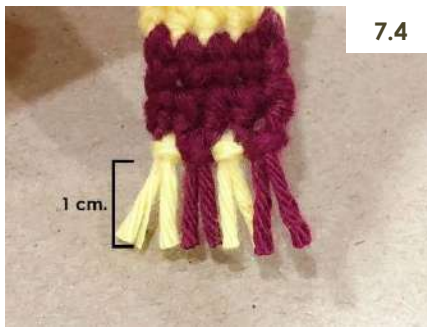

Using one of red yarn fold its lengths in half, draw a loop through scarf.

Then put two other ends through the loop. Pull the red yarn to tight the loop

Repeat step 2 and 3 for the remaining stitches. Keep the length of tassels around 1 cm. and cut the excess yarn.

## 8. HAIRPIECE

2.25 mm. crochet hook

Begin with brown yarn.

Rnd 1: Make magic ring 7 sc (7)

Rnd 2: (BLO) sc 2 in each st around (14)

Rnd 3: (Sc 1, inc) x 7 (21)

Rnd 4: Sc 1, inc, (sc 2, inc) x 6, sc 1 (28)

Don't fasten off, we will start to crochet the hair strand.



### 1ST ROUND OF HAIR

(Total strands of hair for 1st round is 28 strands)

Hair strand	Stitch	Total stitch
1	Ch 42, start in the 3rd chain from hook, hdc 40, flip your work to the wrong side and slst in the 28th stitch of round 4 of the hairpiece. (Wrong side facing up) (Pic 8.1 - 8.6)	40
2 - 16	Ch 42, start in the 3rd chain from hook, hdc 40. (End every hair strand with a slst in the same st of round 4 of the hairpiece)	40
17	Ch 16, start in the 3rd chain from hook, hdc 14. (Slst in the 12th st of round 4 of the hairpiece)	14
18	Ch 42, start in the 3rd chain from hook, hdc 40. (Slst in the 11th st of round 4 of the hairpiece)	40
19 - 26	Ch 13, start in the 3rd chain from hook, hdc 11. (End every hair strand with a slst in the same st of round 4 of the hairpiece)	11
27	Ch 42, start in the 3rd chain from hook, hdc 40. (Slst in the 2nd st of round 4 of the hairpiece)	40
28	Ch 16, start in the 3rd chain from hook, hdc 14. (Slst in the 1st st of round 4 of the hairpiece)	14

Fasten off and weave in the yarn end. (Pic 8.7)

Using a new brown yarn start in front loop at the 7th stitch of round 2 of the hairpiece and crochet in clockwise direction (Wrong side facing up). (Pic 8.8) For 2nd round of hair, we will crochet 2 hair strands in every stitch, slst the 1st hair strand in the same stitch before starting the 2nd hair strand and slst the 2nd hair strand in the next stitch.

## 2ND ROUND OF HAIR

(Total strands of hair for 2nd round is 8 strands)

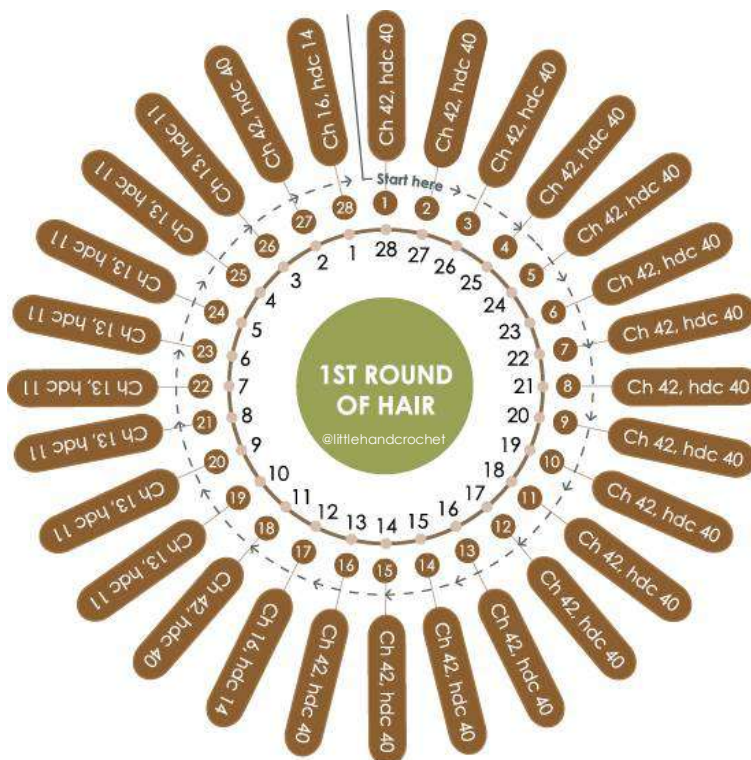
Hair strand	Stitch	Total stitch
1 - 8	Ch 42, start in the 3rd chain from hook, hdc 40, (Hair strand 1, 3, 5 and 7 are slst in the same st) (Hair strand 2, 4, 6 and 8 are slst in the next st)	40

*\* The 1st, 2nd, and 3rd stitches of rnd 2 are not to crochet \**

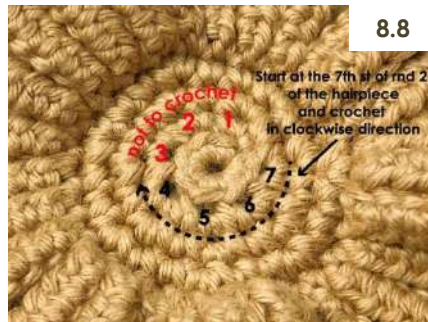
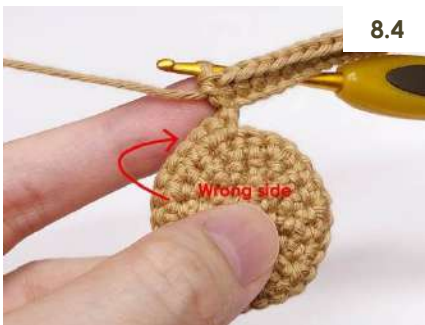
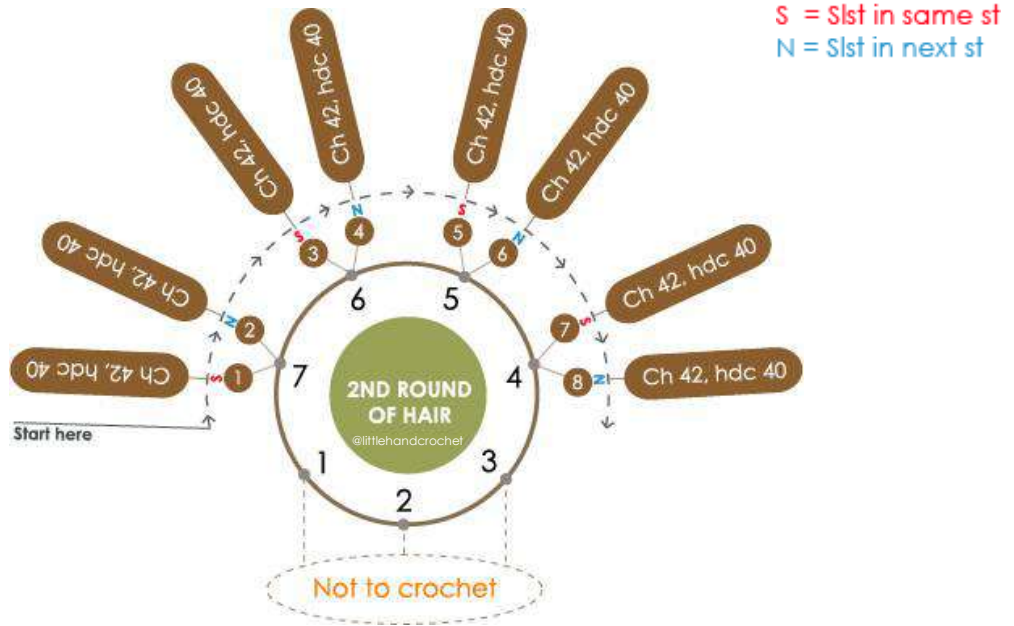

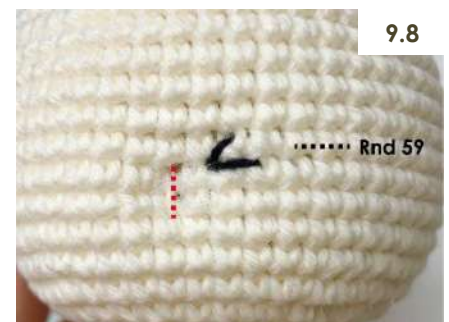
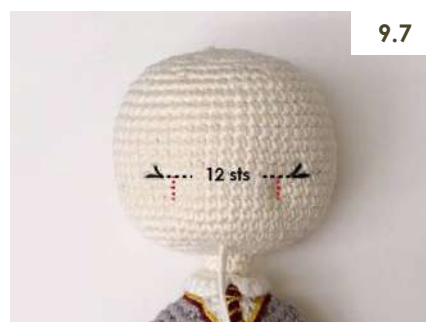
## 9. HOW TO ASSEMBLE & EMBROIDERY

### 1. FACE:

- **Eyes:** Mark point A, B, C, D (Pic 9.1) and thread a needle with skin color yarn and insert it from under the chin, bring it out at [A] (Pic 9.2), push the needle back in at [B] and out at [C] (Pic 9.3), push the needle back again in at [D] and bring it out at the beginning point. (Pic 9.4) Pull tight the yarn to make the indentation for the eye and knot the yarn. (Pic 9.5) The space between two eyes is 10 stitches. (Pic 9.5)



- **Eyelashes:** Embroider the eyelashes on rnd 59 and apart from the eye indentation 1 stitch. The space between two eyelashes is 12 stitches. (Pic 9.6 - 9.8)



- **White eye:** Place 8 mm eye beads on the eye indentation and sew the white of the eyes with white yarn. (Pic 9.9 - 9.11)



- **Eye line:** Sew the eye line above the eyes with black embroidery thread. (Pic 9.12 - 9.14)



- **Nose:** Sew the nose with skin yarn between rnds 55 and 56 and apart from each eyes 4 stitches. Embroider the nose 2 stitches long about 5 times using a horizontal line.

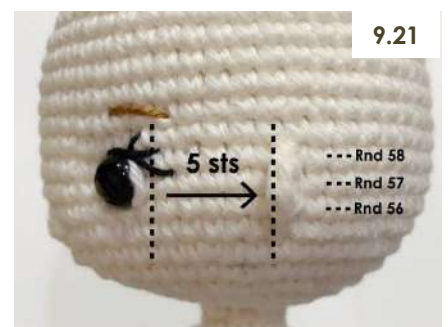
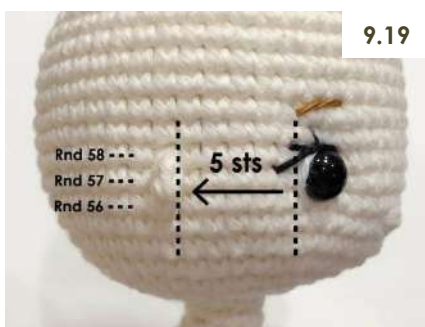

- **Eyebrows:** Sew the eyebrows with orange brown thread above the eye 2 rnds. (Pic 9.16 - 9.18)



- **Ears:** Sew the ears on rnds 56 to 58 (3 rnds) and apart from the eye 5 stitches. (Pic 9.19 - 9.21)



## 2. HAIRPIECE:

Before you glue the hair strand on the head, please arrange and pin every hair strands in the appropriate position then glue it one by one on the head.

- [1st round of hair](#) (Pic 9.22 - 9.27)

- Hair strand 28: Place it above the right ear.
- Hair strand 17: Place it above the left ear.
- Hair strand 1: Place it behind the right ear
- Hair strand 16: Place it behind the left ear
- Hair strand 2-15 (14 strands): Place them between 1st and 16th hair strands for cover the back of the head.
- Hair strand 18: Place it in front of the left ear.
- Hair strand 27: Place it in front of the right ear.
- Hair strand 19-26 (8 strands): Place them on the forehead between 18th and 27th hair strand to make bangs. (The ends of the hair strands are same level as the eyebrows)



- [2nd round of hair](#) (Pic 9.28 - 9.35)

- Hair strand 1: Place it overlap the right ear and 28th hair strand of the 1st round of hair.
- Hair strand 2: Place it between 3rd and 4th hair strands of the 1st round of hair.
- Hair strand 3: Place it between 5th and 6th hair strands of the 1st round of hair.
- Hair strand 4: Place it between 7th and 8th hair strands of the 1st round of hair.
- Hair strand 5: Place it between 9th and 10th hair strands of the 1st round of hair.
- Hair strand 6: Place it between 11th and 12th hair strands of the 1st round of hair.
- Hair strand 7: Place it between 13th and 14th hair strands of the 1st round of hair.
- Hair strand 8: Place it overlap the left ear and 17th hair strand of the 1st round of hair.

**4. SHOE STRIPS:** (Use 2.25 mm. crochet hook) Make 2 shoe strips and use black yarn to make 16 chains. Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing. Sew the shoe strips between rnds 7 and 8 on both legs. (Pic 9.37 - 9.39)

## 10. BOOK

2.25 mm. crochet hook

### • Pages

Make 3 pages and use white yarn to make 7 chains.

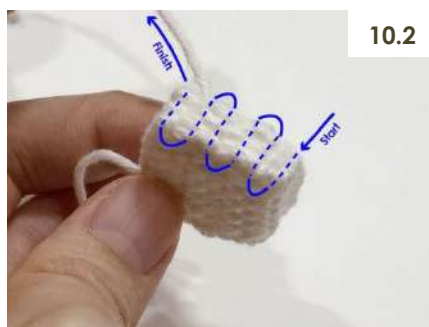
Rnd 1: Start in the 2nd chain from hook, then crochet sc in each remaining chain, turn **(6)**

Rnd 2-6 (5 rnds): Ch 1, sc in each st around, turn **(6)**

Fasten off and weave in the yarn end.

Don't fasten off the last page, leaving a long tail for sewing and sew 3 pages together.

(Pic 10.1 - 10.3)



### • Cover

Use dark brown yarn to make 8 chains.

Rnd 1: Start in the 2nd chain from hook, then crochet sc in each remaining chain, turn **(7)**

Rnd 2-6 (5 rnds): Ch 1, sc in each st around, turn **(7)**

Rnd 7: Ch 3, **(FLO)**, tr in each st around, turn **(7)**

Rnd 8: Ch 1, **(FLO)**, sc in each st around, turn **(7)**

Rnd 9-13 (5 rnds): Ch 1, sc in each st around, turn **(7)**

Fasten off and weave in the yarn end. Glue on rounds 7 and 8 of the cover and put the pages on it. (Pic 10.4 - 10.6)



## 11. CROOKSHANKS THE LITTLE ORANGE CAT

### 1. HEAD

2.25 mm. crochet hook

Begin with orange yarn.

Rnd 1: Make magic ring 6 sc **(6)**

Rnd 2: Sc 2 in each st around **(12)**

Rnd 3: (Sc 1, inc) x 6 **(18)**

Rnd 4: Sc 1, inc, (sc 2, inc) x 5, sc 1 **(24)**

Rnd 5: (Sc 3, inc) x 6 **(30)**

Rnd 6: Sc 2, inc, (sc 4, inc) x 5, sc 2 **(36)**

Rnd 7-11 (5 rnds): Sc in each st around **(36)**

Rnd 12: Sc 2, inv dec, (sc 4, inv dec) x 5,  
sc 2 **(30)**

Rnd 13: (Sc 3, inv dec) x 6 **(24)**

Stuff the head with fiberfill.

Rnd 14: Sc 1, inv dec, (sc 2, inv dec) x 5,  
sc 1 **(18)**



Rnd 15: (Sc 1, inv dec) x 6 **(12)**

Rnd 16: Inv dec x 6 **(6)**

Finish stuffing the head firmly. Fasten off and leaving a long tail for sewing. Using a yarn needle weave the yarn tail through the front loop of each remaining st and pull tight to close.

### 2. EARS

2.25 mm. crochet hook

Make 2 ears, begin with orange yarn.

Rnd 1: Make magic ring 6 sc **(6)**

Rnd 2: (Sc 1, inc) x 3 **(9)**

Rnd 3: Sc 1, inc, (sc 2, inc) x 2, sc 1 **(12)**

Fasten off and leaving a long tail for sewing.



### 3. FRONT LEGS

2.25 mm. crochet hook

Make 2 front legs, begin with orange yarn.

Rnd 1: Make magic ring 4 sc **(4)**

Rnd 2: (Sc 1, inc) x 2 **(6)**

Rnd 3: Inc, sc 5 **(7)**

Rnd 4: Inc, inv dec, sc 4 **(7)**

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.



## 4. BODY

2.25 mm. crochet hook

Begin with orange yarn.

Rnd 1: Make magic ring 6 sc (6)

Rnd 2: Sc 2 in each st around (12)

Rnd 3: (Sc 1, inc) x 6 (18)

Rnd 4: Sc 1, inc, (sc 2, inc) x 5, sc 1 (24)

Rnd 5-6 (2 rnds): Sc in each st around (24)

Join both front legs onto the body.

Rnd 7: (Sc 2, inv dec) x 2, sc 2, (the 1st leg) start at the 1st stitch on the 1st leg and sc 5, (skip last 2 sts on the 1st leg), (skip 2 sts on the body), (the body) sc 1, (the 2nd leg) start at the 1st stitch on the 2nd leg and sc 5, (skip last 2 sts on the 2nd leg), (skip 2 sts on the

body), (sc 2, inv dec) x 2, sc 1 (26)

(Pic 4.1 - 4.2) (Please see how to join both front legs onto the body diagram on page 24)

Rnd 8: (Sc 3, inv dec) x 2, (sc 2, inv dec) x 2, sc 3, inv dec, sc 3 (21)

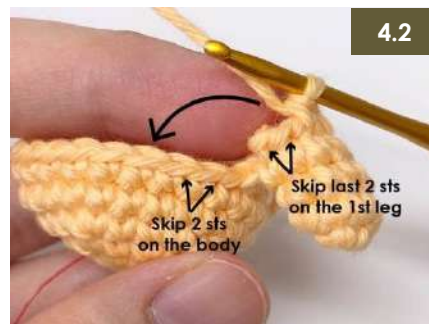
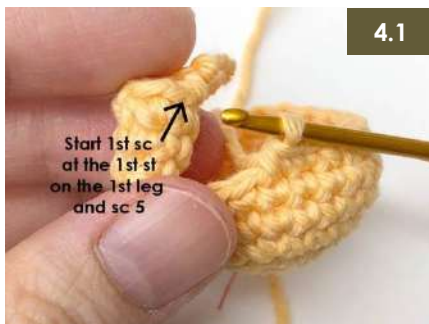
Rnd 9: Sc in each st around (21)

Stuff both front legs slightly with fiberfill.

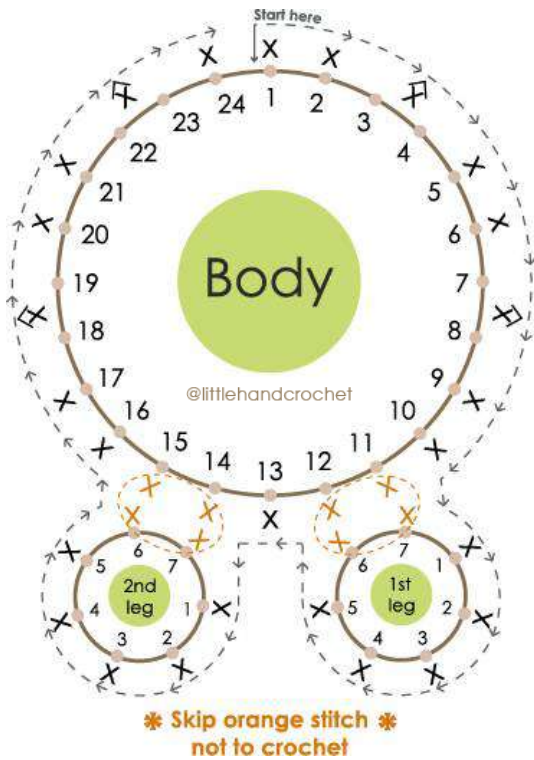
Rnd 10: (Sc 5, inv dec) x 3 (18)

Rnd 11: (Sc 1, inv dec) x 6 (12)

Finish stuffing the body firmly. Fasten off and leaving a long tail for sewing. Sew the remaining yarn under the front legs to close the gap between the leg and the body. (Pic 4.3 - 4.4) Sew both front legs onto the body on round 5 and pull them tight together. (Pic 4.5 - 4.9)



How to join both front legs onto the body diagram



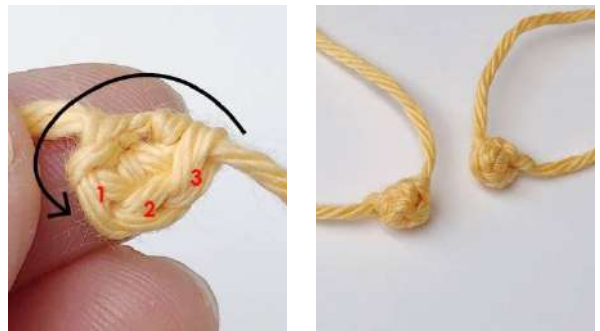
## 5. BACK LEGS

2.25 mm. crochet hook

Make 2 back legs and use orange yarn to make 2 chains.

Rnd 1: Start in the 2nd chain from hook, then crochet [(sc 1, hdc 1, sc 1) in same st] (3)

Fasten off and leaving a long tail for sewing. Using a yarn needle weave the yarn tail through the front loop of each remaining st and pull tight to close.



## 6. TAIL

2.25 mm. crochet hook

Begin with orange yarn.

Rnd 1: Make magic ring 5 sc (5)

Rnd 2-14 (13 rnds): Sc in each st around (5)

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.

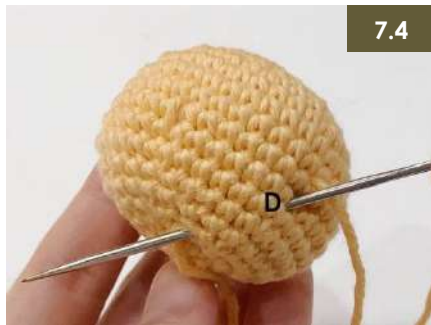
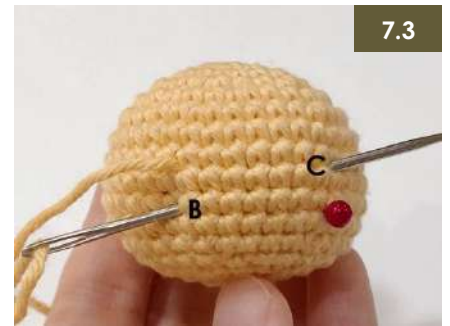
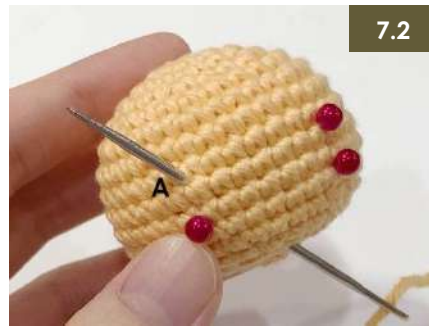
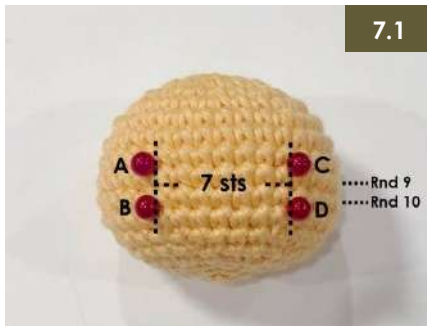


## 7. HOW TO ASSEMBLE & EMBROIDERY

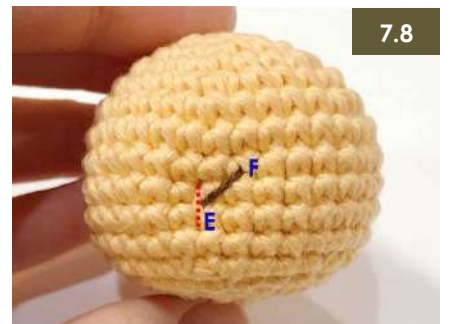
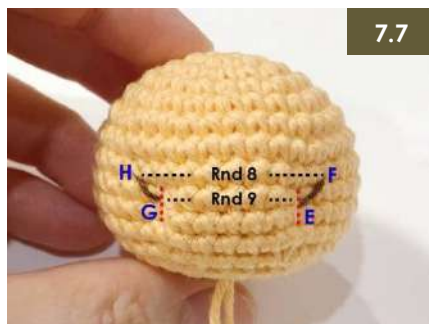
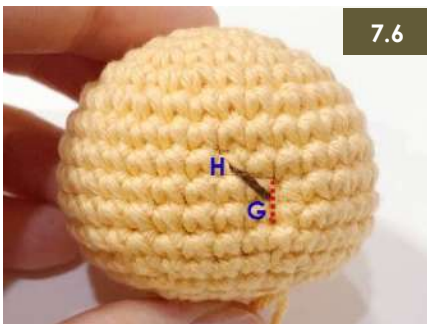
### 1. FACE:

- **Eyes:** Mark point A, B, C, D (Pic 7.1) thread a needle with orange color yarn and insert it from under the chin, bring it out at [A] (Pic 7.2), push the needle back in at [B] and out at [C] (Pic 7.3), push the needle back again in at [D] and bring it out at the beginning point. (Pic 7.4) Pull tight the yarn to make the indentation for the eye and knot the yarn.

The space between two eyes is 5 stitches. (Pic 7.5)



- **Eyelashes:** Thread a needle with dark brown thread and insert it from under the chin, bring it out at [E], push the needle back in at [F] and out at [G], push the needle back again in at [H] and bring it out at the beginning point. (Pic 7.6 – 7.8)



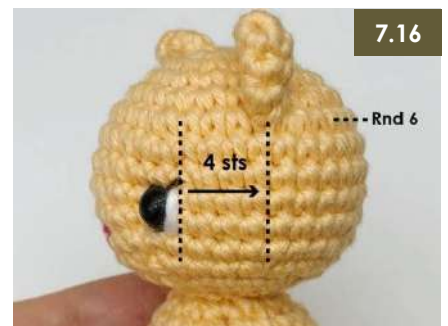
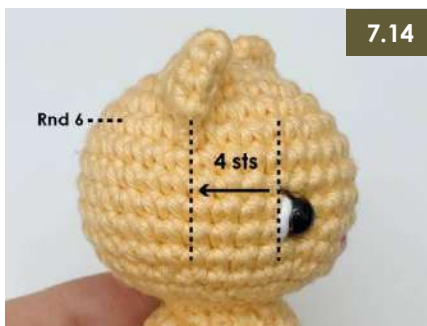
- **White eye:** Place 6 mm eye beads on the eye indentation and sew the white of the eyes with white yarn. (Pic 7.9 - 7.11)



- **Nose:** Sew the nose with pink thread between rounds 10 and 11 (same level as the bottom line of the eyes) and apart from each eyes 3 stitches. Embroider the nose about 5 times using a horizontal line. Additionally, make a vertical line from the middle of the nose 1 rounds down. (Pic 7.12) Sew the head carefully onto the body. (Pic 7.13)

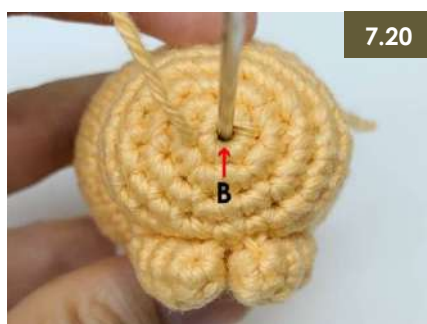
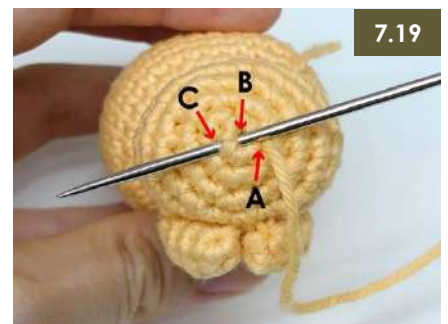
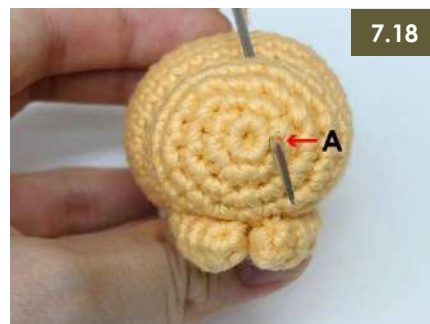


- **Ears:** Sew the ears on rounds 3 to 6 (4 rnds) and apart from the eye 4 sts. (Pic 7.14 - 7.16)



**2. BODY:** Make the bottom indentation for standing easier. Thread a needle with orange yarn and insert it from back of the body, bring it out at [A], push the needle back in at [B] and out at [C], push the needle back again in at [B] and bring it out at the beginning point. Pull tight the yarn to make the indentation for the bottom and knot the yarn.

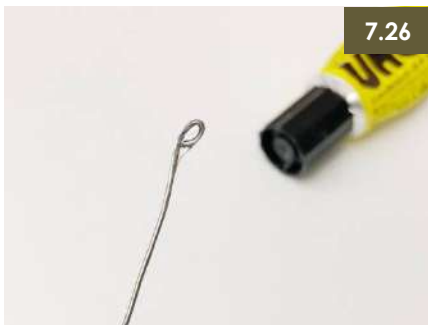

**3. BACK LEGS:** Sew the back legs on round 5 (same round as the front legs) and apart from the front legs 1 stitch. (Pic 7.23 - 7.25)



**4. TAIL:** Bend the ends of the soft wire and glue it. Insert the soft wire into the tail and cut off the excess wire. Sew the tail on round 3 of the body and bend it in 'S' curve. (Pic 7.26 - 7.30)
